Dear Governor Sununu:

This is to thank you for meeting with me yesterday evening, and to respond to your request that I suggest a few specific positions in which I would be interested.

As you suggested, I am thinking in terms of the structure of the White House staff as it has existed during the Reagan years. I understand that some of the jobs I am listing may not exist in the Bush administration, and that others may have already been filled. Also, although I've tried not to be presumptuous, I may be listing some position for which there are others more qualified than myself.

I've asked acquaintances who are more familiar with the White House staff than I am to suggest positions in which one might make a difference in terms of policy and in which someone like me -- a lawyer who has devoted a lot of study over the years to a variety of policy concerns, primarily domestic -- would not be duplicating the functions of the White House Counsel's office or interfering with the effectiveness of that office. I've come up with the following ideas:

1) Deputy Assistant to the President for Domestic Policy. Ken Cribb held a similar position at the level of Assistant to the President, a rank which I understand is an unrealistic aspiration for me. But the functions of that office -- reporting to the Chief of Staff on a wide range of domestic policy concerns -- are just what I've had in mind. If these functions could be given to a person of lower rank than Cribb had, I would be most interested.


2) Staff Secretary. I understand this to be primarily an "Operations" rather than a "policy" position, but that it is a key position whose occupant does have responsibility for helping to ensure that the President and the Chief of Staff have the information they need prior to making policy decisions.

3) Deputy Assistant to the President for Legal Policy Development. This is the position in the Office of Policy Development that I believe you mentioned last night. Mike Uhlmann held it during most of the Reagan years.

4-5) Deputy Cabinet Secretary or Executive Director of the Domestic Policy Council. I think you may have been referring to one of these positions when you discussed working on policy issues with the Secretary to the Cabinet. I understand that at different times during the last eight years each of these two positions has been (and at other times has not been) important to the development of domestic policy. Depending on how the cabinet staff is structured, either would be appealing to me.

Again, I appreciate your taking the time to meet with me. I look forward to seeing you again after the first of the year.

Re: a major process/personnel point, and a few short term specifics

You will need regular information to protect you from problems in the conservative community. In your own interest, let me suggest a specific mechanism by which, as the volume of paper buries you at the White House, you can stay on top of developments in the various "outside" groups.

You need one staffer whose portfolio is primarily the care and feeding and motivating of conservatives (I've written you about one such possible person, Grover Joseph Rees). This person's mandate should be to prevent you from ever being blind-sided the way people in the movement sometimes blind-sided the current occupants. Occasionally this was simply ill-will on the part of some of our people. Much more frequently it happened because, at the White House, little ongoing attention was devoted to understanding what things were "permanent" with conservatives, much less to monitoring what was hot with conservatives, what they cared about "this week", and how to keep them on-line with the President. To fill this position you need someone loyal to you but with whom your fellow conservatives feel comfortable. This person will need the ability to get things to you quickly, and the smarts to realize what things must move instantly and what things can wait for the next regular meeting with you. This person needs to be a multi-issue conservative with, however, sufficient breadth to elevate the unifying issues, such as judicial selection and the related pro-life questions.

As for short-term specifics:

1. Our mutual friend Peter Thomas would very much like to come to Washington for the right kind of position.
2. The White House legislative operation was a disaster throughout the Reagan years. Other than the foregoing point on having your own personal conservative "handler" there is no greater service that could be performed for the President-elect than to put in place an operation that is simultaneously loyal to Bush (rather than to Congress) and willing to play hard ball for the things Bush and you believe in.




