EARLY CHILDHOOD MUSIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

Mr. John Smith, a Massachusetts music educator, is planning a Preschool Music Program for age appropriate children. He has just returned from an intensive program at Vandercook Music College, Chicago, Illinois. The concepts involved were initiated in Hungary by Zoltan Koday¹ and promoted in the United States by Dr. Edwin Gordon²; and have grown into an American folk song musical and movement program.

Dr. John Feierabend, Instructor, recently completed this intensive course based upon the works of both Koday and Gordon. The program encourages children to playfully sing, listen, dance and play through a carefully planned course of skills and objectives. Most activities are language based and involve American folk songs and stories with the emphasis on musical concepts and music appreciation; not music instruction.

A presentation at Silver Lake Regional Junior High School, Pembroke, Massachusetts by Dr. Feierabend, on Saturday, October 13, 1990, 9:30 a.m., and a demonstration by preschoolers will be interesting as well as entertaining.

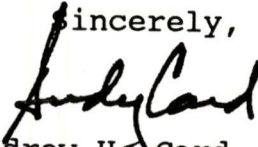

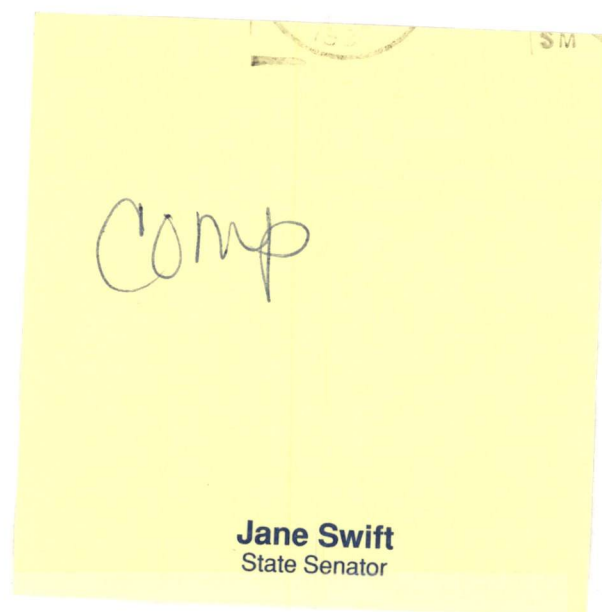

Now we have to work for Bill Weld and Paul! John Silber is going to be a strong campaigner so Bill and Paul will have to energize their organizations to get out the vote. I wrote a note to Ron Kaufman to see if I could give some additional help.

When I was on our Annual Pilgrimage last May to Lourdes, France with our sick, I spoke to the Grand Master of our Order about visiting the United States and meeting the President in Washington.

As you know, the Order of Malta is a chivalric religious order dating from the First Crusade in the 12th Century and is composed of Catholic leaders in the major countries of the world. Although the Order has no diplomatic relations with the United States, it has with forty-six other nations in the world.

The Grand Master, His Most Eminent Highness Frá Andrew Bertie, is Scottish by birth and is a direct descendant from Mary, Queen of Scotland. A former member of the Scottish Guards, an outstanding man and a strong friend of the United States.

We tentatively were considering the period between April 18th and April 22nd, 1991 for the Grand Master's visit and would like to know how to arrange it. I thought that a luncheon at the White House or at Blair House would be appropriate for this dignitary. The publicity would be worldwide and most favorable to the President.

Please let me have your advice, Andy, on this subject at your convenience. I am leaving on September 28th for South Africa and Europe and will be back in Washington on October 24th.

Dear Jackie,

I enjoyed talking with you yesterday, it seems as though a lifetime has passed since the Governor's last year in Concord. I can only imagine how hectic things must get in that office, so I appreciate you taking the time to talk with me. As we discussed, I am currently working for Justice Thayer on the New Hampshire Supreme Court. It is a one year position, which necessarily means that I must make plans for next year this fall.

Because I want to continue working in the public sector and have become interested in criminal law, I have applied to the Justice Department's Honor Program. This program is highly competitive and serves as the premier entry level attorney recruitment program for the Justice Department. A great many judicial law clerks, like myself, apply for the limited number of openings currently available. It is a career path that I am extremely serious about following, otherwise I would not be writing for your help.

My application has already been received and the interviewing process begins the 29th of October. The only phone number that is given to applicants belongs to the Office of Attorney Personnel Management at 202 - 514 - 3396. They may ask you which division I have applied to, and if that question arises, tell the Office that I applied to the Criminal, Civil and the Environment & Natural Resources Division in that order of preference. Edward Dennis, Jr. is the Assistant Attorney General for the Criminal Division, Stuart Gerson heads the Civil Division and Richard Stewart is the Assistant Attorney General in charge of the Environment and Natural Resources Division. Outside of that phone number I really do not have any information as to how the Department makes its selections or who reviews the applications. Again, anything that the Governor can do in this regard would be extremely appreciated.

If there are any questions please give me a call. I have enclosed my resume just to let the Governor know what I have been up to since I left his employ. He may get a question or two on that subject. Thanks again Jackie. If you and Steve ever make it back to New Hampshire please give me a call. Otherwise, maybe I will see you in D.C. next year.
