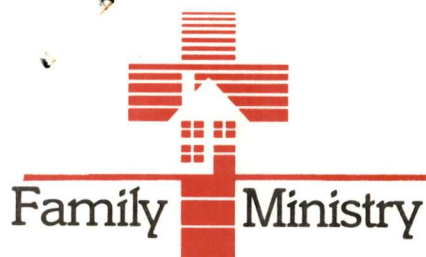
I'm a conservative who voted for you, campaigned for you, a lifelong Republican, a precinct chairman, and Christian.

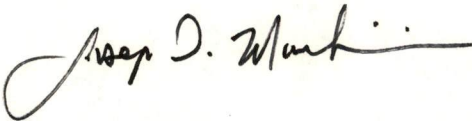
