U.S.S.R. SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 9-14

THE CHIEF of STAFF
has seen

Secretary Baker and I are leading a business development mission to the Soviet Union during September 9-14. We will visit Moscow and Leningrad. We will call on President Gorbachev and leading Soviet government ministers. The objective of the mission is to increase non-military trade and investment with the U.S.S.R.

This mission is the first Presidential designated mission under the Trade Promotion Coordinating Committee announced May 23, 1990. Our group will include CEOs from leading U.S. companies in four industry areas: energy, transportation, housing and food/food processing. At present, the CEOs include:
