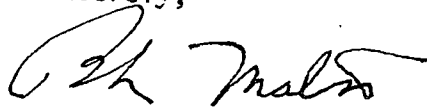

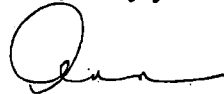
It was good to see you--and the President--looking and doing so well. When we chatted at the National Review reception I said I would like to bring two possible appointments to your attention.

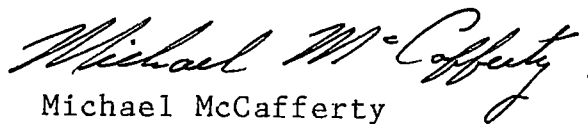

Dear Mr. Sununu:

As you know, in about seven months, the Virginia Constitution obliges the Governor and his staff to seek alternative employment. That includes me. Throughout his term of office, I have been Governor Baliles' advisor, aide and sole speechwriter.

So, now I must decide where to go next, though I may return from whence I came. I was recently asked to write editorials for the Richmond Times-Dispatch. (I did the same for the Norfolk Virginian-Pilot before accepting this position.) After writing more than 1,800 speeches in three and a half years, my interest in continuing this work has waned -- with one exception.

It seems to me that there are a number of striking similarities between Governor Baliles and the President. In rhetorical style, technique, demeanor and public philosophy, they are quite alike. Of course, you know both of these men very well.

The point: I could do some good work for the President. It would give me the chance to both write for history and for someone I admire. It would give you an extremely fast and adaptable writer with a broad background in public policy, who can handle a wide range of assignments with precision, grace and humor.

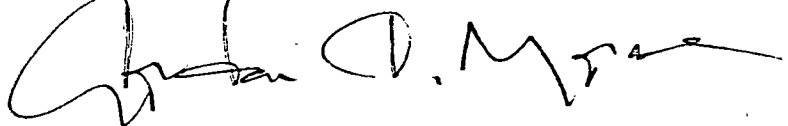

Your letter of April 17th was a welcome reassurance. We, who believe that government does not make a good babysitter and in fact can lull mothers into thinking government can do their job, are having a difficult time with this issue.

Part of the problem is my own senator, Senator Orrin Hatch. I am certain you understand that problem and if you need information, please indicate that. His co-sponsorship of the ABC bill has already given Utah a Child-Care-Center-In-Each-School bill.

The problem I have when I debate the issue before the media is when I am asked how a center can be found for \$1000 a year. And of course, it cannot. President Bush's bill did not go far enough. The dependent care tax now available could be phased out gradually to be replaced by the new credit. But meanwhile, it is difficult to sell tax credit when mothers who work know that isn't enough to cover the costs, but the ABC will provide enough and therefore seems the better bill.

We lost a bill on tuition tax credit in Utah but continue to stress the issue.

Thank you for your letter. You are in our prayers and we admire the work you do in the White House. I can only imagine what goes on when I spend a bit of time in Washington myself and begin to lose reality. The Oliver North thing boggles the mind and shows those in service how little America appreciates a true hero. He deserves our love as do the Vietnam heros.

As you are aware, many research activities at NASA benefit the economy, health, and well-being of the American people.

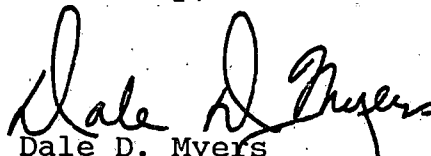

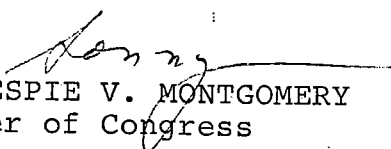

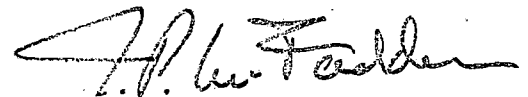
Many thanks for yours of April 17 re the "press accounts" of the President's position on tuition tax credits.

In fact, however, we are not concerned about what others may say, but rather about what we saw and heard the President himself say. Both his words and his demeanor were those of a man saying precisely what he actually believes. He certainly convinced us, as the lead article in catholic eye (copy enclosed) shows. I do not claim that it is a charitable assessment, but I do believe that it is as honest as the President was.

My father used to joke that there was "nothing worse than being a big minority" -- he was of course a life-long Democrat, wryly laughing at that party's treatment of Catholics. As the editorial notes, times have changed, and I for one would not enjoy seeing them change back again. But my primary concern is what, in my judgment, is best for us "Romans," and I can report to you that the editorial drew a considerable response, without dissent.

As I say, I am by no means personally happy about this situation, and would be delighted should the President actually do something about tax credits, or (better yet) vouchers. We will certainly praise him on high if he does. Meanwhile, I thank you again for your kind letter, and regret that my response is unlikely to please you (Bill Buckley says I suffer from "terminal bluntness"). With best personal regards, I remain,

None of us is without peculiarities. One of mine is a long-lasting interest in the General Services Administration.

Last winter when I learned in the press that Roy Goodman was being considered for the head of that agency, I called to encourage him, saying that it was in my view far the most underestimated post in the Federal government. He asked if I would call the President-elect and tell him this. Which I did. He told me the other day that the President had in fact offered him the position but that he felt obliged to decline because of the reapportionment problems in New York.

This means you will be looking for a new nominee. May I take the liberty of suggesting that you might well want to consider Bill Diamond, who is now regional director for New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. He is a superbly energetic and creative public administrator with a long record of effective government service. He is also a committed, active Republican. There are few such in New York!

Just now he and I are hard at work trying to get the City to join us in a \$1 billion development that will build a vast new courthouse annex in Foley Square, along with a 60-story office building. All on a lease-to-own basis, which is to say at zero

outlay cost to the Federal and City governments. That was an invention of Terry Golden, the one truly inspired head of GSA that I have known in the last 25 years.

I could go on at length and will do so if that would be helpful. This is simply to raise the possibility.

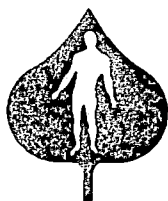

On Thursday, April 27 I sent a letter to your facsimile machine attention: Linda Casey. It was in regards to an Odyssey of the Mind team from the Soviet Union receiving permission to come to the United States for participation in the 1989 World Finals in Colorado, May 25, 26 and 27.

The chairman of Friends of OM, Bill Jones, former manager of Chevron's corporate communications, has made some inquiries about the procedures. He was told the Soviet Union often holds up exit permits until about a week before the departure date. However, since U. S. policy is to allow three weeks to issue a visa, this often hits a snag. It might for us, unless you can help us expedite matters with the U. S. Embassy in Moscow. Actually, we need to make sure they get their exit permits and their visas.

This year I, together with 196 other researchers throughout the United States, received the prestigious Presidential Young Investigator (PYI) Award from the National Science Foundation (NSF). As you know, this award is given to "the Nation's most outstanding and promising young scientists and engineers the future academic leaders, both in teaching and research" (*PYI Program Guidelines*, p. 1).

I would like to suggest that, should the schedule permit, the President receive we award recipients in a single gathering at the White House. This event would have certain advantages:

- 1- It would give the President, after his first 100 days in office, another chance to reiterate his support of education in the United States and truly demonstrate the Administration's support of scientific research and education.
- 2- He would be seen, once more, as the "Education President," on the side of the young educators who have receive recognition with an award bearing his name.
- 3- This event would be a perfect 'picture taking' opportunity, having all the PYIs present with their colorful academic caps and gowns.
- 4- The timing of the event in late May or early June would be perfect. Since all the universities around the Nation have their commencement ceremonies at this time, and all local and national media will focus on these important events. The PYIs' White House meeting could capitalize on the momentum generated already by all these commencements events and thereby receive a high coverage and spotlight attention across the country.

The universities would certainly welcome sending their PYIs to Washington for such an important event, and funding for the trip could come from the university's events and/or discretionary budget.

After all this meeting would provide me with the privilege to ask you a few questions regarding a topic of mutual interest -- Seabrook.

I am writing to you on behalf of a former fraternity brother of mine at Northwestern University, Judge Dean M. Traftlet. Judge Traftlet is one of three lawyers who have been recommended to President Bush for nomination as Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. The recommendation was made by Representative Robert Michel who is the senior most Republican Congressman from the State of Illinois. Representative Michel's Recommendation was submitted on March 16, 1989.

Obviously, I have known Dean for years. He has served with distinction as a Judge in the Circuit Court of Cook County and prior to his election as a Judge, he had extensive private practice experience as an Assistant Attorney General for the State of Illinois, as a general trial attorney with the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul & Pacific Railroad Company and, later at a law firm which he formed with another fraternity brother of ours, Steve Schlegel. Dean has also been highly rated by the Illinois State Bar Association, the Chicago Bar Association and the Federal Bar Association. However, I recall your own concern when you were Governor with recommendations of the New Hampshire Bar Association and I will not dwell long upon Dean's professional qualifications and professional recommendations because I believe the Recommendation package which has been forwarded to the President's office amply sets them forth.

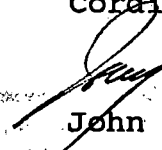

Governor, what I would like to draw your attention to and to recommend to you is my feeling that besides being a very competent lawyer and Judge during his career, Dean is also the type of Republican conservative that I believe we all would like to see appointed to the Federal bench. Dean and his father, Judge Raymond Trafelet, have spent 85 years working for Republican causes in the State of Illinois. Dean's uncle, Raymond Gunkle, was the coordinator for the Illinois campaign for Senator Barry Goldwater when he ran for President. Dean himself spent eight years on the Campaign Board of Representative Edwin Derwinski and has been active at all levels of local, state and national Republican activities ever since our college days when he was a member of the Young Republicans. Dean was also an active supporter of Illinois Governor Thompson.

I have only recommended a few people for appointment to you and I believe they have worked out well for the State of New Hampshire. I believe my recommendation of Dean would likewise work out very well for the U.S. District Court of Illinois and the State of Illinois and I would appreciate it if you can move Representative Michel's Recommendation to the President for action in the near future and give the President the benefit of my recommendation of Dean and the other recommendations contained in Representative Michel's material. Incidentally, I understand that the two other lawyers who were recommended by Representative Michel to the President were not active trial lawyers and, thus, would not bring Dean's years of trial practice to the bench.

Thank you for your consideration in this matter. On a personal note, we dedicated the Fish & Game Department's Region 3 office in Durham on Wednesday, April 19, 1989. It was almost three years ago that you presided at the groundbreaking for that facility. Senate President Bill Bartlett and I both spoke briefly at the dedication. Bill mentioned that when you were Governor, his assignments to take the place of the Governor (which he was doing for Governor Gregg) usually sent him out on very rainy days and, in fact, last Wednesday was very dark and rainy until about two hours before the dedication at which time the sun came out and shone brightly for it. Bill did mention that perhaps his luck in presiding on rainy days in lieu of the Governor was changing with Governor Gregg. In any event, the facility is good looking and efficient and in my talk I did mention your name and expressed the appreciation of the Department for your support for our regionalization concept.

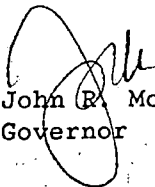

I live approximately 15 miles from the proposed Two Forks site and believe that it is very short sighted in taking office and started the veto process when the project has had years of study and work. I do not know Mr. Reilly's reasons for starting the veto process but I and many others disagree with the decision.

Two Forks is a \$500 million locally funded water project which has the support of Denver and 40 cities, counties and local districts. It is entirely locally funded, no federal or state funds will be used.

Two Forks is needed to ensure Denver and Colorado's growth. If Two Forks is not built, Denver cannot continue to provide sufficient water to the suburbs, and has already threatened to cut off water for future growth.

A \$90 million mitigation program is in place for Two Forks, and \$40 million has already been spent on Environmental Impact Statements and the dam is supported by the Army Corps of Engineers, Colorado Division of Wildlife, Colorado Health Department, U.S. Fish and Wildlife, and the Nebraska Game and Parks Department.

No impact on Nebraska whooping crane habitat was found by U.S. Fish and Wildlife or Nebraska Game and Parks Department.

EPA Administrator William Reilly refuses to meet with the Colorado Congressional delegation about this Colorado water project. Yet, he is holding a public hearing with Democrat Senator Bob Kerry of Nebraska.

Loyal Colorado Republican activists and donors who worked hard and dug deep into their pocketbooks to elect President Bush feel betrayed by his EPA Administrator. 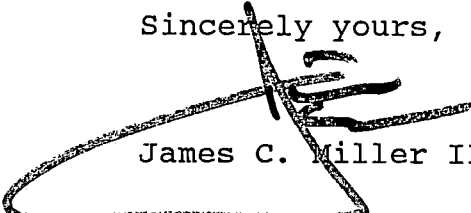

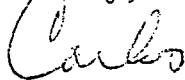

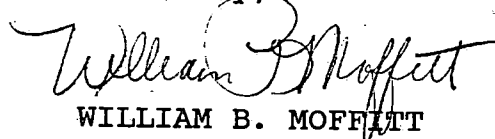
Dear Governor Sununu:

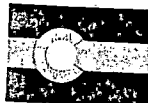

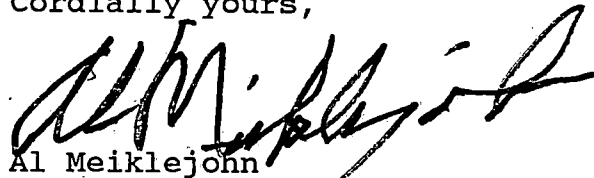

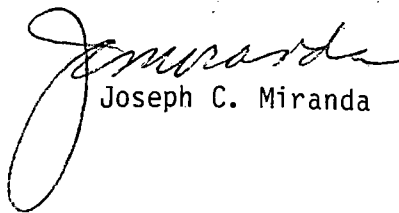
