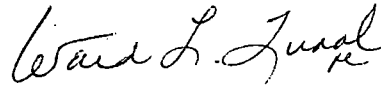

I am writing to recommend Gary Knight as a candidate for the post of Deputy Assistant Secretary for House Liaison at the Department of Energy.

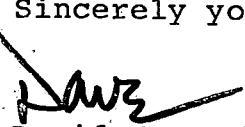

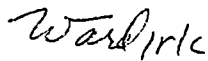

Lee asked me to thank you for a most productive, worthwhile evening and to tell you he will shortly be sending you a letter regarding competitiveness in the U.S. -- a subject we did not have a chance to fully discuss.

He also asked me to forward to you specifics on our request to include automobiles in the Administration's Structural Impediments Initiative.

Key points in the attached White Paper include:

- o Bilateral deficit will not disappear or be significantly reduced unless you address the auto deficit problem.
- o The three U.S. auto company executives in the field in Japan all agree that Japan's closed auto distribution system is the key problem.
- o The Japanese claim anyone can enter, but only if you will gamble on sky-high real estate in Japan. Example: an expenditure of \$300 million in Tokyo areas nets only 4,000 sales or 0.0006 percent of the Japanese market.
- o There will be increased U.S. auto sales to Japan but only from low U.S. content Japanese transplant facilities. They will not allow American firms access to the high-volume Toyota, Nissan, Honda dealer networks in a manner similar to that which they have received in GM, Ford, and Chrysler dealerships in this country for the past 25 years.
- o The SII talks must lead to real, verifiable results and access for all manufacturers with committed showroom space, inventory stocking levels, service bays and manpower -- the same treatment the Japanese have received in this market for over 25 years.

- o Three years ago Chrysler had zero exports to Europe. This year we are going to ship over 50,000 units. Three years ago we had zero exports to Taiwan. This year we are going to ship 3,300 units. Three years ago we sold about 100 units in Japan, and this year we have only been able to increase it to 700-800 units after spending close to \$3,500 per unit in advertising and \$4,000 per unit in homologating the vehicles for nit-picking Japanese regulations.
- o Chrysler, as Lee said, would like to be selling 100,000 vehicles per year in Japan. Chrysler will commit, as we did in Europe, the necessary resources only if we have a real shot at the Japanese market -- not typical Japanese tokenism, i.e., committed showroom space, manpower, spare parts, stocking levels, and number of dealer points.

We are forwarding this same Structural Impediments Initiative information to Secretary James Baker, Secretary Nicholas Brady, Special Trade Representative Carla Hills, and Council of Economic Advisers Chairman Michael Boskin as they are all involved in the process. Following your advice, Lee has requested me to prepare additional factual information for your use in presenting this egregious automotive distribution case to the Administration.

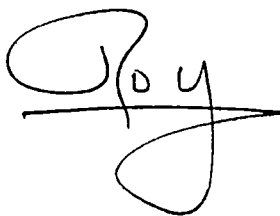

I am writing to recommend Paul Sussman for service in the Bush administration.

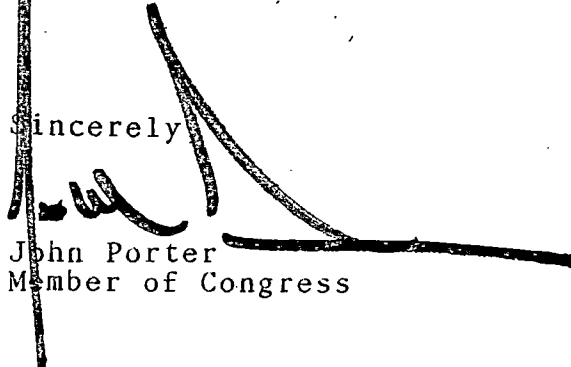

Enclosed please find a letter to President Bush signed by 150 House Republicans requesting that President Bush announce his opposition to the use of a Continuing Resolution for FY90, and pledging to vote to uphold a veto of any CR which the Congress might try to send him. As you know, this number is sufficient to sustain a veto. We write to request your strong support for this initiative which we believe will strengthen the President's hand in negotiating with congressional Democrats, and give House and Senate Republicans a greater role in establishing priorities and policing the spending process.

Stopping the abusive practice of using CR's has been a top priority of the House Republican Task Force on Congressional Reform. In fact, many Democrats also oppose use of the CR including some senior members of the Appropriations Committee. As you know, President Reagan's strong vow in his 1988 State of the Union Address to veto any CR led to congressional enactment of 13 separate appropriations measures by October 1st, 1988 as called for by law. We believe that the accomplishment of last year should become the norm, not the exception in the budget process.

It is our observation, Governor, that time is often used by the congressional Democrats as a weapon. By delaying appropriations measures until the last minute and bundling them together for presentation to the President, the Legislature robs the Executive of his constitutional prerogative to oversee all spending legislation and veto those bills with which he disagrees. By using a last minute CR, the President's veto comes at a high price -- he must take blame for the embarrassing spectacle of shutting down the United States Government.

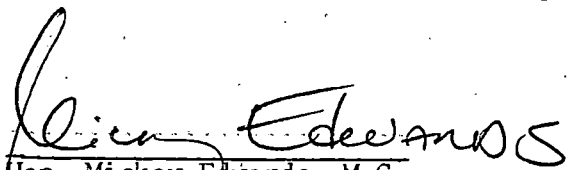
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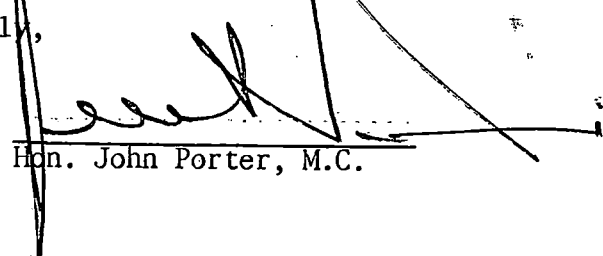
By vowing to veto a CR, the President can seize the high ground on what we consider to be an important "good government" issue with which the American people can identify. Opposition to the CR also focuses attention on the general pattern of procedural abuse which is all too common in the House.

Finally, and most important, we believe that the opportunity to sign 13 separate bills gives the President a stronger hand with which to insist that his priorities, not those of the congressional democrats, become law. In past years, we have watched with frustration as President Reagan was forced to negotiate furiously over a handful of extraneous provisions packed into a \$600 billion CR, while the overall shape of the spending package was largely conceded to the will of the democrats.

In summary, we are asking for the President to announce that when Congress returns from August recess he expects to see them work diligently to report all thirteen bills out of the Senate, conference all thirteen bills expeditiously, and send them to the White House by October 1st. Past appropriations history shows that this is not an unrealistic request, and if it were accomplished this year, it would go a long way towards institutionalizing responsible legislating.

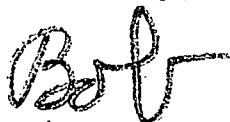
As I told you previously, I have sufficient votes to sustain a veto when President Bush vetoes any bill designed to codify the Fairness Doctrine.

You may want to be thinking about what your strategy should be, however, if the codification is tucked into an appropriation bill or the reconciliation bill (which the House already may have done by the time you read this letter), which will contain many things the President wants.

The Democrats tried this last session after they failed to pass the Fairness Doctrine as a stand-alone bill. The House tucked the codification in the Continuing Resolution. President Reagan, in one of his "make my day" comments, told the Democrats that if the Continuing Resolution came to his desk with the Fairness Doctrine in it he would veto the entire Continuing Resolution. At this stage, the Democrats buckled and took the Fairness Doctrine codification out of the Continuing Resolution before it got to the President's desk. You may want to be prepared for them to test President Bush in a similar manner by trying to include the Fairness Doctrine in some appropriation vehicle or reconciliation bill this year.

Keep me advised as to what your strategy would be. If you're going to veto any bill that includes the Fairness Doctrine, and I would hope you would, we'll need to work a bit harder to hold our troops in line to sustain a veto because there will be all kinds of things in the appropriation bill or reconciliation bill they will want.

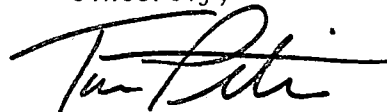

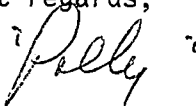

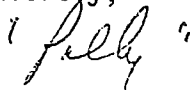

Dear Governor Sununu:

This letter follows up our telephone call of last week and our contact at the Cabinet dinner concerning the President's attendance at the United Nations General Assembly. We are currently inscribed to speak second on Monday morning, September 25th, at approximately 11:00 a.m. The exact time for the President's speech can be adjusted slightly to meet any special needs he might have.

In the past, the President has come up that morning, travelled by motorcade to the United Nations, been met at the entrance by the UN Secretary General before he speaks and calls briefly on the new President of the General Assembly also before he speaks. The new President of the General Assembly must be elected, but the leading candidate is the Permanent Representative of Nigeria, Joseph Garba.

Following the speech, the President would probably want to consider having a substantive bilateral meeting with the Secretary General.

The remainder of that day, should the President choose to remain in New York to conduct further bilaterals, should be built around a dinner that evening which he would host for our NATO Allies and close friends such as Australia and Japan. The attendees would be the Heads of State of those countries or Foreign Ministers, whichever were present in New York. This would be a social occasion, but there would be room on the edges for bilateral and personal contacts.

In the past, the President has also held a substantive meeting with the close Allies in which he speaks for fifteen to twenty minutes following which there is then a session, moderated by the Secretary of State, in which each of the countries is given an opportunity to comment on the major themes touched upon by the President.

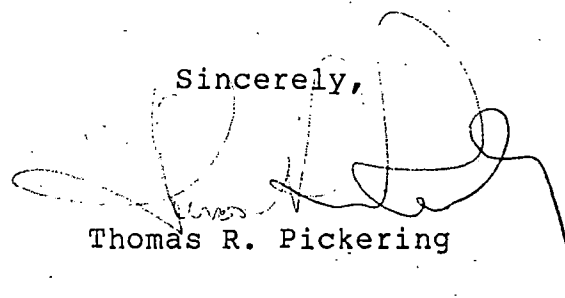
The remainder of the meetings which might be scheduled for that day and the day following would depend upon the attendance of other Heads of State with whom the President might wish to have bilateral contact. We will be monitoring closely that list of individuals and can pass on to you various attendees names for consideration.

The only other suggestions I have at the moment might be a brief opportunity for the President, possibly following the substantive meetings with the Allies in the afternoon, to meet very briefly with the U.S. Mission staff and the senior Americans serving at the United Nations. This would be a five to ten minute appearance in which he would say a few words and have the opportunity to shake hands with at least some of those working here at the Mission and at the UN. Since he has done this on many occasions in the past in his various overseas trips I would like to recommend that he also consider doing so here. It would be strongly and deeply appreciated and a tremendous morale boost to those who serve him here faithfully and have done so over a long period of time.

In order to be sure that Secretary Baker is being kept abreast of our contacts on this question, I am taking the liberty of forwarding a copy of this letter to Assistant Secretary Bolton in the State Department who is responsible for International Organization Affairs.

If there is any more information we can provide, please do let us know.

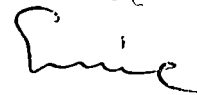

As New Hampshire residents, we are very proud that three of the four members of the New Hampshire Congressional delegation voted against the Medicare Catastrophic Coverage Act that passed Congress in 1988. We are even prouder that the entire New Hampshire Congressional delegation now oppose that law and favor its repeal.

As strong believers in President Bush, we are disappointed that, so far, he has not supported repeal of that law. Because of your position as Chief of Staff to the President, we urge you to do what you can to make certain that President Bush is fully informed about the Medicare Catastrophic Coverage Act and is aware that it does little if anything to reduce medical expenses for the vast majority of retirees and, at the same time, heavily taxes most of them far out of proportion to any possible benefits.

For most retirees, far better catastrophic health coverage can be obtained from private sources at less cost than the income tax surcharge that finances this new program. Thus repeal of the Medicare Catastrophic Coverage Act would reduce the scope of government and achieve greater efficiency in the provision of health care to America's retirees.

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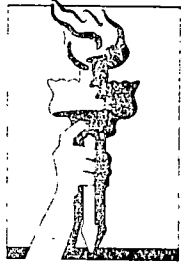

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I am pleased to send you a copy of Privatization 1989, the Reason Foundation's third annual report on the progress of privatization around the world. (You may recall meeting Kevin Teasley from Reason Foundation at the Consumer Alert luncheon in April; he gave you copies of our proposals for airport and air traffic control privatization.)

I'm writing now to express concern about the languishing of the privatization effort under the Bush Administration thus far. My understanding is that the nominal successor to Ron Utt as "privatization czar" at OMB, Frank Hodsel, has four other major functional areas in his portfolio--including national defense and international affairs! Clearly, he's not going to be spending much time on privatization.

In my judgement, it is crucial that OMB have a full-time associate director for privatization. There should be designated privatization chiefs in every department, and aggressive pursuit of contracting-out under A-76. In addition, a full-time privatization director should be coming up with specific asset-sales proposals to flesh out the \$5.7 billion in asset sales in the current budget resolution.

I hope you can send me some encouraging news on these matters. A lot of us are getting very concerned about the future of privatization under this administration, as you can see from the enclosed newspaper clippings. I look forward to hearing from you.
