Dear John:

As a follow up to my letter of April 18 to President Bush regarding the codification of the Fairness Doctrine, I wanted to alert you to the fact that the House Energy and Commerce Committee did include such a provision in its budget reconciliation package. Although the Senate Commerce Committee did not follow suit and include a codification provision, the possibility exists that a conference committee would retain the Fairness Doctrine measure.

The purpose of my letter is to ask that President Bush make it clear that he will veto the budget reconciliation package should it contain the Fairness Doctrine provision. I would emphasize the fact that codification is an unnecessary and unfair requirement. Broadcasters still have an obligation to present balanced views to the American public. It is important that President Bush stand firm on this issue as did his predecessor and veto any legislation which codifies the Fairness Doctrine.

Thank you for your cooperation and attention to this request. I look forward to hearing from you.

'Coal Will Continue To Provide a Better Lifestyle for U.S.'

By Malcolm Wallop

MINERS, like ranchers, are risk takers. Nobody knows for certain what they will face from year to year. Miners are wealth creators, and wealth creators are important in America because they contribute much to the stability of the nation.

Energy, whether coal or otherwise, is a problem and is going to remain one. There is no way that I see Congress creating an energy policy; it is congenitally designed to do anything but that. There are some 46 committees and subcommittees of Congress that have some say in energy, and there are 31 cabinet offices, sub-cabinet offices and agencies of the U.S. government with jurisdiction over energy. None of these will take the responsibility.

So there is the risk and instability of not knowing what the future holds. There also is the risk of environmental regulations that may make the industry uneconomic.

But the biggest risk that I see is if America does not continue to find the means to produce energy. That would mean that the country would stop growing and stop competing. People will stop producing more for themselves and their families each decade.

What is the future of coal? I don't know anybody who can contemplate a future very far down the road that doesn't include coal in massive amounts. Will it be produced and consumed in precisely the same ways as today? Of course not. Will it just fade away into some small portion of our chemicals industry? Of course not. Coal will provide a major portion of the energy mix for as far into the future as we can conceive at this time.

Besides using coal domestically, we must export more. We have urged the new U.S. Trade Representative to suggest to the countries with whom we have overwhelming trade imbalances that this nation is well prepared to supply their energy needs so far as they relate to coal.

A major factor affecting the future of coal is

environmental legislation. The nation's program for clean air is one element of the strongest and most comprehensive environmental protection programs of any industrialized nation. I was a participant in the drafting and arguments over the 1978 Clean Air Act. It appears to me now that the '78 act set back clean coal technology and its advance for at least that decade because of the rigid prescription of "best available control technology" as we knew it then. Who cared about trying to find something better?

We have to be careful where we go from here. I generally like the provisions, as they have been announced, of the President's clean air proposals, but

I have not seen the specifics yet. Some in America wanted greater reduction of pollutants and others wanted a longer time in which to reach the targets.

But the Bush plan does contain compromises. Rather than mandating one technology to satisfy either environmentalists or utilities and coal producers, the President has proposed that the standard be achievement. Some utilities will use scrubbers, some will use low-sulfur coal and some will use new clean coal technology now under development. That's where the flexibility comes in. Also it allows a time spread beyond the year 2000. Also, in what the President calls a "bold departure," utilities will be able to buy and sell pollution credits from one another to reach emission requirements.

The environmental challenges to coal will not end here. At some time in the future, we'll have to face the carbon dioxide question, as well.

IN THE MEANTIME, my guess is that with the aid of clean coal technology, coal will be used in the future of this country. It will continue to provide a better lifestyle for Americans, who will live longer, live happier and live wealthier so long as mineral producers are willing to face risks and take risks in order to provide this better life.

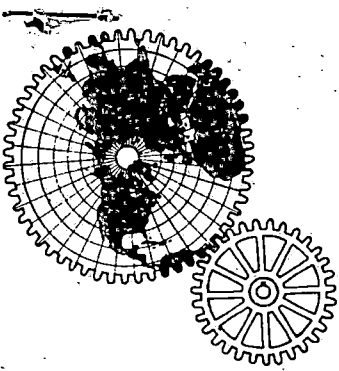

Dear John:

I'm sending along a brief report on the status of capital gains that I hope you can take a minute to read. I genuinely believe the fate of the Bush Administration rests on the outcome of this issue, and agree with reports that you think the President should become more active with the people in making a case for it. I've also advised Dick Darman that I think he should switch tactics to a modified "outside" game. Dick, the quintessential insider, would probably prefer not to be identified with such an effort, so as to keep his bona fides with congressional Democrats. But you're made to order to be identified as being responsible for urging this tactic.

The President, I'd hope, would use the August recess to full benefit to rally public opinion to his position. The Democrats will be doing so in subterranean fashion, as they did two years ago in putting together the coalition against Bork during the August recess. August is the best time for the President to communicate, because the country is relaxed, with spare time to think about the issue and talk about it with neighbors and relatives at the bar-b-ques and picnics. And the Democratic Congress will be dispersed among them. Important: Identify those Democrats on Ways & Means most vulnerable to switching to our side and have Atwater work their congressional districts. The Dems will be doing exactly that with Beryl Anthony et al.

The President does not have to be blustery or combative in order to scare the dickens out of the House Democrats. He need only point out that many economists are worried about recession, which would upset everyone's hopes for solving the budget problems, and that his capital gains tax is insurance against such a development. The President should take note of Rosty's willingness to negotiate and the correlation with the rise in the stock market this year, as the capgains proposal has gone from an impossibility to a real chance of enactment.

You'll note in my report that Horace Busby believes the

White House is missing a bet by not pointing out that older Americans, especially older women, would benefit enormously from the President's proposal, being able to sell assets instead of having to hold on to avoid the current big tax liability. As Alan Reynolds put it in his Wall Street Journal piece last week, even the Democrats can't find anyone who will be hurt by the President's proposal.

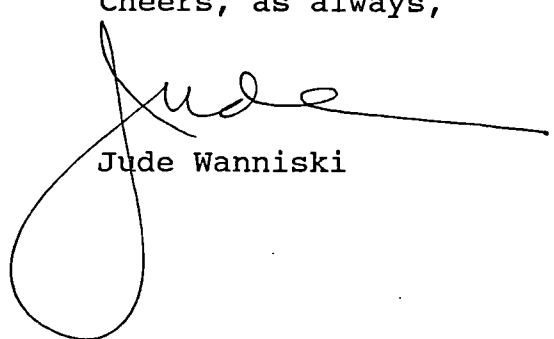
Indexing is fine, but it only protects the assets of those who have already compiled wealth. Ironically, the liberals are going for that element of the plan that benefits the rich the most. A cut is needed for capital to flow to those who aspire to be rich. The President should be making these points to the nation at large, to get the conversation going everywhere! A small effort will produce great gains in September when negotiations resume.

The President's opening position in response to Rosty's plan should be a 40% exclusion, which lowers the top rate to 16+ percent. You'll note I'm predicting that when it all settles out, we'll have a 33% exclusion, which gives us an 18.76% effective rate. Newt Gingrich called and asked what I thought of a zero rate after a three-year holding period, and I advised that a 15% rate was as low as I'd go, that all the rich people I've ever known indicate they wouldn't try to avoid a rate that low, and it gains revenue the government does need. It would help the national conversation if the President would make that point too, that he would prefer a permanent rate no lower than 15%.

The President could also mildly observe that those Democrats who have dug their heels in against his proposal could always campaign for re-election next year on plans to raise the capital gains tax! And that he'd be happy to run for re-election in 1992 against a Democratic nominee who would do the same.

In short, the President should act as if he has already won this debate, which he has, and cement it in place with a little hardball -- or fast-pitch softball -- of his own. This single issue, I believe, will guarantee the remainder of his first term. Failure will show up quickly in the financial markets, the economy, and the budget deficit. Good luck. And please give my best regards to the President.

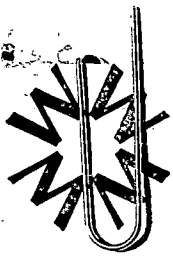

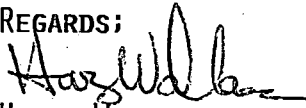

Dear Mr. President:

The National Association of Stevedores (NAS) respectfully urges you not to extend the Steel Voluntary Restraint Agreements which are due to expire on September 30, 1989. There is no justification to apply VRAs to those countries which trade fairly in steel. And, in the case of countries which trade unfairly, existing trade law -- which was designed specifically to combat unfair trade practices -- should be used.

The vast majority of U.S. imports and exports, including steel, are waterborne and must be moved over facilities operated by NAS member companies. The NAS is a nationwide trade membership organization representing privately owned stevedoring and marine terminal companies. NAS companies do business on all four seacoasts, and in the States of Alaska and Hawaii, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and at various inland ports.

NAS member companies employ tens of thousands of longshoremen daily. The livelihood of NAS companies and their employees is totally dependent upon the movement of this nation's imports and exports. Our experience with the VRAs and with the Steel Trigger Price mechanism which preceded the VRAs has been a reduction in cargo volumes handled, accompanied by a reduction in gross receipts from which ever increasing fixed operating costs must be paid.

The current VRAs on steel also help to increase the unit cost of transportation which must be added to the cost of goods. The emphasis now in the American economy is on U.S. exports. These exports should not be unnecessarily hampered by increased product and transportation costs caused by the steel VRAs and other costly barriers to commerce. The U.S. steel industry is doing well, domestically and in international markets, and does not need the continued protection of the VRAs.

We believe it is time to eliminate the negative impact of the VRAs on the U.S. economy as a whole. Please do not continue the VRAs.

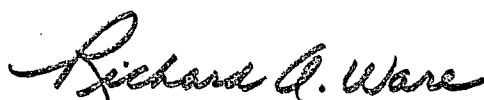

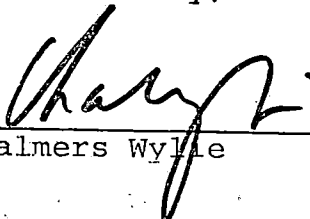

Secretary Watkins' "10 point initiative (6/27)" to help restore public credibility in the Department's ability to safely operate its unique defense, research and test facilities is right on target. He clearly accepts personal responsibility and states further that an "immediate task would be to create a new culture of accountability within the department... [and] to provide the kind of environmentally-responsible direction that is critical to achieving the important national missions of the Department of Energy."

The above statement gives clear direction to his strategy. I do take great comfort from his comments and am so desirous for his success.

The American Energy Assurance Council's (AEAC) Stage 3 proposal, a consensus based plan, is being considered in the Secretary's office. Bill Hatch (Chairman, 1989 N.H. House Science and Technology Committee) now works for Linda Stuntz who has responsibility for its evaluation and recommendation to Admiral Watkins. To date I have not had any contact with the Secretary's staff, but I am hopeful that we can provide enough facts to Bill to gain his support for the AEAC proposal.

I am concerned about the effectiveness of Virginia Polytechnic Institute to advise the DOE on the issue of restoring trust and credibility. The paper I heard in Tucson, which was entitled "Achieving Consensus in Environmental Programs," emphasizes their research context and under the caption, "How we can apply theory to understand ERP problems and find solutions," they state, "We're at the very beginning of our study, with more questions than answers -- and probably not enough questions." The grant for this "on the job training proposal" cost the department \$8.9x10⁶.

Their list of references misses all the literature I've studied during the past five years, following two weeks of concentrated study, in 1983, in MIT's summer session under Larry Susskind. The AEAC two-year budget is 1.8 million dollars and their request to DOE is for \$200,000. Sounds like a more cost effective project.

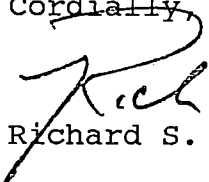

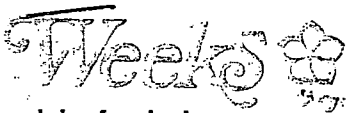

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I'm not much at writing letters of this sort, but I will try.

Within the past few days several individuals have contacted me concerning the appointment of John Price to the FCC. None of those who contacted me knew that the others had done so, but they all told me the same thing using the same language. They said that Mr. Price will not be appointed to the FCC "because there will be no price to pay."

I found that statement shocking. I thought that only political opponents have to pay a price, and I did not--up to this point--consider President Bush a political opponent. I felt that he, as he said many times in his campaign, shared our values. I felt he was a friend of the family, and to the evangelical/conservative community which gave him the largest single number and block of votes of any group.

I'm not a politician. I have never played the political game. So I don't know what the rules are nor how to play. But I do know something about what those evangelical/conservatives who voted for Mr. Bush feel about the way we seemingly are going to be treated in this episode.

We didn't ask for much. Relatively speaking, an appointment to the FCC is down the scale in the ranking of the importance of positions. So, basically, we were only asking for crumbs from under the table.

We made a decision several weeks ago not to try to pressure the President any longer for this appointment. He has heard our request. If he does not care enough about the concerns of the pro-family movement to grant this one request, then it is obvious that he does not care about the pro-family movement in the manner in which we were led to believe he did.

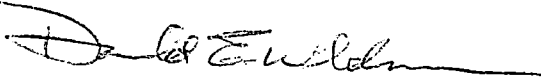
I don't know about there not being a price to pay. I am not use to that language. But I do know this. When the appointments are made, we fully intend to let our people know of the efforts to get Mr. Price nominated and of the fact that the President refused even this one relatively minor

request. We intend to let them know about Lee Atwater's comment that "You people (evangelical, conservative Christians) are sucking hind tit. You have nowhere else to go." We intend to let them know that the White House is more interested in the concerns of the broadcasting industry than those of the evangelical/conservative people who gave their overwhelming support to Mr. Bush. I really don't think of that as being "a price to pay". I think of that as reporting the facts. And I am sadly disappointed that this entire episode has come down to this type of situation.

I feel awkward writing this letter to you. I feel, from our mutual membership in CNP in years gone by, that you share our concern. But I felt that it would be best to address this letter to you, believing that you would see that it got into the proper hands.

May God bless you and your work.

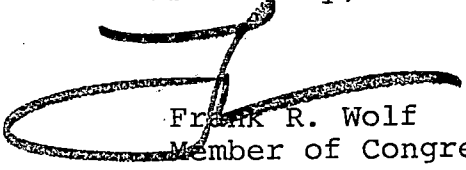

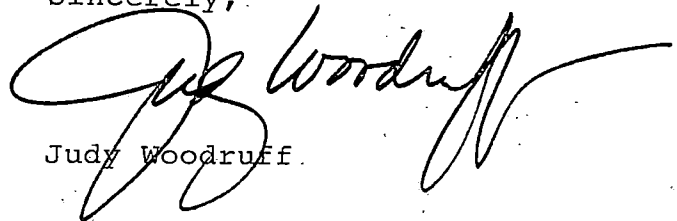

This is an invitation, in the sports jargon I've tried to learn since covering politics, to do a hat trick -- or in the baseball equivalent, to hit for the cycle. Specifically, to 1) Provide enormous assistance to the biggest disabling birth defect of children in this country. 2) Have a thoroughly enjoyable time, And 3) Assail Robert D. Novak, the Prince of Darkness, in any manner you wish.

The date is October 25 and the occasion is the Spina Bifida Association's most important national fundraising effort. The event is a dinner here in Washington and the feature will be a roast of Bob Novak. Mark Russell and Mark Shields have already agreed to be the masters of ceremonies: with Novak, only one of these estimable wits isn't sufficient. The roasters will be a select group of very prominent politicians.

Because of the topic, the people involved and Messrs. Russell and Shields, it'll be a very fun and unforgettable evening.

Permit me to give you some background on Spina Bifida. It is the most prevalent single birth defect in this country, striking an estimated 3,000 newborns every years. The last five March of Dimes poster children have been Spina Bifida kids. The incidence of Spina Bifida is greater than that of muscular dystrophy, multiple sclerosis, polio, and cystic fibrosis combined. 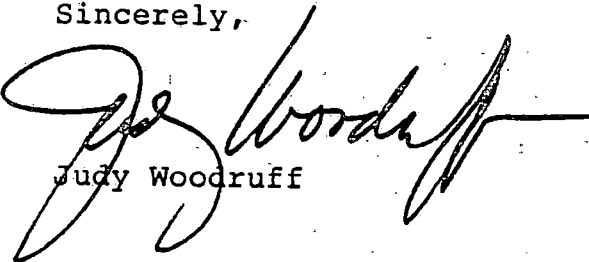

The reason I am writing is that our son, Jeffrey, was born with Spina Bifida. We've been very fortunate, as he has a very mild case and is functioning normally. But we've seen scores of little children who've had far greater problems, and need help.

I know that you are besieged by all sorts of requests, Mr. President. But few are for a more deserving cause. As you know, Mrs. Bush was the honorary chairperson of the Spina Bifida benefit dinner in 1987. 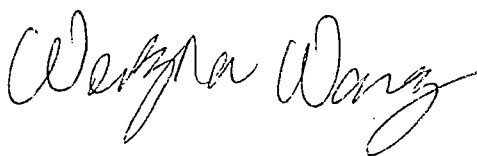

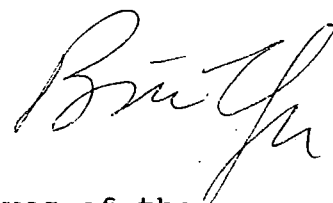
Enclosed are copies of our most recent letters to President Bush, and his adviser Brent Scowcroft. We believe a portion of Mr. Scowcroft's letter may particularly interest you. Your attention to that part may help the Chinese people.

One of our most consistent requests of world leaders is for joint sanctions. Most critically, we would like the suspension of exportation of both arms and military technology that the Chinese leaders find most useful against their own people. We know the tanks used in Tiananmen Square were fitted with Israeli cannons, and the helicopters were of French origin.

We particularly fear that Israel may be very reluctant to cooperate with joint international sanctions. Continued world focus upon China distracts from the differences of Israelis and Palestinians. Arms and technology trade with generally ostracized nations, such as Iran, has frequently been highly profitable for Israel. It may be necessary to restrict the transfer of military technology between Western nations and Israel if the Israeli government will not cooperate. It is vital, though, that no third party arms circumvent any cooperative embargo of the major East and West nations. We thank you for your attention and look forward to your assistance.

SUBJECT: Global Environment at the Economic Summit

This memorandum is sent to you at the request of Allan Bromley, Science Advisor (Designate) to President Bush.

The Economic Summit is likely to find President Bush confronted with proposals on global environmental issues from some participating heads of state as follows:

Francois Mitterand, President of France may propose:

- o An integrated space and ground based global environmental monitoring system.
- o An intensified global cooperative research effort on global climate change.
- o Establishment of ecological and environmental preserves - possibly establishing the Antarctic as such a preserve.
- o Support for an international convention to protect global environment, especially addressing climate warming.
- o Cooperation in an international program of energy conservation.

Margaret Thatcher, Prime Minister, United Kingdom may propose:

- o Program of intensified research on global climate programs.

- o Negotiation of a "framework" convention (an agreement on principles) that would govern separate protocols as they are justified by scientific evidence.

President Bush can take a forward position on global environmental issues while advocating the need for an adequate knowledge of both the science as well as of the economic and social costs of international actions. He may wish to make the following points among others:

Past Record

- o The U.S. was first to demonstrate the increase in atmospheric carbon dioxide by establishing the climate observatory at Mauna Loa in Hawaii in 1958 (NOAA, DOC).
- o The U.S. was first to demonstrate the climate warming consequences of increasing greenhouse gases at the Geophysical Fluid Dynamics Laboratory in Princeton, New Jersey 20 years ago (NOAA/DOC).
- o The U.S. advanced with other nations the present World Climate Program of the World Meteorological Organization and the United Nations Environmental Program.

Possible Elements of a Presidential Statement: (See accompanying paper on the policy issues on the global environment by the Academies of Sciences, Engineering and the Institute of Medicine). The President might endorse and support:

- o A global cooperative environmental research and monitoring effort. The President has already provided for an expanded Global Change Program in the FY 1990 budget.
- o Urge a major international effort on the development of engineering and technology necessary to ameliorate undesirable climatic effects. This should be a call to industry as well as government.
- o Support international discussions, and agreement on principles, that might be the basis for an international convention while urging that economic and social costs of proposed actions need to be well documented before specific agreements.

On December 2, 1988, I wrote (as President of the Pacific Basin Development Council) to then Secretary of Commerce Verity expressing concern over the lack of an appointment of a Pacific Islander to the Marine Fisheries Advisory Committee (MAFAC). The Committee is key to providing advice to the Secretary of Commerce, the Undersecretary for Oceans and Atmosphere and the NOAA Assistant Administrator for Fisheries on both national and regional issues.

Traditionally, one seat on MAFAC has always been filled by a qualified individual representing the U. S. Pacific Islands. The most recent call for nominations to MAFAC was made in February of 1988 and several names of candidates from our area were forwarded to Undersecretary Evans for consideration.

Nationally, appointments of numerous new MAFAC members were made prior to the October 1988 MAFAC meeting. However, none of the new members included anyone from the U. S. Pacific.

My letter of December 2 has gone unanswered as of this date. On March 1, 1989, the four Governors who compose the Board of Directors of PBDC, wrote to Secretary of Commerce Mosbacher. I have enclosed a copy of that correspondence with this letter. We requested immediate attention to the MAFAC appointment issue. On May 9, the Secretary wrote a general letter of acknowledgment (see enclosed) but did not give us any indication of why our previous request had not been responded to and certainly gave no indication of any action to our current requests in the foreseeable future.

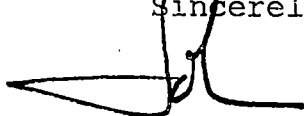

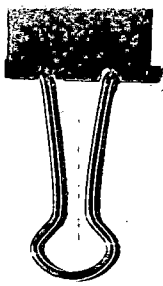

Greetings and peace from a troubled land.

Hopefully you will recall our earlier exchange of letters (about computers) and your happy memories of your former teachers.

In your present position you must hear a tremendous amount of criticism of everything Israeli. As I leave here after seven years I would like to do the opposite: to give a tribute to a group that has given consistently good service to our school, The Customs Bureau in Jerusalem.

Taking advantage of the closing of many American Catholic High Schools I requested, and received, a large amount of donated Science equipment. With the complete cooperation of the Jerusalem Customs' Bureau, all of it was delivered to the College des Freres, "Customs' Exempt; Educational".

Later, and here taking advantage of the Free Trade Agreement the school set up a very complete computer program. The Free Trade Agreement was honored at every step.

Prior to 1948 the College des Freres was 17% Jewish. Since then all of our boys are Arabic. Despite this make-up, and despite the present sad difficulties, the Customs' Bureau in Jerusalem respected the educational needs of our students. Where I was unsure of the law their advice was always available. Myself and the school have been treated with professional courtesy throughout my seven years here.

Mr. Shemish in Jerusalem, his secretary (" Suzie "), and Mr. Nathan Cohan at the customs' depot are the responsible individuals. With all the criticism you must be hearing, I think it only fair to say "thank you" to people doing a good job.

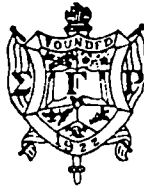

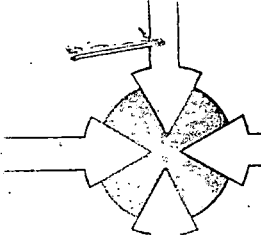

Your participation on the Capital Gang program last Saturday night was watched by me with special interest. I think you provided balance and a clear statement of the issues from the President's perspectives. As I interpret the enclosed articles from the Christian Science Monitor, "Nuclear Mess," "Bush versus Pollution," and "Free Market Tack to Cleaner Air," they represent your policies and attitudes. During your six years as Governor of New Hampshire when I served as chairman of the House Science and Technology committee, my commitment to support you and your administration was based on these ideals and your strong support to implement them. You made your interests very clear to President Reagan.

Last month I attended the Nuclear Power Assembly meeting which gave me the opportunity for conversations with 52 attendees. A clear consensus was expressed for the critical need for public support if the nuclear power option is to be viable.

The renewed crisis in confidence in the federal government's management of the nuclear programs, and the resulting low morale in the Department of Energy, was brought to my attention by Susan Wiltshire. 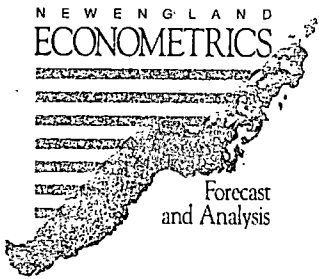

It has been a long time since you and I had a discussion on the New Hampshire economy. Frankly, I miss those chats and believe it might be time for another.

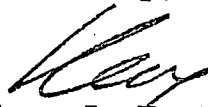
