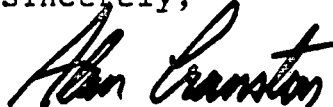

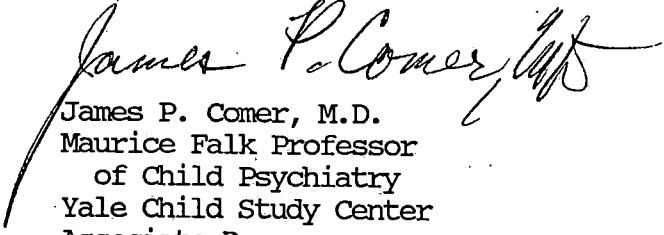

I understand that Marshall Breger is currently under consideration for a federal judgeship. I am taking the liberty of writing to let you know of my great respect for Marshall and to suggest that he would be an outstanding choice for one of the three open seats on the Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit. I have long been impressed with Marshall's intellectual strength. He is a former law professor and he is someone whom I always felt would be well suited for reflective pursuits.

As I am sure you know, a good portion of the D.C. Circuit's caseload involves review of government agencies and the procedures they employ. Dear Governor Sununu:

Puerto Rico is deeply committed to President Bush's war against drugs. We have worked closely with the Vice President's Task Force on Drug Interdiction. During the last four years we launched an unprecedented effort to combat the drug scourge, creating a joint Federal-Puerto Rican Task Force (known in Spanish as FURA) which has interdicted over \$1.8 billion in drugs that otherwise would have entered the United States. We established an Interpol communications network linking over 25 Caribbean and Central American countries to combat international drug kingpins.

As the President's drug strategy recognizes, drugs are an international menace that must be confronted internationally. I much support President Barco's initiative to hold an international drug summit. As chief executive of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, and on the front-line in the international crusade against drugs, I hereby express our desire and willingness to host and help sponsor the proposed summit.

Puerto Rico is uniquely suited to serve as the site for this event. Our island is ideally situated in the Caribbean, serving as a gateway between North and South America and a convenient location for European leaders attending the summit. Puerto Rico has strong ties of language and culture with both the United States and the countries of Latin America and the Caribbean. Our knowledge of Spanish will be most advantageous to the representatives of the several Spanish-speaking countries participating in the summit.

Furthermore, Puerto Rico has several modern facilities suited for hosting such an important international event. For example, the 1979 Pan American

Games, and the first annual economic summit of G7 nations, were held in Puerto Rico.

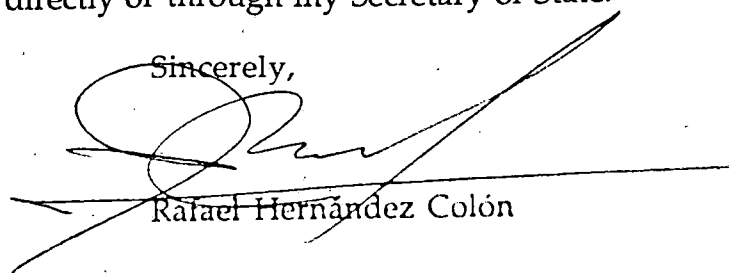
From a security standpoint, Puerto Rico is well-prepared to host the event. The U.S. Secret Service, the Coast Guard, the I.N.S., the F.B.I as well as several other federal agencies have offices in Puerto Rico. The Secret Service frequently protects VIPs in Puerto Rico. The Service would, in fact, control security at the site, something which they might not be able to do outside the United States. These are controls that the White House would not have if the summit is to be held anywhere else. As Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, I assure you we will fully cooperate with the federal agencies in securing a safe conference for President Bush and all other participants of the international drug summit.

Puerto Rico has the most advanced infrastructure and telecommunications structure of any area in the Caribbean Basin. Our facilities include a large and modern airport facility, and advanced highway and road systems, and state-of-the-art telephone service and satellite links.

As you well know, Puerto Rico recently suffered a major natural disaster that will have a dramatic impact on our economy. This has come at a particularly inopportune time, just prior to the start of the tourist season. Puerto Rico is well on its way to recovering from the damage caused by Hurricane Hugo and this will in no way affect the proposed summit. The national and international attention that such a summit would give Puerto Rico, however, would show the world that "Puerto Rico is back."

Hosting the summit in Puerto Rico would help signal Puerto Rico's tradition of democracy and free enterprise. From every vantage point, Puerto Rico is particularly well-suited to host and help sponsor the drug summit. As Governor, I offer the Commonwealth's full cooperation and available resources to host the proposed international drug summit. Please let me know of your interest in this matter, either directly or through my Secretary of State.

Dear Governor Sununu:

I was in the audience when you spoke, as the Keynote Speaker, at the Florida Blue Key banquet on Friday, October 20th. I enjoyed your speech very much. You have delivered an important message, as well as a "new perspective" about the world, that the movements for personal freedom and economic change in Poland, Hungary, East Germany, the Soviet Union and the other communist countries prove the value of "democracy" and "free enterprise." The wind of changes, in many of the communist nations, is unmistakable.

Governor Sununu, you have said that the United States now has the opportunity to contribute to this changing world, and we must work to encourage these changes with the right amount of pressure (or tension) - not too much and not too little. Your comparison of not using a fishing tackle with a 2-lb. line for a 5-lb. fish was very appropriate.

Let me congratulate you for your timely message and elegant delivery, and compliment you for your distinguished leadership at the highest national level. As a fellow engineer and fellow engineering educator/administrator, I have noticed that your engineering skills have provided you with an analytical mind and a mathematical figure of speech. Who else, as a political leader, would use the language of "right amount of tension or pressure," and caution against "using a 2-lb. line for a 5-lb. fish"?

I feel very fortunate that with President Bush's enlightened leadership, based upon high principles and common sense, and with your able assistance to him, the United States can meet its various challenges to the security of our nation.

Governor Sununu, I have been very much concerned about the economic well-being of our nation, in particular, about our trade deficit problem and its very serious impacts (including the "impact" on our domestic federal budget deficit).

Enclosed is a write-up by me, completed on the day before your Florida Blue Key keynote speech, on "A Macro-Approach for our Trade Deficit Problem" for your information. I have developed an entirely "new concept" as a vehicle for a macro-approach to our devastating trade deficit problem. A proposed mechanism, utilizing this new concept, will allow us to simultaneously 1) maintain "free trade," and 2) maintain the international leverage to ensure that our free trade stance does not reduce our economic power.

To give you the background how I happened to work on the trade deficit problem, I was Dean, College of Engineering and Director, Engineering & Industrial Experiment Station (EIES) at the University of Florida for 15 years (1973-88). In these capacities, I was very interested in a range of topics associated with the economic well being of our nation, e.g., technology transfer, innovation and entrepreneurship, automation and improvement of industrial productivity, and trade deficit; and was involved in many of these activities.

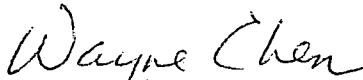

For example, I created in 1977, the NASA-STAC (Southern Technology Applications Center) as a "technology transfer" organization, first covering the entire State of Florida and then also the southeastern states plus Texas. This organization continued to report to me for 11 years (1977-88). As additional examples, I was an organizer and panel moderator for HIGH TECH '84, and a Keynote Speaker for AUTOMATION '86 (American Automation Association, Houston, Texas, March 9-12, 1986). Since 1986, I have been studying the trade deficit problem.

Governor Sununu, since our nation is experiencing a monumental crisis in our trade deficit, and no viable solution is on the horizon, I hope that my writing might stimulate some thoughts, discussions, follow-ups, and the evaluation of the proposed concept and mechanism.

Dear John:

I thought it would be useful to bring to your attention some actions that the State of New York has taken regarding the implementation of our Shoreham settlement with the Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) and regarding the communications established as a result of my August meeting with the President and you.

First, however, let me alert you to a development that may warrant your attention.

I had understood since the August meeting and Henson Moore's session last month with Gerry Crotty, my chief of staff, and Brad Johnson, my Washington counsel, that there would be a mutual effort to keep our dispute on the merits and avoid unnecessary attacks. Recently, however, Energy Secretary Watkins is reported to have told 800 bankers at the Edison Electric financial conference in Palm Beach Monday that our Shoreham settlement was "stupid," that Long Islanders shouldn't mind Shoreham because living on Long Island is "extremely risky," and that "they are being deceived [on Shoreham] by some of their leaders." I have no difficulty responding to our bellicose Admiral friend, but I'm not sure this is the tone you, or I, wanted. Let me know.

I believe we can cultivate a more constructive approach by seeking consensus on some of the remaining issues in dispute. In this regard, I note Secretary Moore's statements to the American Nuclear Energy Council that the federal tax consequences are the same regardless of whether Shoreham closes or operates, and that tax considerations are not therefore a basis for concern about the settlement. I hope the Administration will communicate that conclusion to Reps. Gingrich and Ritter, who have been citing this non-existent "tax bail-out of New York" to attack the settlement.

Forthcoming discussions on economic assumptions for assessing the costs of power supply options for Long Island should also further the consensus-building process. These discussions, agreed upon at Secretary Moore's meeting last month, are to be held between Department of Energy (DOE) staff and that of the New York State Public Service Commission. I understand that the Public Service Commission has indicated its interest in such discussions, which I hope can proceed expeditiously.

Similarly, I understand that my State agencies' staffs and DOE have been working diligently to set up a technical meeting to discuss energy planning. Writing New York State's energy plan has brought home to my State agencies a number of lessons that Federal planners might find useful. Among the most important of these is giving the environmental impacts of energy choices equal attention to the energy choices themselves. In addition, my Administration stands ready to participate directly in the Northeastern session of DOE's national energy policy hearings whenever it can be scheduled. I hope DOE will continue in this Northeastern hearing the broad focus on all major energy sectors of its first phase of hearings.

LILCO has throughout this period cooperated fully with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in complying not only with the requirements of its license and applicable NRC regulations, but also with the NRC staff's inquiries regarding ongoing procedures at the Shoreham plant. The relevant New York State agencies anticipate that they too will proceed with the timely completion of plans to implement their parts of the settlement and to consult appropriately with the NRC regarding those plans.

In that regard, you may have been apprised of NRC Chairman Carr's September 18 response to Secretary Watkins's letter of July 27 seeking immediate NRC intervention in LILCO's activities at the Shoreham plant. Chairman Carr's conclusion that LILCO's current activities and plans discussed with the NRC meet the requirements of law, regulation and license is most significant in itself. It is equally important, however, for what it says about the NRC's recognition of the realities of the State's settlement with LILCO. As settlement opponent James Larocca (President of the Long Island Association) acknowledged, "We have to decide whether it's worth the battle.... They [the NRC] are apparently not going to fight the battle for the Department of Energy or anybody else because they don't have an operator willing to operate the plant." The overriding reality is that LILCO and the State are working together because we both recognize that the fiscal health of LILCO, the lowest-cost rates for Long Island ratepayers, and the greatest assurance of a reliable power supply are best provided by the settlement and not by the operation of Shoreham. With these realities in view, Mr. Larocca's group is (according to the September 20 Newsday) reconsidering its opposition to the settlement.

In a similar vein, on October 5, New York State Supreme Court Justice Travers decided that the DOE lawsuit against the State did not demonstrate a "likelihood of success on the merits." This is

further judicial confirmation of our view that the only meaningful issues relating to the settlement that remain to be fully resolved are a few straightforward regulatory matters, not legal matters.

Finally, as you recall, the President promised at the August meeting that he would provide responses to the 10 Shoreham questions I left with him. I hope, with the passage of two months since the August meeting with the President, that these responses will soon be forthcoming. They would, I believe, contribute to a constructive process in which the shared recognition of facts and conditions can enable us to move beyond this unfortunate and unnecessary conflict. The sooner we do so, the sooner we can face the challenges of common concerns and the pursuit of shared goals in energy policy.

The Romans had an expression which, to the effect, stated: "Courage isn't the only virtue . . . but it is the only virtue that, without it, nothing else seems to matter".

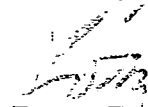
Permit me to make one assumption: That the guys who are elected to serve their constituencies in Washington are there to do what is in the best interest of the United States of America.

Dear John,

Thank you for your call concerning the transuranic mixed waste storage problem that has been caused by the State of Colorado refusing to take more of its own waste at the Rocky Flats Plant. I realize that this is important to national defense, and I am surprised that the State of Colorado, while hoping to keep the jobs and the project there, is not willing to accept the bi-product that goes with it.

However, I must take the position, as I have on other types of waste, that those states that generate waste and do not accept waste from my state or will not handle their own waste, may not ship that waste to the State of South Carolina. I have taken this position consistently dealing with hazardous waste and certainly believe that it applies to the transuranic waste. I do not understand how the State of South Carolina could take 7,000 - 10,000 cubic feet of waste from a facility in Colorado that is only willing to handle 1,601 cubic yards of its own waste.

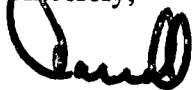
So, my position on this matter is that South Carolina is willing to handle the waste generated in our state, and, as you know, we have a great deal of waste stored at the Savannah River site awaiting for permanent storage at WIPP. We are not willing to take waste from other sites because they refuse to handle it themselves. But, if you choose to move part of the operation from the Rocky Flats facility in Colorado to the State of South Carolina, bringing the jobs and the payroll, then, of course, we will handle any waste bi-product that should come from that. I believe that to be only equitable.

As a matter of information, I am informed that the Savannah River site could handle several aspects of the operation at the Rocky Flats facility, and will be glad to provide you more detailed information per your request.

John, we always stand ready to do our patriotic duty in the State of South Carolina. We are strong supporters of national defense. We have been strong proponents of nuclear energy, but we will not become the dumping ground for other states not willing to meet their own responsibility while seeking to glean prosperity from having such facilities in their own state.

I look forward to seeing you in the near future, and if you have any questions in this regard, please do not hesitate to give me a call.

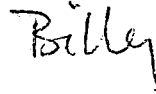

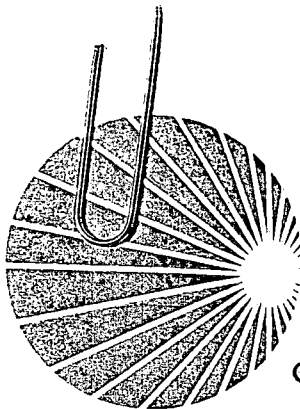

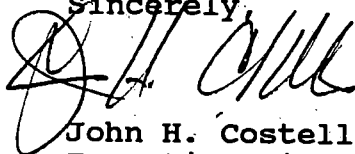

Al Zapata and Henry Ramirez, two veterans of the Republican Party affairs, are developing a plan in consultation with Lee Atwater, to attract the growing Hispanic electorate with emphasis in California. The Hispanic population, nationwide, is projected at 21 million in 1992. Two-thirds will be Mexican Americans with a median age of 26.7 years. The potential is apparent and can be a key factor to the Bush presidency and its incumbency plans. The President has the style to attract the youth. I met George Bush at a young age in Houston 20 years ago and my admiration remains as firm and strong today.

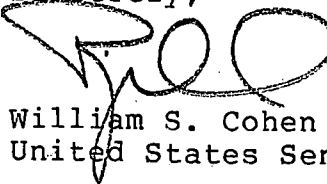
While in Boston recently, I met with Jim Daley, the owner of the Copley Plaza Hotel, one of Boston's oldest and finest hotels.

I had to write you after I read the R. W. Apple article on you in last Wednesday's New York Times. It was an excellent article, one that was long overdue. When I thought how happy it would have made Mark Haroff, I decided to write and tell you about my last meeting with Mark.

I had been a friend of Mark's for 20 years and yet he never told me about his illness. Late last year, a mutual friend said he had heard a rumor that Mark was ill. When I went to Washington for the inaugural in January, I called Mark and visited him at his home. He never said one word about his health and I never asked him any questions because he seemed to be in good physical condition.

Our entire one-hour discussion focused on how the press was misreading the new chief of staff. As a matter of fact, Mark had drafted an article which he was going to submit to Newsweek for its "My Turn" column. He asked me to read it and comment on it. Many of the points brought out in the Times article were in Mark's draft. I told Mark that if he were so concerned, he should seek a position in the new administration, possibly one that would be put him close to the new Chief, especially in the early days of the transition when it is nice to have a friend around whose judgment you respect.

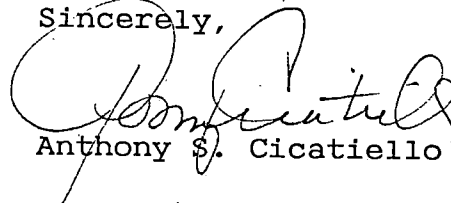
When I got the call about his death, I didn't want to believe it. I shut out politics for several weeks because it lacked a vital ingredient for me -- knowing that Mark was there to discuss an idea or to get a reading on the national scene. Even Governor Kean called me to ask where I had been since I hadn't talked with him for two weeks. Mark Harroff was the person who called me in 1974 and asked if I would go to New Jersey to run Tom Kean's campaign for Congress. It was Mark's persuasion that got me to move to New Jersey.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I read with great interest in the September 5, 1989 issue of the Wall Street Journal of your session with 10 college presidents which "included a lecture from White House Chief of Staff Sununu...about tuition increases that he deemed excessive".

I applaud the efforts of the Justice Department to look into what has long been an open secret--namely the collusion among the so-called "high prestige" Eastern colleges with regard to tuition, financial aid and admissions as well as the copycat effect which causes second tier schools to raise tuitions so that they can also appear to be prestigious.

I have a daughter who is a freshman at Brown University, and I am very quickly becoming more than a little upset with that institution which, even with financial aid, costs far beyond the ability of a secretary at the gas company to pay for. Since my daughter has been at Brown I have learned that their orientation activities included the hiring of 40 buses to take the students for a frolic in the surf at Newport--not a sign to me, at least, of heavy-duty cost-cutting endeavors. However, in spite of the hefty price tag of the school, she was not able to enroll in a writing class, despite statements in orientation materials that students who received, as she did, a 5 on the Advanced Placement English Test would receive preference in registration for writing courses. Surely education costs must be bloated if for \$19,500 a year a student cannot get the most basic instruction. I eagerly anticipate whatever future delights Brown University has in store for poor me.

Another interesting issue in higher education is the question of merit vs. need-based aid vs. athletic merit aid or scholarships.

I resent the fact that even UNH, for example, not exactly an athletic power in the Big 10 sense, seems to find beaucoup money for merit-based financial aid to athletes, but rather a paltry amount for outstanding students. UNH only funds, to my knowledge, three National Merit scholarships, and these scholarships will constitute only a small part of the need-based financial aid package. Given the same family financial situation, a marginal student ends up with the same financial obligation as an exceptional one. Compare that to the full merit-based athletic scholarship which is awarded without regard to ability to pay. Nice to know that our educational priorities are so well thought out.

The most disturbing aspect of the almost totally need-based financial aid system is that it is yet another instance in our society in which one is rewarded for irresponsibility. I could quit my job, blow my money on luxuries, and generally whoop it up and then have the taxpayers and people who endow universities pay the entire cost of my children's education. I certainly know enough people who have educated their children at practically no cost to themselves by the simple expedient of spending every penny they have on fancy cars, nice furniture and gracious living. In contrast, I might as well have my entire salary direct-deposited to my daughters' universities since that's where every cent goes anyway. That's my reward for being fiscally responsible and raising a fine student (NH Governor's Scholar, National Merit Scholar, University Scholar at Brown, Valedictorian at Trinity High School, 1500 SAT's).

I fully support the efforts of the Bush Administration to keep higher education costs in line. I've long observed that the increases in funding that educators have told us were "bare-bones necessities" usually end up benefiting mostly themselves. There seems to be very little "trickle-down" effect to students.

Dear John:

I understand that you are reviewing the Department of Commerce regulations requiring use of turtle excluder devices (TEDs) in trawl nets. I urge you to support Secretary Mosbacher in his final decision to implement these important regulations.

During consideration of the Endangered Species Act Amendments of 1988, considerable time and effort went into development of a provision on the conservation of sea turtles. The integrity of that Act, which establishes a policy that "all Federal departments and agencies shall seek to conserve endangered species and threatened species", demands strict adherence to the requirement that Federal agencies "use the best scientific and commercial data available". According to the Commerce Department's National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, use of TEDs will "substantially reduce the loss of an estimated 11,000 threatened and endangered turtles that are caught and drowned in shrimp nets every year." It does not appear that a comparably effective method of saving sea turtles is available at this time.

Enclosed please find a copy of a letter which I sent Secretary Mosbacher urging that he implement the Federal regulations protecting threatened and endangered sea turtles. I hope you will take my views into consideration as you review this important issue.

Dear Governor Sununu:

You will recall that we served together in the New Hampshire legislature 1973-1974 and helped Mel Thomson stem the tide of higher taxes. Ten years later you were instrumental in saving the taxpayers \$20 million during the construction of I-93 through Littleton by advocating the construction of a causeway at Moore Reservoir instead of two costly bridges. Without your help, George McAvoy and I could not have persuaded highway officials to consider the causeway.

You stand for honest, frugal government and free enterprise. I hope that your attitudes will influence the Executive Office. That's why I am writing you this letter about South Africa. In your position you have access to much intelligence information, but perhaps the personal impressions of an old acquaintance may be of special interest to you.

You know of my longstanding interest in South Africa. You may recall meeting my friend Dr. Rex J. Keddy in your office. He is head of the Nuclear Physics Department of Witwatersrand University in Johannesburg and South Africa's leading nuclear physicist. Dr. Keddy visits the U.S. annually to lecture at American universities. I recall visiting your office at the State House and introducing you to Mrs. Ilmary Keddy, during one of her visits to the U.S.

I recently returned from a stay with the Keddys in Rivonia, outside of Johannesburg. This was my fifth trip to South Africa. The last one, during which I was accompanied by Governor Mel Thomson, was in September of 1986 just before the Congress voted to override President Reagan's veto of harsh sanctions against South Africa. On this latest trip I had an opportunity to witness the effects of sanctions.

I flew via Heathrow Airport July 30 and returned August 22. I visited Anglo American's new Daggafontein plant (completed in 1987), part of the East Rand Gold and Uranium Company, and several other large industrial sites. I also inspected several public works construction sites. As usual, I was very impressed by the ingenuity and work ethic of the South African people. Unlike the U.S., for example, South Africa maintains a positive balance of foreign trade under very adverse political conditions.

South Africa is also making enormous progress in resolving her internal problems. Apartheid is certain to end. The big question is how.

If South Africa enjoys prosperity, the transition to a new society will be relatively peaceful. If South Africa suffers economic handicaps, the transition will be violent in the extreme. Unfortunately the U.S. policy of economic sanctions favors the violent alternative.

Again and again I observed that unskilled Black unemployment has increased under U.S. sanctions. With unemployment comes diminished economic opportunity which causes social unrest. Both the extreme left and right gained strength in Wednesday's elections—a result of this economic uncertainty. Sanctions have fueled the communist movement and caused the Conservatives to turn inward: "a fortress mentality." This unfortunate result was predicted by nearly all observers. Yet, it's not too late.

South Africa is facing major decisions. The U.S. should help South Africa make the right decisions.

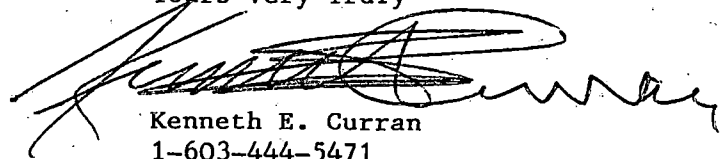
The future of South Africa is the subject of an excellent videotape produced by Anglo American Corporation. Recently shown throughout that country, "The World and South Africa in the 1990's" is 96 minutes long (VHS) and narrated by Clem Sunter, an official of Anglo American. It summarizes a major study of South Africa's future. It shows several alternative scenarios which the nation faces.

I think it would be wonderful if you could view this video tape and convey its message to President Bush. Better yet, perhaps the President himself could see it.

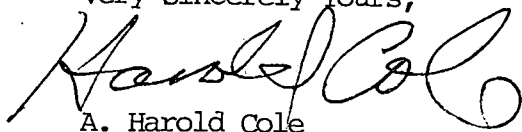
Dear Honorable Sununu:

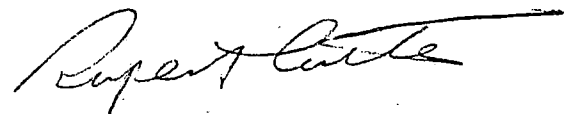
Dear John,

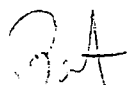
