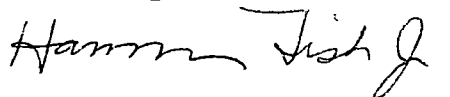

As you may know, I was one of the founders and original members of the Board (and still serve) of the National Endowment for Democracy which was created in 1983. The Endowment's first chairman was John Richardson, and I served as the first vice chairman. The officers serve for two-year terms.

The present chairman of the Endowment is former Trade Representative William Brock and the vice chairman is former Democratic National Committee Chairman Charles Manatt. The other members of the Board are LeGree Daniels, Jay Van Andel, Polly Baca, Zbigniew Brzezinski, Congressman Dante Fascell, Senator Orrin Hatch, Lane Kirkland, John Richardson, Olin Robison, Albert Shanker, Sally Shelton-Colby, Charles H. Smith, Jr. and Eddie N. Williams. Carl Gershman is the President of the Endowment and holds a staff position.

Under the bylaws of the Endowment, no member of the Board may serve longer than three consecutive terms. As a result, in January 1991 (one year from now) Bill Brock, Polly Baca, LeGree Daniels, Al Shanker and Charles Smith are required to leave the Board. Within the next month, the Board of Directors will fill five present vacancies and are thinking ahead

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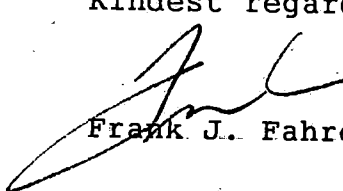

to the vacancies that will be created in 1991 when five of our original members will retire. In other words, there will be ten new members of the Board of NED within the next year. A New Member Committee, headed by Bill Brock, recently met and have preliminarily proposed eight names as suggested members five of whom are to be elected at our January Board Meeting to fill the five vacancies that presently exist. The eight names preliminarily submitted include: former Ambassador to Chile Harry Barnes, Frank Carlucci, Henry Cisneros, Stu Eizenstadt, Eleanor Holmes Norton, Drew Lewis, Bill Luers and Roz Ridgeway.

I have communicated with Bob Kimmitt at State the fact that these eight names have been proposed. While certainly NED is an independent body, I think that it is important that President Bush have input into the makeup of the Board due to its important work. As the senior Republican on the NED Board, I would appreciate your counsel (I have requested the same from Secretary Baker through Bob Kimmitt) as to comments concerning the eight names that have been put forth as well as any suggestions you might have for additional nominations. I am not pleased with the suggested names and would like to put forth others.

Dear John:

President Bush recently recognized 1990 as the bicentennial year of our Nation's first patent and copyright laws through the issuance of his Presidential Proclamation 6013 dated August 15, 1989. The Foundation for a Creative America is in charge of the planning for the celebration of the 200th anniversary during the week of May 7, 1990.

It seems to me that the President's direct participation in the week of celebration can highlight American technology and innovation at a critical time in our Nation's competition against our trading partners to be on the cutting edge of new technology.

On Thursday evening, May 19th, at the Sheraton Washington, there is an opportunity for the President to attend the Third Century Awards Ceremony at which event ten men and women will be honored for contributing substantially by their patents and their copyrights to America's contemporary life. The Young Inventors and Young Creators awards will be presented to winners of ten nation-wide science and problem-solving competitions and eight creative arts and authorships competitions. These youngsters, ranging in age from the fourth

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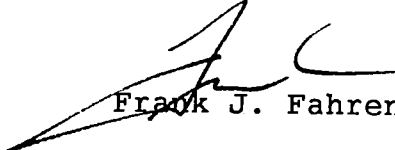

grade through senior high, have been competing in these individual competitions during the past year. It seems that Mrs. Bush, who is so closely associated with literacy and educational causes, would be a perfect choice to present the medals and savings bonds to these young winners. The celebration week really provides President Bush with an opportunity to speak directly on American creativity and innovation.

There is historical precedent for the President's involvement in the 200th anniversary. President Benjamin Harrison, in April 1891, not only addressed delegates to the National Congress commemorating the Centennial Anniversary of the Patent System, but also hosted a reception at the White House.

I believe formal invitations and letters will be directed to the President and the Scheduling Office from the Foundation for Creative America and by Joseph M. Potenza, the Vice President of the Foundation.

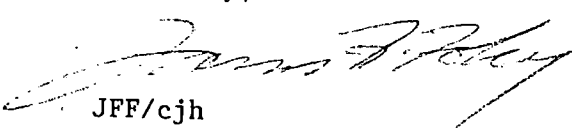

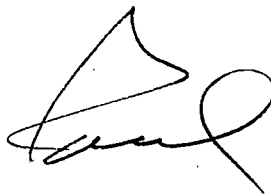

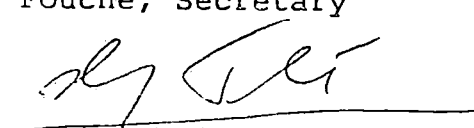
Honorable Governor

In these days of rapid change and of movement toward democracy occurring in the world, here in the Americas, Haiti seems completely removed and completely opaque to the winds of democratic changes. Governor, it has been nearly two months since three members of the Haitian Opposition: Mr. Evens Paul, Mr. Marineau Etienne, and Mr. Jean-Auguste Mesyeux have been detained by the military government without any charges being brought against them. During their incarceration, the three detainees have been beaten and badly injured, and have been paraded on national television with their bruises and injuries shown in conspicuous manners, as a warning perhaps to others who may disagree with the military government. A picture of the three as they appear on State Television is enclosed for your handling. Honorable Governor SUNUNU, the HAITIAN PATRIOTIC COMMITTEE OF CHICAGO requests your good offices in bringing the case of Haiti to the attention of the President, the Secretary of State, and other officials of the government; and in pressuring the military government to release the detainees or allow them their day in court, and also to end the campaign of terror too long in an endemic state in Haiti. Violent crimes are occurring daily, death squads are roaming the country, the government claims to be investigating but not a single arrest of any criminal has been made. In the case of those who speak against the government, retribution is swift and many times deadly. We hope your office will continue to fight for human rights, and will denounce abuses against human dignity wherever they occur. On 12/13/89, another leader of the Opposition was arrested. Frantz Patrick Beauchard, an ex soldier, was one of the leader in the coup against military dictator Henry Namphy back on September 17, 1988. He is being detained along with his brother. No news of their condition have reached us yet, since the government has banned the news media from covering the story.

If Haiti is to ever reach the path to democracy, abuses such as these must not be allowed to go on. After 34 years of despotic rules by Duvalier and now his holdovers, change can only occur, if the friends of Haiti continue to pressure the die-hard Duvalierist still in charge of the country. Haiti too must have democratic institutions, and free and honest elections, and that is the only way out of the crisis in which the country is sinking deeper and deeper.

Governor, the people of Haiti thank you, and are counting on you to once more speak for the voiceless.

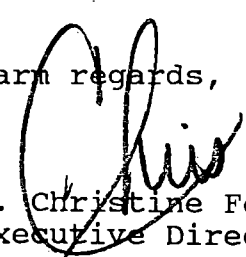

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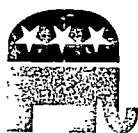

Dear John:

I would like to put on the record the outstanding performance of Doug Wead in a very delicate diplomatic situation which developed this week.

On December 13th at 1:30 p.m., the President was scheduled to meet with five leading Islamic leaders who were in Washington to discuss the creation of a Center for Islamic Studies at Catholic University.

The Egyptian Ambassador was the man contacted to coordinate the arrivals at the White House. He notified only the two leading Islam leaders from Egypt but none from Saudi Arabia who were at the same meeting on the morning of December 15th. When the Saudi representatives learned that they would not meet the President, they notified their Catholic University contact who called the NSC Council. Some individual in the NSC office told the Catholic University office to have the Saudi representatives proceed to the White House and join the meeting.

Dr. Abdullah Nassif, Secretary General of the World Moslem League and Sheik Hassan Enany arrived at the White House at 1:39 p.m. and were told that they were late for the meeting and could not attend. They went back to their hotel fuming with rage. The Saudis represented the group which was to fund the Center for Islamic Studies at Catholic University.

When Catholic University called me, I called Doug Wead and explained the situation. You or your staff apparently were not available, so Doug, on his own initiative, sent a letter to Doctor Abdullah Nassif explaining that the President's schedule prevented his extending the time of his meeting with the Islam

authorities and regretted not being able to meet with him.

This letter was sent to Dr. Nassif at the Willard Hotel at about 9:30 p.m. and Dr. Nassif received the letter to the knowledge of the Saudi Arabian group. He had to leave Washington at 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, 14 December.

On Thursday, December 14th, the Saudi Islam group met with the Catholic University Committee and agreed to establish the Center for Islam Studies at the University with a multi-million dollar grant.

The Catholic University negotiators believe that if Doug Wead had not taken action immediately, the whole concept of the establishment of the Islamic Center would have been jeopardized and the relations between Islam and Catholicism would have been set back.

It is a pleasure to see such intelligent and prompt action taken by a member of your staff to respond to a very delicate and important diplomatic situation.

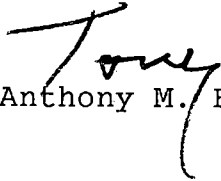
Dear John:

Pursuant to our conversation of November 13 on the occasion of the opening session of the 20th Universal Postal Congress held at the Kennedy Center, I directed the Assistant Postmaster General for International Postal Affairs to have his staff review the stamps issued by Nicaragua since the installation of the Sandinista Government.

Our conclusion is that the Government of Nicaragua has not used the vehicle of stamps as a means of propaganda or to overtly promote Marxist or militaristic ideology. The overwhelming majority of stamps issued between 1981 and 1987 are completely nonpolitical in theme and execution.

I am enclosing a summary of our findings.

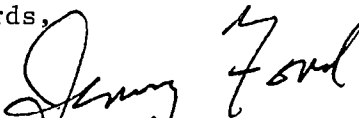
Enclosed is a copy of the Grapevine piece from the November 27, 1989 issue of Time magazine.

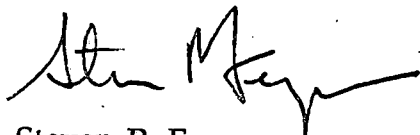

Dear John:

As you know, I am an active and concerned Board member of the Mary Hitchcock Memorial Hospital and the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center. I would respectfully request that as you participate in the finalization of our nation's budget you give strong consideration to the funding needs of the Medicare program.

In New Hampshire, the Medicare shortfall is reported to be \$60 million. This has required other insurers, and ultimately the businesses and citizens of the state, to make up that shortfall. I am convinced that there is in fact a shortfall at the Medical Center as the costs of attracting and retaining labor, especially nurses, as well as the costs of new drugs and technology have not been provided for in recent Medicare payment increases. We have witnessed an increased intensity of the Medicare patients we serve which is not being picked up by the case mix adjusted payments.

Moreover, our funding as a rural referral center and as a teaching hospital has been frequently debated in this year's budget process, but any further reductions will have a significant impact on the costs of health care provided from local resources.

Due to an illness, this letter was delayed. I am aware that the 101ST Congress, in a flurry of activity to finish the business of the first session, has approved major pieces of health legislation for the President's signature. It is my belief, however, that the issue of Medicare underpayments remains to be resolved and needful of your consideration.

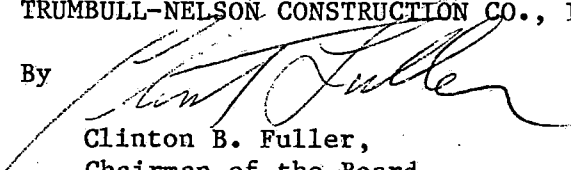

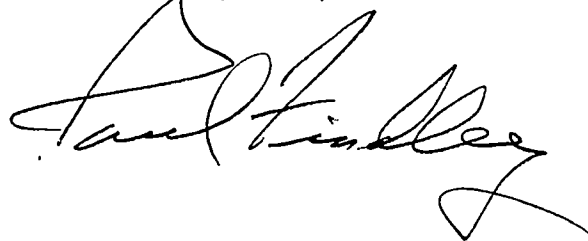

Dear Governor:

Cray Research Corporation is attempting to sell an upgraded supercomputer to Iramco, in Saudi Arabia. Its first sale was in 1984. The Saudis are insisting that the supercomputer must be shipped by Tuesday, November 28.

Under the US-Japan Supercomputer Agreement, we must give Japan 30 day notice of these sales. Unfortunately, notice was just sent by State two weeks ago. If Japan takes the full 30 days, which we assume they will, Cray will lose this sale.

Cray has not exactly been in the best financial shape recently. Loss of a \$19 million sale would not help improve its position. As you know, Cray currently is the extent of the US supercomputer industry, so I am hopeful that the Administration might provide some assistance. Specifically, I hope that a high-level contact could be made to encourage the Japanese to sign off on this sale before the November 28 deadline.

I have another question here which is why do we need to provide the notification when only an upgrade is involved. It would seem more appropriate to use the notification process when new sales are made.

This sale is vital to Cray. I would greatly appreciate anything you can do to provide assistance.

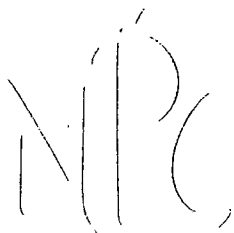

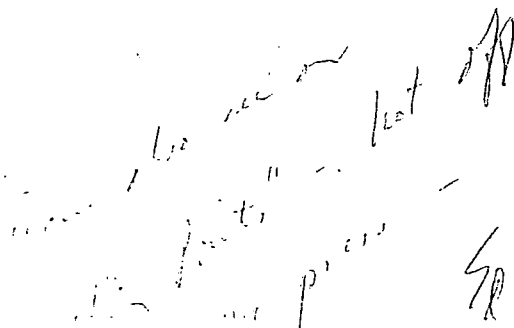

We are aware that the Economic Policy Council is considering whether or not to propose changes in the MFJ restrictions on Regional Bell Operating Company (RBOC) provision of information.

The American Newspaper Publishers Association strongly opposes entry by the RBOCs into information services over their own telephone lines. ANPA represents over 1,400 newspapers and 90 percent of the daily and Sunday newspaper circulation in the U.S.

RBOC entry would introduce the incentive to engage in unfair competition; regulatory safeguards would be inadequate to remove the opportunity to disadvantage competitors. Further, RBOC entry would run counter to the goals of competition and diversity of information services for consumers and businesses that have long been the foundation of U.S. telecommunications policy. As you consider this issue we urge you to include these important principles in your deliberations.

The circumstances that justified imposition of these restrictions have not changed. The reasons are the same as those justifying the long distance restriction on the RBOCs. Central to the analysis is that the RBOCs still have bottleneck control over local telephone facilities. There is no alternative for the local delivery of electronic information services.

Today's telecommunications policy, prohibiting RBOC ownership of content provided over their own monopoly phone lines, remains the most effective way to expand the growing electronic information services marketplace. It encourages competition by providing the RBOCs with no incentive other than to invite all information providers to use their monopoly local network as an electronic highway to consumers.

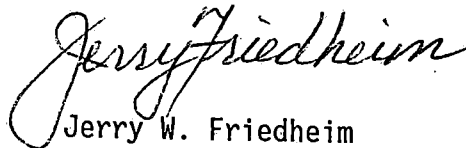
The information marketplace in the U.S. continues to develop. According to a 1988 report of the Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration, there are 4,000 databases in the United States. There has been no compelling record developed as to why the RBOCs should enter this market. Further, there have been no "efficiencies" demonstrated that would result from the RBOCs offering electronic publishing. What is clear is that the RBOCs retain the ability to discriminate and cross subsidize given their position as monopoly owner of the local phone bottleneck. FCC regulatory safeguards remain inadequate to prevent these abuses.

The U.S. is a world leader in the area of information services. We have a positive trade balance in information services, with two-thirds of the world's databases located in the United States. In fact, Japan imports eighty (80%) percent of its databases, seventy (70%) percent of which come from the U.S.

In sum, there is no international trade/national competitiveness argument for lifting the MFJ restriction on Regional Bell Operating Company entry into information services.

As a member of the Economic Policy Council, we urge you to reject endorsement of legislation that would lift the MFJ information services restrictions or simply transfer the decree to the FCC. Instead, we urge the EPC to support a public policy that would continue to prohibit RBOC entry into information services over their own lines. Such a policy will best further the goals of competitiveness, international trade and diversity.

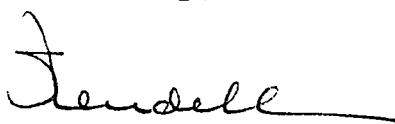

The recent visit of Cardinal Casaroli to Baltimore to join with the Catholic Bishops celebrating the 200th anniversary of the Catholic Church in the U.S.A. points up the need for a Catholic Liaison in the White House.

There was no one in the Office of Public Liaison who recognized the importance of the meeting. Only for Juanita Duggan in the Cabinet Affairs office, Cardinal Casaroli would have returned to Rome without seeing the President or other key members of the Administration. This effort on her part was performed outside of the Office of Public Liaison - on her own time.

I have written to you before, also to Andy Card, on this subject. Relations with the Catholic Church will not improve over time, but will deteriorate. It is widely known in Catholic circles that there is no place in the White House to go to discuss important Catholic issues. I recommended an outstanding young man, Michael Keenan Jones, to fill this position but, in the meantime, he has joined Admiral Watkins' staff at the Department of Energy. I do not know if he could be made available at any later date.

All I can do, John, is state the facts and point out the need to you and the Administration.

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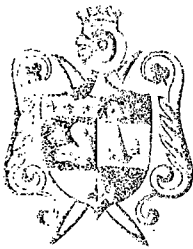

I met you several times in New Hampshire and have been able to support you wholeheartedly as you have risen to your present position.

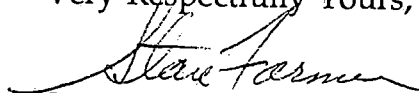

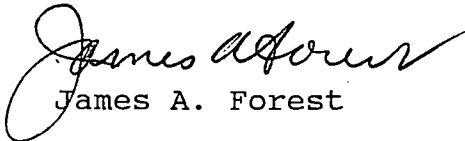

The most positive event in the 199 year history of the U.S. patent system was the establishment of the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit in 1982.

Why? Because it has a small number of judges who are engineering school graduates to begin with and are able to comprehend the scientific and engineering facts that come before them in patent cases. American industry suffered too long from the decisions in patent cases of federal judges who never even took a high school physics course. You wouldn't ask a person who reads only Braille to be an art critic.

Patent cases because of their complexity are the major part of the Federal Circuit's workload even though there may be a greater number of federal employee grievance cases (like the air traffic controllers who sought reinstatement).

I urge you to do the engineering profession and high tech industry a favor by involving yourself in these appointments. It is too important to be left to Justice, which gave us the likes of the recently impeached Alcee Hastings.

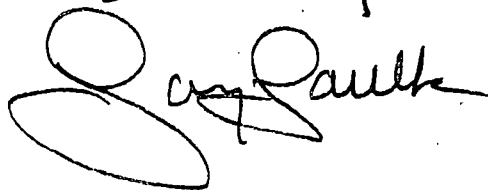

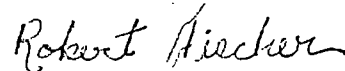

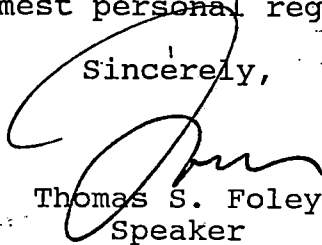

On behalf of the 1.9 million members of GREENPEACE USA (and our companion organization, GREENPEACE ACTION), we are writing to urge you to withdraw the nomination of Victor Stello to be the Assistant Secretary of Energy for Defense Programs.

GREENPEACE USA, GREENPEACE ACTION and 35 national, state, and local organizations are opposing his confirmation by the Senate.

Over the past two years, revelations of mismanagement and criminal negligence in the Department of Energy nuclear weapons production complex have shattered any semblance of public trust in the agency's operations.

It has not helped that this critical position of Assistant Secretary for Defense Programs has not been filled. But there is absolutely no question that the urgent tasks facing the DOE at its nuclear weapons production facilities demand an individual of exceptional integrity and ability. Victor Stello is not that individual.

In the three months since his nomination was sent to the Senate, skepticism has grown over Mr. Stello's credibility and qualifications for such a sensitive role. Two days ago, Secretary of Energy James D. Watkins asked Undersecretary John Tuck to assume on an interim basis the role of Acting Assistant Secretary for Defense Programs pending confirmation of Victor Stello. We hope that this is a sign that you are reconsidering the Stello nomination.

Mr. Stello's professional record at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), most recently as Executive Director for Operations, has shown him to be on the wrong side of nearly every safety and environmental issue that has confronted the Commission.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

As the Economic Policy Council considers the AT&T Consent Decree, TIA urges you to oppose efforts to relax the "line of business restrictions" imposed on the Regional Bell Operating Companies (RBOC's).

The Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA) is a national trade association whose membership includes nearly 500 manufacturers and suppliers of all types of telecommunications equipment. TIA's members are located throughout the United States and collectively provide the bulk of the physical plant and related products and services used to support and improve our nation's telecommunications network.

Legislation has been introduced on Capitol Hill which would negate the provisions contained in the AT&T Consent Decree, including the current restrictions on entry by the divested BOC into the telecommunications manufacturing and equipment supply business. The EPC "Opinions Paper" and the legislation presently under consideration would place the protection of competition, telephone ratepayers, and consumers in the hands of regulatory authorities whose inability to provide such protection led to the imposition of the MFJ "line of business" restrictions. If enacted, these initiatives would undermine the substantial progress achieved since divestiture towards the development of a dynamic, fully-competitive telecommunications equipment industry in the U.S.

Since divestiture the level of competition and the pace of innovation has increased dramatically in all sectors of the U.S. telecommunications equipment industry. The opportunity to compete for sales to the divested BOCs has encouraged investment in new entrants and existing industry participants. In addition, the more

open, highly dynamic marketplace has provided U.S. equipment manufacturers with a strong incentive to become more efficient and creative in meeting the needs of prospective purchasers, and therefore better able to compete in domestic and overseas markets. Today the industry is bigger and stronger than ever. Commerce Department statistics indicate there are more than 6,000 companies in the U.S. which manufacture or distribute equipment or components. Telecommunications equipment sales exceed \$65 billion in the U.S. market. R&D in the telecommunications industry is expected to reach \$20 billion in 1990 with the vast majority being conducted in the U.S.

Moreover, allowing the BOC's to manufacture telecommunications equipment will place U.S. telecommunications equipment suppliers at a significant disadvantage and will drastically alter the international competitiveness of the U.S. industry. This is because the BOC's are likely to enter joint ventures with foreign manufacturers to produce switching equipment and other network products, and buy such equipment exclusively from the partnership. This would give the foreign owned manufacturers guaranteed access to the biggest part of the U.S. market at a time when U. S. companies are excluded from full participation in many foreign markets. In short, such an approach would 1) foreclose American markets to American-owned firms 2) deny American firms the revenue needed to do the R&D necessary to compete in world markets and 3) give foreign-owned firms captive markets and guaranteed sales in the U.S.

TIA supports efforts to ensure that the "line of business" restrictions embodied in the AT&T antitrust decree remain consistent with the broader national interest. However, TIA believes that a careful examination of the origins of the MFJ manufacturing prohibition and its effect on the telecommunications equipment industry makes it clear that removal of the restriction at this time would have a significant adverse impact on competition, telephone ratepayer interests and consumer welfare.

In hopes of clearing up some of the apparent White House confusion about the scientific consensus on global warming, I have included for your review a copy of Worldwatch Institute's latest paper, Slowing Global Warming: A Worldwide Strategy. The first section of the report addresses the limits of scientific knowledge regarding human-induced climate change. The rest of the paper develops a practical and affordable action plan to slow global warming.

Our proposals and others like them are being taken seriously by policymakers in Europe. We are concerned, however, that the position of the U.S. government on global warming is beginning to be embarrassing in international circles--scientifically illiterate and politically cowardly. Fortunately, the President is in a position to change this situation rapidly--if he gets the right advice.

Also enclosed is a paper by Dr. Paul Damon of the University of Arizona, who for over two decades has studied the connection between solar variance and climate. In the enclosed paper, Dr. Damon points out basic errors made by Seitz, Jastrow and Nierenberg in their study, Scientific Perspective on the Greenhouse Problem, which we understand has caused much of the White House confusion. I hope you will have time to review Dr. Damon's critique.

Please let me know if you would like to discuss these issues in further.

So, I write to:

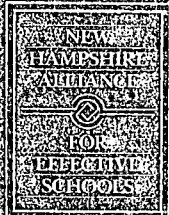
1. thank you for getting the program started, and
