Dear Governor Sununu,

Hanging on my wall is a photograph of myself reading a proclamation in front of Thompson Hall on the University of New Hampshire campus. The year was 1986, and you had issued this proclamation to salute the work of TRIO programs in New Hampshire. While I would be quite surprised if you remembered issuing this proclamation, I do hope you remain familiar with the work of TRIO programs not only here in New Hampshire but across the nation as well. On the basis of this hope, I am writing to request your assistance in another most important recognition of two of the TRIO programs.

Next year marks the 25th Anniversary of the Higher Education Act of 1965. In conjunction with this historic milestone, the National Council of Educational Opportunity Associations (NCEO) will conduct a National Student Leadership Conference for 100 Upward Bound and Talent Search students. The conference will take place in Washington, D.C. during the month of June.

The NCEO has set several goals for the conference. A list of these goals is enclosed. The conference will be called The Upward Bound/Talent Search Student Congress. Using the Senate model, two students will be selected to represent each state and territory.

In my capacity as president and past-president of the NCEO, I have been promoting this idea for the past three years. I am presently serving on the committee to plan and conduct the conference.

We are very excited about this event and are certain that it will serve as a prototype for future national conferences for Upward Bound and Talent Search students. As you know, these two programs serve a diverse cross-section of the country's population and represent one of the federal government's major initiatives for low-income, handicapped, and minority youth. These are the people who must be prepared to assume the leadership roles the nation will require in the next century.

At this time, I'd like to ask that you consider the following requests in support of this leadership conference and the 25th anniversary celebration of Upward Bound and Talent Search.

We would like President Bush to be aware of the conference and celebration. In the process, he may come to a greater appreciation of the work of these two programs over the past twenty-five years in addressing the issues of access and success in higher education for disadvantaged and minority youth - an issue gaining increasing priority across the nation.

As President Bush has said on several occasions, education is one of his top priorities. His recognition of these two exemplary federal programs will serve to increase their visibility and the possibility for greater replication. President Lyndon Johnson's leadership in bringing about passage of the Higher Education Act of 1965 established him as an Education President. I believe President Bush can demonstrate that education is indeed a bipartisan issue by asserting his commitment to the vision of this Act.

We hope President Bush will demonstrate his interest in educational opportunity by lending his support to the leadership conference and celebration. We ask that you convey to President Bush our interest in receiving an official recognition of this event as deemed appropriate. Of course, we would be honored if he will be available to address the students or to receive representatives of the Upward Bound/Talent Search Student Congress at the White House.

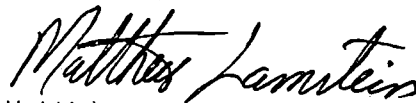
In the course of planning for the conference, we are seeking to gain Secretary Cavazos' interest in the project. To date, we have not yet received indication of his support. The Department of Education has reason to be extremely proud of the achievements of these programs during the past twenty-five years, and I would be surprised if the Secretary did not want to join in the recognition of their effectiveness in opening doors of opportunity for disadvantaged youth of the nation.

To assist in the implementation of this project, we have asked the Office of Post-Secondary Education to explore the availability of partial financial support for the project out of the Secretary's discretionary funds. If you consider it appropriate, I'd like to ask that you speak with Dr. Cavazos about support for this project.

Thank you for considering my requests. Please contact me if you require further information. I look forward to hearing from you.

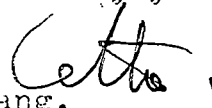
It is one thing to use a fancy word, but it is another thing to spell it correctly.

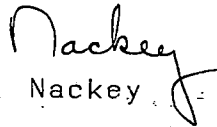

This letter is in reference to the Support for East European Democracy (SEED) Act of 1989. The Act successfully establishes a framework for U.S. assistance to Hungary and Poland that can be instrumental in helping these countries bring democracy and free enterprise to their people. President Bush is to be commended highly for his role in enacting this vital piece of legislation.

Under the Act, the President has the responsibility to designate two private, nonprofit organizations to act as Polish-American and Hungarian-American Enterprise Funds. As I am sure you are aware, it is essential that these organizations have a thorough understanding of democratic capitalism and a proven track record in dealing with the issues of democratization and privatization.

The U.S. Chamber of Commerce is uniquely qualified to oversee such funds and has a wealth of experience in assisting and promoting market-oriented economic reform around the world. No other business organization in this country has the developed program skills, network of contacts in Eastern Europe and experience in delivering the kind of assistance envisioned under the SEED Act that even approaches the Chamber.

Specifically, the Chamber's most recent East-West Trade program efforts led to the establishment of an American Chamber of Commerce in Hungary this past September - the first such organization of American business in Eastern Europe since before World War II. Other senior Chamber officials and I have led recent high-level delegations to Poland, Hungary and Czechoslovakia to articulate to both the current leaders and, more importantly, the future leaders in those countries' universities the values and benefits of free enterprise.

The Chamber for many years has had affiliates, such as the National Chamber Foundation (NCF) and the Center for International Private Enterprise (CIPE). These affiliates, 501(c)(3) private, nonprofit organizations, already are

active in the region. For example, NCF publishes the only journal, *The Journal of Economic Growth*, dedicated to educating people in developing and non-capitalist nations about free market solutions to economic growth. CIPE, consistent with its charter from the National Endowment for Democracy, recently funded inaugural private enterprise projects in Poland and Hungary. Ironically, the CIPE grant in Hungary will be sponsoring a course on free enterprise at Karl Marx University in Budapest.

The Chamber also has provided administrative support for four bilateral business councils (Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland and Romania) in Eastern Europe for the past fifteen years. These councils, consisting of business leaders from the United States and their foreign counterparts, strive to improve the climate for business and trade between the countries.

The Chamber has an unambiguous commitment to the principles of democracy and free enterprise, an existing network of contacts both in the American, Polish and Hungarian private sectors, and a proven track record of delivering effective assistance to emerging entrepreneurs around the world. Therefore, I respectfully recommend that the President give careful consideration to designating organizations established under the auspices of the U.S. Chamber to carry out the SEED Act's requirements for the Enterprise Funds for Poland and Hungary.

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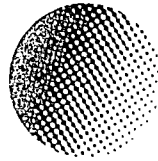

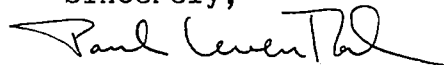
I am writing to advise you of a conversation today between Vladimir Nazarov, a first secretary at the Soviet Mission to the UN, and Milton Hoenig, the Institute's scientific director. Dr. Hoenig inquired as to whether there might be arms control items on the Soviet agenda for the upcoming December meeting between Presidents Bush and Gorbachev. Mr. Nazarov replied that a Soviet initiative for the December meeting on the question of a cutoff in the production of nuclear weapons materials would be formulated as it was at the recent ministerial meeting in Wyoming.

As I noted to you in my letter of last week, it is our understanding that at the Wyoming ministerial, the Soviets offered to negotiate a complete halt in the production of nuclear weapons materials, including tritium. We continue to believe that the Soviets might be considering a unilateral production halt and that this opportunity should be fully considered by President Bush in anticipation of his upcoming meeting with President Gorbachev.

We would welcome the chance to discuss this possibility with you, especially in light of current events at the Savannah River Site. If your schedule does not permit such a meeting, I hope you will facilitate a meeting with Roger Porter or another designee on the White House Staff or the National Security Council before the U.S. agenda for the meeting is set.

I will telephone you in the hope that it will be possible to schedule such a timely meeting.

The Catholic Bishops of the United States urgently request the President to veto the District of Columbia Appropriations bill.

The D.C. Appropriations bill eliminates the Dornan Amendment by permitting the local tax revenues to be used to pay for the approximately 4,000 abortions per year. The restriction on federal funding in the bill is meaningless, because every requested abortion for any reason will be paid for with district funds.

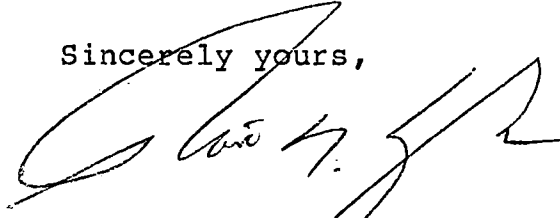

Dear John,

I am writing to you out of concern for federal funding of the Medicare program. Although the reconciliation process has not finalized the FY 1990 rates, and there have been some modest increases proposed; I am particularly concerned about initial discussions taking place on the FY 1991 budget which indicate funding levels may drop considerably.

With sixty five percent of our patient days being funded by Medicare, the New London Hospital could not survive as an acute care facility. In our most recent fiscal year (9/30) we were fortunate to have an operating loss of only \$200,000 on \$11.7 million dollars of revenue. Our contractual allowances for that year were 2.2 million dollars, an increase of \$500,000 over the previous year, and approximately 1.5 million dollars of the total is directly attributable to unfunded Medicare liabilities. In the first month of our new fiscal year we posted an operating loss of \$210,000 which is directly attributable to four patients who are on Medicare.

I believe we have done a credible job in bringing our expenses under control and we cannot survive as an acute care facility if we do not have fair and equitable treatment by our major payor, the federal government. Since the inception of the prospective payment system in 1983, the increases in Medicare funding for hospitals has fallen behind the medical cost index by over fourteen percent and the prospect of further widening that gap in FY 1991 is untenable. We have been fortunate through other sources to subsidize our major business, the acute hospital, but in the long run I feel it is highly unfair to continue to subsidize the federal government.

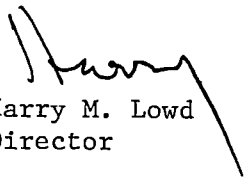

By way of followup to our meeting of August 4, at which Milton Hoenig, the Institute's scientific director, and Roger Porter and Ed Rogers were also present, I am writing to put forward a further idea in connection with the Institute's proposal for an initiative to achieve a complete U.S.-Soviet halt in production of nuclear weapons materials, including tritium.

First, let me report on a meeting on this subject that I and Dr. Hoenig had last week at the Soviet Mission to the UN with Alexey Y. Manzhosov, first secretary in the Department of Arms Limitation and Disarmament in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He asked to meet with us to convey a message from Deputy Foreign Minister V.P. Karpov to whom we had written on September 29, requesting a meeting concerning our proposal.

During the course of the meeting with Mr. Manzhosov, he advised us of Minister Karpov's active interest in the proposal. He also discussed the implications of the Soviet announcement of a timetable for the shutdown of all of its plutonium production reactors by the year 2000 (Soviet press release enclosed). He reiterated what we had heard from Counselor Kysliak at a meeting in the Soviet Embassy last June (the minutes of which we provided you) that the Soviets were prepared to discuss a tritium cutoff in a negotiation with the U.S. on a fissile material cutoff. He also expressed disappointment that, at the Wyoming ministerial meeting, Secretary of State Baker expressed no interest in a proposal by Foreign Minister Schevardnadze for a production-halt negotiation.

We told him we had learned independently that Karpov has stated that Schevardnadze's offer included a reference to a tritium cutoff. He responded that he had no information as to whether tritium was mentioned, but that Karpov was present at the Wyoming ministerial and that such a statement, if he made it, would be highly authoritative.

Of course, the Institute would be disappointed if the United States expressed no interest in what we understand was a Soviet offer at the Wyoming ministerial meeting to negotiate a production halt of all nuclear weapons materials including the short-lived material, tritium. At the same time, we would not be surprised because, as Dr. Hoenig and I stated in our New York Times op-ed article of August 28 (enclosed), we anticipated the U.S. government would be predisposed against a fissile material cutoff negotiation, especially one that could have the end result of all U.S. production reactors remaining down (because of ongoing safety problems) while some Soviet reactors continue operating to produce tritium.

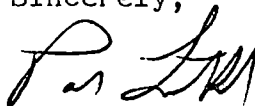
In light of the above, I ask you to consider the following idea on how a mutual, complete production halt could yet be achieved:

It is our hope that President Bush and General Secretary Gorbachev might yet communicate privately prior to the forthcoming December summit to identify a mutual interest in, and a workable approach toward achieving, a complete halt in production of nuclear weapons materials. If Mr. Gorbachev is prepared to shut down all remaining production reactors, both plutonium and tritium producers, it might be possible to work out a way for accomplishing this that would be acceptable to both leaders in advance of the meeting. For example, Mr. Gorbachev could offer to do it on his own initiative, or he could offer to do it in response to a proposal from Mr. Bush. Either way, the summit meeting could then be concluded with an announcement of the shutdown of all Soviet production reactors to match the current situation in the U.S., as well as with an agreement to proceed with a negotiation to make the mutual shutdown of U.S. and Soviet production reactors permanent and verifiable.

Dr. Hoenig and I have made a similar proposal to Minister Karpov.

Thank you for your consideration of this latest proposal which, we believe, is in the supreme mutual interest of the United States and the Soviet Union to give impetus to shared confidence-building, arms-reduction, economic and environmental goals. I will telephone you in the hope it might be possible to schedule another meeting, perhaps with a small delegation of U.S. experts available to us, to discuss this proposal further with you.

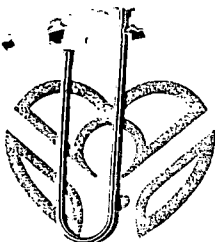

These individuals make up the Mailers Council and are a coalition which was established about a year ago to try to communicate with the Executive Branch of our Government regarding their current and future concerns about the financial help of the Postal Service. They have gotten the ear of the Postal Service, the Postmaster General and the United States Congress. However, they have not been able to communicate their concerns to any member of the Bush Administration or the White House.

In late February or early March a new yearly postal tax in the amount of \$10 billion will be filed with the Postal Rate Commission. This will be one of the more indirect taxes levied beginning around election time of 1990. The cost of running the Postal Service, has for the last couple of years, exceeded the rate of inflation by about two to one. Two years ago, just after a postal rate increase, the Postal Service forecasted that it would make a profit in fiscal year 1988 of \$1.6 billion. As you know, the year has just ended so final financial numbers are not yet available, but Postmaster General Frank acknowledges that the Postal Service will be lucky to have broken even.

John, while you and I both understand that the Postal Service is an independent, self-financed agency, the average American citizen may well view a 30¢ stamp in January 1991 as a tax increase.

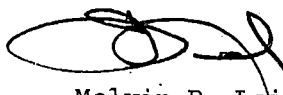

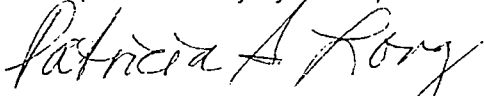
