Dear Mr. President, Dear Friend

This is to thank you once again for your kind assurances as well as to expand on the considerations and concerns which prompted me to call you yesterday.

The so-called "Armenian question" dates back to the last century and the allegations are mostly on events which took place during the First World War.

I am sure you will agree with me that study of such events of the past should be left to historians. When I came to power the Ottoman Archives were closed to the public. The Armenian propaganda used to exploit this against us. As You know, it was my government which opened the Archives for academic research. This should also facilitate an objective and factual assessment of the events in question. There has never been an intention on our part to distort the truth. Now it is up to the scholars to bring the facts to light. The Turkish Government can only welcome it.

It would be totally wrong for politicians to pass judgement on these historical events, especially at a time when they are under academic scrutiny.

I am distressed that Senator Dole's proposal is co-sponsored by 56 other Senators. The fact that many Senators friendly to Turkey should figure among the co-sponsors leads me

to believe that there is misconception in the minds of many as to the real nature and possible consequences of such a resolution.

I wish to assure you, Mr. President, that on this question which provokes profound national sensitivity, the Turkish nation in its entirety is of one mind.

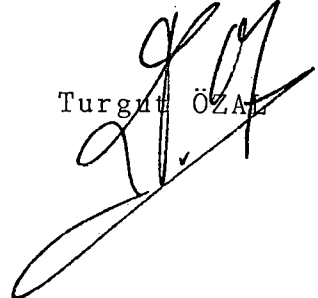
In the past, the opposition of the previous Administration and the efforts of the members of Congress, forestalled the passage of a resolution similar to Senator Dole's proposal on no less than three occasions. The US Administration and the Congress showed the wisdom to stand against it because they did not want to take sides in a historical controversy and because they valued the friendship of a reliable ally.

We are very pleased that the strong Turkish-American relations are getting even stronger and wider in scope under your Administration. But the stakes are no less high now than they were before.

I am confident, Mr. President, that you will use all the means at your disposal to defeat this wrongful proposal, which seeks to legislate history and which could only severely damage the excellent relations that we both value so highly.

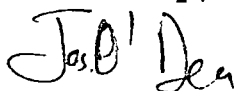

Dear John:

We are running out of time for the administration to act on the Alcohol Fuels Mixture Credit Clarification to extend the blender's credit to ETBE. If this is not accomplished by October 15, the decision will become a legislative issue reflecting poorly upon the President and myself, especially after the President's June 13 visit to Lincoln.

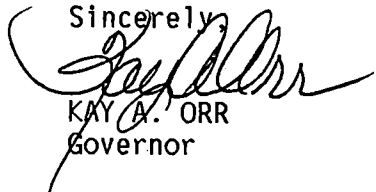
There are many reasons for proceeding as quickly as possible. As you know, the Midwest Governor's Conference passed a resolution requesting the administration take immediate action on this request. Also, there are substantial environmental advantages to the use of oxygenated fuels, including ethanol and ETBE, in terms of reduced carbon monoxide and ozone emissions. The blender's credit is necessary to aid in developing the tools needed to carry out the Clean Air initiative. Other advantages to the development and use of ETBE are: (1) The reduction of dependence on foreign oil (improving our balance of trade); (2) Utilization of a renewable resource (corn); and (3) Creating an opportunity to add value to grain products creating jobs and enhancing rural development opportunities.

It is also important to note the blender's tax credit will not cost the treasury. Since the credit is taxable, it could be a gain to the treasury.

Supporters of this move are Secretaries Yeutter, Watkins, Skinner, and Administrator Riley. There are also indications of strong Senate support as well as support from farm and ag organizations and automobile and oil companies.

Attached is a copy of the Midwestern Governor's Conference resolution and an article referencing the coming of tougher auto exhaust standards adding further to the need for tools to carry out the Clean Air initiative. Your immediate attention to this matter will be greatly appreciated.
