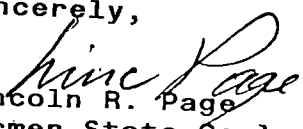
Dear Governor Sununu:

The recent issue of the American Minerologist has a definitive paper on the effects of acid rain on certain building stones. The experiments recorded show that local rather than distant sources of the acid radicals are mostly responsible for the damage. It is obvious to me that blaming the coal fired electric plants of the midwest, rather than automobile emissions, for most of the acid rain is causing us to waste our efforts at controlling the damage. Your help in redirecting our efforts in solving this problem would be appreciated.

I am enclosing a copy of the "Discussion" in this paper by Dr. Ross and associates of the Geological Survey in Reston, Va. Dr. Ross is not only the expert on the minerology of acid rain but also the asbestos problem, (another area where we are wasting millions of dollars because of misinformation.)

I hope you and Nancy are enjoying Washington and that you still have the smokey quartz crystals to remind you of New Hampshire.

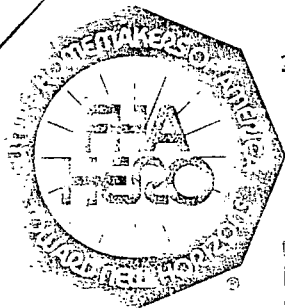

Our association has a grant that allows us to have a new state program. The state officers and myself recently organized TASC - Teens Are Seeking Choices. This program promotes self-esteem, saying no to substance abuse, and many other teen issues such as teen pregnancy and teen suicide. DARE and TASC are similar in philosophy and our state meeting are focusing on TASC as their theme.

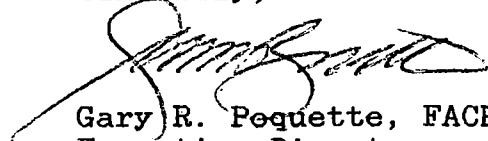

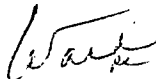

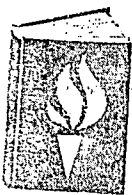

I enjoyed the opportunity to work with you on issues of federalism during your chairmanship of the National Governors' Association. I now write to you on another constitutional issue, this time in my capacity as president of the Freedom to Read Foundation. The Foundation is a First Amendment legal defense fund associated with the American Library Association.

My letter is prompted by Senator Armstrong's proposal for a ban on "pornographic" magazines at military exchanges and other stores under the control of the U.S. government. Such a ban would violate constitutional principles and create a precedent that could affect other materials available in these stores, as well as the nation's public libraries. If Senator Armstrong's proposal were to become the subject of an executive order, it would allow the government to restrict access to certain kinds of material because the government has taken the position that the content of that material is objectionable. Similar grounds, namely governmentally determined unsuitability based on the content, would then be available against a whole range of materials, not only "pornographic" magazines, that express objectional ideas. The Constitution forbids government from making decisions of that kind.

It is well established that "the First Amendment means that government has no power to restrict expression because of its message, its ideas, its subject matter or its content." *Police Department of Chicago v. Mosley*, 408 U.S. 92, 95 (1972). While "obscenity is not within the area of constitutionally protected speech or press" (*Roth v. United States*, 354 U.S. 476, 485 (1957)), pornography is accorded First Amendment protection. Thus, the Supreme Court unanimously reversed a conviction based on a statute that "quarantined] the general reading public against books not too rugged for grown men and women in order to shield juvenile innocence." *Butler v. Michigan*, 352 U.S. 380, 383 (1957). It has also ruled against restrictions on outdoor movies that were justified in terms of protecting passing minors. *Erznoznik v. Jacksonville*, 422 U.S. 205 (1975).

That the government is merely choosing to deny use of its facilities for the promotion of these magazines is no defense to the

constitutional objections. In *Island Trees Union Free School District No. 26 v. Pico*, 457 U.S. 853 (1982), the Supreme Court ruled that a school board did not have the authority to remove five books from the school library on the grounds that the books were "anti-American, anti-Christian, anti-Semitic, and just plain filthy." The key to the decision was the fact that the board was attempting to limit access to materials with which they disagreed. That is the essence of what the First Amendment prohibits. Similarly, when the Library of Congress made a viewpoint-based decision to discontinue the production and distribution of braille editions of *Playboy* magazine, a federal court ruled that the discontinuance violated the First Amendment. The rule of decision is that once the government undertakes to make something available it cannot discontinue that availability for content-based reasons. I submit that the proposal of Senator Armstrong is just that and thus fails to pass constitutional muster.

On behalf of the Freedom to Read Foundation, I urge President Bush to reject Senator Armstrong's proposed executive order and uphold the important values that underscore our constitutional freedoms.

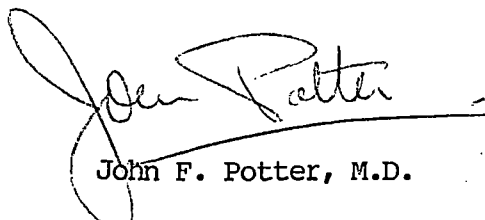

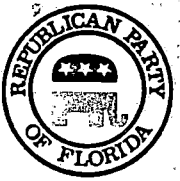

My dear John:

This letter is being sent to you on a confidential basis, in view of the nature of my remarks regarding a person involved in our broadcasting industry.

John, early in the Reagan Administration I warned Nancy to be cautious about Ted Turner and that his conduct, so often totally irresponsible, might pose some major concern for the President in the man's appearances at social events at the White House or at some other location in a gathering related to the Office of the President.

Apparently, Nancy and her social secretary and other aides did not understand the serious nature of that of which I spoke, so I wrote directly to the President.

John, I have always made it a firm policy not to release, even to close friends, any written exchange involving the Chief Executive of the United States. I feel, however, that in addressing this material to you in your capacity and with your emphasis upon basic values for this beloved Republic, you will understand the spirit in which I enclose a copy of my letter of my letter of May 7, 1987, to President Reagan and his response of May 20.

Yes, as a result of my reaching President Reagan, we did "close the social door" at the White House to the man I call "Mr. Irresponsibility."

Yet, in spite of warnings I made to our mutual good friend, candidate George Bush, during the campaign and prior to the Inauguration and by way of a letter in the midst of the campaign to Craig Fuller, George Bush, after the Inauguration still had Turner and some of his associates at the White House.

Believe me, John, there is no "jealousy" on my part for any reason. First of all, I have been invited at least once to dinner at the White House by every President from Harry Truman to George Bush. Also, I am presumptuous enough to say that I do not think I have to yield to Mr. Turner or anyone else as far as my record in broadcasting is concerned.

I do have a concern, however, because of my profound respect for the Office of the President and, above all, the great American who occupies the Presidency today, to have him "victimized" in any way, directly or indirectly, by this incredible man from Atlanta.

Rather than comment in any more detail, I suggest you read the enclosed photocopy of an article prepared by Cal Thomas as it appeared in the St. Paul Pioneer Press Dispatch under date of November 6, 1989. Yes, now Ted Turner has "taken on God." You have to read this piece to understand that about which I am writing, John.

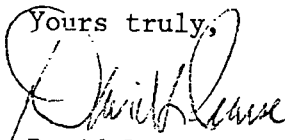
Dear Chief of Staff Sununu:

The purpose of this communication is to enlist your aid and support for a cause that has widespread influence amongst the people of our great nation and more specifically those of the Granite State. You well know the delivery of health care is under attack and thus becomes a perennial target for cost cutting in these days of ever increasing deficits. Despite the problems, whether they be real or perceived, the American public is at present being served well given the constraints, and our life expectancies bear out these sentiments. This may not hold true in the future should the federal government decide to cut Medicare funding in the budget that will be submitted to Congress for fiscal year 1991.

The preponderance of hospitals in the United States are rural in character and traditionally have a higher percentage of Medicare recipients. As we observe our patients growing both older and more in number, we find ourselves with less resources to deal with same. Here in Plymouth, Medicare represents 52% of our volume and that number is growing. Over the last five of six years reimbursement for Medicare has declined to the point whereby the cost of rendering care has exceeded the reimbursable amount by ten percent.

The consequences of inadequate funding are profound. While I speak as a hospital administrator, I can assure you that the true loser in this scenario is the elder Americans of today and tomorrow. These are folks that deserve a better fate. I implore you to exercise your considerable influence and good judgement to ensure that the Medicare program receives adequate funding.

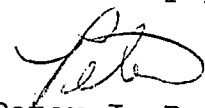

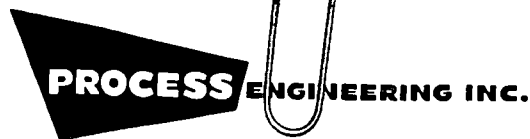

We are continuing to move forward with many of the exciting programs that were instituted in your days in the corner office. I thought you'd be interested in reviewing the initial report on the evaluation of the Governor's Initiative Program. You should certainly be very proud of the results. It was only through your foresight and leadership that we are this far.

The strides we've made have had a definite impact on educational performance of our public school system. I truly believe that targeted programs such as these are the way to improve the quality of our schools and the performance of our students.

I believe there is strong consensus that the "Computers for the Teacher" initiative has the single greatest impact on improving the quality of our schools. Without the "Computers for the Teacher" Program, we never would have been able to introduce the other technological advances that we are currently seeing -- such as interactive video discs and distance learning. It's a shame that we have not figured out a way to truly make New Hampshire a model for the nation with this initiative.

We have talked a couple of times about our concerns regarding the interrelated nature of the automotive policies under development by members of the Administration. As you know, Ford has supported the President's clean air initiative -- even though the Administration and the industry recognized that it was at the limits of our technical capability.

At the same time, we have pointed out to senior members of the Administration that a number of product requirements under consideration are actually in conflict. For example, proposed safety regulations will increase vehicle weight which, in turn, will reduce fuel economy. Moreover, without careful policy coordination, the cumulative impact of new product requirements will seriously erode the competitiveness of the U.S. auto industry at a time of weakening market demand and unprecedented foreign competition.

CAFE requirements will have the most pervasive effects on Ford and other full-line manufacturers. While we anticipate continuing improvements in the fuel economy of cars and trucks as we incorporate new technologies, there are no major breakthroughs on the horizon that will allow us to make major improvements in our fleet fuel economy. For Ford, mid-1990 car CAFE levels above 30 mpg will require a major tearup of our present plans and severely limit sales of some of our most competitive product lines. A major increase in truck standards will have similar effects. Proposed controls on CO₂ emissions in the Senate clean air bill, which are a back-door approach to higher CAFE standards, would have even more drastic effects.

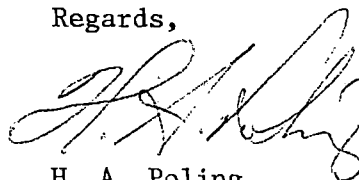
We were encouraged when Secretary Skinner told us last month that CAFE policy would be developed by an interagency task force that would report to the Economic Policy Council on all aspects of the issue -- including the impact on consumers, jobs, and the health of the industry. We plan to furnish Secretary Skinner with our best estimates of what is technically achievable and the impacts of various CAFE levels.

In view of this EPC review, we were distressed that last week Senator Bryan cited a Department of Energy study as support for his unrealistic CAFE legislation. The DOE study stated that meeting a 32 to 33 mpg car CAFE by 1995 would "greatly disrupt manufacturer product plans" and pointed out that the 39-mpg level for 2001 was a "hypothetical maximum case" and should "not be interpreted as a feasible fuel economy level ..." Senator Bryan virtually ignored these qualifications in his press release (attached).

We also were very disappointed that DOE elected to release the results of the study -- which is only an outside contractor's working draft -- before our industry had a chance to detail its concerns. From what we have seen, the study has some basic flaws. It projects fuel economy benefits that are about twice that which can be achieved on a typical vehicle and, in effect, double counts the benefits of some technologies (e.g., fuel injection) that are already standard on today's products. The estimates were not adjusted to reflect the adverse effects of new and pending emissions and safety requirements on fuel economy.

We would hope that you will consider several actions: 1) ask DOE to issue a statement that its study is still incomplete and does not support the CAFE levels in Senator Bryan's bill; 2) work to delete the CO₂ requirements in the Senate Environmental Protection Subcommittee bill; and 3) alert members of the Cabinet to the importance of the EPC having a full discussion of this issue before any policy statements are made.

Recently an 800-page report published by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services entitled "Report of the Secretary's Task Force on Youth Suicide" has come to my attention. The report is dated January 1989, and was a culmination of two years of tax-supported research. The segment of the report that particularly interests me is the one blaming religion for some teen suicides. Its subtitle is "Gay Male and Youth Suicide." Written by Paul Gibson, identified only as a San Francisco therapist and program consultant, this study accused Catholics and Baptists and other traditional and fundamentalist religions who depict homosexuality as morally wrong of creating "unresolvable internal conflicts for youth who adhere to their faith but believe they will not change their sexual orientation." The writer concluded that churches opposing homosexuality cause a youth to feel condemned to hell and push that youth to attempting suicide. The government study further stated that churches need to change their beliefs concerning homosexuality.

It goes without saying that such a report is not only inaccurate and without proper documentation but is absolutely nauseating and the greatest anathema to those of us who are Christians and evangelicals. To think that we have to pay for the production of such a report is unconscionable. I would appreciate very much your personal attention to this matter and to letting us in the Christian community know how we can deal with such distortion and its attack upon the very foundations of our Judeo-Christian faith.

It is hard for me to imagine that you or the President has any knowledge of such going on within our own government. Thank you for your consideration in this matter.
