A recent newsletter reported that OCRWM program was not a high priority. Compared with all the issues faced by the Secretary, this statement can be understood. However, my closest friend in OCRWM wrote me last week to express his concern regarding the lack of a permanent director for the past two years, the loss of highly experienced and wise persons who had left the office, the lack of guidance from the secretary's office and the resulting low morale.

What can be done to mitigate these serious concerns?

My best information reports a successful interview by John Bartlett with Senator Johnston, Chase Undermeyer and Martha Goodwin.

If a favorable decision is reached to recommend his appointment to the senate, I understand such action would result in his confirmation sometime in January or February. How wise would it be to consider his temporary assignment now, particularly if senate support seems clear? At a recent hearing Senator Johnston referred to Bartlett as Director.

Nuclear Waste Negotiator

When and if the President desires to appoint this negotiator, the attached recommendation came to me Monday, 10/16, from a close friend, Tom Cotton, who worked for OTA when I served on Secretary Hodel's AM/FM Panel. He authored "Managing the Nation's Commercial High-level Radioactive Waste" for OTA. The enclosed comments are from Tom.

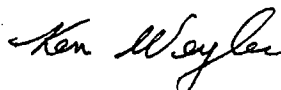
My question to you, therefore, is whether you have a slot for a part-time Air Force Reserve Brigadier General within the White House staff or National Security Advisors.

Our fight to save Shoreham from the wreckers is not over.

As you will have noticed, the Justice Department, at the request of DOE, have joined the suit of some private citizens of Long Island and SEC to enjoin the agreement of the Governor of NY and LILOO because they did not file an environmental impact statement.

In June, I and some other stockholders filed a stockholders suit against LILOO to set aside the decisions of the Annual meeting because of a grossly improper proxy statement. We were pressured to withdraw it, and I have not been able to get help to reinstate it. But we have a new man coming into SEC - Richard Bredson. He could start it on his own initiative. I just sent him details of the previous suit, suggesting that he follow it up. I wonder whether you would consider writing to Bredson, suggesting the same? If this happens about the time that the SEC and Justice suit is heard, the combined impact might be considerable.

Representative Don Ritter of Pennsylvania has also been trying to put pressure on SEC.

SUBJECT: Scientific Reports Supporting Turtle Excluder
Device (TED) Regulations

Attached are five reports prepared by NOAA Fisheries. Four of these reports were cursorily summarized in the last two pages attached to NOAA's memorandum, which you were provided by our Congressional Affairs officer on Saturday. They are:

1. Henwood and Stuntz, 1987, which supports the data concerning turtle captures and mortalities in the absence of the TED regulations.

2. Kemmerer, Summary Report from Trawl Tow Time Versus Sea Turtle Mortality Workshop, 1989, supporting the data concerning turtle mortalities associated with various tow times.

3. and 4. Stuntz and Kemmerer, August 28, 1989, both of which evaluate the effectiveness of 105-minute tow times in the Gulf and in the Atlantic.

5. Stuntz and Kemmerer, September 11, 1989, comparing the current TED regulations to an alternative regime of year-round TEDs in the Atlantic and year-round 105-minute tow times in the Gulf.

You have asked us to consider an option involving 90-minute tow times in the Gulf, and we will provide an analysis of this as soon as possible. You noted that the difference to the shrimpers was only a 4% additional loss of shrimp (27% versus 31%). However, we believe that the shrimpers will not be satisfied with either a 90 or a 105-minute tow time. Our best information is that this option is more costly to the shrimpers than TEDs properly used, but, of course, we will all do what we can to identify any legally available option.

To receive the best explanation of the scientific NOAA Fisheries scientific data and reports, we recommend that you be briefed by Dr. William Fox, the new Assistant Administrator for Fisheries of NOAA. Dr. Fox is an eminently qualified scientist who is intimately familiar with both TED and turtle issues. He is a political appointee who has most recently served as Director, Cooperative Institute for Marine and Atmospheric Science, University of Miami, and as Chairman of the Florida Marine Fisheries Commission.

A paper outlining additional options has already been provided to your staff.

I noted the recent Wall Street Journal item reporting your priority to move forward nominations for posts within the Administration that are being delayed at various points in the review process. I believe one of these is the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Pension and Welfare Benefits where David Ball's confirmation hearings have yet to be held. I understand that this is of concern to people working in the benefit plan and investment areas where significant issues are being held up pending high level attention.

It is unfortunate that Mr. Ball has not been confirmed, and I know of no reason why he should not be. However, if he should withdraw or not be confirmed, I would like to suggest an alternative candidate, C. Webb Williams, whom I have known well for many years, who is very well qualified for the post and who could fare well in the confirmation process.

Webb was a financial executive with Exxon who opted for early retirement in October 1986 after a 32 year career. He has a wealth of experience working both here and abroad. Among other assignments, he was Treasurer of Exxon's worldwide chemical operations. For the last nine years he had charge of financing Exxon's multi-billion dollar employee benefit plans and investing benefit plan assets. This provided a day to day working exposure to ERISA as well as financial markets. Webb has maintained his interest and kept abreast of developments in the area. He was an active candidate for Executive Director of the pension Benefit Guarantee Corporation and his name had previously been placed in consideration for the Assistant Secretary of Labor post.

He has always been interested in public affairs and politics and is a life-long Republican. Webb, like our friend de Tocqueville, is seeking a way to become involved in political life and contribute to the maintenance of democracy and individual freedoms. I believe that he would do a number of jobs imaginatively and well, but he seems particularly well suited to be the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Pension and Welfare Benefits.

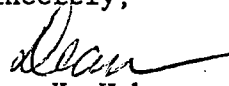

Dear Governor Sununu:

I know you and President Bush share my concern about homelessness in this country and I wanted to share with you legislation I introduced today to create a National Commission to Aid Homeless Mentally Ill Individuals.

As you know, homeless mentally ill individuals represent a significant portion of the homeless population and have very specialized needs. If we hope to effectively address homelessness in America, these special needs must be met. Failure to recognize and address these needs will limit our ability to succeed in addressing the larger problem of homelessness in general.

The legislation I introduced, which has been endorsed by the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill (AMI), would focus attention and resources directly on the problems that are faced by the homeless mentally ill by creating a national commission known as the Commission to Aid Homeless Mentally Ill Individuals.

For your information, I have enclosed a copy of the bill and a copy of my statement upon introduction of the legislation which provides additional details on the duties of the commission.

Governor, while I have introduced this idea as legislation, it could easily be implemented as a Presidential or Executive Commission. I know you and the President are sensitive to the problems of the homeless. I think this commission could make a positive contribution and I would appreciate it if you would consider implementing it through the Executive branch.

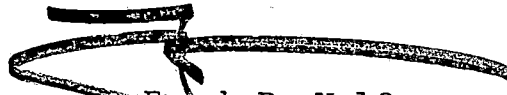

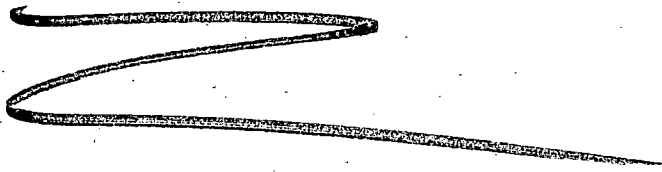

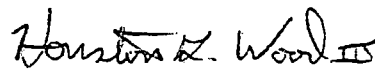
