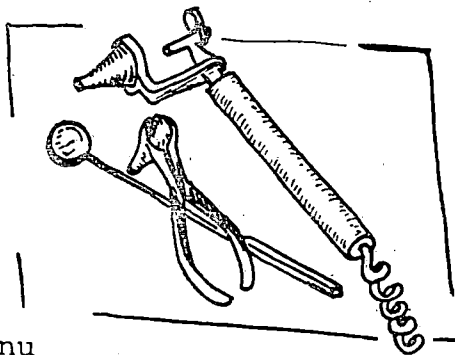

Dear John:

As the state of New Hampshire moves into the third year of the Public Service of New Hampshire (PSNH) bankruptcy, I'd like to provide you with an update on the efforts of Northeast Utilities (NU) to resolve the bankruptcy by merging PSNH with NU.

The rate plan that the New Hampshire Legislature approved and Governor Gregg signed in December represents a milestone in this process. The ten-year rate plan envisions annual rate increases of 5.5 percent for seven consecutive years, with the exception that there'll be no rate increases in years eight, nine, and ten.

Although, like you, NU would have preferred no rate increases, we recognized that, to resolve this bankruptcy, any acceptable proposal had to offer creditors sufficient value to obtain their endorsement. We therefore developed a rate plan designed to provide the necessary value to creditors and, at the same time, to build a strong financial foundation to ensure PSNH's ability to continue to provide customers with excellent energy services.

Even with this significant action behind us, there is still more that needs to be done. I want to assure you that we're working very hard to secure the remaining state and federal approvals that will clear the way for a final resolution to the PSNH bankruptcy by the end of this year.

We're pursuing approvals of the entire reorganization plan by individual creditors, shareholders, and the bankruptcy court, and approval of specific parts of the plan by the Securities and Exchange Commission, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, and other state commissions.

We believe that the bankruptcy judge will confirm the plan in April. From that time until we've completed all other necessary work to consummate the merger, we'll be managing PSNH under a management services contract, and the company will operate under a new Board of Directors elected by the companies' creditors and existing shareholders. Once all the merger conditions have been met, which we hope will be achieved by late this summer, PSNH will join the NU system.

We've already announced that F. R. (Dick) Locke, currently NU's senior vice president--Customer Service, will move from this position to oversee PSNH during both the interim period and after the merger is completed. The recent news release is enclosed. Dick is well-suited for this role, having been instrumental in helping to integrate Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO) with NU. He was WMECO's vice president and chief administrative officer for six years. Dick is already busy, meeting with PSNH management and employees, preparing the way for NU to assume responsibility for managing PSNH. I hope you'll have a chance to meet him, because he's anxious to get to know and work with the people of New Hampshire.

In conclusion, I'm pleased with where we are and hope that the remaining steps can be achieved within a few months so that New Hampshire can put this troubling bankruptcy behind it for good. Thank you for your interest and support over these many months. Your concern has contributed greatly to our progress. As always, NU will continue to keep you informed.

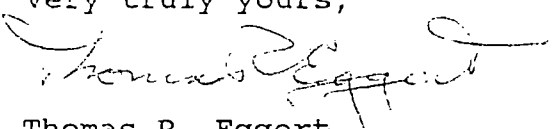
I will be arriving at Dulles about noon on February 15 to attend a National Association of Counties meeting the following day.

Dear John:

For me, one of the pleasures of serving with you on the ACIR was working together on issues of federalism where we share a common understanding and hope. Now I would like to bring to your attention some work of my colleagues and I have been doing to apply federal principles and arrangements to a very different situation, one in which we both have an interest. That is in connection with the Israel-Palestinian conflict.

Since 1969 when I submitted my first memorandum on the idea to key leaders of the Israel government, I have been firmly convinced that only through some kind of federal arrangement - in all likelihood, a somewhat unconventional one -- involving Israel, the Palestinians, and Jordan can peace be achieved in that long-standing conflict. In 1976, Shimon Peres, then Israeli's Defense Minister, commissioned me and my colleagues to identify and explore the fullest possible range of federal options. We identified eleven basic options plus many more combinations. In the following years, we explored many of those options through conferences, research, many publications, and consultations involving Israelis, Palestinians, Americans, Europeans and others.

At first, we seemed to be close to whistling in the dark. By 1988, however, all the principal parties were speaking of "confederation" as in the favored solution. Each principal meant something different by the term, but the very fact that it was the term used indicates a new awareness of the federal options broadly understood as the way out. That is where we stand now.

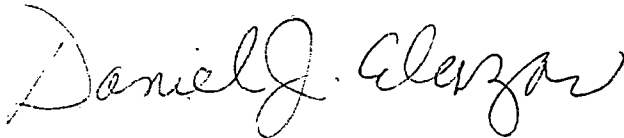
For many years, I have believed that the United States, the home of the first practical application of the federal idea, has not done enough to foster federal solutions for appropriate international conflicts where all too often our leaders, no great friends of federalism at home, press for unitary solutions abroad. Here the United States has an opportunity to take an

I would like to share with you the results of our work,
including some concrete ideas application in the present

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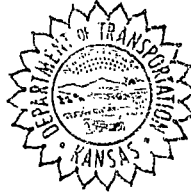

REFERENCE: Memorandum of Agreement between the Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of the Army concerning the Determination of Mitigation under the Clean Water Act Section 404 (b)(1) Guidelines

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I understand that you and Secretary Skinner have met and discussed the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) referenced above and that as a result its implementation has been delayed. Thank you.

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) is opposed to implementing a National Wetland Policy by way of the MOA executed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) which was executed on November 15, 1989.

Although the MOA was executed during November 1989, the KDOT did not receive a copy for review purposes until December 29, 1989. After reviewing the MOA, we find that we have serious reservations with certain aspects of the agreement. If it is implemented as written, it could hinder the progress of much needed public works projects that are already regulated by Section 404 (b)(1) guidelines.

The MOA is a serious deviation from existing regulations that are based on the Clean Water Act (CWA) and it has been promulgated without allowing for public notice and comment. This MOA provides for implementation of wetland mitigation policies and procedures that could cause other vital aspects of public works projects and the environment to be ignored. In effect, by this MOA, wetlands as a national objective has been elevated above all other national objectives including a safe and efficient transportation system. More specifically, environmental policies and procedures based upon the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) that regulates transportation project development relative to the environment, have been subverted. That is, the MOA does not conform to national policy whereby appropriate recognition and weight are given to all environmental, economic and sociological concerns. This point can be observed in the following statements in the MOA:

Mr. John Sununu

Page Two

"The determination of what level of mitigation constitutes "appropriate" mitigation shall be based on the values and functions of the aquatic resource that will be impacted. This determination shall not be based upon characteristics of the proposed project such as need, societal value, or the nature or investment objectives of the project's sponsor." (emphasis added)

-- page 2, paragraph II B

"Other reviews, such as NEPA and the Corps public interest review, cannot be used to nullify any Guidelines requirements or to justify less rigorous Guidelines evaluations." (emphasis added)

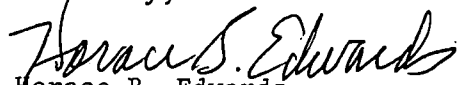
-- page 5, paragraph III C

In summary, we feel the MOA is unnecessary, provides excessive and unrestrained power to the EPA and the Corps with these changes in the Section 404 permit process (which should have been reviewed and commented on by the agencies affected), and it undermines the environmental review process provided by NEPA.

If this MOA is in fact needed, we are asking you ^{to} and we have asked the members of the Kansas Congressional Delegation -- to see that appropriate action be taken to have the MOA modified so that wetland policy objectives do not unreasonably preclude achieving other national objectives and to require that the EPA and the Corps provide the public and affected agencies an opportunity to review and comment on the modifications.

Thank you for considering our comments and concerns.

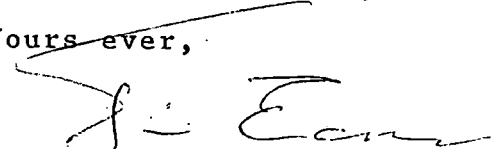

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is very disturbed and disappointed that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) is allowed to undermine the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process and enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on the type and level of wetland mitigation procedures that will be used to determine compliance with Section 404(b)(1) guidelines and achieve a "no net loss goal" without the participation of affected agencies. The MOA was signed, sealed and delivered. No comments were sought from the agencies which would be most directly affected by it as required under the Administration Procedures Act. The Office of Management and Budget requested that no agency set policies on the "No Net Loss" issue prior to completion of the President's Domestic Council Policy Task Force deliberations. The Task Force has not had the opportunity to make their findings known, and affected agency participation has been denied. This action by EPA and COE negates their work.

TDOT is concerned about protecting our State's wetlands and has been following federal guidelines. The Department has been working with the State Resource Agencies in the development of a wetland bank. Based on previous experiences in attempting to mitigate on-site small wetlands, we are in agreement that small wetlands which are most affected by highway projects are not practical or cost effective to maintain. We support large tracts that can be maintained and are a more valuable resource. The new MOA requires

that all wetland banks be approved by the EPA and COE and that off-site replacement be a last resort.. Highway agencies are doing their part to preserve wetlands, while private property owners that abutt our right-of-ways are allowed to drain wetlands, cut timber and undermine our wetland mitigation plans. If we cannot control the water resource we cannot hope to save the wetlands along our roadways. TDOT in cooperation with State resource and permitting agency is developing its first wetland bank that can be maintained and protected for all time. We have a plan in Tennessee to save wetlands and can achieve a "no net loss" goal, if we are allowed to do so. The new MOA raises too many barriers between TDOT and the Resource Agencies. The new MOA will further delay needed projects and denies the State agencies who have the most knowledge of wetlands in their State the opportunity to handle their own wetland issues and do what is best for the State and its citizens.

We support a comprehensive wetland policy but one that is developed with the participation of the affected agencies. We request that the new MOA be voided and a new one developed that conforms to national policy and gives appropriate recognition and weight to other environmental, economic and people concerns.

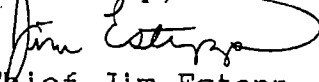

This position, along with at least six other appointed positions at FEMA, has remained vacant for almost a year. These vacancies have a direct impact on the efficiency of programs that relate to the fire service community.

In the past this organization, which represents the vast majority of chief fire officers throughout the nation, has voiced its concern regarding these vacancies. Although we recognize that the President has been pressured with matters of significant impact, nevertheless, in view of the devastating disasters that have occurred over the past year, it is apparent that these appointments should be made immediately.

I would like to reemphasize our support for Mr. Lacy Suiter, Director of the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, for the position of FEMA Director and Mr. Harry Shaw of the United States Fire Administration for the position of Administrator. Both of these individuals have impeccable credentials and would add the much needed direction to that agency.

We urge you to make these appointments as soon as possible. If this organization can be of any assistance to you with information regarding the applicants, please do not hesitate to contact us.

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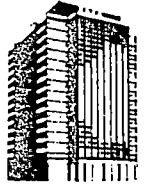

On behalf of the Thousand Springs Power Project, Gene Meyer and I would like to meet with you to seek support for redressing an unintended retroactive impact in the House version of the Clean Air Act Amendments. The Bipartisan Compromise version of S. 1630 in Section 405(g) provides a fair transition rule based upon reliance.

The Company has spent over \$64 million for land, water rights, permit applications, and various contracts. It anticipates receipt of environmental permits by November 1990. Financing and commencement of construction was intended before the end of the year. Under the transition rules contained in the Tax Reform Act of 1986, the first unit must go into operation in 1994. All of the Company's efforts and funds will have been wasted because the financing cannot proceed without assurance that a constructed facility can be operated.

As an independent power producer, the low sulphur coal-burning plant will be "super clean" and sell power throughout the West and Northwest. As a "new source" under the acid rain provisions of the Amendments, the first 250 megawatt unit of the proposed plant (2,000 megawatts) would not automatically be entitled to "emissions allowances" for air discharges when it goes into operation. Funding for construction cannot be obtained without guarantees that the plant will be allowed to emit air discharges when operational. For a more comprehensive explanation of the project, enclosed is a detailed memorandum.

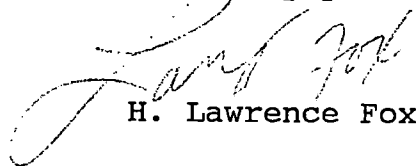

Any of the following legislative techniques would allow the Project to be financed:

1. Define "existing" unit as was done in the Senate to include Thousand Springs and provide a corresponding designation of emission limits for the Project.
2. Statutorily establish a guaranteed set aside for the Project from an allowance reserve.
3. Have the Amendments provide for an immediate "self help" system such as the conversion of currently-held emissions reduction credits into emission allowances.

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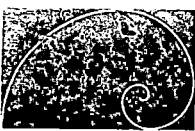

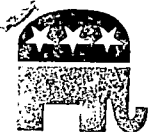

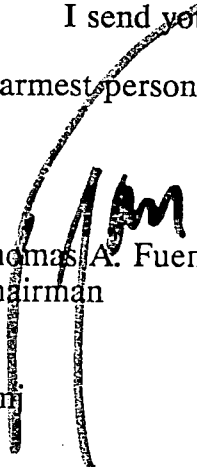

Subject: citizen harassment by the Internal Revenue Service

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I have seen recent reports that the IRS is being tasked to go after additional revenues including a very large amount of funds due from delinquent taxpayers. I surely share the concern of the White House, and of my fellow citizens, that perhaps millions of people are getting away with something on their taxes, quite some number of them into the millions of dollars individually.

But I have also seen reviews of a new book which takes the IRS to task for its arrogance and abuse of taxpayers, combined with extensive ineptitude in doing their job. It is in connection with this latter reference that I appeal my case to the White House, a case which, as far as I am concerned, is entirely black-and-white: where the IRS has not a leg to stand on in a year-long episode featuring (in spades) their arrogance, illegality, abusiveness of a taxpayer, and a sense that they had not the least idea of what they are doing.

I enclose this story, completely documented, and am offering it to the press as well.

* * *

I should hope that this Administration, with its stress on ethics and on competence, might consider making a special investigation of this case. It does not involve a great deal of money--apparently none, because the IRS appears to have run away and tried to hide from the way they handled this affair--but it surely involves principle.

I can say that I have felt, through this matter, like the American colonists under siege from King George III's government, which seemed to exude the attitude that authority means correctitude, and that they would beat the colonists into submission to unreasonable taxation procedures through sheer power regardless of the merits of their position.

But like the colonists (and perhaps unlike too many taxpayers who submit to beating up by the IRS), I fought back and by all appearances I won, to the shame of, as far as I am concerned, the U.S. Government. None of this should have happened, and I hope that--at least at the hands of the IRS official who I believe to be responsible for this fiasco--it never happens to another taxpayer again.

As included in the documentation, this referenced official first took what I saw as a totally unreasonable position and shoved it down this taxpayer's throat in 1987. This story is documented in an unfolding fashion in the Appendix included with this submission to the Office of the President.

- When the IRS then turned truly abusive in an unrelated matter in 1989, I found that it was the same official who seemed to be behind that as well. I then resolved (months ago) that if there were no satisfactory upshot of this matter, I would ask for an investigation of this official on the grounds that she may have been as consistently abusive of taxpayers in general as she has been (in my view) of me in two successive instances.

The upshot of the matter, as included in the full documentation of this story in the enclosed material, was entirely unsatisfactory. Thus I do request such an investigation of this individual and, depending on the applicable regulations and the findings of the investigation, seek either disciplinary action against this individual, or dismissal from U.S. Government employment.

While completing the 15-page summary of the 33 Tabs of material behind the 1989 squabble, it began to occur to me that perhaps there was even more to the IRS's handling of this matter than had met my eye in the course of the whole unsavory affair. I then prepared an Addendum to this material in which I speculate on the outright misconduct by this official in this matter. While I term this document "speculation," it is an entirely logical and reasoned deduction on the basis of the documented facts of the matter.

Should upon investigation this speculation--or something quite akin to it--be confirmed, then I believe there would be grounds at least for disciplinary action against this individual on the basis of this alone, and, hopefully, dismissal from Government employment.

* * *

There is still a live fuse in this matter--an element of it seemingly long forgotten in what appears to have been the IRS's headlong rush to sweep their pitiful performance under the closest possible rug (any rug), when I fought back fairly and squarely simply on the basis of the facts and reason, and showed them up for the fallacy of their actions. That is in regard to my having taken credit against my first quarter estimated tax payment in 1989 for part of the refund due me for overpayments in 1987. This credit was disallowed (Tab D-2), but in running away from a position taken on similar grounds concerning a credit on my 1988 taxes due, the IRS forgot to inform me that this position of theirs has also been reversed and swept under the rug.

Thus this fiasco could continue for another year if, in submitting my 1989 taxes, I run once again into the IRS's senseless buzzsaw on this matter. I sincerely do not wish that to occur, and appeal to you and officials of the Executive Branch to preclude it. I note that the IRS indicated they would provide an explanation of why they had disallowed that particular credit, but

they never did (see Tab D-2 and underlined statement on Page 2 of the "Summarization of TAB Material . . .").

* * *

I understand the Inspector General of the Department of the Treasury is now engaging him- or herself in investigating abuses by the IRS. Perhaps this matter will be referred to him or her, and I am taking the liberty of sending a copy of this cover letter to that office.

But I believe there is a larger issue in this matter which merits the direct attention of the top elected official in this nation. Lord Acton said, "Power corrupts, and absolute power corrupts absolutely." I believe investigation will show that you have a "corrupt" official at least in this sense, who should be investigated, possibly disciplined, and even possibly rooted out of our nation's Government entirely.

Congressman Dante Fascell, Chairman of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, recently sent me a copy of his letter to President Bush urging the creation of a bipartisan Presidential Commission to review U.S. international radio broadcasting operations. I fully endorse this recommendation, and would like to suggest Zbigniew Brzezinski as a possible head of the Commission should such a panel come to pass. Not only is he a superb scholar and prolific writer on East European and Soviet subjects, but he also has broad government experience and a keen understanding of international radio broadcasting.

We are now witnessing monumental political and economic changes in Eastern Europe and the Soviet Union that may lead to a new order in Europe. Radio Free Europe and Radio Liberty, as well as the Voice of America, have played a critical role in this evolution toward democracy. That the programming of these radio stations will remain an indispensable part of U.S. foreign policy is clear, but at the present time we need to re-examine the overall framework and policy of our broadcasting effort.

I am delighted we had a chance to meet yesterday and discuss the work of Radio Free Europe and Radio Liberty. Your support is deeply appreciated!

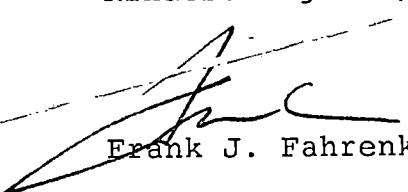

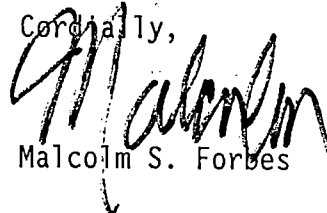
