Each year the California Bankers Association sponsors a trip to Washington, D.C. for bank Presidents and CEOs to meet with Members of the California delegation, bank regulators and key Administration officials.

On behalf of the California Bankers Association, I would like to request a meeting with you and our bankers participating. We will be in Washington from April 23 to 25. The time that is best for our schedule, would be on Wednesday morning, April 25 at 10:30 a.m. However, if that time is not conducive to your schedule, but another time during our visit it better, we would be more than glad to meet you at the time most convenient for you.

The purpose of the trip is not only to discuss specific legislation pending in Congress that affects our industry, but also to discuss economic and policy issues, in general, and to raise the political awareness of each banker participating.

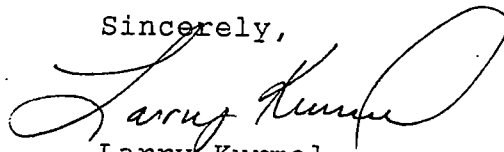

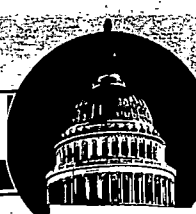

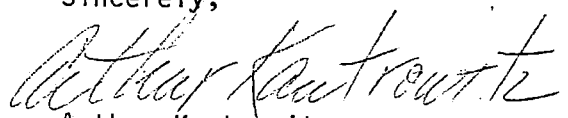
I am writing to support the courageous stand on the greenhouse panic which the media attributed to you. Current scientific knowledge does not justify trillion dollar programs.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I am writing to you about a grave threat to the civil liberties of all Americans and particularly to the Arab American community. For nearly three years now, the Immigration and Naturalization Service has sought the deportation of eight immigrants in Los Angeles--seven Palestinians and the Kenyan wife of one of them--solely because of their political views. The eight immigrants are students, business persons, community activists, here for as long as eighteen and no less than four years. None of them had previously been arrested. The case has engendered a national outcry against the Department of Justice's conduct because it strikes at the mainstream of American life and at our cherished values of free speech and fair play.

The government has acknowledged that the eight individuals are not alleged to be--nor even believed to be--engaged in any criminal conduct. As former FBI Director William Webster said in his confirmation hearings for the Directorship of the CIA, "The individuals who were arrested in California had not been found to have engaged themselves in terrorist activity."

Initially the immigrants were charged under the 1952 McCarran Act with membership or affiliation in an organization which distributes literature that advocates worldwide communism. The organization in question, the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine, is a part of the PLO, and the eight respondents have consistently denied membership or affiliation with it. Indeed Middle East experts in this country don't believe the PFLP even exists in the U.S. Charges under two other sections of the McCarran-Walter Act were subsequently brought against them and also declared unconstitutional. Throughout these proceedings, the immigrants have consistently denied all the allegations against them.

Shortly after the arrests in January, 1987, a secret INS plan, "Alien Terrorists and Undesirables: A Contingency Plan", was leaked to the press. The plan is a blueprint for rounding up thousands of Arab immigrants, detaining them in isolated campsites in Louisiana and Florida, and deporting them. Acknowledging that Congress would not pass a law authorizing a roundup based solely on nationality, a test case to establish the necessary legal precedent is outlined in the Contingency Plan.

The guidelines for prosecuting the case set forth in the Contingency Plan have been closely followed in the Los Angeles case. This includes the charges used, the use of "fallback" technical visa violation charges, holding the arrestees without bond as alleged "national security threats", and attempting to use secret "in camera" hearings to effectuate the deportations. The eight respondents in February, 1987 were released on their own recognizance and low bail after the government refused to present its alleged evidence of the "national security threat" in open court.

The government has also acknowledged eavesdropping on the eight respondents and on their lawyers. Indeed, even after the revelations of eavesdropping, the INS refuses to confirm whether such eavesdropping is still occurring. This has prompted the filing of a lawsuit seeking a halt to this unwarranted intrusion into the lives of the immigrants and their attorneys.

For nearly three years this case has dragged on. We have had statutes declared unconstitutional, adduced blatant admissions of discrimination from government witnesses, exposed time and again the misconduct and conflicts of interest and unfairness of the Justice Department's case, and won the support of all who cherish the First Amendment. The INS, nonetheless, continues to seek these deportations. One must ask, why?

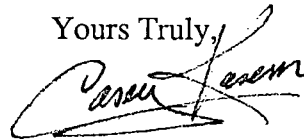
Is this an attempt to stifle the Arab American community and keep it from engaging in the ongoing debate concerning Middle East issue?

Would the government dare to employ such contempt for due process against any group but Arab Americans?

If it's Arab Americans today, who next can be deported for their ideas, their beliefs, their heritage?

It is our hope and our aim to stop these deportations and to insure that the rights of these individuals--and all immigrants--are protected. While this overview is necessarily abbreviated, I have enclosed additional material for your perusal. If there is any other assistance I can offer in this matter, please do not hesitate to ask. I thank you in advance for your courtesy and interest in this matter and look forward to your reply.

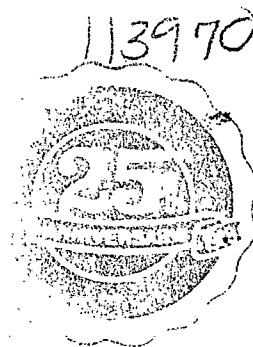

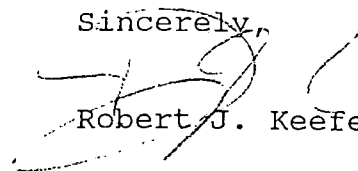
My impression there was that the Japanese are quite anxious about the US-Japan relationship; that they are baffled by the turn of American public opinion against them; that they are more willing to be responsive to US suggestions than any time previously; and, they believe that their "handlers" in the Bush Administration lack skill and credibility in dealing with them.

During my visit, I watched Bob Strauss address a crowd of top Japanese business and government executives as their "Ushiba Foundation Lecturer." I heard his report of private visits with their top politicians. And I marveled at his unique ability to put hard suggestions to them in a way that they respect and respond to. He has simply mastered the art of dealing firmly and directly with the Japanese as no one else has done.

He could be most helpful in the management of the US-Japan relationship right now. And he could not turn down his old friends Bush and Baker, if they asked him. The attached paper makes this case. I would appreciate your consideration of it.

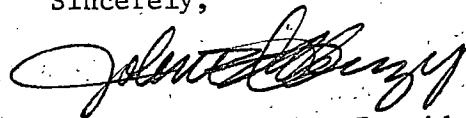

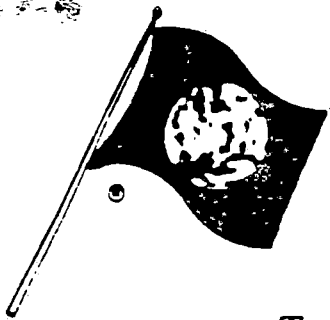

In response to ongoing efforts to arrive at compromise language to replace portions of S.1630, The Clean Air Act Amendments of 1989, which was reported out of the Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works in November 1989, it seems particularly timely for the American Mining Congress (AMC) to advance the enclosed series of proposed amendments to the pending legislation.

The enclosed amendments were developed by the AMC Air Quality Control Subcommittee--a group of environmental experts from a cross-section of AMC's member companies. The changes suggested are remedial in nature and are essential if the mining industry is to support the proposed legislation.

AMC and its member companies are very concerned with the potential for adverse consequences from passage of certain sections of the bill under consideration in its present form. Therefore, the wording of the enclosed amendments reflects the specific language used in S.1630.

AMC is advancing the present proposals with a view toward developing legislation that can be implemented in a practical and realistic manner, while enabling the mining industry to continue viable domestic operations. Collectively, AMC's over 400 member companies encompass the producers of most of America's metals, coal, industrial and agricultural minerals, as well as manufacturers and financial institutions serving the industry.

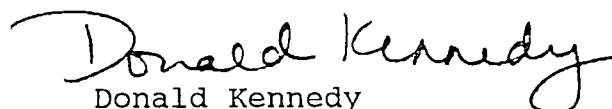

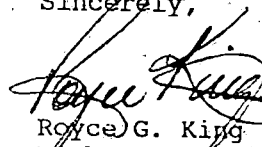

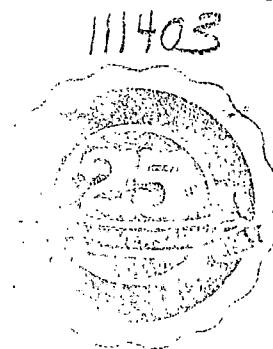

As you know, Dr. Jonas Savimbi and his UNITA troops have been fighting valiantly for many years to liberate Angola from the Communist dominated regime that now controls that country.

Dr. Savimbi is a true Angolan nationalist, but he is also a friend of the United States. Moreover, there can be no question that if the Soviet Union were not propping up the regime there he would have won long ago.

Now, Glasnost and the new era of Soviet/American amity aside, Moscow's surrogates in Angola are on the verge of defeating Dr. Savimbi's forces. The Soviets are, as you know, continuing to provide the marxist Angolan regime with planes, munitions, advisors and perhaps even pilots.

It is time for the U.S. to let the Soviets know that this is unacceptable and that, indeed, we consider this continued military participation in Angola a significant roadblock to better economic and political relations.

I know that you must appreciate the folly of letting Savimbi and UNITA fall, and I urge you to do whatever you can to convince the President to take steps to help prevent this.

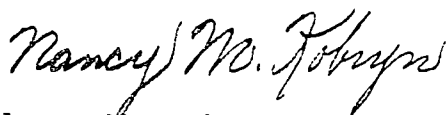

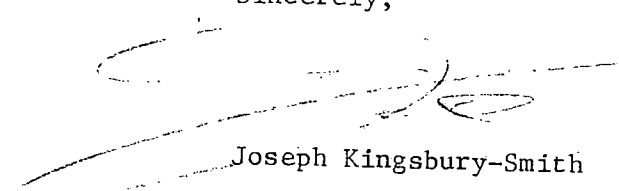

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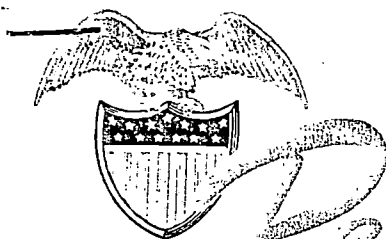

Dear Gov. Sununu,

I write to you, both in your capacity as Chief of Staff, and as a long time friend of the Baltic-American community. Unlike most who contact the White House to ask for help, I would like to offer some. It concerns the President's "Baltic problem."

As you no doubt know, there is growing annoyance in the Baltic American community, and among conservatives, over the Administration's seemingly uncertain position on developments in the Baltic States. (Even the liberal Washington Post is joining the chorus.)

While I can appreciate the President's reluctance to exacerbate Gorbachev's problems by encouraging the Balts, the White House's handling of this issue at press conferences has been less than optimum. Rather than allay concerns, recent statements have raised them.

I and other Baltic American organization representatives have established close working relationships with the State Department and Congress. The number and level of contacts has generated trust and cooperation. But for reasons unknown to us, we have been locked out of any dialogue with the White House. As a result, the White House is perceived as being opposed to Baltic interests. I know this isn't true, but no one in the Administration has made an effort to explain this to our community. If certain key people in the Administration - yourself, and officials from the NSC - were to sit down with Baltic American leaders and explain the Administration position, we could help you.

I'm not talking about a photo opportunity. Just a brief get together, off the record if necessary, where the Administration could clarify its position to Baltic American leaders. Such a sincere attempt at dialogue could ward off confrontation and replace it with cooperation. If we have a clearer understanding of what you are doing, we could work with you, rather than against you. Without such a meeting, I fear that the Baltic American community will turn more and more to the press and Congress and push for a stronger White House position on the Baltic. Based on my understanding of the Administration's strategy concerning the Baltic and Gorbachev, such outside public pressure and dissatisfaction could complicate an already complex and extremely fragile situation.

Is there anything you could personally do to bring such a meeting about?

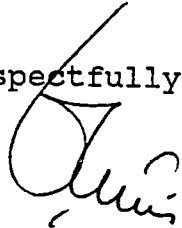

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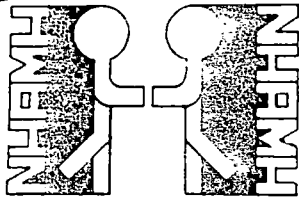

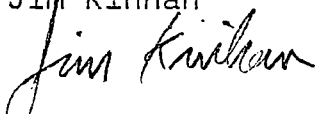

On January 24, the Executive Committee of the Shipbuilders Council of America, the national organization consisting of the principal domestic shipbuilders, ship repairers and the vendors of marine equipment to the industry, met with Secretary of Transportation Samuel Skinner to discuss the future of shipbuilding in the United States.

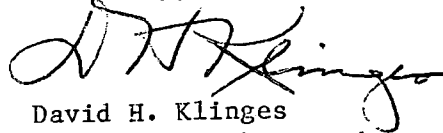
One of the issues explored with the secretary was the prospects of American shipbuilders becoming a force in the international market for the construction of commercial ships in the 1990's. The major impediment to our shipyards participating in that market is the pervasive subsidy practices of foreign governments. United States Trade Representative Carla Hills is presently engaged in negotiations with our trading partners, primarily Japan and West Germany, seeking the elimination of such trade distorting practices.

Notwithstanding the massive revitalization of the Navy undertaken by the Reagan Administration, the domestic shipbuilding industry was ravished with the loss of over 30 percent of its workforce in the decade of the 1980's. This occurred through no fault of our own, but was directly caused by the unfair trade practices of foreign governments.

Last year, the Congress authorized and appropriated \$600 million to establish a very modest program to alleviate, in part, the well documented shortfall in sealift assets. Secretary Skinner was very sympathetic of this effort, but indicated that the Department of Defense plans to defer the execution of the program this year. The importance of this program cannot be over emphasized. It will serve as a bridge for the shipbuilding industry to the mid-1990's when we expect the international market for merchant ships to increase dramatically.

I urge you to schedule a meeting for President Bush and the Council's Executive Committee at which the merits of the establishment of the sealift program can be aired for the benefit of the president.

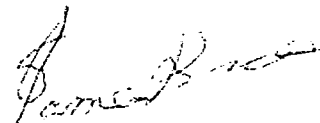

Today's Wall Street Journal reports that the Administration is close to making a compromise that "would remove the Social Security surplus from the Gramm-Rudman targets." Before the Administration agrees to such a radical change in policy, I hope that you will seriously consider its potentially devastating political effect on the balanced budget amendment to the U.S. Constitution, a policy goal long supported by President Bush.

An effective balanced budget amendment would cover all spending. If certain funds are excluded from the constitutional amendment, it risks becoming a dead letter from a Congress that seeks to evade the budget limits.

The simple political truth is that any balanced budget amendment proposed by the Congress would in whole or in part reflect any change in Gramm-Rudman. After all, how can we ever pass a balanced budget amendment through the U.S. Congress that covers all spending if current law removes Social Security from the deficit calculation?

There is a very real prospect of passing the balanced budget amendment during the Bush Administration. We are close to 250 cosponsors in the U.S. House of Representatives and within striking distance of the necessary 67 votes in the U.S. Senate.

If a balanced budget amendment excludes Social Security from the balanced budget requirement, a huge loophole would be opened in the amendment. A future Congress that wished to circumvent the balanced budget requirement could do so simply by funding nonretirement programs (e.g., food stamps for the elderly, SSI and Medicare) from that account. Of course Social Security is still not in balance over the next century, and a constitutional amendment is permanent.

As for a two-thirds statutory vote requirement allegedly protecting Social Security, it could be overridden by a simple majority vote. More to the point, the House of Representatives historically has not agreed to any super majority vote rules on budget restraints.

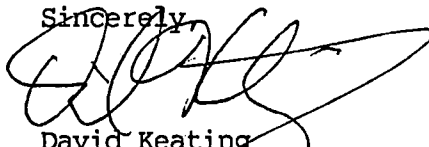
Senator Paul Simon has already proposed a balanced budget amendment that exempts Social Security and all other retirement trust funds from the balanced budget amendment calculation. We think this

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is a serious mistake, and any Administration compromise that would endorse the concept of taking Social Security out of the Gramm-Rudman calculation helps Senator Simon's proposal.

I've enclosed a letter that we sent to Senator Simon critiquing his proposed constitutional amendment and testimony I presented to the Subcommittee on Social Security on removing Social Security from the Gramm-Rudman calculation. Ignoring the effect on a balanced budget constitutional amendment, such a change would seriously harm the budget process.
