Subj: High-Speed Ground Transportation - Air-Train

Dear Dr. Sununu:

Your advocacy for increased engineering judgment in the formulation of public policy was well received at the recent Engineers' Dinner at the University of Delaware.

As we discussed, a perfect example of your message is Senator Moynihan's request to the Federal Rail Administration to spend Federal funds on a West German technology called "Magnetic-Levitation" applied to high-speed ground transportation. The report is due this summer. Moynihan's instructions to the Department of Transportation do not include alternative technologies.

For some years we have been working on a competitive design called the "Air-Train." We estimate that its energy consumption is two-thirds that of the Mag-Lev system, and initial capital costs are less than one-half.

Additional engineering detail is needed to develop comparative costs over a specific route for which Mag-Lev has been selected for study by D.O.T. We could put together our engineering data applied to the same route, for a direct comparison with the Mag-Lev system.

May I give you a 15-minute presentation of our Air-Train and plans? I am scheduled to be in the White House on the evening of the 21st of March.

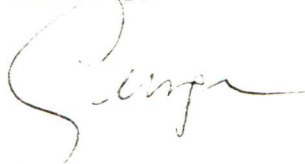
Dear John:

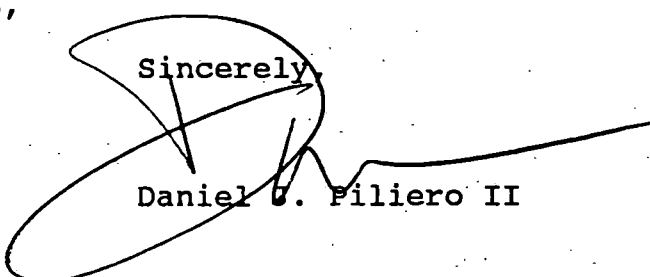

Dear John:

It appears that the Baptist Joint Committee on Public Affairs (BJC) has made claims of being the representative of Southern Baptists in Washington. This is not correct. We relate to the BJC only through our own organization, the Public Affairs Committee (PAC). Our Christian Life Committee (CLC) also represents Southern Baptists in Washington. We are well represented by the PAC and the CLC but the Baptist Joint Committee has frequently taken stands which are very much out of the mainstream of thinking of Southern Baptists.

On Wednesday, February 27, 1990 we understand that a White House meeting was arranged by Bobbi Killberg concerning the proposed child care legislation. Apparently a representative of the Baptist Joint Committee was there who purported to speak for Southern Baptists. We understand that certain information which he gave to the President was inaccurate. A copy of the actual Resolution passed by the Southern Baptist Convention in 1988 concerning child care is attached hereto in order to clarify matters.

Members of the PAC were not included in the February 27th meeting. There was a representative of the CLC present and for this we are grateful. Also not included in the meeting were Southern Baptists such as Dr. Gary Bauer whose thinking is also in line with that of most Southern Baptists.

I thought that you should know that last week the Executive Committee of the Southern Baptist Convention voted to cut the funding for the BJC in next year's Southern Baptist Convention Budget by 87.24% (from \$391,000 to \$50,00). The vote in the Executive Committee was 53 - 17. This overwhelming vote was because of dissatisfaction with the extreme liberal positions of the BJC. A statement of the reasons for the reallocation of our funds for representation in Washington was adopted by the Executive Committee. A copy is attached hereto. Your attention is directed particularly to Paragraph II (i) beginning on page 3 and continuing to page 5.

The Executive Director of the BJC has also made many inflammatory statements. A sheet showing a few of them is attached hereto.

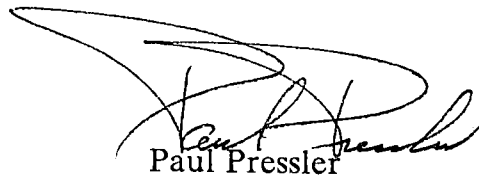

The Southern Baptist Convention in June 1990 will vote on finalizing this reallocation of funds. It is our impression that, between now and June, James Dunn and the BJC will do everything in its power to salvage its position so that in the future it can continue to promote its left wing agenda. I believe that during the next four months the BJC will seek to appear close to the White House and leading Republicans in order to try to communicate to Southern Baptists a false impression of broad credibility. If this happens, it could hurt the principles in which you, I and the vast majority of Southern Baptists believe.

Thank you for all that you do to make our nation all that it should be.

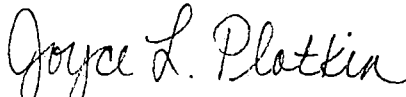

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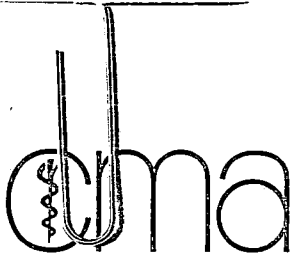

Reference is made to a Memorandum of Agreement between the Corps of Engineers and the Environmental Protection Agency concerning the determination of mitigation under the Clean Water Act Section 404(b)(1) guidelines.

Although our Department endorses in principle the President's policy of "no net loss of wetlands" and recognizes the valuable significance of wetlands resources, we have some concerns on the policy guidelines set forth on the reference agreement and its possible effects on the Construction Plan we have developed for the next five years.

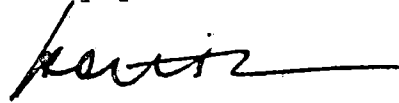
The main concern we find in the proposed guidelines is that they expressly exclude a project's need, societal value or the nature of the objectives of a proposed action, factors that are considered in the decision making process of a public agency.

Many public projects are being proposed in the highly developed San Juan Metropolitan Area which are essential for the economic development of the area and for an adequate transportation system of this region. The ones with a higher priority are the development of twenty acres of land in the San Juan Bay for the construction of a ports terminal, the extension of Runway in the Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport and the San Juan Freeway System linking Routes PR-2, PR-17 and PR-181. The development of these vital projects can be affected with the above mentioned guidelines. For the past 18 years the project for the conversion to freeway of Baldorioty de Castro Avenue, P.R.-26, has been delayed due to problems associated to mitigation measures and the 404 process.

Another area of concern is the rigidity in the consideration of mitigation measures for projects affecting wetlands. We feel that the options need to be more flexible and should take into account the geographical limitations of the area where the project is proposed, the public needs, the costs of alternatives and the ecological importance of the resource that needs to be protected.

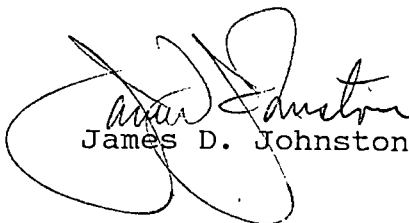
In a separate letter dated February 6, 1990, we provided a memorandum on CAFE structuring which reviewed three approaches.

While we urge the Administration to oppose any modification of CAFE requirements, we are seriously concerned about a letter dated January 26 (copy attached) sent by the Department of Justice to Senator Bryan which targets one of these approaches. The letter criticizes the percentage increase approach as anti-competitive, and further states that OMB had no objection to the letter.

It is particularly disappointing that Justice would single out just one of the CAFE alternatives as anti-competitive when in fact such arguments could be made equally or more persuasively for other CAFE structures, including current law which clearly disadvantages full-line U.S. manufacturers.

We urge that the Administration not adopt the views contained in the Department of Justice letter.

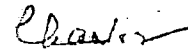

Dear Mr. Sununu:

While the evolution in the World history of the Communist regime, "as to believe" is crumbling and torn by a great moral struggle, and is a world shattering event, we must not be misled by their goal of world domination. For how long and how many of Gorbachev's sweeping reforms will survive in future events?

By the fact that uncounted Soviet troops are still keeping guard in the Baltic States, "Captive Nations" still controlling those people's destiny, serious attention must be given to these events. It would not take long to replace a new leadership, to restore the gun towers and guard dogs.

Of course, the new self-elected leaders helped in their efforts to restore order, but just as easily they could help Lech Walesa, the Polish "Hero" turn back to the shipyards, and the ghost of the Romanian President "Nikolai Ceausescu" could be brought back from his grave.

Gorbachev's hope is to try to lead a global military power - Glasnost, Perestroika. Gorbachev's cry for disarmament is a FRAUD. The benefit is for the growth of Soviet Arms Pact - by successfully marketing abroad weapons and hardware.

Now, they are seeking a "Love Match" agreement with the United States, it must be clear to us that the momentum of the Soviets' offensive program has not been slowed. The possibility is seeing the beginning of a process that the Soviets are achieving clear military power - not in order to get engaged in a war - but to get what they want from us without having to fight a war. on behalf of the Council on International Freedom (CIF) I represent and on behalf of the American Romania Relations Committee (approximately 5,000 members, of which Lucien Orasel is Chairman), at the request of both of these Committees and their members - may I ask you for a small favor?

Mr. Sununu, as the Chief of the White House Staff, and the right arm of President Bush, we would very much appreciate it if you could give us some of your valuable time and grant us an interview to discuss our concerns on important issues: Global, political, involvement in "Human Rights", and introduce new insights, ideas, and sources of information of considerable value. We are especially concerned about Romania and monetary events in Eastern Europe, as information filtering through from some of our members just returning from Romania - is quite alarming. We believe it is of the utmost importance for the United States to get involved before Romania feels compelled to join the Community Market.

We are willing to travel to Washington at any date or time you may designate to meet with you, at your convenience. We are sorry not to be able to send the report - as we would like to present it personally to discuss this important matter.

We look forward to a favorable reply.

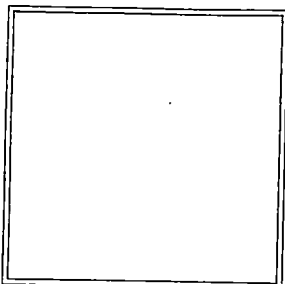
