Today, I met with Branko Terzic concerning the open Commission position at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

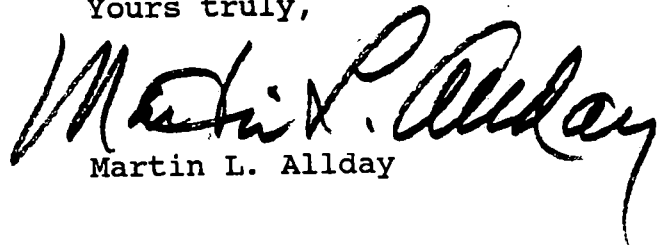

Dear Governor Sununu,

I thoroughly enjoyed having a chance to share a quick breakfast with Nancy during my recent visit to Washington. Listening to her description of how challenging your schedule has been lately made me especially grateful that we will have an opportunity to meet in person on June 20, at 5:30 p.m.

It has been a few months now since your inspirational address in Boston to Women Who Affirm Life, Inc., (WWALI). I would like to take this moment to thank you again for addressing us and, above all, for your consistent and courageous efforts to protect human life--especially in its most vulnerable form of unborn life.

As you may know through your assistant Jackie, I am working closely with Senator Hatch's office on the drafting of a proposed bill that would provide funding for organizations like The Nurturing Network which provide a **positive alternative** to abortions.

By way of review, The Nurturing Network is a charitable organization which I founded five years ago to provide a positive alternative to abortion for women faced with a crisis pregnancy.

As a former member of senior management in two Fortune 500 Companies and now the mother of two small children under the age of five, I have been particularly sensitized to the seemingly conflicting demands of career and motherhood. When Bill and I lost our first child in a mid-trimester miscarriage, my attention became riveted to the tremendous loss **every** mother experiences whenever a pregnancy does not result in a baby. I researched the problem of abortion with the heavy heart of a Mother who had just lost an unborn baby and the analytical mind of a Harvard Business graduate eager to understand more.

What I found may be of particular interest to you. First of all, **91 out of 100** women interviewed who had received abortions, "would have preferred to find a positive alternative" if only it had been made available. (Please see my enclosed testimony before a Congressional Subcommittee for further detail.) Contrary to the pro-choice rhetoric we hear so much of these

days, these women were not describing anything close to "freedom of choice" when they submitted themselves and their babies to abortion. They repeatedly described extraordinary pressures brought to bear on them by members of their own non-supportive network.

Our research further showed that it was the boyfriends, employers, peers and, sadly enough, even the parents of these mothers-to-be who pushed these women toward a desperate alternative they would have preferred to avoid.

I conducted further research on an even broader sample of women that uncovered another surprising fact. The woman profiled in the popular media as most likely to experience an abortion (or a crisis pregnancy for that matter) is not the one who is actually most likely to experience this problem. Contrary to the image of a poor, uneducated, minority teen, the most common victim of this crisis is 20-26 years of age, white, middle class, and at least high school educated. When I analyzed what resources were available for this segment of women, what I found shed an entirely new light again on the escalating abortion statistics. Literally no programs existed that were specifically geared to meet the needs of this segment of upwardly mobile women.

I no longer felt that I had a choice to continue in six figure salary jobs while literally hundreds of thousands of women were being denied a viable alternative to abortion. If helping to find a solution meant becoming a "volunteer," then so be it. In 1985 I formed a network--named appropriately enough The Nurturing Network--that for the first time emphasized the message that giving life to your unborn child does not have to mean giving up your own life.

It took two years, the sale of our vacation home, and help from lots of good friends and strong supporters to form a nationwide Network which now has over 4500 members in all 50 states.

- * We have over 400 OB-GYNs in our Medical Network, who will in many instances, deliver our clients' babies at a reduced rate or even free of charge. We pay for the deliveries if necessary.
- * We have literally hundreds of employers of our Employer Network who will "mentor" our clients during their pregnancies--allowing them to "preserve their resume-value" during a temporary leave of absence from their current employer who may be less than supportive.
- * We have almost 200 colleges and universities in our Educational Network who will permit our clients to transfer within three weeks (our clients don't have 3 months to wait for a normal admissions process!) to a comparable institution so that their education need not be interrupted and peer pressure can be minimized.

- * We have hundreds of licensed counselors, clergy and social workers in our **Counseling Network** who will provide the necessary emotional and spiritual support during such a vulnerable time.
- * And, finally, we have over 500 nurturing families in our **Nurturing Home Network** who will provide more than a "place to live" by opening their hearts and homes on a one-to-one basis.

About 80% of our over 1000 Clients represent canceled abortion appointments. They also represent a segment of working mothers and college women who do not want to rely upon our government to pay for their actions or decisions. Our program puts them in touch with the kind of employers who understand the critical need for work policies that include flextime, part-time, paid maternity leave and on-premise quality day care. Referrals and introductions to these employers plus our counseling, training and direction have shown hundreds of women that the life alternative can be viable and rewarding. They are now living proof in every state of our country.

I share our mission with you, Governor Sununu, not to pat ourselves on the back--but to let you know that others share your vision and values...and to offer at least one small example of how this is working.

I look forward to meeting you in person on June 20. In the meantime, may God continue to bless you and your family. As a former resident of The State of New Hampshire, you will appreciate why I still feel most comfortable referring to you as "Governor." Our state was so fortunate to have had you during those years.

May your work continue to be guided by an inspired vision, a compassionate heart and sound health to lead our nation through this conscience-numbing rationalization of abortion.

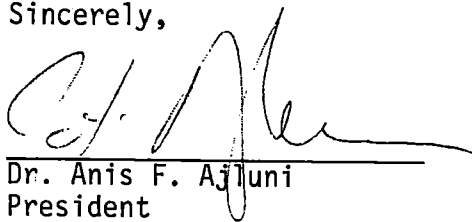
The American Federation of Ramallah, Palestine is a national organization with over 30,000 members and 25 chapters in various cities throughout the United States.

DEAR GOVERNOR SUNUNU

AS YOU TAKE PART IN THE CURRENT ROUND OF BUDGET DISCUSSIONS, I HOPE YOU WILL HOLD FAST TO THE NO - TAXES PLEDGE MADE REPEATEDLY BY PRESIDENT BUSH DURING HIS ADMINISTRATION. IT IS INFINITELY BETTER FOR THE COUNTRY AND ITS ECONOMY TO "CUT SPENDING" RATHER THAN INCREASE TAXES. HOWEVER, IF TAXES MUST BE RAISED, I URGE YOU TO KEEP IN MIND UNFAIRNESS IN RAISING EXCISE TAXES ON SUCH CONSUMER GOODS AS BEER AND TO REJECT ANY SUCH PROPOSALS.

AS A DISTRIBUTOR OF ANHEUSER-BUSCH PRODUCTS, I AM WELL AWARE THAT ON AVERAGE, BEER ALREADY IS TAXED 3 TIMES MORE HEAVILY THAN MOST OTHER CONSUMER GOODS. EXCISE TAXES ON BEER HAVE PERSISTED EVEN THOUGH THEY HAVE BEEN REMOVED ON MANY LUXURY ITEMS SUCH AS FURS, JEWELRY AND PERFUME. EVEN THOUGH EXCISE TAXES ON BEER HAS NOT INCREASED SINCE 1951, (STATE BEER EXCISE TAX COLLECTIONS) HAVE INCREASED BY ALMOST 700 PERCENT DURING THAT TIME.

THIS IS ESPECIALLY UNFAIR SINCE 60 PERCENT OF THE BEER CONSUMED IN THIS COUNTRY IS PURCHASED BY HOUSEHOLDS WITH AVERAGE INCOME OF \$35,000 OR LESS. OBVIOUSLY, INCREASING THE TAX ON BEER WOULD BE HIGHLY REGRESSIVE, HITTING THE LOW AND MODERATE INCOME GROUPS MUCH HARDER THAN THE WELL-TO-DO. WITH THE INCOME GAP BETWEEN RICH AND POOR WIDENING WHILE THE TAX BURDEN ON THE NATION'S LESS WEALTHY HAS GROWN, IT IS UNCONSCIONABLE TO ASK THE WORKING MEN AND WOMEN OF AMERICA TO ABSORB EVEN MORE OF THE TAX BURDEN BY RAISING BEER TAXES.

WHILE SOME CLAIM THAT SUCH A TAX WOULD IMPROVE AMERICA'S HEALTH, THIS ARGUMENT FALLS APART UNDER EXAMINATION. RESPONSIBLE DRINKING IS CONSISTENT WITH A HEALTHY LIFESTYLE AND ABUSERS WILL NOT BE SIGNIFICANTLY AFFECTED BY PRICE INCREASES CAUSED BY MORE TAXES.

I'M VERY CONCERNED ABOUT THE NEGATIVE EFFECTS AND EXCISE TAX INCREASE WILL HAVE ON MY INDUSTRY. OVERWHELMINGLY, THE BEER CONSUMED IN AMERICA IS BREWED IN AMERICA. BEER IS DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR NEARLY 200,000 JOBS IN THIS COUNTRY, AND INDIRECTLY IT SUPPORTS TENS OF THOUSANDS OF JOBS IN RETAILING, AGRICULTURE, EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURING AND OTHER INDUSTRIES. ANHEUSER-BUSCH ALONE PAYS ABOUT 1.5 BILLION

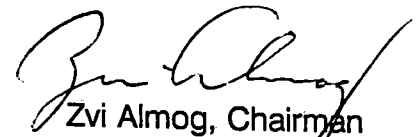

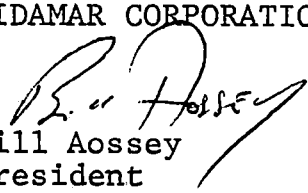

It was a pleasure to visit with you last month. I realize your busy schedule does not afford you much free time and I appreciate the effort.

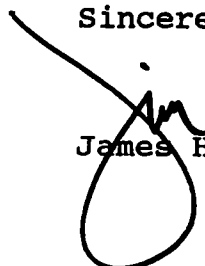
As I mentioned during that visit, we are going to issue a block of four stamps with the Soviets in October. The enclosed press release and photos of the stamp designs give the background for the issue.

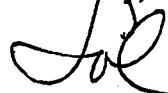

It is certainly the first time ever that African Students at MIT as a group are rallying to add their voice to his noble cause. Thank you for your assistance.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

First, let me introduce myself. My name is David Angel, and I am the Director of Dataquest's Semiconductor Industry Service, the world's oldest and largest service covering the semiconductor industry.

Each fall for the past 15 years, Dataquest has held a conference of the leaders of the worldwide electronics industry. We would like you to be the keynote speaker at this year's Semiconductor Industry Conference to be held October 8-10 in Monterey, California. The keynote speech is scheduled for 8:00 p.m. on October 8, although at this point, October 9 is also a possibility.

There is a stubborn perception that the Bush administration is not supportive of the U. S. high-technology industry. I understand that perceptions are not facts; however, that view is intensified here in the Silicon Valley. In 1989, our keynote speaker was Robert Galvin, chairman of Motorola. When I discussed this issue with Mr. Galvin and several of my peers in the electronics industry, your name came up in each conversation. I believe that this is a rare opportunity to convey the Bush administration's position on high technology to an distinguished audience of the executives of the global high-technology industry.

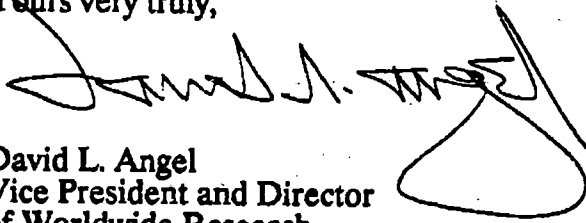

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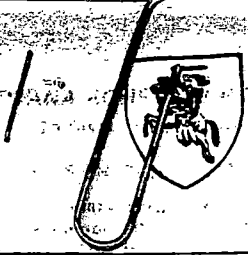

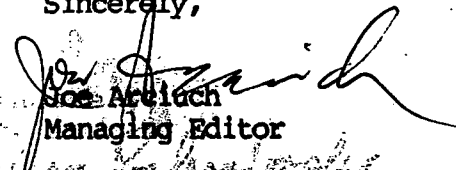

Thanks for the interview yesterday. You are so articulate and informative that the television program will be great.

Also yesterday -- when we discussed President Bush's participation in the first "USA Tourism Summit" in early June -- you asked me about any conceivable commercial angle to the President's participation.

Let me assure you that the President would not be endorsing any one company or group of companies. He would instead be endorsing tourists coming into the United States, and expressing appreciation for the enormous number of foreign tourists (who spend enormous sums) brought by the business leaders attending.

They were invited precisely because they are the premier, established wholesalers from each country. Each has been generating large numbers of foreign tourists for years. Each has the potential of generating even larger numbers in the future. Included are such prestigious individuals as the Chairman or CEOs of Lufthansa, Qantas, Finnair, and United Air Lines.

In fact, John, the woman I told you about -- Ms. Noel Irwin-Hentschel, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of ATI -- proposed the idea of the "Tourism Summit" when publicly testifying before the Senate Committee in September 1989. When the idea was not picked up by anyone else, she went out and organized it herself.

Isn't this what America is all about? Isn't this what the "thousand points of light" is all about?

I really, really do hope the President will give 15 or so minutes of his time. It would mean a lot.

With regard to the child care legislation currently pending in Congress, it has been brought to my attention that it excludes churches and synagogues from receiving funds if religion is involved.

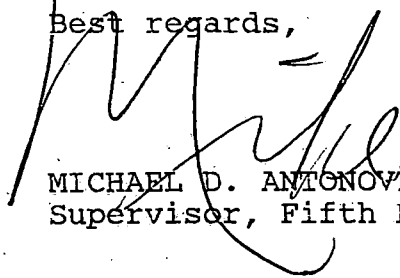
This would be a terrible omission and contrary to our Constitution's guarantee of freedom of religion. We have freedom of religion -- not freedom from religion.

For example, the federal government funds the construction on military installations of houses of worship, yet we don't exclude them from having religious instruction. The same is true of the funding for chaplains in the military forces who are free to worship without restrictions.

In contrast, the proposed child care legislation denies our children the same rights awarded to our servicemen. Failure to amend this legislation will discriminate against our religious child care centers and force them to close or eliminate their ability to say grace and teach the Ten Commandments.

Hopefully, in the name of freedom of religious expression, the final legislation will not discriminate against religious child care facilities.

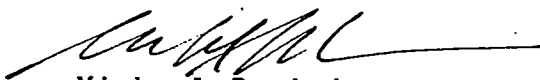

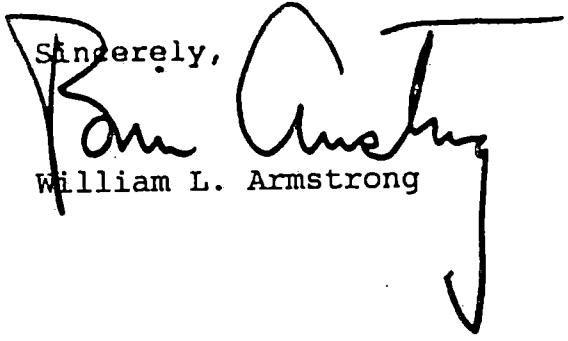

On behalf of the State of New Jersey U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship Commission, I understand from discussions with Navy officials that the Battleship U.S.S. New Jersey, BB-62, will be decommissioned in Long Beach, California and towed to Bremerton, Washington, to be mothballed.

This decision was made, not by the Department of the Navy, but by the Department of Defense, which mandated the decommissioning of two of the four battleships. Accordingly, the Navy has designated the West Coast to perform this process for the sake of cost effectiveness.

It is for this reason that the State Battleship Commission is directing its efforts to the White House Chief of Staff, recognizing that this matter can only be resolved through the intervention of a higher authority.

The Commission requests that the Battleship New Jersey be decommissioned and mothballed in the Philadelphia Navyyard or another East Coast location. The Commission was, in fact, formed to someday acquire the Battleship when the Navy removed it from the active and mothball fleets.

When the Commission acquires the New Jersey, it will most likely be established at Liberty State Park on the Hudson River facing the Statue of Liberty. This location will provide the greatest opportunity for the Battleship's maximum exposure as a museum and memorial. It will also enhance the Navy's image and recruiting potential, not unlike the way the Intrepid has done on the New York side of the river.

To prepare for acquiring the Battleship at a future date will require a tremendous fundraising effort in order to obtain the means to convert the ship into a museum. If the New Jersey remains on the West Coast, the funds needed to tow the vessel from Washington to the East Coast around South America will be prohibitive. I also understand from conversations with the Panama Canal Commission that a cold iron ship the size of the U.S.S. New Jersey cannot be towed through the canal.

-(over)-

I firmly believe the state of world events mean the New Jersey will never again be recommissioned. I further recognize that some additional costs are needed to decommission the ship on the East Coast and that the availability of a Navyyard for drydocking may be a few months away to commence the process. However, the commission is convinced that it is imperative for this to occur on the East Coast.

The residents of New Jersey identify greatly with the vessel that carries the state's name. It is the most decorated of the four battleships, having seen action in World War II, Korea, Vietnam and the Beirut Crisis. In fact, it is the most decorated warship of any nation of any era. Furthermore it is the only battleship that can be memorialized in the state of its name. The East Coast is also a logical location for decommissioning since three of the four battleships, including the New Jersey prior to Vietnam, have once been decommissioned in Philadelphia.

Since after the Korean Conflict, the New Jersey has never been to the waters of New Jersey and New York for Port of Call and I know the presence of the New Jersey for its final goodwill tour will attract attention and aid recruiting on the level of "Red October." Lastly, the New Jersey was the flagship of Fleet Admiral Halsey during World War II, a native of New Jersey.

Therefore, it seems that the overall benefits of bringing the Battleship to the East Coast far outweigh the additional funds it would require for such a move. In fact the added costs, compared to the recommissioning of 1983 and decommissioning now, is comparatively small.

The Commission is compelled to ask for all the assistance you can provide at this time to orchestrate this move. Otherwise, it will be impossible to change venue once the Battleship is decommissioned out west.

The Commission is certain that President Bush will be forever remembered by the people of New Jersey if his administration can help achieve this request as it embodies the very existence of our Battleship Commission.

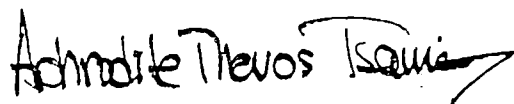
