Participant responses to the two-day White House Climate Change Conference were both predictable and avoidable.

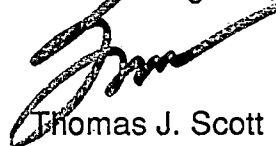
Up-to-date meeting management techniques, utilized ahead of time, to structure the agenda could have turned the meeting into a solid plus for the President. It could have enhanced his environmental leadership image and moved some of the web-footed dreamers who were present closer to reality without compromising your desire to avoid premature action.

Sadly enough, our early February offers to help OSTP and CEQ in planning the agenda were waived and EPA wasn't in the loop.

This current strategy of avoiding discussions of policy options while the science is maturing is reminiscent of the utilities' approach to the acid rain issue. It is likely to be about as effective in the world of global politics as theirs was in the reauthorization of the Clean Air Act.

When you're ready to talk damage control, keep in mind that utilities, as well as other industrial and environmental organizations, are talking to us about ways our work in acid rain, stratospheric ozone, and toxic risk can be used as a model to deal with climate change. There may be some things we're doing that could be helpful to you.

Dear Governor Sununu:

Wetlands are unique biological treasures which recharge groundwater, filter sediment, hold excess flood water and sustain a great amount of wildlife including much of the nation's endangered and threatened species. Although wetlands are now recognized as valuable, productive lands, they continue to be lost at a rate of 458,000 acres each year. Such loss is alarming. Fortunately, however, attention to the issue is increasing.

The prominence and urgency of this issue has been, in large part, promoted by both the President's "no net loss" policy and by heightened controversy in public opinion and in Congress. We understand that the White House Domestic Policy Council has formed a task force to examine the issue and develop a set of recommendations regarding regulatory and non-regulatory approaches to protecting wetlands.

As members of the Congressional Sunbelt Caucus we have formed a task force to explore some of the same issues that we believe the Domestic Policy Council task force is addressing. The Sunbelt Caucus task force is comprised of twenty-one Members of Congress from eleven states throughout our region.

Our task force, like that of the White House, has been organized to closely examine all aspects of the wetlands issue. It is for this reason that we would like to meet with representatives of the White House Domestic Policy Council task force.

We believe that it is important that concerned Members of Congress and the Administration, as well as others, come together

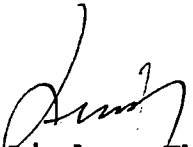

That is why I am directing a copy of this article to you...a leader in your field. I know that you are aware of the energy problems facing the U.S. and I know that you are concerned about energy options for the future. This article will help expand your knowledge base as this nation moves closer and closer to making policy decisions on energy.

For instance, what about the 25 percent receipts to the counties, i.e., the public? What about the tax receipts to the U.S. Treasury as well as state treasuries from taxpayers employed directly and indirectly due to the timber sale program? Are these not public benefits?

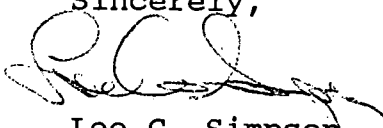
As a nation are we so rich that we can throw away the opportunities available to sustained utilization of a renewable resource? In our opinion, environmental conservation demands maximizing the benefits to the public by full utilization of forest land suited to harvesting of trees so that regeneration can increase and sustain the value of our greatest natural resource.

Please do not be deluded into acting on such a simple "below cost" analysis. If we accept the premises underlying this analysis, then the next step to shutting down other forests is to impose layer after layer of administrative and environmental costs and ignore benefits to bring about the seemingly obvious yet tragically erroneous conclusion that harvesting should be eliminated since receipts are below costs.

We urge you to reconsider a course of action that the public cannot afford.

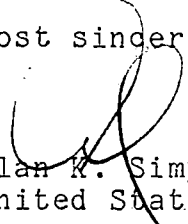

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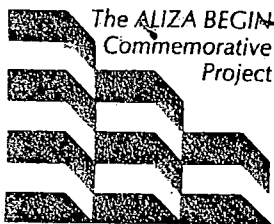

I am writing in reference to our phone conversation on April 4, 1990 concerning the "Farm Animal and Research Protection Act," and your request for further information on this issue.

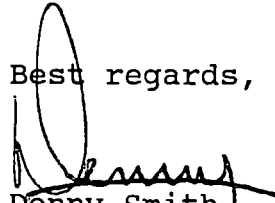
It has been rumored by those in the biomedical field that the Administration was advised not to support this bill. Supposedly, the Justice Department did not see a need for additional legislation on this matter. However, it is obvious that our present law does not serve as a deterrent to animal rights activists who repeatedly destroy research facilities. The research industry has suffered 71 terrorists acts in 26 states.

HR 3270 penalizes crimes and illegal acts of terrorism against US farmers, ranchers, and agricultural and biomedical researchers. Also, this bill authorizes the Secretary of Agriculture to conduct investigations and provides for a civil right of action by the owners of the farm or animal facility against the violator.

The Senate has already passed a similar bill, S.727, by unanimous consent.

I recommend that you look closely at HR 3270. We all benefit from the results of biomedical research, and the taxpayer's dollar as well as the information produced should be protected.

Dear John:

I am writing to discuss legal immigration legislation, the Administration's position toward it, and ethnic group politics.

I understand that "much consideration" was given to the likely adverse reaction of Asians and Hispanics when the Administration developed its position on legal immigration reform. This degree of consideration is both unfortunate and mistaken.

First, immigration reform should be crafted only with the "national interest" in mind. Unfortunately, some of the most recent immigrant groups have interests that might conflict with the national interest. When this conflict occurs, we must give preference to policies that benefit the nation as a whole.

Most important, I believe the Administration has misread the position of most Asians and Hispanics on immigration. While the organizations representing Asians and Hispanics might support increased levels of immigration, most ethnic minority voters feel otherwise. In fact, most voters from these ethnic groups approach immigration the way most Americans do: a substantial plurality believe that current immigration levels are sufficient; a nearly equal plurality favor a reduction in the levels of immigration; and less than 10% support increasing immigration levels.

I believe the Administration should be careful about relying on Democrat-Party-based ethnic groups for accurate descriptions of the way most Asians and Hispanics feel about immigration. Some of my Republican colleagues

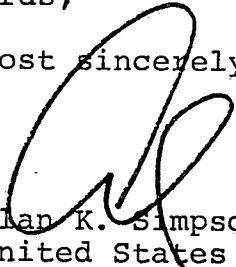

in the Senate have made this mistake, and I encourage the White House to avoid it.

I have enclosed some polling information to reinforce my point, and I strongly encourage the Administration to reconsider its mistaken approach to legal immigration reform.

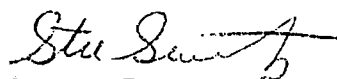

Mr. Sununu:

This is a follow-up to my letter of March 28, which I had written to you upon the advice of Mr. Gary MacDougal.

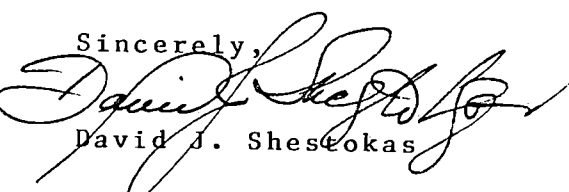
My previous letter addressed President Bush's approach to the Lithuanian situation, its political implications in Illinois and certain questions of international law. I also mentioned a rally that was to take place this past Friday.

Regarding the rally: Attendance exceeded two thousand, though organized in only three days. While the thrust was to promote the Lithuanian cause, much anger was directed at the president. The signs promoting Lithuania were equaled by signs critical of the president. Speakers included Congressman Durbin and Senator Simon, both of whom spent most of their time eliciting crowd response by criticizing the president. Republicans, including myself though I am Lithuanian, were best off not to speak.

Though I was personally heartened by Mr. Bush's letter to Gorbachev, for Chicago's Lithuanians it is not enough. I truly believe there must be an action available to the president that is both stronger and more public that still preserves policy considerations. Failure to act will have adverse effects upon Republican prospects here in Illinois this fall. Such negative impact, because of the importance of 1990 will likely last until at least 2000 and probably beyond. A positive action by the president would likely be as long-lasting.

Again, the politics of Illinois should be considered along with the just and sincere cause of the Lithuanian people. I would hope for a response that I can appreciate as a Lithuanian-American and will be useful as a Republican candidate for the United State Congress.

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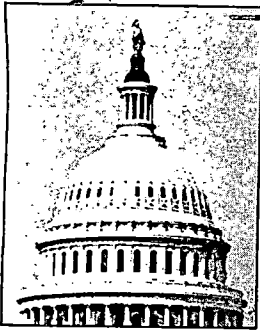

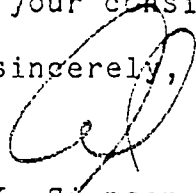
It is my understanding that the Vice President will be making a visit to Central America in the near future. One of the key members of his staff during his stay will be his interpreter.

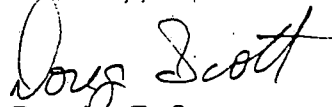
Dear Governor Sununu,

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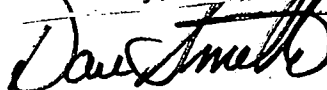

Mr. Sununu:

I am writing you upon the advice of Mr. Gary MacDougal with whom I conferred this morning regarding recent events in Lithuania.

By way of introduction, I am the Republican candidate for Congress in Illinois Fifth District. I am of 100% Lithuanian descent. On Monday I hosted a meeting between leaders of Chicago's Lithuanian-American community and Representative Lynn Martin. On Tuesday, in light of the Soviet assault upon Lithuanian hospitals I received many phone calls asking if there was something I could do. I spoke with Mr. MacDougal and he suggested I convey my thoughts to you.

Some general political background: The Chicago area is home to the largest Lithuanian community outside Lithuania. There are over 100,000 people of Lithuanian heritage here. I can tell you that they are exceedingly unhappy with the president's current approach to the Lithuanian question. As I am sure you are aware, the president carried Illinois by much less than 100,000 votes in 1988. If there is not some positive movement on his part it will surely cause him problems in 1992, and in the much more short term, there is the potential for adverse fallout to harm Jim Edgar's campaign for governor this year, and, despite her support of the Lithuanian community, damage Ms. Martin's campaign for the United States Senate. I can tell you that the community has a long memory. Lithuanians tend to be Republican because they believe that Franklin Roosevelt gave away their country at Yalta. Lack of movement by President Bush could adversely affect Republican prospects at many levels here in Illinois.

The politics of Illinois aside, I understand some of the policy constraints and international considerations that limit the president. In my discussions with community leaders I have mentioned these constraints and indicated that asking for full diplomatic relations puts upon the president a request he cannot at this moment responsibly fulfill. In my talks I have suggested an alternative that seems to encourage all except the most militant members of the community.

You Were Born To Drink Quibell.

There are important issues of international law at issue in the Lithuanian controversy. Among these is the status of the Lithuanian boys returning home from what Lithuania contends to be an illegal conscription. Conscription by an occupying power of the nationals of the occupied land is illegal both by treaty and by precedent dating back to our own War of 1812 and beyond.

Incidentally, the recent comments of Vice-President Quayle on this issue seem at best ill-advised and have caused great distress both here and in Lithuania. (The Lithuanian World Center in Lemont, Illinois is in contact with competent sources in Lithuania.)

The general issue of Lithuania's status is also a complex question, as I am sure you are aware. The United States position, that the Soviet incorporation is illegal, appears straightforward on its face, in action it has been ambivalent. The criteria for recognition varies between the political, the practical and the legal. This I understand as a politician, a businessman, and an attorney.

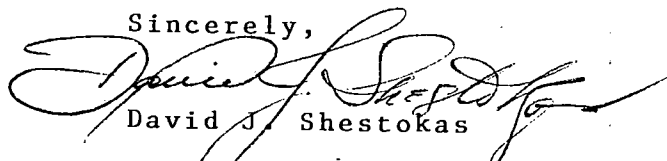
These considerations lead me to believe that Chicago's Lithuanian community would be heartened and a tenable position obtained for President Bush, Mr. Gorbachev, and the Lithuanian government by involving the United Nations in the resolution of the international legal questions. The involvement of the U. N., at the invitation of the United States, would be implicit recognition of Lithuania without de jure activity by the United States. Mr. Gorbachev, having renounced the Nazi-Soviet pact, and relying so heavily upon world opinion in his internal politics, if handled properly, could save face, at home and abroad. The Lithuanian government would likely react favorably to the involvement of a "neutral" third party. Our president could open the debate to the world, and in doing so, please his constituents here in Illinois.

I am enclosing a flyer regarding the Lithuanian Hot Line in Lemont, and details about a "Freedom Rally" being held downtown Chicago this Friday afternoon. There is hope that the rally will attract 10,000 people.

I would hope that I might be able to convey some message of support from the President on Friday. If that were to happen, I would limit my own comments to precisely his message.

There are important Illinois political considerations in addition to the sincere, just concerns of Illinois Lithuanian community. I thank you for your time and would be happy to serve in conducting a dialogue between the White House and Chicago's Lithuanian community.

Before the Administration takes any position on these proposals, we urge you to learn more about the California situation. In particular, you should know of two recent developments.

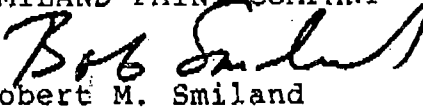

I see from recent press reports that you are under an increasing amount of criticism concerning your positions on the environment. Even though "Sununu bashing" has become fashionable, I want to applaud your efforts in striking the difficult and delicate balance between environmental protection and economic prosperity.

Your position on the clean air legislation is right on target. The legislative provisions that have the most potential impact on the state of Montana are those concerning Acid Rain. The Bush Administration's policy of opposing cost-sharing mechanisms and mandatory scrubber requirements are essential in achieving reduced emissions in a least-cost way. In addition, I urge you to continue supporting those provisions that would allow some ability for clean states, such as Montana, to enjoy a moderate amount of economic growth. In this regard, we are asking no more than to enjoy the benefits and opportunities that exist in the other states.

I also commend your publicly stated position on global climate change. Through my work on the NGA's Global Climate Change Task Force, I have worked hard to avoid making specific time recommendations for achieving emission reductions. The Bush Administration's "no regrets" philosophy is a most reasoned position, until further data has been acquired by the international scientific community. We cannot be lulled into following those "shoot from the hip" environmentalists who are anxious to prematurely impose enormous costs to our economy--even though the environmental benefits from such policies are unknown.

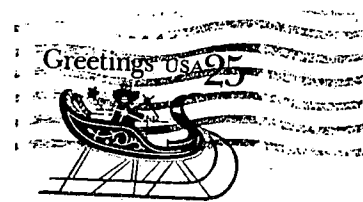

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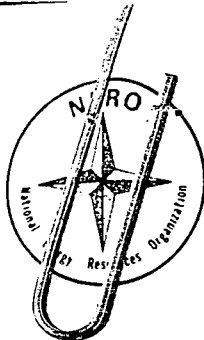

The U.S. telecommunications equipment manufacturing industry is a vital part of the U.S. industrial complex. The industry represents about 10 percent of all manufacturing output and employs hundreds of thousands of workers. Since the AT&T divestiture under the Justice Department's Modified Final Judgment (MFJ), the industry has grown enormously. Total industry output has increased dramatically as has the number of manufacturing establishments. This industry growth is due principally to the opportunities that were created by divestiture.

As you know, the parties involved in the settlement agreed that certain prerequisites were necessary to ensure a competitive environment in the telecommunications marketplace. Among other things, the MFJ stipulated that the Regional Bell Operating Companies (RBOCs) not enter into certain lines of business where their monopoly power could be used to stifle competition.

There is now a movement underway sponsored in large measure by the RBOCs to return the telecommunications marketplace to one dominated by monopoly control and limited competitive opportunities. The RBOCs are mounting an expensive lobbying campaign to eliminate various provisions of the MFJ through special interest legislation.

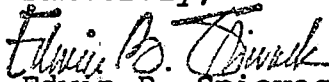
The North American Telecommunications Association, the Independent Data Communications Manufacturers Association, and the Telecommunications Industry Association, collectively representing the interests of virtually all U.S. manufacturers of telecommunications equipment are against overturning the manufacturing provisions of the MFJ. The three associations have prepared the attached report which demonstrates the health of the U.S. telecommunications equipment manufacturing industry.

Dear Governor Sununu:

A few days from now, you will receive a special invitation to participate in helping to bring the greatest gift of all to a child in need: the gift of a loving family and permanent home.

Your opportunity will come in the form of an invitation to an important national event.

On Thursday, May 17th in Washington D. C., a Gala Benefit will be held to commemorate the critical work and accomplishments of the National Committee For Adoption -- and to focus public attention on the urgent need to knock down the barriers that stand in the way of adoption.

As I'm sure you know, there are countless children who have come into this life without a family, or a home.

Yet, while the beginnings of their lives may be uncertain, or the circumstances of their births unknown, each and every one of these children is wanted...and needed by someone.

I know because my wife Carol and I have been blessed with three wonderful adopted grandchildren. The joy they have brought the entire Simon family is one of the reasons I am active in supporting the National Committee For Adoption.

Our work with the Committee has made me keenly aware of the tragic, senseless hurdles that still separate homeless infants and children from prospective parents eager to share their love and build a family.

At the Gala, we will pay tribute to several who have helped the Committee and the adoption cause such as former President Gerald R. Ford and Olympic diving champion, Greg Louganis, who serve on our Advisory Board. Both were adopted. Singer Patti La Belle, an adoptive parent, also serves, as does America's best-known adoptive grandparent, Barbara Bush, the Committee's honorary chair.

But you certainly don't have to have a personal connection with adoption to understand the urgency of this cause.

Today, complicated laws, outmoded regulations and bureaucratic red tape prevent orphaned or abused children from reaching loving, permanent homes while responsible, generous adults who want to adopt are kept on waiting lists for years.

At the same time, misperceptions, fears and a broad lack of understanding keep many people from adopting...people whose lives could be so greatly enriched by the experience.

As a result, infants fighting AIDS or abandonment live for months on end as hospital "boarder babies", children "grow up" shuttled from one temporary foster home to another, or remain trapped in refugee camps year after year.

The Committee is fighting to break down these barriers. But as the only national organization promoting and defending adoption, the Committee must raise critically-needed funds to fulfill its mission.
