Dear Governor Sununu:

It is my understanding that one of the revenue options considered during the recent deficit reduction negotiations was a proposal to amortize a portion of the business tax deduction for advertising expenses. On behalf of the membership of the American Advertising Federation I would like to thank you for the rejection of this harmful proposal.

The AAF represents all facets of the advertising industry, including major advertisers, advertising agencies and the broadcast and print media. In addition, our membership includes over 50,000 advertising professionals in 229 local ad clubs nationwide.

Increasing the tax burden of advertising would not only harm our members, but the economy as well. Given the current economic slowdown it would be disastrous. A decrease in advertising will result in fewer sales, causing the economy to slow even further.

Advertising fuels our free market economy. It provides consumers with valuable information about products and services that they want and need. Advertising is a powerful catalyst for competition and promotes the entry of new firms and products into the marketplace. Advertising supports public access to news and entertainment. It is the sole source of revenue for broadcasters and the primary source for magazines and newspapers.

Congress will continue to receive pressure to find new sources of revenue. I hope you will oppose all attempts to limit the full business tax deduction for advertising expenses.

Dear Mr. Sununu,

I am a New Hampshire resident who resides on lake front property in Warner, and an active member of the Tom Pond Protective Association, an association of lake front property owners dedicated to the protection and preservation of N.H. lakes.

During the past three years our group has worked closely with the State of New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services in the Clean Lakes Program conducting Phase I (Diagnostic/Feasibility Study) on our lake. We have devoted much of our time and personal money toward this project, as there have not been sufficient funds awarded to the State to conduct these studies for more than but a few N.H. lakes. We have been pleased with the results of our efforts, but need to continue our work to preserve the quality of our lake.

In 1972, the EPA established a Clean Lakes Program, at the public's request, to help preserve and protect the Nation's lakes. They provide assistance to States in defining the causes and extent of pollution problems, and implementing techniques to restore these bodies of water.

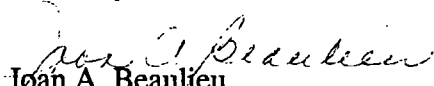
New Hampshire lakes are one of our most important natural resources, they are vital to wildlife, fisheries, recreation and tourism, as well as the quality of life of N.H. residents. The State of N.H. derives a good deal of its yearly revenue from tourist who come to N.H. to swim, boat and fish. The EPA grants for our Clean Lakes Program has allowed N.H. to increase recreational, aesthetic beauty, property values, fishing and wetland habitats.

The EPA's budget for FY 1992 is currently undergoing review and EPA has requested zero funds under the Clean Lakes Program. This seriously jeopardizes New Hampshire's Clean Lakes Program. We need continued support of the Clean Lakes Program in order to preserve and protect these valued assets, so that they will benefit N.H. citizens for generations to come.

We ask for your assistance and support in requesting additions to the EPA budget for the Clean Lakes Program, as it is so vital for the well being of our citizens and our environment.

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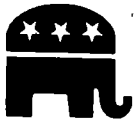

Thanks for taking my call earlier this week regarding the NRIIA.

As we continue our search for a new President of the National Republican Institute for International Affairs, we hope to find that individual who closely meets the original criteria the search committee established for the position. Specifically, we are hoping to find a person with solid practical political experience, Capitol Hill experience, good relationships with and a working knowledge of the White House, the State Department and the National Committee, good communications skills, fundraising and managerial experience.

Also, it is very important that the person we hire has a real desire to hold this job for an extended period of time and that this position not be a parking place until the next election. You should also make the candidates you interview aware of the travel schedule involved, which we estimate to be as much as 150 days of travel per year to many remote places.

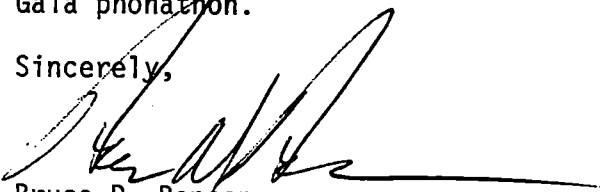

I was fortunate to have a few words with you when President Bush visited John Marshall High School for a rally earlier this month in Rochester, Minnesota. Perhaps you will recall me mentioning to you that I used your article from the publication Intergovernmental Perspective when I put together a paper at the conclusion of a course given by Professor Hale Champion at the Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University in Cambridge.

I did use your article and quotes from it and attached it as an addendum to my paper. I enclose a copy of the paper for you.

I would be very interested in learning of any additional action in the direction of a constitutional amendment that will strengthen the role of the states in the federal system and make it more in line with what I believe to have been the intent of the 10th Amendment to the Constitution. If you know of any further action along this line in the Congress or administration, I would be very pleased to learn of it. I will be returning to Harvard next fall after the current legislative session is finished here in Minnesota to finish my degree and I continue to favor changes in governmental structure that will increase the role of the states in delivering necessary government services.

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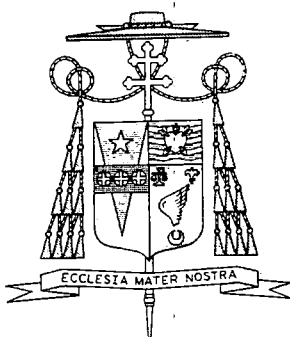

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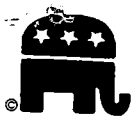

Dear John,

Your dinner was the hottest ticket of the Conservative Leadership Conference. And I believe your addressing that particular conference was opportune.

I wanted to ask your assistance on behalf of my long-time friend and associate, Denny Daugherty.

He is seeking a new position where he will be able to serve the Bush Administration more effectively.

He is now a career status employee in the Office of the Solicitor at Interior, a position he achieved after many years of work for the Reagan-Bush administration.

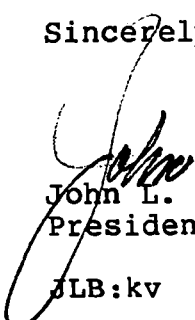
As you may know, there is a spot opening on the NTSB. Jim Burnett, a Republican, retires on December 31.

First, thanks for sending Joan the president's autobiography with his signature along with yours and the signatures of the NH contingent at the White House. It definitely was the highlight of her birthday.

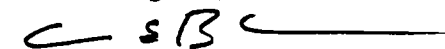

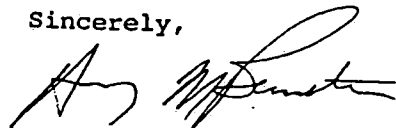

Your participation as a keynote speaker at our Opening Plenary Session on Monday, January 28, 1991, at 8:30 am will help ensure that the resulting national research agenda is focused on the issues most pressing to our nation. We would greatly appreciate it if you could now confirm your participation at this Forum, so that we may move forward in finalizing our national program. We recognize that even though you may agree to speak at this time, a scheduling conflict may arise at the last minute and you may have to send an alternate to give your speech. We can accept that potentiality, though your personal presence will have the greatest influence on the Forum's focus.

We expect attendance to be approximately 400 people, including representatives from numerous international organizations. As you can see from the program, members of the Corporate Advisory Board like the Honorable Thomas D. Larson, Lt General Henry Hatch, and James W. Poirot (Chairman of the Board of CH2M Hill) are just three of this nation's government and business leaders who have made a major commitment to participate at this forum over the entire two and one half days to ensure that the resulting research agenda meets our national needs.

We hope you will honor us by agreeing to be a keynote speaker. I have also enclosed a few copies of our most recent newsletter which will give you some additional background on the Foundation's activities and identifies all our Board and Corporate Advisory Board members. We look forward to receiving your confirmation of participation.

I am emphatically not an isolationist;

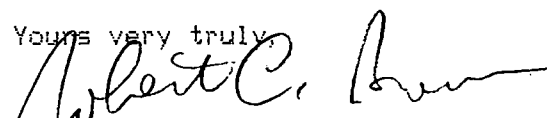

3. After an early retirement from the USAF and while I was serving in the NH legislature I tried many times to be recalled to active duty to fly combat in Vietnam.

Our 45 years of patiently maintaining troops in Germany proved successful. I anticipate a similar success following our 35 years of maintaining troops in South Korea.

I urge you to use your influence on President Bush to return to the original policy of rotating troops in Saudi Arabia so as to outwait the Iraqis as we outwaited the Soviets and will probably succeed in outwaiting the North Koreans.

Based on two years I spent in Turkey, two years in Beirut and Damascus, and on my combat military experience, I am convinced that an offensive initiated by us would be military, political, and moral madness.

Each day these needs are placed in adversarial positions, unnecessarily. After more than a year of study and debate, the American Academy of Environmental Engineers found that there are ways America can encourage sustainable development and protect the environment.

The Academy recommendations for government action include:

- * Provide incentives for everyone to practice pollution prevention -- government, business and the public.
- * Shift away from "command and control" regulations which inhibit innovation towards pollution prevention.
- * Fund research needed to better define health and environmental risks. This will enable the public to make decisions based on facts and not emotion.

A four page summary of our work together with a copy of the Workshop on Environmental Issues Related to Industrial Competitiveness Proceedings is enclosed. The Proceedings explain the basis for the Academy recommendations.

There is a problem which is re-emerging in the Defense Department and needs to be addressed within the administration. I know you respect my knowledge of Special Operations so I have presumed to write to you. A small cadre of scientists and retired military officers who want to "humanize war" are again gaining a foothold. Vic Reese, the present Acting Director of DARPA (recommended for Directorship) is a proponent of "nonlethal" warfare. This is a nice concept, but it is also nonsense. It offers a variety of Buck Rogers devices to be carried into battle by special operations forces. It is my conviction that these systems reduce our ability to wage war and will not be used by special operators.

Police actions, peace keeping missions and the like, require minimum force to achieve an objective. Special operations, on the other hand, demand maximum instantaneous force to shock and confuse the enemy in order to allow escape and instill fear. Missions are conducted on enemy soil and, not surprisingly, the enemy shoots real bullets.

What Vic Reese should be pursuing are major technological advances to enhance close combat and special operations with "leap ahead" technologies like electro-magnetic guns. If indeed, our new military strategy stresses contingency operations in lieu of a NATO- Warsaw Pact conflict, then lethal weapons systems for close combat and special operations will be crucial.

This is not a new dilemma and perhaps some words of wisdom are in order:

... That is why governments and commanders have always tried to find ways of avoiding a decisive battle and reaching their goals by other means or of quietly abandoning it. Historians and other theorists have taken great pains when describing such campaigns and conflicts to point out that other means not only served the purpose as well as a battle that was never fought, but were indeed evidence of higher skill. This line of thought had brought us almost to the point of regarding, in the economy of war, battle as a kind of evil, brought about by mistake-- a morbid manifestation to which orthodox, correctly managed war should never have to resort. Laurels were to be reserved

for those generals who knew how to conduct a war without bloodshed; and it was to be the specific purpose of the theory of war to teach this kind of warfare... .

Recent history has scattered such nonsense to the winds. Still, one cannot be certain that it will not recur here and there for shorter or longer periods in betraying those responsible into mistakes which, because they cater to weakness, cater to human nature... .

We are not interested in generals who win victories without bloodshed. The fact that slaughter is a horrifying spectacle must make us take war more seriously, but not provide an excuse for gradually blunting our swords in the name of humanity. Sooner or later someone will come along with a sharp sword and hack off our arms.

. ON WAR, Carl Von Clausewitz 1832

Our Soviet "friends" continue to hold a sharp sword at this very fragile period in history.

I leave you with a "war story". When I was in Viet Nam I conceived of a device to be used in beach reconnaissance. It was slightly more complicated than a small flashlight with a compass built into it. A government laboratory agreed to develop the unit. When it emerged from the hands of scientists a year later it typified the very cutting edge of technology. The laser device measured 2 ft. by 2 ft., weighed 9 pounds in water requiring a swimmer to inflate his lifejacket, and it did not do the job. It was deployed to Viet Nam and on the very first beach reconnaissance mission it was dropped in the darkness to the ocean bottom by an E3 boatswain's mate.

I assure you that Buck Roger's stun guns won't float any better, but if "nonlethal" warfare becomes the focus of DARPA it will certainly "blunt our swords" in the future and divert precious resources from the development of that new generation of warfighting tools which ultimately provides this Nation with the cutting edge.

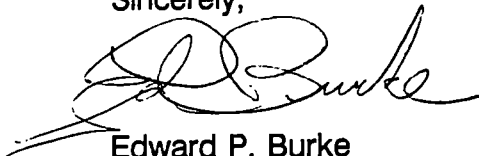
Dear Governor Sununu:

Enclosed for your review and retention is a copy of Bethlehem's Report for Third Quarter 1990. Bethlehem's reported net income of \$10 million for the Third Quarter and \$53 million for the First Nine Months was 79% lower than our net income for Third Quarter 1989 and 73% lower than First Nine Months 1989. The decline in net income results from lower steel prices, higher operating costs and lower shipments. Bethlehem continues to be a company in transition and certain sections of the Report are marked to indicate areas of progress and concern.

1. Higher Costs.

Production costs at most steelmaking operations were higher. In addition, Sparrows Point incurred higher costs in connection with planned outages for modernizing a hot strip mill and for accelerated coke oven repairs.

2. Lower Shipments.

Steel shipments were approximately 6% lower in the third quarter of 1990 than in the year earlier period. The decline in shipments was primarily attributable to reduced

shipments from our Sparrows Point, Maryland plant, due in part to blast furnace problems during the first half of the year.

3. Bar, Rod and Wire; Rail and Pipe; and Structural Products.

Severe market and competitive pressures continue to affect the Bar, Rod and Wire Division, the Rail Products and Pipe Division and the Structural Products Division. During the third quarter of 1990, Bethlehem announced that it was considering a plan to improve the competitiveness of the Bar, Rod and Wire Division and return it to long-term profitability. The plan includes more than \$100 million in major facility improvements, but is dependent upon obtaining a more competitive agreement on labor costs with the United Steelworkers. Also, Bethlehem is considering a wide range of restructuring alternatives for the Structural Products Division and the Rail Products and Pipe Division which could also result in significant capital expenditures and/or material charges to income.

4. Steel Related Operations.

This segment had losses from operations of \$12 million and \$15 million in the third quarter and first nine months of 1990 compared to losses of \$8 million and \$128 million for the same periods last year. Losses for the first nine months of 1989 included unusual charges of \$105 million principally for restructuring and downsizing the BethForge and Baltimore Marine Divisions.

5. Liquidity.

Our cash and cash equivalents declined to \$231 million at the end of the third quarter from \$281 million at the end of the second quarter. The decline resulted from reduced cash provided from operating activities, high levels of capital spending and continued pension funding.

6. Capital Expenditures.

Capital expenditures were \$332 million during the first nine months of 1990 compared to \$256 million for the first nine months of last year. We currently estimate that for 1990 capital spending will be about \$475 million and \$500 million in 1991. The estimate for 1991 does not include amounts for improvements being considered for the Bar, Rod and Wire Division.

7. Pensions.

We contributed an additional \$64 million to our pension fund during the third quarter for a total of \$226 million this year. Additional contributions for the remainder of the year will be considered as appropriate.

8. Sale of Assets.

We realized cash proceeds of \$13 million from the sale of assets during the first nine months of 1990 and expect to realize a total of about \$75 million from asset sales for the year, including the planned sale of two lake vessels. During the third quarter of 1990, we announced our intention to sell the Freight Car Division.

9. Clean Air Legislation.

Congress has recently passed legislation that would impose more stringent environmental control requirements under the Clean Air Act. Coke making facilities will have to meet progressively more stringent standards in the years ahead. Bethlehem operates coke making facilities at its Burns Harbor and Sparrows Point plants, the Structural Products Division and at Lackawanna, New York. We continue to evaluate the impact the new standards will have on these operations, but based on our present understanding of these standards we believe that our operations will be able to comply.

10. Trade Matters.

The Uruguay Round of multilateral trade negotiations under the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade will be concluded later this year. It is essential that the overall objectives of these negotiations be achieved, that our trade laws be strengthened, and that we continue to have strong and effective unfair trade remedies.

11. Outlook.

We anticipate that our shipments in the fourth quarter will moderately exceed those of the third. However, our fourth quarter and 1991 results will continue to be adversely affected by the additional costs being incurred in connection with the hot strip mill modernization and coke oven repairs at Sparrows Point. We currently estimate that domestic steel shipments will decline somewhat in 1991 from about 83 million tons in 1990.

Line-item Veto

Dear Governor Sununu,

We met a few times in Concord while I was on the faculty of Franklin Pierce Law Center, where, among other things, I initiated Franklin Pierce's unique Master of Intellectual Property degree program, designed especially for foreign students from developing nations.

I have recently retired and my wife and I have moved to West Texas.

I am writing you because it seems to me that now would be an opportune time for President Bush to give the Line-item Veto a strong try. The country is disgusted with the performance of Congress every year, and especially this year, in not handling the Budget competently.

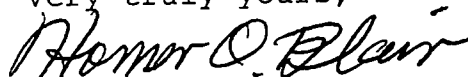
Historically, times are fairly good economically, and Congress should be running a surplus, rather than the continuing deficits. What will we do if we have a depression or an all-out war?

Until the President has the Line-item Veto power, he can not really be held responsible for the Government's overspending.

I believe President Bush should go on television, explain the Line-item veto in simple language with straightforward visual aids, get the Past Presidents to appear with him in support, use quotes from deceased Presidents, show the number of States that give their Governor this power, give a few examples of past items he would have vetoed, and ask the people to support him with Congress in this matter.

I fully realize it will not be easy to make this change, but I think now is the right time to try.
