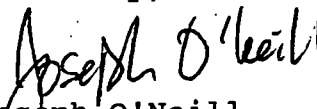
I am writing on behalf of the National Retail Federation to urge you to oppose any effort to deny the deductibility of interest paid by corporations on income tax underpayments.

The National Retail Federation is the largest national trade association representing the retail industry. Created by a recent merger between the American Retail Federation and the National Retail Merchants Association, the new organization represents the fifty state retail associations and some 27 national retail associations. In total, the NRF represents over one million U.S. retail establishments, and employs nearly 16 million people.

This proposal, which is being considered by the budget summit participants and is similar to H.R. 5557, is contrary to long-standing tax law principles and is punitive in nature. In addition, the proposal will disrupt the current federal and state audit systems currently operating between the corporate taxpayers and the government. For these reasons, the Federation does not view the proposal as part of any reasonable solution to solve the federal budget deficit.

Therefore, we urge you to support efforts to remove this proposal from any budget agreement or subsequent implementing legislation which may result from such an agreement.

Dear Governor Sununu:

I am writing on behalf of Chubb LifeAmerica, one of the largest private employers in Concord, New Hampshire, concerning the budget deficit conference's consideration of a major tax increase to be placed on life insurance companies. The contemplated tax increase would be based on deferred acquisition costs. The increase in the industry's tax burden would be from \$1.5 billion to \$3 billion per year -- nearly double the significant tax currently paid by the industry.

We must all share the burden of dealing with the deficit. However, one industry should not be singled out for an increase of such magnitude. It would drastically increase the industry's cost of doing business. For example, based on current estimates, Chubb LifeAmerica's tax increase could range from \$6.8 million to \$13.5 million, equal to approximately 17% to 34% of our after tax income.

As I mentioned, we must all do our part. But the life insurance industry - vital to our country's financial health - is being asked to shoulder far too much of the burden.

Thank you for considering our concerns. I would be pleased to answer any questions and discuss these matters further with you or any of your staff.

I write on behalf of the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) regarding Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Director Richard Darman's proposal to allow pharmacists to switch Medicaid patients to different and cheaper drugs than those prescribed by their physicians. The AOA strongly opposes therapeutic substitution of physicians' prescriptions and respectfully requests that you vote against this proposal.

As a member of the budget summit which is considering cost-saving measures for the Medicaid program, you have a societal responsibility to oppose this proposal and ensure that Medicaid patients are not subject to second-rate care and harmful prescriptions. It must be realized that the decision as to the most appropriate therapeutic agent can be made only by the patient's physician, predicated on physician findings, a complete knowledge of the patient's medical history, symptoms, behavior and pertinent laboratory findings. Furthermore, it must be underscored that just because an individual, such as a pharmacist, has the academic ability to determine specific drugs for specific diseases, he or she in no way is qualified to change a physicians' prescription because only the physician has conducted a thorough patient evaluation and history. Armed with the academic ability and the patient exposure, the physician is the only individual who should control prescriptions.

Further, if therapeutic substitution is permitted, new medical liability issues would surface by exposing the patient to real and indefensible medical risks. In such situations, the physician-patient relationship also would be compromised.

Finally, the AOA requests that you vociferously oppose Darman's provision that pharmacists would not be liable under any state or federal laws if they substitute "therapeutic alternatives" approved by the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services. This exemption makes absolutely no sense. If any immunity is granted, it should be for the physician who alone knows best what prescription is most appropriate for his patient.

I hope you will agree that Darman's proposal is not a reasonable one and that the budget summiteers strike it from the negotiating table.

Thank you for your consideration of these comments.
