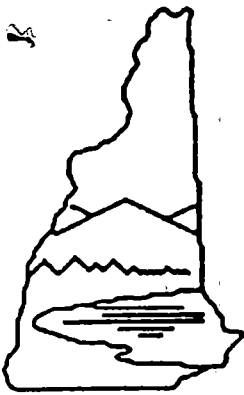

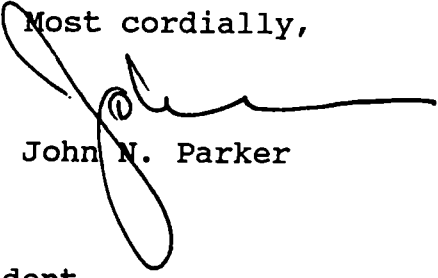

New Leadership & Re-Organization Is Needed At NRCC

In troubled times like now when President George Bush is confronted with budget and Gulf crises, he needs help from the Congress, but as you can see no help is forthcoming. It is about time to elect more Republicans in the Congress.

The present leadership at NRCC has failed to accomplish this goal. Year after year, the NRCC raises six times more money than the DCCC, declares deficit at the end of the election cycle with less Republicans being elected. We want to know where and how all this money is being spent.

We are a minority in the House despite all the tall promises by the hotshot and expensive consultants to turn this around. In order to dissolve this permanent minority status for the 34 years, urgent reforms at the NRCC are needed right now to enable us to get ready for 1992.

The House will be Democratic for as far as the eye can see. The 1990 census is not going make a great difference. Reapportionment and campaign's laws reforms may shift a few seats, but very few. The Democratic majority is there until our party decides to help the challengers make the races equal.

Having run three times for the 11th congressional seat in California, I have the following observations and recommendations to share:

1. Candidates need more attention and prompt answers to their many questions. I experienced little cooperation from the NRCC staff and was often transferred from one phone to another or did not receive a return call.

Just to give you a few examples, I called Ed Rollins from California and he agreed to see me on June 26. But when I arrived at NRCC's office, I was told by his secretary that he is not there even though another staff member told me that he was in the office.

I got stuck with Marc Nuttle, another hotshot consultant who gave me five minutes and asked whether I had the survey. I was very furious. On top of this, he denied me a photo op with the President, telling me that only the top 25 candidates are scheduled to see him. My running for the third time with 70% of the Republicans in the district behind me does not qualify me. I was shocked. What a treatment?

2. We need stronger field organization to establish one to one contact with candidates.

3. We need camaraderie between the incumbents and challengers. I suggest that each Republican incumbent sponsor one or two challengers throughout the race to help, monitor and provide guidance.

Let me give you a glimpse of my candidacy. With Lantos' past record already tarnished by conflicts of interest, I could have defeated him this year with the help of my Congressional friends. But no Republican Congressman cooperated with me to file a complaint against him with the Ethics Committee which was central to my campaign strategy. A copy of the complaint is attached. I begged every friend in the Congress I knew, knocked on their doors to receive only false promises.

Newt Gingrich promised in his office on June 28th to file the complaint on my behalf but later declined. A copy of his letter is attached.

Guy Vander Jagt promised in his office on June 27th to provide me three refusal letters to enable me to pursue this matter with the Ethics Committee on my own. When I called him after four weeks he told me that he had already gotten three letters from three members of Congress, and I should have received those letters a long time ago. I never received those letters. He did not keep his promise.

My own California delegation was of no help either.

The story implicating Lantos, copy attached, as it appeared in the San Jose Mercury News of April 15th is so strong that reporter who wrote it is ready to testify even today before the Ethics Committee. Lantos has never been able to refute it.

4. Top positions at NRCC should be filled by people who know what it takes to walk in a serious candidates' moccasins, not by highly paid consultants or bystanders who have never run for an office in their lives. The jobs of the Co-Chairman and Executive Director should be filled by candidates.

5. Competent staff, not young kids from some Campaign Academy or so-called consultants should be hired to handle day-to-day inquiries of the challengers. As you know that our challengers are very competent, experienced and qualified people as evidenced by their resumes and profiles which are on file with NRCC. They need better treatment.

6. The Republican Party should provide well known speakers, personalities to the challengers to raise funds.

I got a lot of promises from every Republican leader I met during the last six years but no body showed up. The issue of non-support from the party for me was so hot that it hit the local newspaper's editorial before the election which said, "The Republican voters in the 11th District have every reason to sue the national party for not supporting Bill Quraishi."

times after the Primary, which I won by 70% margin, I was neck to neck with Lantos by 39% to 37%. I spent \$150,000. I would have won the race by infusion of another \$50,000 to my campaign

7. List of potential contributors should be shared with challengers.

I want you to understand that I am not bitter and I am not trying to put the blame on others for my failure. I just simply failed to accomplish my goal. You cannot change the past but you can surely learn from it. Challengers could have had easier life if our NRCC understood the American politics. I am just frustrated and discouraged but determined to fight on.

8. More and more candidates workshops should be held by NRCC. This provides a forum for candidates to learn from incumbents and interact with each other. No workshop was held during the last two years.

9. More coordination is needed between the County, State and National Parties. We need strong support at grass-roots levels.

My criticism is constructive and positive and I am not mad at any body to get even. All I want more Republicans in the Congress.

With my humble I.Q. of 200, I have a vision and future for America. Unfortunately, quite of a few members of Congress don't understand American politics. To get elected, they are selling this country to special interests every day.

To summarize the above, I believe an overhaul of the entire NRCC structure is needed based on the above recommendations. The year of 1992 is a very attractive year. I believe one third of the House seats will change hands in 1992.

An aggressive program should be launched to contact serious candidates right now who have run before, can raise money, have name recognition, and no hidden skeletons, to come to Washington to plan a strategy for 1992.

If you follow my suggestions as above, I bet you we will become a majority not only in the House and in the Senate as well with President Bush at the helm of affairs in 1992.

If the above suggestions and other good ideas are not followed through, there will be scarcity of potential candidates and no substantial opposition, if the challengers are not helped.

I am not planning to run in 1992 because my business has suffered quite a bit. So I have to put my economic house in order. However, I am available to further the cause of the Republican Party. Please call me anytime.

S. 358, "The Immigration Act of 1989," is a budget buster.

Next year, and in every subsequent year, this piece of legislation will cost American taxpayers over \$3 billion.

The unemployment rate in the United States is steadily rising. The overall rate is currently 5.7%, up from 5.6% only a month ago. The increase is even more striking among the most vulnerable segments of our society, where workers compete with and are often displaced by recent immigrants. This year unemployment among blacks increased from 11.4% to its current level of 12.1%, more than twice the national average. Among Hispanics, the rate has increased from 8.0% in 1989 to 8.7% this month.

With unemployment already a serious problem in this country, and with recession impending, it does not make sense to continue to import even more competition for our own citizens who are already unemployed or underemployed. More detailed information on this difficult issue is attached for your review.

For these very crucial reasons, we urge you to recommend to President Bush that he veto this legislation.

If we can figure a way to make Saddam Hussein out to be a laughing stock, a madman, an object of ridicule, a menace to the Iraqi people, an embarrassment to Islam, a danger to Arab unity, or all of the above, we will win the Gulf confrontation "hands down." Produced on cassettes and distributed to targeted audiences throughout the Gulf region, such tapes can have the same corrosive effect on the Iraqi dictator's power and prestige as the Willie Horton TV ads did on Michael Dukakis in our last presidential campaign, only more so because of the nature of the weapon and the nature of Arab society.

The attached proposal describes the cassette tape offensive I envision. I call it PROJECT SADDAM.

I predict that the 'negative' cassette tape campaign I propose will hurt Saddam Hussein badly. But I can't prove it. Only implementation can. Of this I am certain, however. The cassette tape weapon and war is here to stay. We must learn how to use it to accomplish our objectives. The current Gulf crisis is a great place to begin.

I would welcome the opportunity to meet with you or your aides to explore the benefits and costs of implementing PROJECT SADDAM.

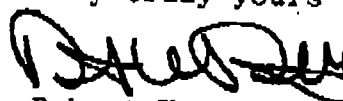

On behalf of the National Conference of State Legislatures, we congratulate you, Senator Dodd, Senator Kennedy, Senator Hatch, Senator Mitchell, and the Administration for reaching an agreement to include the Child Care and Development Block Grant within budget reconciliation. We also wish to acknowledge the leadership provided by Senators Bentsen and Packwood and Finance Committee members for cooperation in developing a comprehensive childcare package.

This agreement on the block grant addresses state legislators' programmatic priorities and strikes a compromise that we wholeheartedly support. This bipartisan agreement is a major victory for our nation's children. The Senate Child Care Block Grant will significantly expand state child care efforts to make quality child care more affordable and available.

As we have testified, the National Conference of State Legislatures believes that the Federal government must adopt a comprehensive approach to caring for our nation's children. We also believe that child care assistance should be targeted to those in low-income families. States alone, primarily due to fiscal restraints, cannot provide all the remedies for our child care needs. The Child Care Block Grant will supplement, not supplant, state child care programs and ensure state flexibility. States retain the authority to set child care standards which are essential to children's health and safety and the flexibility to address local needs. We applaud the use of financial incentives rather than federal mandates to help states improve the provision of child care services.

One aspect of the agreement, however, will be impossible for states to achieve. The agreement requires states to set up a child care certificate program within the next year. Seventeen states do not have any voucher systems while the remainder only have partial systems in place. One year is insufficient time to enact state legislation and develop and implement automated systems and payment mechanisms. NCSL believes that this time frame is unworkable and must be extended in conference.

Comprehensive federal child care policy, however, is not complete without inclusion of a tax credit for low-income working families. NCSL supports the Senate Finance Committee's combination of tax credits, particularly, proposals to increase the money that working poor families can spend on child care expenses and Dependent Care tax credit refundability. Increasing the funding for the existing Title IV child care program for state-determined low-income non-AFDC families who are at risk of dependency or need care in order to work will also supplement state efforts.

Our support for this child care agreement does not end with the passage of budget reconciliation on the Senate floor. State legislators will work together with you to ensure that the federal commitment to child care continues through the appropriations and regulatory process. Adequate federal funding and workable regulations will be required to ensure the implementation and effective operation of this new federal-state child care partnership.

NCSL appreciates your willingness to respond to the concerns of states and thanks you for your bold leadership throughout the negotiations process.

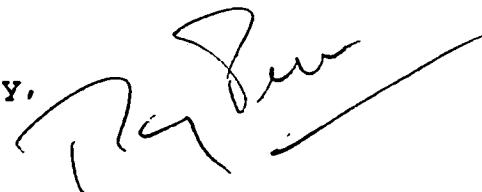

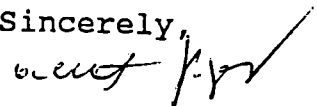

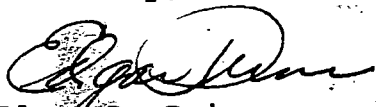
Dear Gov. Sununu:

Dear Governor Sununu:

The call for independence by non-Russian nationalities within the Soviet Union is the greatest challenge Mikhail Gorbachev currently faces, and the United States must act now to ensure that independence is achieved peacefully.

In light of your recent visit to the Soviet Union, I thought the enclosed Backgrounder, entitled "Promoting the Peaceful Decolonization of the Soviet Union," might be of interest to you. In this Backgrounder, Heritage Policy Analyst Douglas Seay examines the nationalities problem in the Soviet Union, and argues that it should not be viewed as simply an ethnic conflict or as a fight for greater autonomy. He sees the nationalities issue as "a problem of decolonization, of the non-Russian nationalities seeking independence from the Russian-dominated Soviet Union."

Seay believes that the decolonization of the Soviet Union is in America's best interest, and suggests several steps this Administration could take to push the process in a peaceful direction. Some of Seay's recommendations include: discussing decolonization at the November CSCE conference; warning Moscow not to use force against the nationalist movements; increasing contact between the United States and the various Soviet Republics; and including some republics in American assistance programs for Eastern Europe.

I hope that you will find this paper a useful reference.

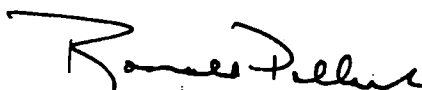

Dear Mr. Sununu:

As a major sticking point in the budget summit appears to be the issue of capital gains, I would like to suggest a logical compromise on that issue: adopt indexing of capital gains rather than an exclusion or a rate change.

Indexing capital gains for inflation has the following advantages:

1. It achieves precisely, rather than crudely, the single most important purpose of a capital gains break, which is to avoid taxing asset value increases that merely keep pace, in terms of purchasing power, with inflation. Taxation of such "gains" that merely keep pace with inflation amounts to confiscation of capital and deters investment. Put most simply, indexing is fair -- it fully taxes real gains, but only real gains.
2. On average, it achieves at least as well as an exclusion or rate change the other purposes of a capital gains break, such as stimulating entrepreneurship and investment and mitigating the double tax on corporate equity.
3. Most importantly, from the point of view of the budget summit, it gives smaller tax reductions to high income investors, and greater reductions to middle income taxpayers, than an exclusion or rate reduction, according to a recent study by the Congressional Budget Office.
4. It avoids most of the incentive for reintroduction of tax shelters (eliminated by the '86 tax reform) whose purpose is to transform ordinary income into capital gains.
5. It favors long term investing over short term speculation.

I urge you to give the most careful consideration to this alternative, which could break the logjam on capital gains while providing a better solution than either current law or an exclusion or rate change to the crucial question of how best and most fairly to tax capital gains.

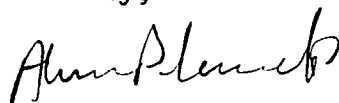

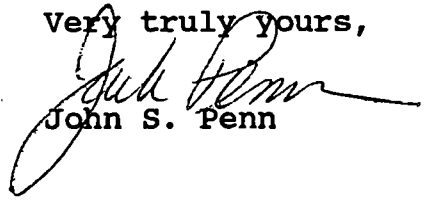

I am writing to you on behalf of the National Child Support Enforcement Association (NCSEA) to express our strongest concern regarding the proposal which is being considered by the participants in the budget summit to reduce the federal match for the Title IV-D child support enforcement program from the current level of 66 percent to 50 percent. I understand that the issue of funding for the child support program will be considered by the participants in the Budget Summit during the next few days.

The membership of NCSEA, which includes thousands of child support enforcement employees, administrators, judges, state and district attorneys, advocacy groups and others involved in child support, believes that this reduction of federal financial participation (FFP) for the Title IV-D child support program from 66 percent to 50 percent, would have a devastating effect on the child support program, and ultimately would result in more federal dollars being spent rather than less.

The child support program provides two major financial benefits to the taxpayer. First, the IV-D program provides a means of cost recovery, in that it recovers Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) benefits from delinquent non-custodial parents. Secondly, the program results in cost avoidance, in that it helps other parents stay off AFDC by collecting child support on their behalf. A study performed for the federal Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) estimated that for every dollar collected on a non-AFDC case, the federal government avoids the payment of twenty cents in AFDC costs. Given the current budget crisis, a program that recovers and avoids welfare costs should be strengthened, not weakened. Cuts to the IV-D program will likely be more than offset by increased AFDC and Medicaid Costs.

From 1977 through 1988, the Title IV-D child support enforcement program recovered over \$10 billion in federal and state AFDC costs. In addition, using the OCSE "cost-avoidance" formula, the governmental savings due to \$16 billion in non-AFDC collections during this same time period, amounted to an additional \$3.2

billion.

When the IV-D program began in 1974, the FFP rate was 75 percent. This has gradually been reduced to 66 percent. During the past nine months, due to Gramm-Rudman sequestration, that rate dropped even further, to 64 percent. During this same period, federal mandates, culminating with the enactment of the Family Support Act of 1988, have continued to increase. Any further reduction of FFP from the current match rate will seriously jeopardize the ability of IV-D agencies to comply with federal mandates. In fact, it will cause a significant decrease in the ability of IV-D agencies to continue even the present level of services. The reduction of FFP will cause state programs, already facing state budgetary limitations, to lay-off staff, close offices and delay or cancel new automated systems.

NCSEA is also aware that some members of Congress have expressed concern that the federal government "loses money" on the IV-D program while some states "make money" and that this may have precipitated the current effort to cut the FFP rate. Although we believe the "loss" to the federal government is not as great when cost-avoidance is included in the calculation, we nevertheless agree with and would support congressional action to mandate that states and counties reinvest federal IV-D incentives back into their IV-D programs. A resolution advocating this position was ratified last week by the NCSEA membership during its annual conference.

While we know that you face a challenging task in preparing the new federal budget, NCSEA does not believe that we can afford to sacrifice the Title IV-D child support enforcement effort in this country.

Thank you for your consideration of these comments. We sincerely hope that, as the participants in the Budget Summit conclude their recommendations in the next few days, progress made in the IV-D program in the past ten years can continue so that custodial parents and their children will be able to obtain economic self sufficiency.

I am sure you are aware that on August 24, Senior Judge Daniel Huyett of the US District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania struck down as unconstitutional major portions of the Pennsylvania Abortion Control Act.

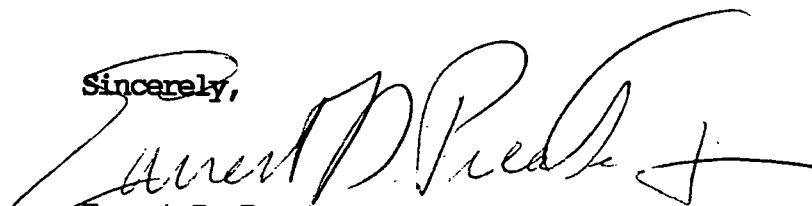
Since I know how significant this case is to the Administration, I am enclosing a number of newspaper articles reporting on the decision so that you can gauge the media reaction for yourself. Most reporters treated this, probably correctly, as just the first step on the road to the Supreme Court. Judge Huyett's quick action (the 191-page opinion was issued just three weeks after the trial concluded), coupled with Guam's reported reluctance to serve as the next major abortion test-case, does appear to put Pennsylvania on the fast track to the Supreme Court.

You will note an assumption in many of the news accounts that this case will be the vehicle that forces a newly comprised court to consider overturning Roe v. Wade. That may or may not prove to be the case. Our legal position is that in light of Webster, Pennsylvania's statute can and should be held constitutional without expressly overturning Roe. Alternatively, we would argue that if Roe must be overturned for our statute to be held constitutional, then that should be done.

We will, of course, cooperate fully with Attorney General Thornburgh and Solicitor General Starr (to whom I have written separate letters) to enable them to track the progress of the case and, at the appropriate time, present the Administration's position in court, when appropriate.
