Dear John:

I haven't written to you since you became Chief-of-Staff, as you have been doing fine. Now that you are running with the ball on energy strategy, I wish to offer a few suggestions which I believe are worthy of your consideration and in line with what I believe is your belief (and mine) that the private sector is enormously more efficient than the Government in dealing with energy matters.

There are good reasons why most energy matters are best handled by the private sector. The expertise and business acumen in energy matters is in the private sector and this is applied when market forces provide adequate reward. This has been the case for the increase in non-OPEC oil production in the early 1980's resulting from price incentives. At that time, there was also a reduction in demand for oil which was similarly due to price incentives prompting the adoption of more efficient energy use methods. During the past 16 years, the extent of contribution of the National Labs and Government supported contract research labs has been nil because they lack the appropriate expertise in developing commercial products. In fact, the National Labs tried to slow down the commercialization of the coal-fired fluidized bed boiler because they had insufficient understanding of the fluid mechanics and chemistry.

The nation's energy problem is one of providing low cost, secure liquid fuels for transportation. Other aspects of energy use have been dragged into the foray because very cheap oil was used for power generation. The coal use issue is one of finding an inexpensive method to use coal cleanly. I recommend that you consider identifying the real needs and challenges and separating them from the notion that we are running out of energy. You might advocate improved efficiency, driven by market forces, as the route to reduced dependence on imported oil and quote the improvements in car mileage and the reduction in fuel consumption for the heating of new homes since 1974 as examples of how improved efficiency by the private sector works.

Additionally, you could recommend as standard banking procedure that when computing the ability of a prospective mortgage recipient (commercial as well as residential) to make the monthly payments on the mortgage he is applying for, lending institutions include utility bills along with the traditional PITI, principal, interest, taxes and insurance. This shifts the conservation issue into the private sector where the economic incentive works with amazing efficiency. It places solar heating where it has to earn its keep.

You could also recommend that state utility commissioners examine interfuel substitution as part of both electricity demand side management and air quality maintenance. Natural gas cooling always has been available; now it is really worthwhile as the equipment cost premium over electric equipment is less than the cost of building the incremental power plants. Con Ed in New York now offers \$400/kw for demand reduction; this explicitly includes gas cooling. This can be a win-win-win situation as gas is a clean fuel. Should someone question the availability of gas, obtain the record of the wellhead price of gas for the last seven or so years (since decontrol took effect), including this winter's (January '91) spot market price. A comparison of predicted (by DOE, AGA and all the presumed experts) and actual gas prices for the past ten years shows the gross inaccuracies due to built-in biases towards presumed high prices. As someone else has said, "Let the record speak for itself." We now have substantial amounts of Canadian gas coming to the United States. This provides additional assurance of a stable, long term supply beyond that provided by our own resources. Why is gas so much cheaper now than in the 1970's? Technology advancement by the private sector in response to market forces and because the gas is there.

Directing the GSA to comply with the section of the 1990 Clean Air Act pertaining to the use of clean fuels by centrally fueled fleets by buying natural gas fueled vehicles in quantity would help us to reduce oil imports and clean up the air.

Cogeneration at military bases can lower cost and reduce energy use. In many cases this has not been done as the lowest priority of the military has been to invest in equipment to reduce base operations cost. Now there are plenty of third party financiers who will finance cogeneration on a shared-savings basis. DOD and GSA should be receptive to cogeneration. As electric utilities need additional capacity in the mid-1990's they are accepting the idea of non-utility generation. Here again the private sector can do it.

Should you wish to do something for synthetic liquid fuels, then a long term government purchase (possibly by DOD) of specification fuel(s) made specifically from domestic coal and possibly other plentiful domestic resources could be considered. The only Government role would be to inspect to ensure that the contractor did not cheat. This leaves the whole issue of technology, finance, operation, waste disposal and commercial sales of byproducts in the hands of the private sector, where it belongs. Should such a plan appeal to you then you may wish to examine what could be the outcome of such a purchase. The Northern Great Plains Coal Gasification Plant was built with a Government loan guarantee - the loan was defaulted on when gas prices collapsed due to increased natural supply - and serves as the most likely type and location of plant which would be built in an open competition. Based on that technology and known catalysts to make gasoline, liquid transportation fuels could be made for around \$30/barrel, possible even less. Should you want more information on Synfuels or other energy matters you might contact Bill Gouse, now Senior Vice-President of MITRE. After leaving MIT and Carnegie-Mellon, he was Deputy Assistant Administrator for Fossil Energy in ERDA from 1974 to 1977, has kept up with the technology and, I believe, is a loyal Republican.

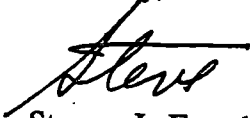

Public acceptance of nuclear power is the hardest issue because it is not a technical or financial issue. It is an issue of public confidence in the ability of large institutions (the Government being one example) to operate (and design and construct) complex systems with numerous opportunities for hazardous accidents, in a high quality manner. Perhaps there is a nuclear plant in the United States that deserves a Malcolm Baldrige award for quality. Such an award (a real devil's advocate examination would have to be made before such an award) would help to restore confidence that American made nuclear plants can be safe. The problem is not with the engineering but with the quality of construction, management and operation. I cannot recommend how to raise the level of acceptability of nuclear power to where the financial risk of a new plant would be acceptable to the investment community except to say that the whole concept of quality in both management and individual responsibility is what is being questioned. The NASA Challenger "O-ring" and Hubble telescope mirror error are examples of deep deficiencies in top management and leadership. As Admiral Rickover would say, "Why not the best?" In our over litigious society the expectation is zero defects.

My apologies for too long a letter and my sincere best wishes for finding an effective energy strategy; in brief it could be to provide incentives and controls so that the nation will be provided with secure, clean, least-cost energy service by the private sector in a quality manner.

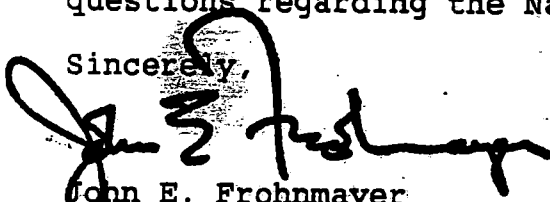

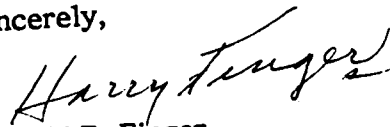

The plain and simple truth is that no one can get residential construction loan financing today. No lenders are lending because they fear the criticisms of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency.

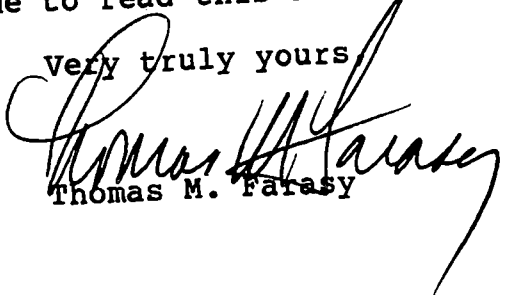
