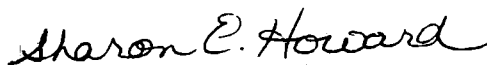

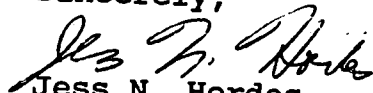

I am pleased to share with you the attached copy of the ADL's 1990 Audit of Anti-Semitic Incidents. The League has been compiling data on anti-Jewish vandalism and ~~harassment since 1979 and this year the number of~~ incidents increased dramatically to a record 1,685 episodes.

The Audit reveals that increased efforts by law enforcement authorities to apprehend the perpetrators and strict enforcement of anti-bias crime statutes are among the most effective means of countering bias crimes. The passage in 1990 of the Hate Crime Statistics Act is noted as an important tool to confront this criminal activity in the future.

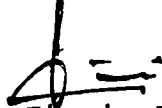

Dear Senator Sununu,

I am an author, journalist, broadcaster, former Member of Parliament of Canada, and former Member of the National Parole Board. We talked on the phone and I met you when I worked for four and a half months as a writer, researcher and media contact assisting Bill and Doug Wead, May 3rd to September 15th, 1988 on the George Bush Presidential Campaign. I attended the GOP Convention in New Orleans (I was the only one in their group with press credentials). I spoke with you in the Family Issues Suite, which I helped the Weads organize.

In April, 1988, Bill Wead asked me to come and help Doug Wead in writing Bush positions on issues as requested by media, primarily the huge religious press, doing research and generally handling all problems that emerged. I also provided background information from my own research writings on narcotics traffic, international drug cartels, terrorism, crime, violence, child abuse - the many fields in which I have expertise having written both reports for government and books.

I spoke with you on the phone several times, as I did with George Bush Jr., and other family members who called. I know you will not remember as I was probably the most anonymous backroom worker in the campaign. Incidentally, it was done at great cost to me personally, since the Weads did not pay my expenses. Nonetheless I admired George Bush very much and realized that his election affected my country very deeply, perhaps in some ways more so than our own elections.

Perhaps you should know that when the Weads asked me to come to Washington to help them, they said I could use any material I wanted and that they would also supply me with information, including exclusive stories that I could publish in my columns. I watched them build the network of Religious Right leaders in every corner of the continent. Some days I handled as many, or more than 30 calls from preachers and other conservatives who asked questions and offered help. Doug Wead took credit for predicting the Michigan and Iowa losses and for mobilizing his Amway forces to contribute victories, first of Super Tuesday, then the November election.

I would appreciate any help you or your staff can give to clarify, perhaps even correct impressions I gained inside that control centre of the New Religious Right in my office/room in the Wead apartment in Crystal City.

I have been in New York and DC through the past month and will probably go to other cities to complete my research. I will return to Washington if I can arrange an appointment with you or with someone assigned by you to assist me. As references, if you require them, I suggest the names of Edward Batal, former liaison for the U.S. Marines to the U.S. Senators; Donald Larabee, former President of the National Press Club and assistant to the Governor of Maine; Laurence O'Rourke, White House correspondent for the St. Louis Post Dispatch; and even though Congressman Al Swift is a Washington State Democrat, he has known me professionally for more than 25 years from his days as News Director of KVOS TV, Bellingham, Washington.

Here are some of the questions I would like answered:

1. Would you provide the names and structure of the White House staff directly under you? The names and titles of the three aides who, I understand, worked in an advisory capacity in the White House. One was Doug Wead, liaison to the religious community.
2. How much of the success for George Bush's victory among the evangelical and conservative Republicans do you attribute to Doug Wead's networking?
3. Were you aware of the tug-o'-war between Doug Wead's constituency and former Chief of Staff, Craig Fuller, for Vice-President George Bush?
4. Can I get the official statement on the dismissal of Doug Wead? If not, could you please advise me as to the actual cause of the dismissal?
5. What is the name, title and background (resume, if possible) of the Wead successor?
6. Can you please provide the official resume of Doug Wead and his brother Bill, who, I am advised, has moved from speech-writer for Dr. Louis Sullivan to White House aide for Health and Human Services.

I would appreciate any help you, or your staff, can provide to expand or clarify material I already have, some of which is incomplete and some requiring a check on accuracy. I was privy to considerable information and experience during the campaign inside the Wead home/office at 1200 Crystal Drive. Now I would like the follow-up information and, if possible, an interview with you or someone assigned by you, with knowledge of the subject of special interest in this research.

While I saw a great deal of the campaign to draw the Evangelical and Fundamental Christian leaders, with their millions of followers, on side with George Bush, I would like to know the sequel to their expectations and promises of support for their agenda by Mr. Bush. I have seen some of it in news reports on television, magazines and from friends in Washington. They were explicit in their goals - among them Bush support for their pro-life, anti-gay legislation and opposition to fetal tissue research. I have had the campaign statements but I would appreciate the current presidential reports of the President's position, or official statements. I know his support on these matters was promised "if he became president". If so, it is a massive swing from his positions in his earlier campaign (1980).

Your consideration and assistance would be very much appreciated.

Dear Governor Sununu:

Many of my constituents have raised serious concerns with me regarding the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands which I would like to bring to your attention.

A credible and legally defensible Manual for delineating jurisdictional wetlands is essential in order to build public support, especially since the original Manual was developed with no opportunity for public review and comment. Until appropriate corrections to the Manual are made, the wetland issue will be one of confrontation rather than cooperation.

The recent draft revisions to the Manual continue to delineate as wetlands many areas that are only temporarily wet and exhibit few, if any, functions of true wetlands defined in Environmental Protection Agency and Corps of Engineers regulations as "swamps, bogs, marshes, and similar areas". Specifically, I recommend the following corrections to the Manual:

- 1) The current hydrology criterion for delineating a wetland retains the concept of water table at some depth below the surface. Inundation or water at the surface would make the hydrology criterion a much more meaningful and positive indicator of true wetlands in the fields and would be consistent with the recent Regulatory Guidance issued by the Corps on "prior converted wetlands."
- 2) The growing season for Thermic Soils is identified as February through October. A more precise definition of the "growing season" would specify plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in Spring and the average date of the first frost in Autumn.

I urge you to incorporate my comments to assure that revisions to the Federal Manual for Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands provide greater consistency and accuracy in delineating a true wetland (i.e., swamps, bogs, marshes, and similar areas).

Christie Whitman lost to Bill Bradley by two percentage points, Republicans won a State Senate seat in South Jersey despite being outspent nearly two to one, we won a Assembly seat in a district that has not elected a Republican to the Assembly in over 15 years, and numerous county and local seats were gained by Republicans. The results of November 6, 1990 are a clear indicator that New Jerseyans are unhappy with the policies of the democrats who control the State Legislature.

New Jersey is one of only five states holding State elections this year and nowhere is there better opportunity to prove that the traditional democrat philosophies are being rejected by the voters. I am confident that 1991 will be a banner year for the Republican Party in New Jersey.

With your support we can raise the money that is essential to carry out our plans and regain control of the Assembly.

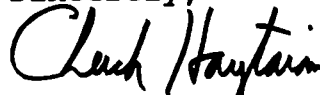

I have serious concerns regarding the federal Manual for identifying and delineating wetlands.

Recent draft revisions of the Manual are technically in error in that they give wetland status to sites which are only temporarily wet and exhibit few characteristics of true wetland ecosystems.

The current revision is also not accurate in its definition of growing seasons, in that it defines the growing season for thermic soils as the period from February through October. This is at least six to eight weeks before the growing season actually begins in many areas.

Please modify the Manual to include an extended "surface water" criteria and to provide for a more realistic definition of the growing season. These changes will result in greater consistency and accuracy in the delineation of true wetland ecosystems.

Dear John:

First, and most important, this letter is a vote of confidence and support to President Bush's actions in "Desert Storm".

Politically, President Bush is tied to the U.N. Security Council's mandate for action against Iraq at present. Any major deviation and expansion of aims beyond this at this time cannot be countenanced since the great majority of Americans and the world's people do not truly understand the actual threat posited by Saddam Hussein's actions. The Security Council has demanded that Iraq get out of Kuwait and that must be the current public pronouncement of Mr. Bush: this limited objective.

Quite recently the President's comments have been construed in some of the media to include a wider series of objectives. This has been interpretative variously to mean the destruction of the Iraqi military and/or the destruction of Saddam Hussein. I wouldn't be greatly surprised to hear an expansion of the war aims to include at least the first of these and possibly the second as well. These could gradually become the aims of Mr. Bush when expedient for him to expound the same.

We all know the aphorism about repeating history when it is ignored. Too many people either don't know of or ignore recent history that parallels the present. Adolph Hitler had German troops march into and occupy the Rhineland quite some time before he was ready to start WW 2. In post-war analysis of this event, hindsight is convincing enough to inform us all that any semblance of French or British military reaction to Hitler's aggressive move would have stopped the expedition into the Rhineland in its tracks. Continuation of this analysis gives great credence that the German troops would have withdrawn then. It is highly likely that Hitler would have been ousted from power. Whether he would have been assassinated then or not, his political credibility almost certainly would have been destroyed in Germany. Then, there is a strong likelihood that WW 2 would not have ensued. (I would not have served in the Army Air Corps then and flown against Germany, nor most likely served in two later major wars.)

Now to a very likely present scenario, Saddam Hussein has publicly proclaimed himself to be the modern version of the world leader of the Moslem world. While proof of his claim is still somewhat nebulous, it is still nonetheless quite alarming. Fortunately he is not as yet the Mahdi. Any "solution" to the Gulf Crisis that would not effectively destroy the Iraqi army and even that would leave Hussein in any condition to retain his position vis a vis the Moslem world could very well be the forerunner of a Holy War of Moslem versus the non-Moslem world. I suspect that Hitler's atrocities would then be regarded as small potatoes in contrast to the emergence of the Moslem Sword by a MAHDI in a JEHAD.

The conclusion is obvious: the Iraqi army must be effectively destroyed as an entity. Saddam Hussein must be neutralized.

I am sending copies of this letter to our New Hampshire Senators and Representatives in order to solicit their continuing support for a conclusion similar to that of my wife and me.

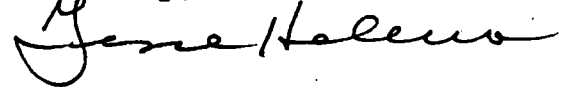

Dear John:

As you know, wetlands issues continue to generate a great deal of controversy within the Executive Branch, Congress, and the public as a whole. As the Ranking Republican Member of the House Public Works and Transportation Committee, I have been inundated with requests for changes in the law. Although I am generally receptive to proposals to streamline the Section 404 process, I realize that legislative changes may be difficult to achieve. Therefore, I welcome the Administration's efforts, through the Domestic Policy Council, to address some of the most troublesome aspects of the existing regulatory program.

One of the most controversial issues before the Council is probably the way wetlands are defined and delineated under the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands. As originally put forward, the Manual adopted an extremely broad approach whereby land which exhibits few, if any, wetlands characteristics would fall within the Act's definition of a "navigable water" and be subject to the same tough regulatory hurdles established under the Clean Water Act. The breadth of the Manual, coupled with the lack of public involvement in its formulation, stimulated most of the controversy around the country. Until appropriate corrections to the Manual are made, the wetlands issue will be one of confrontation rather than cooperation toward achieving the goal of "no overall net loss."

The recent draft revisions to the Manual continue to delineate as wetlands many areas that are only temporarily wet and exhibit few true wetlands functions. Changes to the Manual which appear to me to be particularly appropriate include the following:

1) The current hydrology criterion for delineating a wetland retains the concept of water table at some depth below the surface. Inundation or water at the surface would make the hydrology criterion a much more meaningful and positive indicator of true wetlands in the field and would be consistent with the recent Regulatory Guidance issued by the Corps on "prior converted croplands."

2) The growing season for thermic soils is identified as February through October. A more precise definition of the "growing season" would specify plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in spring and the average date of the first frost in autumn.

I urge you to incorporate these comments to assure that revisions to the Manual provide greater consistency, accuracy, and predictability in delineating true wetlands. These changes, along with many others contemplated in my legislation, the Wetlands Protection and Regulatory Reform Act of 1991 (H.R. 404), would help significantly in improving the effectiveness of and public support for the nation's wetlands protection programs.

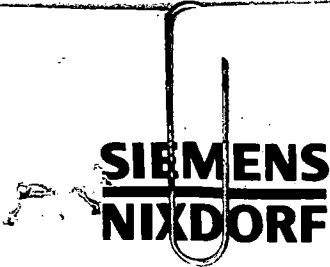

As Governor of the State of Alabama, I wish to bring to your attention some of my concerns on wetlands protection.

The Final Report of the National Wetlands Policy Forum recommends that "the nation establish a national wetlands protection policy to achieve no over all net loss of the nation's remaining wetlands base..." and, where feasible, to increase the quality and quantity of the nation's wetlands resource". President Bush endorsed this goal in his 1988 campaign.

The recent controversy regarding the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands threatened to destroy the consensus reached by the Forum on this important environmental issue. A credible wetlands definition and a legally defensible Manual for delineating wetlands is essential in order to restore and build public support for the administration's "no over all net loss of wetlands" goal. Until the conflicts surrounding the Manual are resolved, the wetlands issue will remain one of confrontation rather than cooperation toward achieving this goal.

The Manual originally published in January, 1989 significantly expanded the limits of jurisdiction into areas that exhibit few, if any, functions of true wetlands. For example, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's 1990 Action Plan estimated the State of Alabama contains 3.8 million acres of wetlands or 11.5% of the surface area. Some recent estimates using the Manual, indicate these acres may nearly double. This expansion of the limits of jurisdiction have

often been accompanied by increasing stringent regulations on land use.

Furthermore, the Manual was developed without the opportunity for public review and comment as required under the Administrative Procedure Act. This process threatens to preempt fundamental Constitutional rights, unnecessarily disrupt economic growth and erode public support of administration policy. The negative impacts on economic growth further compound our economy as we strive to manage the effects of recession.

It is my belief that the Manual contains significant technical flaws which should be corrected. Specifically: (1) the hydrology criteria for wetlands should include water at the surface not a concept of a water table at some depth below the surface. This would be consistent with the October '90 Regulatory Guidance Letter issued by the COE on "prior converted wetlands". (2) The growing season should reflect actual growing conditions. The current Manual contains references to soils and growing season categories which are the same from Florida to New Jersey.

These and other criteria should be incorporated into revisions of the Manual which is then subjected to proper scientific and public review.

A credible identification of the wetlands resource to be protected and establishment of public policy through proper administrative procedures are critical if we are to receive broad public support of the Forum and Administrations goal of "no overall net loss" of wetlands.

I urge you to consider these comments in assuring that revisions to the Manual and establishment of public policy remain both consistent with statutory authority and are conducted under proper administrative procedures.

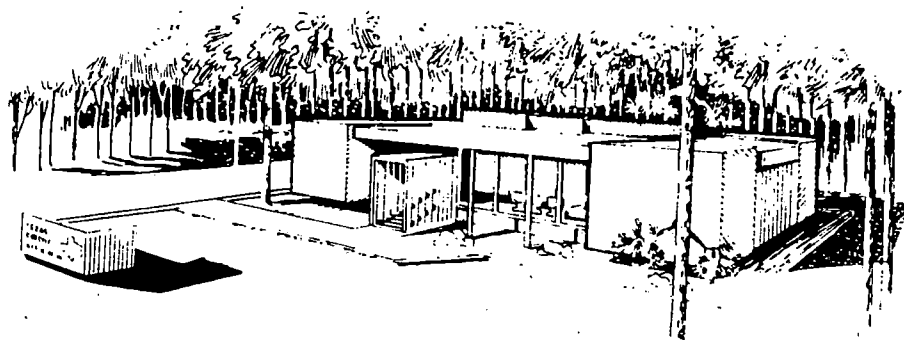

Dear Mr. Sununu:

The Texas Forestry Association is a private, non-profit trade association representing over 3,000 members who grow and manage our Texas forest resource. Our members are concerned about the proposed Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Wetlands.

There are 11 million acres of commercial forestlands in East Texas. Approximately 93 percent of which is owned by private landowners and the forest industry. If the provisions in the manual are adopted, several thousands of acres in East Texas will be improperly classified as wetlands. This would not only restrict their use, but impact local economies that are dependent on our East Texas forest resource.

The TFA offers the following changes to the manual:

- 1) The hydrology criterion for delineating a wetland retains the concept of water table at some depth below the surface. Inundation or water at the surface would make the hydrology criterion a much more meaningful and positive indicator of true wetlands in the field and would be consistent with the recent Regulatory Guidance issued by the Corps on "prior converted wetlands."
- 2) The growing season for Thermic Soils is identified as February through October. A more precise definition of the "growing season" would specify plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in Spring and the average date of the first frost in Autumn.

We appreciate your consideration of our request.

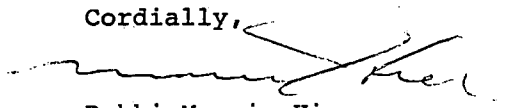

Christ's Peace!

Thank you for your letter of January 9th.

I have some high priority information that I thought I should get to you as quickly as possible.

Jalal Talabani phoned through from Damascus to my main Kurdish contact in this country, Dr. Asfandiar Shukri out in Detroit, to say that he and Mahsoud Barzani, between them, have 20,000 Kurdish armed fighters massed on the Iranian-Iraqi border, and another 10,000 infiltrated into the cities of Kurdish Iraq, both these forces representing jointly the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan and the Kurdish Democratic Party (if I have the name of Barzani's group right). Jalal had asked Dr. Shukri to pass that information on to me so that I could get it to the Administration.

They are not, I am told, thinking of military adventures, and realise clearly enough the danger any such thing would entail for the Kurds -- basically, that they would lose if they pull any stunts. But at the same time as I was told that, I was also told that they would be prepared to cause disruption in Bagdad. I passed my own opinion back that that would be crazy on their part. Instead, I am told, their plan is simply to be in place in case of a breakdown of government in Iraq, intending then to ask the cooperation of Iraqi military units in place to maintain order.

Naturally, they are very much engaged by this whole situation, and hoping that a settlement of this conflict will include the good of the Kurds. It is for that reason that they want to communicate all this to the Administration and be ready to play a constructive role during the crisis.

They are very frightened of the Turks, and fear that the purpose of the Turkish military buildup on the Iraqi-Turkish border is to suppress the Kurds. They also fear that the Turks would have the ambition of annexing Iraqi Kurdistan, the old Wilayet Mosul, in the event of an Iraqi collapse.

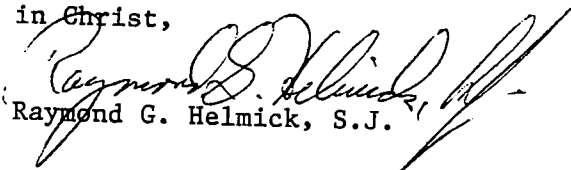
Jalal Talabani's presence in Damascus, and Mahsoud Barzani's also, is explained by the establishment there of an Iraqi government-in-exile, in which there are four Kurdish members -- not Talabani and Barzani themselves but representatives of both -- among a total membership of twenty six. (That part I had heard a couple of weeks ago, and assume you would know it too.) In my own opinion, Damascus is a dangerous place for such an enterprise to be set up, since everything is so controlled by Syrian government.

One other detail I was given was reference to an article that appeared in the Istanbul Gunaydin (Times), -- I wasn't given a date -- by Sadik Kaplan and Seyfettin Ozgezer, saying that the Kurdish fighters had received a consignment of 40,000 gas masks. Talal had confirmed that to Dr. Shukri.

Should you or anyone in the Administration want to communicate anything back to Jalal Talabani, you may not want to go through me. Dr. Asfandiar Shukri, who is in quite regular contact with him, runs the Northwest General Hospital, 8741 W. Chicago Blvd., Detroit MI 48204. His number there is (313) 834-9111, and his home number (313) 855-1165. He is the physician who ran the Kurdish Red Crescent during the years of Mustafa Barzani's rebellion in the 1970s, and subsequently got the elder Barzani out of Iraq to the United States for medical treatment at the end of his life.

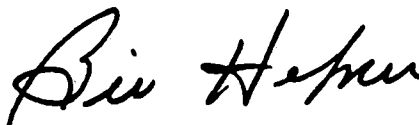

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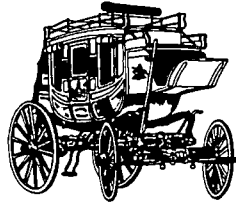

A photocopy of Governor Ned McWherter's card and a photocopy of my proposed oil painting, 72" x 96", is provided for your interest.

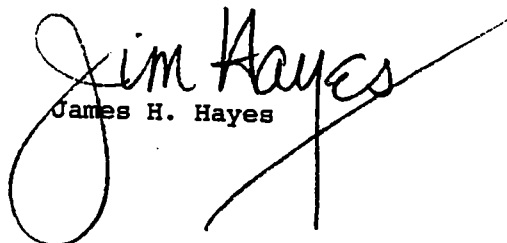

Dear John:

I know you have a thousand things on your agenda, but please let me share my concern about the proposed Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Wetlands. Several forestry groups in North Carolina have advised me that many forested areas will be delineated as "wetlands" under the recent draft revisions of the Manual.

In North Carolina, there are nearly 9 million acres of forest land in the coastal plain. Under the current provisions in the Manual, several million acres will be improperly classified as wetlands and their use would be restricted. In some counties, as much as 90 percent of the remaining undeveloped land would be improperly classified as wetlands.

The following 2 changes would greatly assist North Carolina in identifying true wetlands:

1. The current criteria for water (hydrology) must be changed from a depth of water table requirement to one requiring surface inundation for 14 consecutive days during the growing season. This would be a more meaningful and positive indicator of wetlands, as well as making the Manual consistent with Regulatory Guidance on farmlands issued by the Corps of Engineers on "prior converted wetlands."
2. The definition of "growing season" should be changed from being based on soil temperature to one based on the period between the average date of the last frost in Spring and the average date of the first frost in Autumn. This would accurately reflect the true plant growing season.

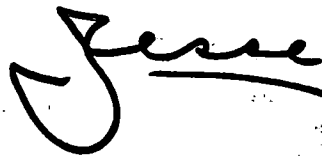

Dear Mr. Sununu,

I am a staunch Republican and supporter of President Bush. I still have a "Bush" bumper sticker on my car from the election campaign. My credentials include being a Republican Precinct Chairman, poll worker, and currently an election judge. I am also a former councilman of the City of Rockville, Maryland.

It is extremely disturbing to me to see the President being given incorrect information and being deceived by members of his Cabinet and their staff personnel regarding the progress in the fight against drunk driving. I know a letter from me sent directly to the President has no chance of being brought to his attention. I THEREFORE PLEAD WITH YOU TO INTERCEDE IN THE MATTER WITH HIM. Lives are at stake; more casualties will occur in the next month or two from drunk driving than there will be in a war in the Middle East. The President needs to be informed of the truth. The deaths and injuries haven't been reduced one iota in the 9 years I have worked against drunken driving.

At a briefing on December 11, 1989, the President, declared drunk driving to be a "National Crisis". He made that declaration after many of us who were working in the field of anti drunk driving persisted in efforts to get him to do so. I was among the leaders in the effort, and was one of two individuals who made up the guest list for the briefing. We were instructed, by Doug Wead, to include on the list all organizations interested in the issue. We did as we were told, and included some organizations and individuals which we would have preferred not to. At that briefing the President instructed Secretary of Transportation, Samuel Skinner, and the Secretary of Health and Human Services, Dr. Louis Sullivan to take steps to curb drunk driving problems. Neither has done one constructive thing, though both have talked a good fight. The 180 of us who were at this meeting left it being sure that Dr. Sullivan was really going to follow the President's instructions, but we were sorely disappointed. Almost immediately, he took out after smoking, and dropped the alcohol health issue like

a hot potato. Many more deaths and injuries from drunk driving can be traced directly to this inaction.

On December 11, 1990, (the 1st anniversary of the original declaration) the President reiterated his belief that drunk driving is a national crisis. However, from his remarks it is obvious that Secretary Skinner, and a Jerry Curry are receiving credit for something they have not done, that is, something to abate drunk driving. They, in truth, have done nothing. The decision of the Supreme Court regarding sobriety checkpoints was not accomplished by the Department of Transportation, but rather the effort was spearheaded by the Michigan Interfaith Council on Alcohol Problems (MICAP) led by the Reverend Allen Rice, not Sam Skinner & company. Of course, the President left the HHS Secretary out of his remarks completely at the 2nd meeting. He had to do so because Secretary Sullivan has done nothing.

Mickey Sadoff of MADD, nor any of her predecessors, has done anything to even try to stop drinking and driving, and certainly the Advertising Council, has done nothing to slow down its alcohol advertising voluntarily and they obviously will not without some courageous legislation. Red ribbons and designated drivers are not designed in any way to relieve the scourge of drunk driving. The President needs to know this. Ms. Sadoff is probably not aware of this herself, but Candy Lightner, and Norma Jean Phillips, past Presidents of MADD, are fully aware of it. Although I personally have lost a son, and a nephew (in separate incidents six years apart) to drunken drivers, there will be no red ribbon on my car.

We do not know who was on the guest list for the second meeting, but we do know that many of us who were at the first meeting were not extended the same courtesy of an invitation that was afforded to those who attended the second meeting. We know why we weren't invited; because we are the real fighters against drunk driving. I think it would be wise of you to find out who permitted such a discourtesy in the name of President Bush. I am sure that if he knew what had occurred that he would not condone it.

Please inform the President of this letter. We are aware that you have a eight children. You have no idea what it is like to lose a child unnecessarily to a drunk driver. The only way you can really know is to have it happen to you. We don't want you to learn because that would mean you would lose one of your precious kids. We are fighting as hard as we can to see to it that it doesn't happen to anyone else.

I am enclosing a number of items, in order to make it easier for to you to understand my concerns.

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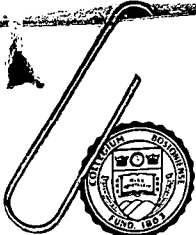

In writing to you yesterday to ask your help with my March visit to Israel I said I would be sending you the two letters in one day, but when I read over what I then wrote on the Gulf I decided to use it as a draft only.

I take it for granted that, in all his actions in this matter, the President is doing his best to prevent a war, and that that objective has an importance for him comparable to his quite proper determination to see justice done by the full withdrawal of Iraq from its invasion of Kuwait. The means he is using are less intelligible to me than they are to you of the inner circle. I had more confidence in the pre-November strategy, that combined defense against further aggression with sanctions to bring about compliance with the resolutions of the Security Council, than I do with a strategy of offensive threats and a deadline, but my uneasiness is about means rather than about objective. I'll put in a few headings here to make it easier to pick out points in this letter.

WHAT SADDAM HUSSEIN WILL SEE AS HIS FUTURE.

The President has taken his stance on a very convincing moral principle, that there must be no reward for aggression, and I fully respect that. It is the very definition of the Just Cause criterion for a just war, in the classical theory, by which defense against aggression, and in fact only that, can be the just cause for war. It remains true, though, that everything that was a matter of legitimate dispute, requiring negotiation or adjudication, before the Iraqi invasion still remains in need of negotiation or adjudication after a withdrawal. They are not forfeit for Iraq's bad behavior. I am glad to see that President Bush has said this explicitly, but I don't see that this message has gotten through to Saddam Hussein with clarity, largely because we have so many people saying that we must somehow "take out," or get rid of Saddam Hussein, that we must destroy Iraq's or his power to do anything in the future, that we must remove Iraq as a serious factor in the Middle Eastern balance, or other such threatening propositions, and these must sound as loud to Saddam Hussein as the President's recognition that what needed to be negotiated or adjudicated before still needs that afterwards.

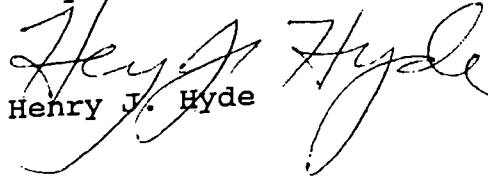

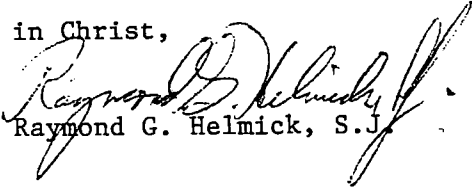
This will be one of two letters I send to you this same day, as I want to write you something about the major crisis of the Gulf. With this letter, though, I would like to bring to your notice the answer I received to my letter of October 13th to Prime Minister Shamir, which you saw at the time.

It is a surprisingly encouraging reply, even if from someone else, Mr. Weiner, writing for the Prime Minister. I will surely make the trip, in the first week of March (my reply to Mr. Weiner also enclosed). I've asked Rabbi Roland Gittelsohn, a great figure of the Boston Jewish community who first asked me to write to Shamir, to come with me. And I want to be sure that I do indeed meet Mr. Shamir himself, to discuss the matters on which I wrote to him, and not simply Mr. Weiner as a substitute for him.

Hence my letter to you. I hope you might, without having to be heavy about it, ensure that there is a meeting with Mr. Shamir when I make this trip in March; and might see, also, that I have the right briefing from people in Washington, whether at State or NSC or both. I'll be speaking for myself, not for the U.S. government, as I've done in many other circumstances, but would like to be sure I don't stick my foot in it or say something silly.

Dear Mr Sununu,

I am writing your offices on a matter involving the FEDERAL EXPRESS CORPORATION and mail destined for OPERATION DESERT SHIELD. KTUU TV NEWS CHANNEL 2 in Anchorage, Alaska reported that FEDERAL EXPRESS was not getting the mail shipped to OPERATION DESERT SHIELD, and in fact the mail had sat on a frozen tarmac runway in Alaska for days. Sir, I call for an immediate investigation into the process by which our mail gets to DESERT SHIELD, and to demand an apology from the FEDERAL EXPRESS CORPORATION on this inexcusable and insensitive treatment of the mail destined for OPERATION DESERT SHIELD. Additionally, I am personally going to organize a national boycott involving Federal Express, and suggest that until an investigation is complete, and assurances are given that will prevent this type of mismanagement from occurring in the future involving mail going to DESERT SHIELD that a "FREEZE" on their contracts be considered.

I wonder if KTUU NEWS had not reported this incident, how long the mail in question would have sat on the frozen tarmac in Alaska. I also request that your good offices contact the POSTMASTER GENERAL and ask him to conduct an investigation of this incident, and to determine if any other FEDERAL EXPRESS Facilities have denied mail destined for our Troops overseas transit.

As you know, I am Director of the Largest Volunteer mail campaign to our troops overseas. I have been hard at work organizing support for the Troops and their families. I have Volunteers in hundreds and hundreds of Schools & Churches, in civic groups all across the USA. I enclose my current address lists to indicate the scope of my Project, and my concern that the thousands of volunteers participating in OPERATION: EAGLE is not denied access to the men & women it is intended for. It is ironic that KTUU News broke this story on December 7th, a "day of infamy"... in my opinion, this is indeed a infamous treatment of the loved ones of our Troops, and the Americans who have joined in this Volunteer effort, and the many wonderful others across America. FEDERAL EXPRESS owes the people of the United States, the Troops of OPERATION DESERT SHIELD, and their wives, children, and families an apology. I hope that your good office can understand the concern and seriousness of this incident. I hope to hear from you immediately regarding this letter. Thank You,
