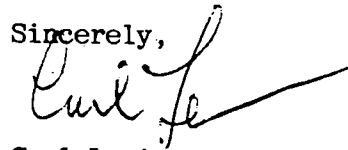

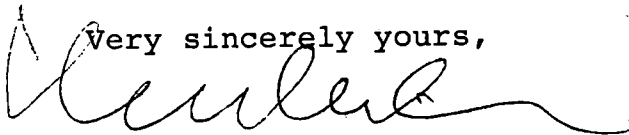
It will be reassuring to the President that, as enclosed notice shows, Kuwait's Treasury is intact to the tune of 120 billion Dollars.

We have enjoyed tremendous success in the past three months manufacturing this bag for college bookstores in 47 states and Canada.

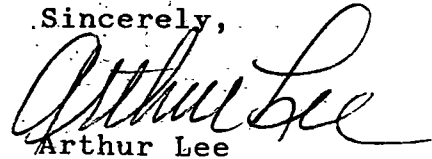
To date, we have produced and sold over 300,000 bags including your Alma Mater M.I.T. along with President Bush's Yale and Andover Academy.

Dear John:

I would like to take this opportunity to express my serious concerns with the **Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands** which is to be published in its revised form in the very near future. If appropriate revisions are not made to the manual, my State of Mississippi will be adversely affected and unduly burdened with these unsound regulations.

It is my belief that in order to achieve the goal of "no overall net loss of wetlands", the manual must be published with ample opportunity for public review and comment. I am aware there has been a set of public hearings held on technical changes to the manual; however, it has been brought to my attention that little, if any, of the recommendations by the public are reflected in the final form of the manual.

The draft revisions continue to delineate as wetlands many areas which are only temporarily wet and exhibit few, if any, functions of true wetlands. In this regard, I recommend the following: 1) Inundation or water at the surface, rather than at some point below the surface, would make the hydrology criterion a more accurate indicator of true wetlands and would be consistent with the Corps "prior converted wetlands" regulatory guidance. 2) A more distinct definition of the "growing season" would specify plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in spring and the average date of the first frost in autumn.

The above suggestions are just two of many which could be made to provide greater accuracy in defining a true wetland. The manual should be subject to public review under the Administrative Procedures Act and, in its final form, reflect true public comment to adequately address the wetlands issue.

I appreciate your personal attention to this matter which is among the most critical issues facing the State of Mississippi today. With best regards, I remain

Dear Governor:

My Congressional District is located in North Carolina's coastal plain. Approximately half of North Carolina's entire inventory of forest land is located in the coastal plain, where as much as 90 percent of many counties will be classified as wetlands under definitions currently being considered. The Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Wetlands currently being finalized will be devastating to the economy of my district, eastern North Carolina, and many areas of our country.

I hope that you will consider two minor changes in the manual which will significantly help in identifying true wetlands:

1. With regard to hydrology, it would be very helpful if the language could be changed to require surface inundation for 14 consecutive days during the growing season. This is certainly a more meaningful and positive indicator of wetlands and is more consistent with the recent regulatory guidance issued by the Corps of Engineers for farm lands which were prior converted wetlands.

2. Please consider changing the definition of "growing season" from one based on soil temperature to one based on the period between the average date of the last frost in spring and the average date of the first frost in autumn. This more accurately reflects the true plant growing seasons. In much of the South, the average temperatures would be high enough under the definition being considered to indicate a year long growing season. However, having grown up on a farm in eastern North Carolina, I know that that is not the case. Needless to say, you cannot plant crops until frost ends and you had better have your growing crops harvested before the first frost if you do not want to lose them.

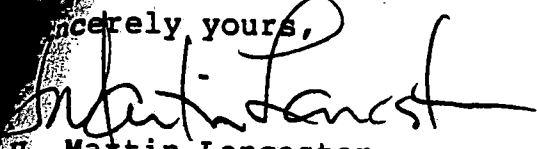

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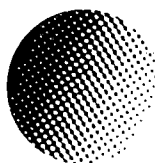

Thank you for your kind note of January 16.

I have enclosed the letter received by our counsel from the NRC rejecting our request for an emergency order to licensees to implement contingency plans for protection against truck bombs. Also enclosed is the Nucleonics Week story on the matter.

This decision is disappointing and remarkable in the face of the increased threat of domestic terrorism to which other major elements of the U.S. Government are responding with increased protective measures.

The NRC staff decision not to take action now is based on the assumption that any threat to nuclear facilities will be detected---and in enough time to permit utilities to put effective protective measures in place. I believe this approach is mistaken because it assumes infallible intelligence, no human error, and effective response plans.

Since nuclear reactors are vulnerable to truck-bomb attack, with potentially catastrophic consequences, prudence dictates precautionary action in the event U.S. intelligence does not pick up or incorrectly evaluates a threat. Again, let me emphasize, as I did in my letter of January 11, the Sandia Laboratories finding that "...unacceptable damage to vital reactor systems could occur from a relatively small charge at close distances and also from larger but still reasonable size charges at large setback distances (greater than the protected area for most plants)." The "unacceptable damage" maximally means the meltdown of a nuclear reactor core and the release of massive amounts of radioactivity comparable to what would occur in a severe accident.

By not ordering special precautions against truck bombs, at least at plants near population centers, the NRC may be putting millions of people at risk. Plants like Indian Point and Calvert Cliffs should be given special attention because of their proximity to New York and Washington.

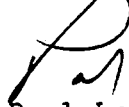
At the very least, the NRC now should be evaluating the utilities' contingency plans to be sure they would work. The NRC never has reviewed these plans or required drills; instead, the plans remain in desk drawers at plant sites.

Beyond the staff determination that no immediate action is needed to require protection against truck bombs, the Commission will give separate consideration to our petition to upgrade the design basis threat for armed attack or sabotage of reactors. The petition asks that the Commission promulgate our proposed changes on an immediately effective basis.

I hope very much, in view of the increased risk of domestic terrorism, that you will give these matters your personal and expert attention.

Dear John:

While under consideration for the party chairmanship, I was hesitant to respond on paper to your request for our opinions on the direction of the Bush Administration in 1991. Now that the selection has been made--and I think it is an excellent one--I thank you for granting me this opportunity to express some views and make observations concerning your 1991 agenda.

No agenda can be discussed outside the context of the extraordinary demands foreign policy is placing on the President's time and energy. He handles it so well, there is a sense it isn't all consuming, but it has to be. This is such a critical time, it seems inappropriate to address other issues, but regrettably other challenges cannot be sidelined.

That brings me to my first suggestion.

Governor, I respectfully urge you to reassess your role and the style of leadership you exude. The President's domestic flank demands more attention than he's got to give. Only you can fill that void. In my opinion you need to assume more the role of the surrogate, rather than the subordinate. The "good cop-bad cop" tactics only work when you've got both a good cop and a bad cop actively participating in the process. I do not mean to detract whatsoever from the manner in which you have conducted the affairs of the Administration in the first two years. I simply believe that the Persian Gulf crisis demands a shift in the approach you take, particularly on the Hill. You are without question the President's man, and there is no one else able to fill this role.

Secondly, I firmly believe the members of the Cabinet must play more active roles in the domestic arena, again, in an effort to strongly support and reinforce all of the President's decisions and move his programs forward both in Washington and throughout the country.

In my opinion the President needs a good, solid domestic agenda, but he doesn't necessarily need a new vision or a stunning performance of rhetorical gymnastics. He's doing just fine with the vision he has enunciated so well over the last two years.

In response to the Democrats' battlecry for fairness, the President's agenda must constantly reinforce the theme that fairness is simply not enough. There must be opportunity to excel.

I read the New Paradigm speech. In my judgement, Dick Darman was right about the handle but wrong about the substance. It has the ingredients for a national agenda. The speech rings true to the philosophical approach of the Reagan Administration and serves as the necessary political and philosophical linkage between the two administrations. It should most definitely be pursued. Just don't call it a new paradigm. That's too abstract and too intellectually arrogant.

The concerns of recession and war will send many Americans back to basics: security in their family life, security in their jobs, heightened religious interest, stronger neighborhood and community ties, and dependence on basic economic, social and political values.

I think most Americans want to know that their President is taking care of business and they want that reflected in the issues the President addresses and the agenda he sets for the nation. This is no time for an 'I have a vision' speech. This is a time for straight talk and stout, solid leadership. Americans coping with the perils of recession and probably war will need the inner-security they can draw upon from their family, their religion, and a President who is confident in himself and in the decisions he makes. At this time, I just don't believe the people want a leader trying to gaze into the next century or the next year. They want a President who is concentrating on today with skill, confidence and hard work. And, that Presidential confidence must always be projected to the people.

Relations with Congress are going to be exceedingly difficult and this is one of the areas where your role becomes more important than ever. You need to demonstrate that you don't dress in a behavioral straightjacket every morning. The President will need a surrogate presence.

Many of the problems with Newt and certain other Republicans, some of whom objected to me as National Chairman, will resolve themselves issue by issue. Newt is the Whip and necessarily you will have to work together.

Bust your 'keester', as Bob Michel would say, to broaden your base among House Republicans. Relationships with Senate Republicans seem better. Expand your base of support. Republican Members in both houses admire you. They want to be your ally and confidant. Let them touch you. Then, lead. It's time to put this primary challenge nonsense to bed, now.

On a separate page, I have provided some very brief observations on other issues which were culled from conversations we in the firm had with Members and staff, Executive Branch personnel, but primarily business associates and clients.

I hope these comments are helpful to you. I appreciate your continued willingness to reach out beyond the confines of the White House for thoughtful comment on the President's agenda. It is a tribute to the President's effectiveness as a leader and to your dedication to the fulfillment of his leadership objectives.

Finally, I greatly admire you and you can always count on me for support.

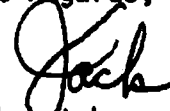

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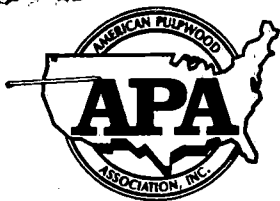

American Pulpwood Association members have serious concerns regarding the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands which we would like to bring to your attention.

A credible and legally defensible Manual for delineating jurisdictional wetlands is essential in order to build public support for the goal of "no overall net loss of wetlands," especially since the original Manual was developed with no opportunity for public review and comment. Until appropriate corrections to the Manual are made, the wetlands issue will be one of confrontation rather than cooperation toward achieving this goal.

The recent draft revisions to the Manual continue to delineate as wetlands many areas that are only temporarily wet and exhibit few, if any, functions of true wetlands defined in Environmental Protection Agency and Corps of Engineers regulations as "swamps, bogs, marshes, and similar areas." Specifically, we recommend the following corrections to the Manual:

- 1) The hydrology criterion for delineating a wetland retains the concept of water table at some depth below the surface. **Inundation or water at the surface** would make the hydrology criterion a much more meaningful and positive indicator of true wetlands in the field and would be consistent with the recent Regulatory Guidance issued by the Corps on "prior converted wetlands."
- 2) The growing season for Thermic Soils is identified as February through October. A more precise definition of the "growing season" would specify plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in spring and the average date of the first frost in autumn.

We urge you to consider our comments to assure that revisions to the Federal Manual for Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands provide greater consistency and accuracy in delineating a true wetland.

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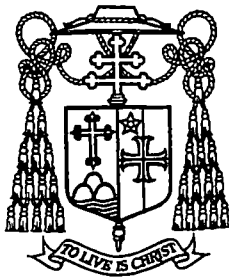

This letter follows up on my note to you of December 28, in which, in the context of Iraq, I raised the question of the vulnerability of U.S. nuclear powerplants to truck bombs and other forms of sabotage.

I believe it is of the utmost importance, given your special responsibility for the Nation's security and your special knowledge of nuclear science, that you give close attention to the enclosed request to the NRC for immediate action to require utilities to put into effect contingency plans for protection against truck-bomb attack.

The request takes the form of a petition for rulemaking filed today by the Nuclear Control Institute and the Committee to Bridge the Gap. The petition also seeks, for the longer term, an upgrade of the design basis threat for sabotage of nuclear reactors and the promulgation of related regulatory measures.

I must tell you frankly that given the present level of protection at most nuclear powerplants in the U.S., a truck- or boat-bomb attack or other armed assault would have a high likelihood of success with potentially catastrophic consequences.

Our petition quotes an unclassified summary of a report on truck bombs prepared by Sandia National Laboratories for the NRC in 1984 which found that "...unacceptable damage to vital reactor systems could occur from a relatively small charge at close distances and also from larger but still reasonable size charges at large setback distances (greater than the protected area for most plants)." The "unacceptable damage" maximally means the meltdown of a nuclear reactor core and the release of massive amounts of radioactivity comparable to what would occur in a severe accident. The risk of such a bomb-induced calamity will be unacceptably high should a war in the Middle East prompt terrorist violence in the United States.

contingency plans that the Commission reluctantly utilities to prepare in 1989 under strong pressure from Capitol Hill are not likely to be adequate to defeat a truck bomb attack in most cases. There is now no requirement to defend against boat bombs. The case has been made that such attacks are unlikely because terrorists are more likely to attack "softer" targets than nuclear reactors. Imagine how this rationale would be received by the American people following a successful vehicle-bomb attack at Calvert Cliffs or Indian Point necessitating the evacuation of Washington or New York City, for example?

It is unlikely that the Commission will take the immediate action, as well as the longer-term measures, we seek without strong prompting from the White House and close coordination with the Executive Branch. I hope very much that you will actively support the protective measures sought by our petition. In addition, as long as war with Iraq remains imminent, I urge you personally to see to it that nuclear reactors (research as well as power) are among the installations singled out by the U.S. Government for special military protection.

I anticipate that there will be coverage of our petition in a leading nuclear trade publication, but we are not seeking general press coverage at this time because of the extremely sensitive nature of the subject and in the hope the Commission will act without the need for wider publicity. Other than the copy I am sending to Senator Simpson, I will treat this letter to you as confidential.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

Here I am swimming against the current, in a pool of bureaucracy, with plenty of lifeguards around but not one of them attempting to rescue me. . .so. . .I come to YOU -- PLEASE do not let me drown in the sea of indecisiveness. On August 28, 1990, I forwarded a taped message to our President together with some documentation that I had addressed in the tape concerning my request for a Presidential Appointment to organize and raise funds for Operation-Desert Shield. In November, I received a request from Mr. Untermeyer's office asking me to fill out the form that he had sent me, a copy of which I have enclosed, which specifically stated what department I wanted to be associated with, also asking for my resume. I subsequently forwarded my resume, several exhibits and documentation confirming my qualifications for what I was looking for, together with a long letter of explanation. Later on I received a letter from his office again stating that the position that I was looking for had many, many applicants. My request was being processed and when a position became available, that he would contact me. After receiving that letter I decided that I was getting nowhere. I picked up the phone and called his office and spoke to a Betty Thompson who in turn gave me a phone number to contact the computer logging and I spoke with Joan Tussey a week later and then followed it up by speaking with Mrs. Bullock in Mr. Untermeyer's office. At the time that I spoke with Mrs. Bullock I learned that the position that I was looking for had been relegated to the Department of Energy. Can you believe the Department of Energy? I didn't want to raise funds for the Department of Energy so after she explained the process to me, I told her that this was not right. She acknowledged the fact that somebody on her staff had catalogued me in the wrong department. She said she would remove my application that day and put it in the proper logging, that of the Department of Defense. That was where I wanted to be, since I wanted to raise funds for Operation-Desert Shield. At that time she gave me the name of Clark Wurzberger at the Pentagon, she also gave me his telephone number and felt that I could get some help from speaking with him.

I called Mr. Wurzberger, who by the way, was extremely nice and apologetic for the error that had been made and said he had great admiration for what I was trying to do and suggested that I call José Martinez at the White House. . .He told me that José was the individual to whom he spoke so he thought I would accomplish something faster if I contacted José.

Well, I called José and spoke with him on Monday, December 31. He listened to me, but somewhere in our conversation he told me that the President would never do that. By now, you know what some of my frustrations are. As I told José I can't believe that there is nothing in this area at this point in time. His answer was, "No, there isn't." My next remark was, "If there isn't anything then let's create it NOW."

It's almost impossible for me to believe, that to this day, there has been no specific committee set up either by the Department of Defense or the U.S. Treasury Department to raise monies for Operation-Desert Shield. The tremendous and awesome cause of that operation should be TOP PRIORITY, money-wise, the Number 1 cause for raising funds. Well, I'm still in the pool, struggling to stay afloat. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE, I'm dying to get this thing off the ground and get the show on the road. Hence, my reason for coming to you, the one (Pussy Cat) in the White House. I'm still screaming for help and I need your help desperately.

Mr. Sununu, during World War II I was a member of the U.S. Treasury Finance Committee which I service for four years from 1941 to 1945. . .also a member of the Minute Man. . .Civilian Defense, and so forth. My background is organizing, public speaking, fundraising and public relations. There is nothing like experience. . .that cannot be bought.

Billions and billions of dollars are needed for this operation and there can never be too many organizations or too many people working to raise funds to help support the troops in the Persian Gulf and ultimate victory. I know it has to be done --- there can never be any other way. We certainly don't want to talk taxes, do we? WE THE PEOPLE love President Bush, we support him wholeheartedly in all his efforts and we firmly believe that his strength and his convictions are right. We sent him a cablegram upon his return from visiting the troops on Thanksgiving Day.

PLEASE, Mr. Sununu, help me get this show on the road. The more positive picture that we can present to the American people in behalf of the President, the more help we will be able to give him. 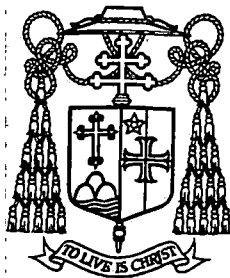

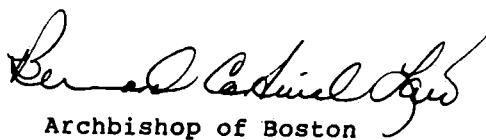

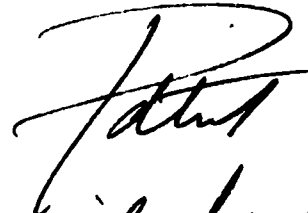

You are invited to participate in a meeting to explore unanticipated problems, options and solutions to the Persian Gulf crisis. The meeting is specifically intended to address issues and solutions that have not yet been openly discussed in government hearings or by the press. New concepts identified by the Persian Gulf Crisis Center include:

- a new set of options that could cause immediate unconditional withdrawal of Iraq from Kuwait without bloodshed.
- two ways Iraq may be able to cause complete withdrawal of foreign forces, and retain full control over Kuwait. Both of the methods may have a high probability of preventing any attack against Iraq.
- several new non-military solutions have been identified that may be very appealing to all parties, prevent proliferation of nuclear, chemical and biological weapons in the Gulf, and provide for long term security in the region.

These and other issues and possible solutions were identified as a result of experimental research that is being conducted by the Persian Gulf Crisis Center. The initial intention of the research was to determine whether it is possible to develop a process that could enable world leaders to rapidly discover unanticipated problems related to their plans regarding the Persian Gulf crisis, explore a much wider spectrum of options, and rapidly develop workable solutions. The research consists of developing and testing several different methodologies of exploring Persian Gulf options. One new methodology that was tested had unexpected results.

Nearly all test subjects who used this process were able to successfully discover unanticipated flaws in existing plans, and to develop new solutions. A description of the process and test results, a list of our Board of Directors, and other information are enclosed. Additional information is available on request.

The Persian Gulf Crisis Center will conduct several meetings with political leaders during January. The new process will be used during these meetings. Your participation would enable you to discover flaws in existing plans and explore an array of new solutions.

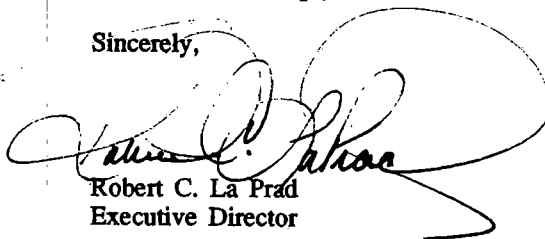

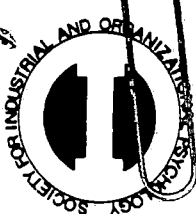

Instead, I will simply urge you to take advantage of the expertise of the Society for Industrial and Organizational Psychology in the discussions that will surround attempts to draft similar legislation for consideration by the current Congress.

There is much sympathy in the scientific community for a piece of legislation that will temper the Ward's Cove decision. Nevertheless, there are certain technical issues that we simply cannot ignore since these issues were resolved with great difficulty over a twenty year period. SIOP would be pleased to help in the development of language that will permit the crafting of a piece of legislation that is acceptable to all parties. Please contact me if there is anything that I or any member of our Society can do to enhance the possibility of a successful effort to pass the Civil Rights Act of 1991.

The Straight Chiropractic Academic Standards Association (SCASA) is again under political attack by another competing accrediting agency, the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE). I am aware that my friend and colleague, Dr. Thomas A. Gelardi, President of Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic, has detailed our concerns to you in his letter of December 19, 1990.

It is publicly known that the competing agency, Council on Chiropractic Education, has spent over \$400,000.00 in the past year setting the stage for its fight against SCASA and was used to undermine and present negative information to the National Advisory Committee (NACAIE) and much of it not pertinent to the Criteria For Recognition for this young accrediting agency, SCASA. SCASA has had the stigma of functioning in the past few years under a probationary status. "SCASA has made significant progress", per Ms. Joan Givens, staff analyst for the AAEB. From the evidence, it appears that SCASA needs more time to increase its position, hopefully not under a probationary status. A four year period of recognizable status is desired to prevent a "catch 22" situation.

On October 30, 1990, I, along with other Evangelical leaders, asked President Bush to dismiss National Endowment for the Arts Chairman John Frohnmayer because of his lack of sensitivity to the concerns of millions of Evangelicals who have been outraged by certain NEA grants. Events since the meeting have further convinced me that Mr. Frohnmayer's dismissal is in the President's interest, as well as ours.

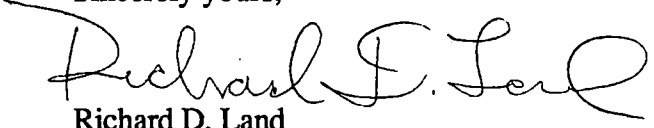
It is clear from the enclosed articles that Mr. Frohnmayer has little regard for our concerns and that the NEA's hostility toward Evangelical Christians has not diminished. The fact that the general counsel for the NEA would single-out leaders in the Evangelical community as "enemies" is deplorable. Additionally, Ms. Davis' use of her position to help the defense in the Cincinnati Mapplethorpe trial is outrageous.

Furthermore, it's clear that Mr. Frohnmayer has no regard for the law. He states, "There will not be a case where I will impose my own judgement [on a grant based on decency concerns]. I am not going to be the decency czar here." Apparently, Mr. Frohnmayer believes even the minimalist "decency" approach of Congress in dealing with the abuses of the NEA is unreasonable. Therefore, he has no intention of upholding the law.

Governor Sununu, the National Endowment for the Arts is out of control. I believe that we have been more than patient and reasonable in this NEA debate. However, our patience is at its end. As I continue to inform Southern Baptists of the abuses of the NEA and its chairman, it will only further alienate a constituency which should be considered a natural ally of the President.

Mr. Frohnmayer must resign in order to save the President further problems. Furthermore, I would like the President to consider the request of the Evangelical leaders at the October 30, 1990 meeting and appoint individuals to the National Council on the Arts who are sympathetic to our concerns.

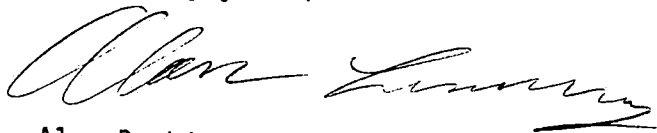

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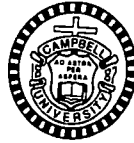

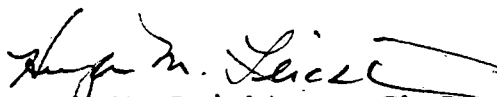
