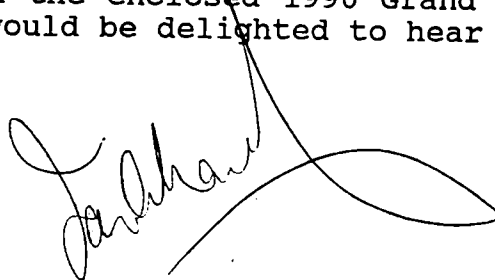

Dear John:

You might wonder why, as an American of Lebanese descent, I am so interested in the Baltic States. Well, They are going through what Lebanon has gone through...the constant overrunning of their country by a bunch of thugs. I have become quite involved in the Dallas-Riga, Latvia Partnership. We are in daily touch with officials in Riga. I have finally received the details of the alleged attempt on the life of Boris Yeltsin on Monday afternoon January 14th. One of the members of his staff received a tip that an attempt would be made on Yeltsin as he traveled from Tallinn, Estonia to Leningrad. He changed travel plans and switched automobiles twice to elude such happening.

During my tenure as a combat infantryman in WW II (Battle of the Bulge and the crossing at Remagen were just two in which I was deeply involved) I had occasion to meet quite a few "slave laborers" as we liberated them. MOST of them did not want to go back to the USSR because they said that they were treated better under the Germans than they were in their own country. I made the mistake of calling one individual a "Russian"..and nearly got beat up. He said emphatically, I'm not Russian, I am Ukraine !" If Hitler had gone into the Soviet Union as a "liberator" rather than a conqueror, the outcome of the war might have been very different.

Anyway, with the tremendous amount of unrest in the U.S.S.R. today, and if all else fails, the United States might consider recognizing ALL SOVIET REPUBLICS AS INDEPENDENT STATES. As wild as this might seem it might prove to be what we need to do.

A tremendous amount has already been done towards the free enterprise system for the Baltic states. American Airlines, J.C. Penney Company, Tandy Corporation, Lincoln Properties, and others too numerous to mention have already expressed more than just a casual interest in doing business there. It is, however, very difficult to plan anything with the apparent political atmosphere of not knowing who is in charge. And the more we delay, the worse it will be for all concerned, including Gorbachev.

The seriousness of consequence to Allied lives by hidden Iraqi armament emboldens me to offer some thoughts on potential means of detecting hidden materiel and personnel, and locating same. Most, if not all, of these schemes have already been considered by experts in the various fields, yet this submission may serve to reinforce consideration of these (and other) means of pinpointing the "trap-door-spiders" waiting to pounce on our forces.

1. Magnetic Anomaly Detection. Many years ago this was being considered for detection of submarines. Old or current hardware may exist.
2. Just as ships can be degaussed by de-magnetizing loops, could guns or tanks be rendered more magnetic by overflying magnetizing coils?
3. Any real-time detection and locating scheme could be immediately transmitted to a computer handling artillery grids
4. Large ferromagnetic masses might increase the coupling of a pair of overflying coils. --- Alternately, conventional metal detectors or mine detectors might be useful.
5. Other ASW possibilities: (a) sonobouys? Attenuation of sand would be a factor. Modification of batteries and microphone might be required. (b) long range passive listening.
6. Oil experts, siesmologists or other earth scientists might be able to decipher siesmic waves transmitted, refracted, or reflected from deliberately placed explosive charges as modified by underground cavities.
7. Astronomers (try J.P.L.) might contribute input involving radiation, reflectivity, transmissibility or other characteristics of camouflage topping, dummy

I'm writing you to request that you refer this request to the appropriate in-house staff assistant to process our request for a Law Enforcement Television Network interview with President Bush during National Law Enforcement Week, May 12 through May 18. LETN has over 2,300 federal, state, county and local law enforcement agencies as subscribers and is growing at the rate of 100 agencies per month. Some Washington LETN subscribers are the Attorney General's Main Justice Building, FBI Hoover Building, and ONDCP Building. A list of current federal subscribers is attached for your information. Rick Rineer, ONDCP Telecommunications Manager and I have discussed channeling LETN programming from his building to the White House via the existing fiber optic system so that you and your staff can monitor United States law enforcement on a daily basis.

I'm also including a short VHS tape which displays LETN programming from the perspective of federal law enforcement agencies to, hopefully, allow your staff an understanding of this state-of-the-art information system. Thank you for your time and for routing the request to the proper staff destination.

As one who has been very active in the Dallas-Riga, Latvia partnership city program I have been in virtual daily touch with government sources in Riga. They, in turn, have been in daily touch with officials in the other two Baltic States. One information resource's husband has been holed up in the Latvian Parliament building for the past ten days. He is "armed" with a mop handle. The black berets there are out of Bryansk (central Russia) and had been fighting in Afghanistan for more than four years.

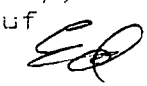
The City Council of Dallas is going to pass a resolution calling on Gorbachev to give Latvia it's freedom as per 1940.

Last week I received a report from VERY RELIABLE sources that an assassination attempt was made on Boris Yeltsin as he was traveling from Tallinn to Leningrad. I have been unable to verify this from an actual eye witness, but you should be able to get correct information from the American consulate in Leningrad or, if there is one, in Tallinn, Estonia.

I don't know whether or not you'd be interested, but if you like I shall send you resumes of the daily telephone conversations we have with the Baltics. It is interesting to note that ALL of the reformers around Gorbachev have been replaced. The people in Latvia feel that the iron curtain is again descending, and that they will still be behind it. They feel that Gorbachev is going to use the violence caused by the black berets as an excuse for taking over their country with military force. All of this to happen while we are busy in the Gulf.

Should you like these reports, they will be very cryptic and to the point. Two weeks ago, for instance, the Russians tried to cross Poland from what was East Germany with a very large column of tanks. Their destination was the Ukraine. The Poles wouldn't let them cross Polish territory. None of this has been in the newspapers...about Yeltsin etc.. But I KNOW my resources. They are accurate.

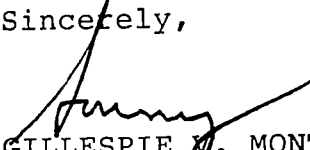

Dear Governor:

While events in the Persian Gulf are understandably foremost in everyone's mind, it seems useful to reflect for a moment on a related issue of national importance -- this nation is addicted to imported oil. Concern over this nation's diminishing level of energy independence prompted our recent introduction of legislation which would authorize the Secretary of the Interior to lease the public lands of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR) for oil and gas exploration and development.

**The purpose of this letter is to seek the continued support of the President in the effort to open ANWR and to ask that he reinforce that support in the upcoming State of the Union address.** The President spoke forcefully at the joint session of Congress last September about the need for pursuing environmentally sound development of Alaska's vast resources, and we would hope that effort would continue. Failure to reinforce his support for ANWR at this time could send the wrong message to undecided members of Congress and the public at large.

We believe opening ANWR to reasonable exploration and development is vitally important to the people of the United States. Our nation now imports nearly 50% of the oil it consumes. This transfusion of foreign oil is dangerously high -- fully one-half of this nation's trade deficit can be attributed to the importation of foreign oil. Our continuing dependence on other countries to meet our energy needs dictates that American consumers and the U.S. economy will remain hostage to volatile energy prices and unstable suppliers.

The current situation in the Persian Gulf also serves as a painful reminder of the dangers of excessive dependence on imported oil. This nation has long recognized the importance of this oil rich region of the world and has been forced to defend foreign oil reserves while we have not even fully explored our own domestic production

capabilities. And now we have the new dimension of U.S. troops in the Persian Gulf. These troops have been put in harms way to combat naked aggression and to protect the economic stability of the West. Each of us must reflect on what actions should be taken to meet our responsibility to the people of the United States to establish energy independence.

Without continued exploration and development of promising domestic areas, the situation will only get worse. **Every major oil field in the United States is declining.** Energy conservation, energy efficiency, and development of alternative energy sources are all important, but are not by themselves sufficient to solve the energy problems we face today or over the next twenty to thirty years.

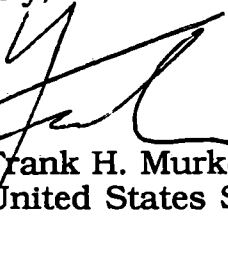
We must have continued domestic oil production. **The Coastal Plain of ANWR is the single most promising onshore area for the discovery of significant oil reserves in the United States.** Experts believe it could be the third largest American oil field ever discovered. But we'll never know unless we look.

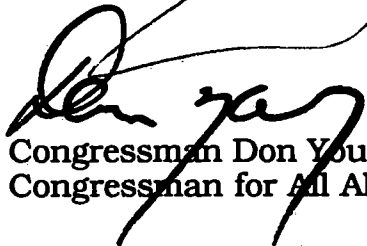

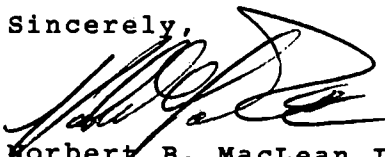

On behalf of the National Association of State Foresters (NASF) I would like to express serious concerns about the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands.

NASF represents the directors of the fifty state forestry agencies who are responsible for the stewardship management and protection of the nation's state and private forest lands --- more than 300 million acres.

As you know, the Manual was jointly issued in January 1989 by the Environmental Protection Agency, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, USDA Soil Conservation Service and USDI Fish and Wildlife Service. Since that time, the Manual has drawn widespread criticism because it was published without prior public notice and opportunity for comment. NASF is extremely concerned with the lack of public participation in a process that will potentially affect millions of acres of privately owned forest land. NASF also concurs with many different organizations that there are multiple technical and administrative flaws in the Manual as well as inconsistencies in policy that need to be fully reviewed and addressed if the Manual is to be considered a credible and defensible national policy.

I assure you that NASF supports the protection of our nation's valuable wetland resources. But we strongly believe it is essential that the rules for determining jurisdiction be established under procedures guaranteeing the broadest possible public participation and attention to the policy implications of the Manual. NASF understands that the Domestic Policy Council will soon consider joint recommendations from the four federal agencies for modifications within the Manual. I strongly urge you to see that the Manual and any proposed modifications be put before the public for full and thorough consideration -- including the opportunity for public comment -- on all aspects of its technical and substantive requirements and underlying policy.

I appreciate your consideration of our comments. NASF looks forward to working with you in the development of a fair and effective national wetlands policy.

As you are a member of the Economic Policy Council, the LP Gas Clean Fuels Coalition would like to share our views relating to key elements of the National Energy Strategy, a task now before the Council.

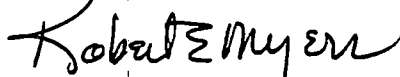
The LP Gas Clean Fuels Coalition is comprised of major oil and gas producers, equipment manufacturers and distributors, transporters and marketers of LP Gas (propane and butane). LP Gas is the most widely used alternative fuel in the world as well as the U.S. with some 350,000 vehicles already in use in this country.

We strongly urge you to consider (1) expanding the CAFE credit limits beyond the current 1.2 cap; (2) expand the alternative fuels that can currently earn CAFE credits - alcohol fuels and natural gas - to include LP Gas and (3) include a mandate for fleet users consistent with the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.

We feel mandates plus incentives are essential ingredients of a national strategy. However, there should be equal treatment of all alternative fuels which is not the case under current law. Incorporation of these elements will bring focus to the NES, accelerate the legislative process where necessary, and reduce some of the legislative and regulatory bias that now exists.

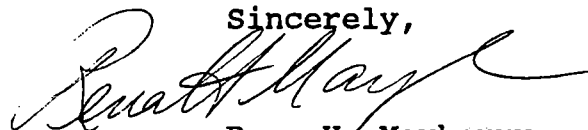

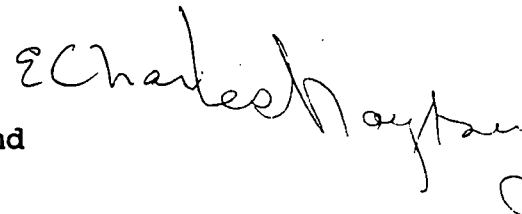

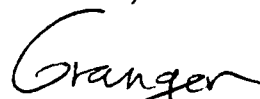
Dear John:

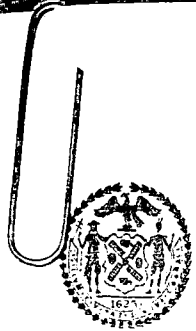

Dear Governor:

I put a call in to the President yesterday to briefly give him my thoughts on the political situation and the development of the 1992 strategy. I realize that there are tremendous demands on the President and the White House at this time, yet I felt somewhat of a personal obligation to express my views to the President.

Since we first became acquainted when I was elected to the House in 1980, I have had tremendous respect for George Bush. I felt strongly at that time that he should be our next President and the successes of the Administration's first two years have strengthened my commitment to his leadership and to his continued achievement.

I had two principal concerns that I conveyed to the President yesterday and, at his suggestion and my ready assent, I will express them to you.

The first is founded in the dinner held last month with Bill Bennett and the Bush political friends. It was clear to me that there was a reluctance on the part of many there to speak candidly about political circumstances or strategy for fear of disturbing or being reprimanded by you. Clearly, some of this will occur no matter what because of your position and the fact that you are a forceful man. And I do not think that you deliberately inhibited discussion. Yet, I felt that certainly within that small group of Bush loyalists there should have been a much greater willingness to express opinions and

put forth ideas.

I believe it is very important that the 1992 campaign, like any campaign at this level, has the benefit of a range of contributions and suggestions. I do not view this as inevitably leading to a diffusion of decision making power or a lax control over campaign strategy and operation. That undoubtedly must and can be avoided. Yet, the campaign can only gain from listening to the counsel of those with good intentions and considered thought.

Clearly, in political campaigns the door for advice cannot be opened too widely or indefinitely. I think the President's strongest supporters recognize and respect the extraordinary loyalty to the President you have shown over the past two years. You could have made things a lot easier on yourself by choosing not to fight as strongly for the President's policies as you have. This same high standard of loyalty to the President ought to be what opens the door for other individuals to give their political advice to the President's top people.

I state the above only in the form of an observation and do not go beyond that. It's a complex question and whether or how a response to it should be made certainly rests in your discretion.

The second item I mentioned to the President was more in the form of a recommendation: the need to begin to strengthen the bonds with House Republicans. Let me quickly qualify that by saying that I am not referring to Newt Gingrich. Do with him what you wish.

There is, however, a group of strong Bush loyalists in the House going back long before the 1988 primaries to which I think the political connections must be revitalized. There will likely be occasions over the next two years when the President could use the support of this group, both in terms of administration policy matters and in political/campaign situations. The bonds should be well-established so the support is there and ready when needed.

Back in December 1986, I started asking Republican Members of the House to sign a letter of commitment to support George Bush for President, and indicating the date of their commitment. In June of 1987 we had close to 70 Members signed on and as a group we publicly announced our endorsement of the Vice President, with him, on the House steps. Within weeks that number grew to 87 while Jack Kemp had only 20 Members in his camp and Bob Dole only 12.

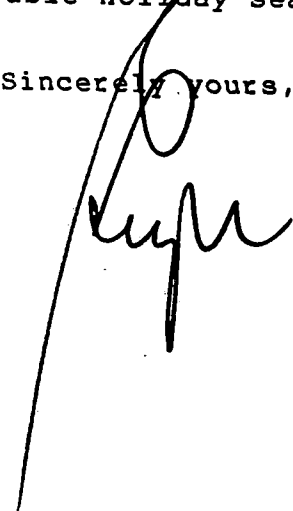
An organized effort should be made to once again solidify the political ties to this group. They were with George Bush from the start in 1988 and I believe the commitment to him is still there. To be of help in the future, however, they clearly must be connected to some degree to the political structure at the White House and the campaign.

I think this group made a valuable contribution to the '88 campaign, particularly in the early stages, and I feel the campaign benefitted with a minimum of headaches from this source. These Members were with George Bush early on because of their belief in him as a leader. Many of them, I believe, can be counted on for '92 as well.

In expressing these thoughts to you, as I did to the President, I, of course, express my willingness to be of assistance in any way I can. I know our objectives are the same.

I hope that this letter gets byond your "for" or "against" war in the Persian Gulf box and merits your consideration. I do strongly endorse the President's action in quickly going to the support of Saudi Arabia, but I am very concerned about the course which has developed since with the terrible possibility of war and its uncertain aftermath. 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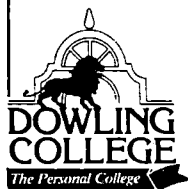

Governor Sununu:

Ref: The Gulf Crisis

I realize the chances of you personally seeing this letter are slim; however, with the hope that somehow the viewpoints presented here come to your timely attention, the following is presented:

1. The Administration, whose policies in the Gulf Crisis I fully endorse, is beginning to lose the battle for essential American public and Congressional support.
2. There are two major obstacles that need to be overcome to help reverse this trend:
  - a. All the NATO nations (and France) must be convinced to contribute ground armed forces in the Gulf in proportion to their current NATO commitment, or in proportion to the oil they receive from the Gulf. Japan must make a significant combat ground force contribution in proportion to the oil it receives from the Gulf. The casualties must be shared!

The American people still see this as a U.S. vs. Iraq war. The war must be truly seen as the United Nations vs. Iraq.

If the Administration continues to fail to convince all the major Western economic powers that they must contribute proportional combat ground forces, public and Congressional support will plunge as American deaths mount, and Germany and Japan continue to prosper at our expense on the "sidelines."

In addition, a timely decision of all the Western powers to contribute proportionate combat forces at this time, when Iraq now perceives a weakening in resolve of the coalition, will help dispel such a perception and lessen the need for war to achieve our objectives.

- b. These same Western economic powers (and especially Japan and Germany) plus the Gulf Oil producing nations must contribute massive financial assistance to the U.S. military effort in proportion to the oil they receive or ship from the Gulf.

What has been contributed so far is simply inadequate, and is causing considerable anger in the American people as taxes, inflation, unemployment, and the deficit mounts.

Assuming most of these nations continue to not voluntarily agree to increase financial support, then our allied Gulf oil producers must be convinced to impose a surtax on oil shipments to the Western nations that will then be paid to the U.S. to finance at least 80% of the U.S. military effort in the Gulf.

This surtax should be supplemented by an "excess profits" tax the Gulf oil producing nations impose on themselves to further pay for the protection the U.S. is providing.

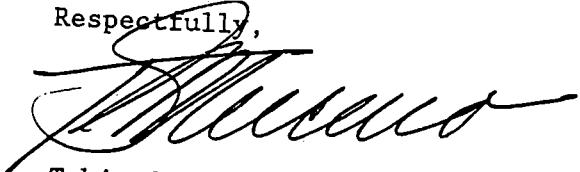
It is highly doubtful that the American taxpayer will support a "special tax" to finance a military effort that the major Western economic powers and the Gulf oil producing nations should finance.

Granted, we are the only true "Superpower," but that doesn't mean America should continue to be a "patsy" contributing disproportionately the blood of our youth and our remaining financial strength for the benefit of Japan, Germany and the rest of our major economic competitors.

Both the casualties and the finances must be shared fairly. The "New World Order" can not be based on America being disproportionately both the Policemen and the Banker for all the trouble spots. The American people simply will not accept this.

You must convince the President of this, and the urgent need for him to publicly take the necessary actions to achieve these steps, or lose the support of the American people ... and perhaps the 1992 election.
