Because of your knowledge and interest in international and domestic tax policy, I am writing to ask you to review and actively support legislation I plan to introduce shortly, the Uniform Business Tax Act of 1991 (UBT). Enclosed for your perusal is a copy of the latest draft bill along with a general summary.

I'm sure you would agree America could do much better than we have in dealing with the deficit and our dismal savings rate. In addition, we have failed to address tax simplification, international competition, low capital formation, transfer pricing abuses by foreign corporations or any major steps forward toward a competitive 21st Century tax policy.

Congress and the Administration should begin to actively investigate and consider the imposition of a new border-adjustable broader-based corporate tax in the United States as a replacement for our current corporate income tax. The UBT or "Schulze Solution" is such a tax that would accomplish the following goals:

- * raise significant revenue from imports (legally under the GATT) which currently are not taxed;
- * exempt interest and dividends from the tax base thus achieving a major step toward full tax integration;
- * implement a far simpler and easy to administer corporate tax system without the need for new IRS personnel;
- * reduce the cost of capital by allowing the full expensing of equipment and machinery;
- * spur the export of American made goods overseas by exempting all exports from U.S. tax liability;

Dear Governor Sununu:

I have recently received numerous inquiries from constituents and small businesses in the Commonwealth of Virginia concerning the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands, particularly possible revisions to the Manual.

I firmly believe that the preservation of wetlands and the ecosystems they sustain is an important goal, and I applaud President Bush's commitment towards this end. However, a framework for "no net loss" protection must function without placing unreasonable burdens on business development and our farmers. As a Member of the House Committee on Small Business, I have received information and testimony that reflects the following concerns:

* There appears to be an interest in uniform guidelines that do not discriminate based upon industry type. For example, lumber companies in Virginia must comply with guidelines that are more stringent than those set forth for farmland.

* The delineation of a wetland based upon the length of the growing season, as measured by soil temperature, is also point of concern for many regions. The February 1 date outlined in the Manual for commencement of the growing season is not applicable for many parts of Virginia.

I appreciate this opportunity to convey these immediate concerns to your attention, and I would be glad to provide you copies of the testimony received by the House Committee on Small Business concerning the impact of wetland regulations on businesses.

We have serious concerns regarding the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands which we would like to bring to your attention.

Recently the President of the National Association of State Foresters wrote to you expressing concern over the possible expansion of wetlands area and jurisdiction by federal agencies over these lands because of new federal definition of wetlands.

A credible and legally defensible manual for delineating jurisdictional wetlands is essential in order to build public support for the goal of "no overall net loss of wetlands", since the original Manual was developed with no opportunity for public review and comment, we feel the new Manual should be presented for public review and comment. Until appropriate corrections to the Manual are made, the wetlands issue will be one of confrontation rather than cooperation toward achieving this goal.

The recent draft revisions to the Manual continue to delineate as wetlands many areas that are only temporarily wet and exhibit few, if any, functions of true wetlands as defined in Environmental Protection Agency and Corps of Engineer regulations as "swamps, bogs, marshes, and similar areas". Specifically, we recommend the following corrections to the Manual:

- 1) The hydrology criterion for delineating a wetland retains the concept of water table at some depth below the surface. Inundation or water at the surface would make the hydrology criterion a much more meaningful and positive indicator of true wetlands in the field and would be consistent with the recent regulatory guidance issued by the Corps on "prior converted wetlands". This inundation need not be year round but must be for a substantial period of time, say six months.
- 2) The growing season for Thermic Soils is identified as February through October. A more precise definition of the "growing season" would specify plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in spring and the average date of the first frost in autumn.

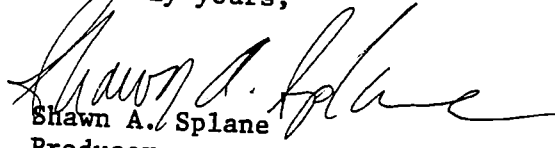

Enclosed you will find a copy of energy conservation legislation I intend to introduce in the next several days. I have also enclosed a section-by-section summary of the bill for your convenience. A copy of this legislation has also been sent to Secretary Watkins.

The purpose of this legislation is to pull together several practical and innovative energy conservation practices that could be adopted relatively easily. I decided on this approach because I believe there are a number of sensible energy conservation initiatives that have been caught up in larger and much more controversial pieces of legislation.

Accordingly, in this legislation I have included several popular provisions designed to facilitate greater energy efficiency in the federal agencies as well as provisions geared toward promoting more comprehensive least-cost planning practices in the utility industry. The bill also includes several new initiatives that will encourage adoption of broader conservation practices in the transportation sector and through federal housing regulations.

I understand that many of these provisions have been proposed as options in the National Energy Strategy. Therefore, you may want to consider this legislation as a possible vehicle for some of the less controversial options in the Strategy. I would appreciate any comments you might have on this matter.

We take the liberty of enclosing, for your information, a copy of our MEMORANDUM on Events in Ukraine in 1990 and their Implications for Western Policies towards Eastern Europe.

In recent weeks, there have been many worrying signs that gradual reforms of the recent past in the Soviet Union have now given way to drastic measures against the democratic forces in the Republics in an attempt by the party hardliners and the military to keep themselves in power.

Attempts to stage a military coup against the democratically elected authorities in Lithuania and Latvia have led to violent deaths and dealt a devastating blow to all hopes for a negotiated settlement of the quest for the restoration of independence of the Baltic States.

In Ukraine and in other Republics a campaign of intimidation against the democratic opponents and the independent press has been intensified. A pattern of renewed repression, masterminded by Gorbachev's hardline advisors, has become evident.

Against this background, a moral choice facing all Western countries between, on the one hand, condoning Moscow's deliberate violence against the civilian population and a return, under any pretext, to the authoritarian rule, and, on the other hand, withdrawing political and economic support for the Gorbachev's regime, should not be in doubt.

Our recommendations, contained in the enclosed MEMORANDUM, outline some of the measures that should be taken by Western countries. We trust that these recommendations will be given due consideration in your re-assessment of policies towards the Soviet Union.

I am writing to express my concern regarding the revisions to the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands. It is my understanding that the guidelines set forth in the Manual have significantly expanded the acreage that can be designated as wetlands.

During my years in the Senate, I have strongly supported legislation to protect our wetlands. The North American Wetlands Conservation Act, a bill to conserve North American wetland ecosystems and wildlife that depend upon such habitats, was passed during the 101st Congress and has now been enacted into law. When I supported this legislation which sought to protect wetlands and mitigate the wildlife habitat loss throughout the nation, I hoped that the criteria for designating areas as wetlands would be realistic and consistent for all land types. It is my understanding that this is not the case. In addition, it is my further understanding that the revisions to the Manual define "wetlands" so broadly that the United States Forest Products and Agricultural Industries could be adversely impacted.

I would appreciate any role you can play to ensure that the criteria for designating areas as wetlands encompasses only swamps, bogs, marshes, and similar areas. Specifically, I am asking you to consider the following:

- * Revisions of the Manual should allow the boundaries of jurisdictional wetlands to more nearly correspond to the functional boundaries of recognizable wetlands that occur on forested landscapes.
- * Revisions and regulatory guidance should assure that all types of land (forests and agricultural) are treated equally. One set of criteria for delineation of wetlands should be established for all types of land.
- * Revisions should describe the hydrologic characteristic for jurisdictional wetlands as the

presence of water at the soil surface rather than some arbitrary depth below the surface.

- * Revisions should define growing seasons similar to plant hardiness zones based on the period between the average date of the last frost in Spring and the average date of the first frost in Fall for a given geographic region.

I believe that the above suggestions will significantly enhance efforts to achieve the President's goal of no overall net loss of wetlands. Your consideration and favorable action concerning these recommendations would be greatly appreciated.

Two suggestions that may help our President.

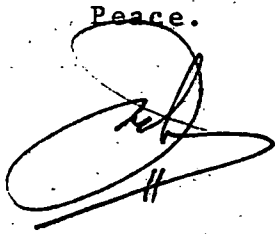

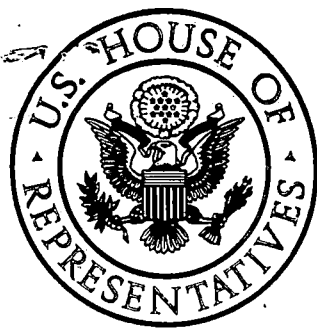

RE: Cease fire in the Gulf War

On January 14, 1991 I submitted to Senator Mitchell a proposal to see if he can give peace a chance and avert the breakout of war in the Gulf. A copy of said proposal was then sent to all Senate members. As described therein, the undersigned explained why he is in a position to assist finding a solution to the Gulf crisis. Unfortunately, by the time the Senate received the proposal, the war had already begun. However, it is still possible to achieve U.S. objectives and serve its interest without further risks and losses. To that goal, I submit the following proposal and analysis:

1. Prior to the breakout of war, one of President Bush's remarks was that Saddam Hussein was under the belief that the U.S. was bluffing and/or Hussein never understood the awesome power against him. Now, there is no need to prove otherwise.
2. It may not be in the best interest of the U.S. to destroy Hussein. It may, however, be in the U.S. interest to destroy his ability to wage wars against his neighbors. It is believed this objective has been achieved.
3. The complete destruction of Hussein's ability to wage war requires the destruction of his army. This could prove to be costly in lives and material. Equally important is the question of whether such complete annihilation of Iraq is not really in the best interest of the U.S. because of the political upheavals that may follow.
4. Suffice to say, there are various ethnic groups in Iraq that will undoubtedly embroil themselves in a bitter and bloody infighting that may endanger peace in the region. Iraq could become much worse than Romania.
5. Peace in the region, and the U.S. interest are better served if Hussein's wings are clipped but leaving him with enough strength to maintain peace within Iraq.

6. This is doubly true if Hussein's attitude towards the U.S. is changed. As discussed below, this can be achieved.
7. The outcome of the war in the Middle East has never been in doubt. It is only a matter of how long and how much. The success of the U.S. forces in the Gulf and, I may add, President Bush's great leadership have set the stage for a new "World Order" of peace and tranquility. The U.S. has already displayed the patience of a first-class super power, and equally important, has demonstrated its ability to follow through with its threats. If Hussein is ever allowed to survive this war, it is a foregone conclusion that neither Hussein nor any other world leader will ever again challenge the U.S. leadership. From now on, it will be sufficient for the U.S. to set the rules of said World Order. The rest of the world, as a direct result of this War, will follow suit.
8. Some critic in certain parts of the world may not readily accept such leadership. However, those who are familiar with world history and the U.S. principles of democracy are very supportive of the U.S. leadership role. Those supporters agree with the U.S. that only through democracy can peace and tranquility prevail in the world.
9. Historians agree that, throughout history, conquerors almost always took advantage of conquered countries. On the other hand, when the U.S. conquered Japan and Germany, it was Japan and Germany that flourished because of the American unprecedented generosity. The Marshall Plans, the open-market policies and many other programs adopted by the U.S. over the years have won admiration of friends and adversaries. No one in the world can disagree with the fact that the U.S. is always ready to help and go the extra mile to promote democracy... not to control or colonize.
10. It is the foregoing fact, among others, that made the Soviet President realize that the Soviet Union had nothing to fear from the U.S.A. and that it was the U.S. who pulled Japan and Germany out of the ruins of the second World War. The Soviet President probably thought of something like this "if this is the way America treats its conquered countries, America is welcome to conquer the Soviet Union without any fight!"
11. The question now that imposes itself is if the foregoing facts are well known in most world quarters, why some Arab leaders, in general, and Saddam Hussein, in particular, are fighting the U.S.
12. First, it is widely believed that Hussein does not know much about the world or the democratic principles of the U.S. Second, the Iraqi President and many Arabs see the U.S. via Israel. Most Arabs do not understand the special relationship that exists

between the U.S. and Israel. They seem to think that the U.S. has the absolute power to order Israel out of Gaza and the West Bank in the Middle East, but is refusing to do so. Further, they think that because of the close relationship between the U.S. and Israel, many of said Arabs, including Hussein and most Iraqis and Palestinians, are under the perception that the U.S. is out to control, manipulate and colonize Arabs.

13. Equally troubling is the widespread perception among many Arabs, especially Hussein and his supporters, that only the Palestinians should have concern about their security. They don't see the relationship between giving the Palestinians the right of self-determination and the security of Israel. I don't believe there are too many Arabs who would think for a moment that the Israelis fear the Palestinians as much as the Palestinians fear Israel.

14. If the foregoing perception can be corrected, a major obstacle in the minds of Hussein and many Arabs can be eliminated. There is no reason why Hussein can't be friendly with the West in general and the U.S. in particular. And, if the Palestinian issue is resolved, I see no reason why Hussein and other Arabs can't be friendly with Israel. This is the way to a lasting peace and tranquility in the Middle East.

15. If there is a person who can make this happen, it is the undersigned. As an Arab American, I believe I can relate to Hussein and others as to why it is in the interest of Iraq, the Palestinians and all Arabs for Iraq to get out of Kuwait, and, equally important, to resolve any differences they may have with their neighbors, including Israel, through peaceful means.

16. Some may find the foregoing to be no more than a dream. But, I believe it can be achieved if the proper circumstances are made available. An immediate cease fire would certainly set the stage for such a peace process.

17. Please use whatever position you may have with the White House to call for an immediate cease fire. If a cease fire is effected, at least for a few days, I am willing to travel to the Middle East and attempt to make peace with Hussein and other leaders.

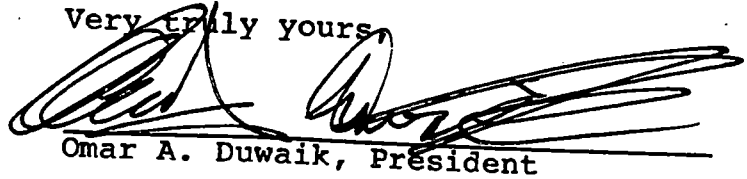
18. It might be argued that a cease fire at this time may give Hussein a chance to rebuild his defenses. First, he is not getting parts from any one. Second, Iraq is not that great an industrialized country that could pose a great threat. Third, the cease fire will be short and little can be rebuilt. Besides, when his defenses were complete, he could not pose any threat. Therefore, the cease fire would not harm the U.S. interest in any way. But, it does give peace a chance, spares the lives of many people, and avoids the slaughter of the Iraqi army and people,

and prevent what could develop into a deep-rooted hatred towards the U.S.

19. The real issue is whether President Bush is willing to forgive Hussein or insist on his removal from power. I submit to you that, if I can change his mind and attitude, it is in the U.S. interest to keep him in power. President Bush ought to know that many Arabs, such as Hussein, talk and yell too much. It is their culture. But they don't really mean harm.

If I can be of assistance, please let me know. Thank you.

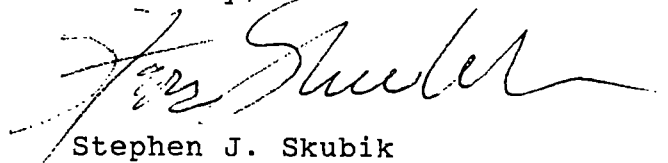
I wish to express my support for the President upon the decision he had to make to send U.S. military forces into action against Saddam Hussein.

SUBJECT: ARAB AMERICANS

In lengthy discussions over the past few days, David Sadd and I have come up with a concept of utilizing Arab-American leaders to maintain the support for the President on the Gulf.

The first group include only key supporters of the President's policy in the Gulf. These are prominent Arab-Americans who would be able to go out and bat for the President. Most of them came to meet with the President and you in August of 1990. We would call this group: "Arab American Advocacy Group." This is the group that we could invite in to meet with you and/or the President to kick off a "support the President" campaign.

The second group is what we would call a "U.S.-Arab Affairs Leadership" group. This group could include the first group as well as those who are interested in U.S.-Arab affairs. The majority of these people are opinion leaders and representatives of think tanks and academic institutions with strong expertise on the Middle East. Some of these people are not necessarily supporters of the President, but could be "worked on."

A third group -the 450 group- would add these two groups to major corporations that have business interests in the Middle East. This group could be brought in for room 450 briefings when we have major legislation to take on Capital Hill such as the Saudi arms sales.

I have attached, for your information, the list of the first group to which David Sadd wanted to add Mitch Daniels and James Abnor. The list for the second group is only partial.

Please take a minute to look at the attached and let me know what your thoughts are.

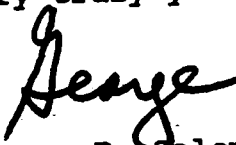

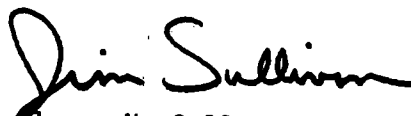

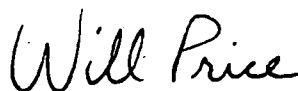
We certainly enjoyed talking with you at dinner last Sunday night in Sacramento.

Dear Governor Sununu:

State governments are facing significant new funding mandates in a number of programs due to federal budget decisions. At the same time, recent studies confirm that in most states, tax revenues are growing at a slower rate than expected. The Center for the Study of the States at the Nelson A. Rockefeller Institute of Government recently reported that state corporate income tax revenue has declined by 1.4 percent since 1989, and 24 of 42 states with a corporate income tax have experienced decreases in corporate income tax revenue. This is at a time when states must be particularly concerned about competition from foreign countries for U.S. businesses that may wish to move overseas in search of reduced labor expenses, government subsidies and lower taxes.

We believe that it is critical for the President to address these issues as he sets the priorities for his domestic program during the 102nd Congress. When the National Governors' Association met in July of 1990, several items of concern to the Governors and state tax administrators were discussed that might alleviate some of these problems. One such item was that state income taxes paid by a corporation should be fully deductible from U.S. income for federal tax purposes.

A resolution was adopted expressing the National Governors' Association position that U.S. tax policy should be neutral to corporate taxpayers subject to the many differing methods of taxation that states may constitutionally impose in order to collect revenues. This resolution was sent to the Secretary of the Treasury who responded that the proposed Internal Revenue Service (IRS) regulations are based on a technical difference in definition of terms used by the federal government and states. The proposed IRS regulations should be modified to respect established case law recognizing that states may only tax income properly attributable to activities in the state. Following such cases, state income taxes should be fully deductible from U.S. source income. Any federal restrictions on such deductibility is an unacceptable encroachment on the state systems of taxation. As a former Governor, you understand, for example, how difficult it is for a corporation paying state taxes to New Hampshire to be forced to allocate that tax to foreign source income earned in Ireland.

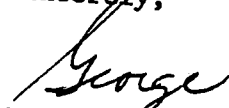
This state tax issue is extremely important to a wide variety of other groups such as the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, the National Association of Manufacturers, The National Foreign Trade Council, the Multistate Tax Commission, the Federation of Tax Administrators, the Council of State Chambers of Commerce, and a dozen other trade groups that have passed similar resolutions supporting the modification of these regulations.

We hope that the President would consider helping the states on this issue in his FY 1992 Budget or State of the Union message. While the specific issue of allocation of state income taxes is somewhat technical, the general theme of helping states to create a neutral environment for state corporate taxes is of utmost importance. Addressing this issue in the President's agenda would send a positive signal at a time when the states and American business are greatly in need of such support and encouragement. Enclosed is a more detailed memorandum on the issue of state income tax allocation.

In addition, I feel equally strongly that World Wide Unitary tax policy must be strongly enforced by the federal government because there are more and more indications of international shell games being played with profits by international companies.

We believe that the theme of helping the states and U.S. corporations competing abroad is vital to the continued growth of America and would appreciate your consideration of this issue.

Dear John:

As I mentioned when we had an opportunity to talk recently by telephone, I am very concerned over certain proposed "options" for the National Energy Strategy [NES]. In this regard, I speak for about 40 electric utilities representing a large portion of our nation's electric energy supply, known as the "Electric Reliability Coalition".

A National Energy Strategy should focus on those few vital goals essential to our country's ability to maintain an adequate and dependable supply of energy at reasonable costs over the long term. (It should reflect to the maximum extent possible those broad areas where a national consensus exists.)

We believe the marketplace will be the primary force in shaping energy conservation and efficiencies, and that states are in the best position to encourage and support conservation and load management programs that are based on sound economics and equitable treatment of all customers.

As our electric utility industry is confronted by the costs of compliance with the new Clean Air Act and concerns about the international oil supply, we must continue to support the development and use of nuclear power for electric energy.

We must maintain the reliability and dependability of our nation's investor-owned electric system which operates under a legal duty to provide regulated service to all customers. The country depends upon a very complex arrangement of interconnected franchised utilities operating under a system of state regulation. We understand that proposals have been submitted to the

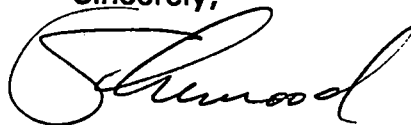

Administration for amending the Public Utility Holding Company Act (PUHCA), which would promote nonregulated new electric generators. The proposals would undercut state regulation of electric generating facilities and service. Also, it would tend to adversely affect reliability and certainly lead to high costs over time. We have opposed and will continue to oppose such changes before Congress and elsewhere as vigorously as possible.

Under the proposed PUHCA amendments, nonregulated independent generators would be highly leveraged with virtually no equity capital. They would have guaranteed take-or-pay contracts from electric utilities. Their profits would be unregulated and undisclosed. We strongly believe that the National Energy Strategy should not be utilized for promoting these narrow economic interests at the expense of regulated service to the public.

For your further reference, enclosed are copies of a recent letter I sent to Energy Secretary Watkins and a speech given by Don D. Jordan, Chairman of Houston Lighting & Power Company, before the U.S. Energy Association.

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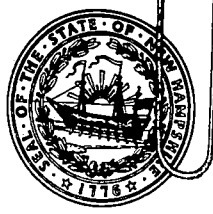

Dear John:

As you know, promoting American exports is a favorite sport in our Mission where almost every section plays a role. At our now famous "Trieste Discovery Day" held last June 1st, 30 representatives from 12 Agencies from our Embassy held functions to support our commercial and outreach programs. This was the largest and widest reaching event of its kind ever conducted by our Embassy and I "think" by any Mission.

In addition to overall coordination and involvement, our Commercial Section in Rome was directly responsible for the successful Italy/U.S. Trade Day held under the auspices of the Trieste Chamber of Commerce. By all accounts, that event was the most successful of all. I spoke before an audience of over 100 businesspeople, and since then we've already identified potential agreements between Trieste and U.S. companies, several of which are new to the Italian market:

- A company in advanced instrumentation may have a licensor in the U.S.;
- A Trieste firm in water purification identified, thru our services, a supplier;
- Many opportunities arose for exports of U.S. food and lumber, not just for Trieste but also for markets of central Europe;
- Our Commercial Section has proposed that the Trieste Fair be the site of one of our 1992 events.

In other areas, "Trieste Discovery Day" proved to be important:

- A scientific agreement was signed between Trieste's Research Park and the U.S. Department of Energy that will have repercussions on U.S. exports;

- Heightened interest in the Region will allow one prominent Triestino and one from a neighbouring province to visit the U.S.: Dario Crozzoli, President of the Province of Trieste and the President of the Gorizia Province, Mr. Crisci will leave Italy on January 10, 1991, for a month long visit to the United States under the auspices of the International Visitors Program.

Clyde Haberman of the New York Times pointed out in a recent article of the International Herald Tribune that Trieste is poised for an exciting future. I'm glad that we, at Embassy Rome, were among the first to perceive it and to take action.

These successes are only the beginning. The attached publication was prepared by the Trieste Chamber of Commerce as a follow-up to our Discovery Day and includes the minutes of the trade seminar, which was the focal point of the event. It was given to me (signed by officials) at a commemorative event in Rome and witnesses how seriously Trieste and Italian officials view our efforts to reach out. (In fact, officials from the Foreign Affairs Ministry complimented us on the initiative.)

We will be following up on Trieste and are already planning on our next Discovery Day in Palermo in May of 1991. Come join us!

SUBJECT: High Definition Television (HDTV)

TO: Governor John Sununu

A number of promising developments regarding high definition television (HDTV) have been announced in recent months and given the continuing political tension surrounding this issue, I wanted to give you an update. Among the most encouraging announcements were those from Zenith-AT&T and General Instruments, both stating their intention to present all digital HDTV proposals in the FCC competition which will lead to a standard being chosen in 1993.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) made a series of decisions at the end of 1989 and early in 1990 which have influenced these developments. The decisions were as follows:

- (1) The intention to pick an HDTV standard in lieu of the current NTSC (North American Television Standards Committee) standard in 1993 from among contesting systems proponents. (Contrasted with protected HDTV industrial projects in Japan and Europe.)
- (2) The intention to take a simulcast approach liberated the companies from the NTSC systems platform. Simulcasting will allow transitional broadcasting of NTSC to avoid flash-cut equipment obsolescence while providing scientific freedom to develop an advanced system without being tied to an old structural platform.
- (3) The decision to pick a system which must operate in 6 MHz and must therefore be spectrum efficient.

These decisions hurt Japan and Europe which have contended that HDTV should be used in satellite distribution rather than delivered by land-based systems. The work of those two members of the triad has been exclusively aimed at the development of satellite systems. The FCC will not deter satellite deployment

but I feel it is important, given the huge investment we have in land based systems (broadcast and cable), that we accommodate those transmission paths as well.

The decision to pick a spectrum efficient technology has favored the United States' lead in micro-processing. The resulting all digital proposals could well put U.S. industries in a leap-frog position as well as produce a system that works compatibly in the computer terminal environment.

In recent years, the U.S. has been perceived as behind in high resolution technologies and a bit of an inferiority complex with resulting political tensions resulted. I am encouraged at present and think that at least on the technology if not manufacturing end, we can state that the U.S. is ahead.

As you continue your efforts in developing the President's FY92 Budget, we wanted to remind you of one particular option that would provide significant multi-year savings: Reform or repeal of the Davis-Bacon Act of 1931.

The administration strongly endorsed H.R. 2259, the 101st Congress version of Davis-Bacon reform, and included its provisions in an amendment to the President's FY91 Budget and the Administration's Defense Management Improvement Act. This bill, which had the bipartisan cosponsorship of 110 House Members, would have saved \$3.06 billion in budget authority and \$2.295 billion in outlays over four years when applied government-wide. About half of these savings would come in Transportation accounts and about one quarter in Defense. Continuing to include Davis-Bacon changes in the President's Budget would be absolutely consistent with the Administration's current position and would assist in pursuing our mutual goals of increased government efficiency and deficit reduction.

As you may know, regulations allowing for the limited use of helpers will become effective on February 4, 1991. Although these regulations will produce significant savings, these changes, which are subject to current statutory constraints, would save only about 60% as much as H.R. 2259 and one-third as much as outright repeal. H.R. 2259 included a threshold of \$250,000, which would have exempted seven percent of the total dollar volume of relevant contracts from Davis-Bacon, and would have expanded the Secretary of Labor's range of discretion in permitting the use of helpers. Further savings could be achieved by including a higher contract threshold. As you will note from the enclosed CBO estimates, raising the threshold to \$1,000,000 would result in four year savings of \$729 million in budget authority and \$610 million in outlays. CBO currently is scoring the savings that would be achieved by other options that might be included in a future reform bill.

A much more straightforward approach to pursue would be outright repeal of the outdated, 59-year old Davis-Bacon Act. Repeal would achieve approximately twice the savings that the H.R. 2259 reforms would, and three times as much as DOL's helpers regulation. In the past, the Administration has estimated that Davis-Bacon increases

Federal Construction costs by up to five percent. A repeal initiative also would more clearly focus attention on the archaic nature of this act.

The President's FY91 Budget located savings from Davis-Bacon reforms on an account-by-account basis, government-wide. Thus, the computational and methodological groundwork has been laid that should allow Davis-Bacon repeal or reform savings to be reflected in the FY92 Budget with relative convenience.

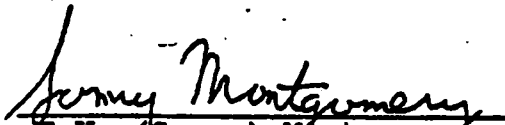
The Administration would remain on sound economic and fiscal ground in recommending either repeal of Davis-Bacon or reforms along the lines of H.R. 2259 with a threshold of \$500,000 or \$1,000,000. Such reforms are politically achievable, particularly in light of the fiscal restraints that were imposed by the recent budget agreement.

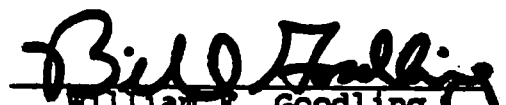
