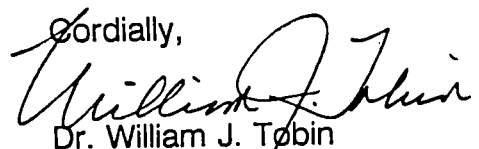

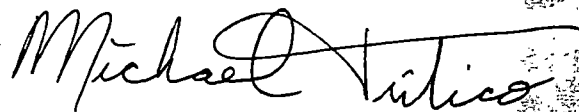
Enclosed is a medal which our environmental group, RESTORE, would like to give to the people who shut off the terrible oil spill caused by Saddam Hussein.

RESTORE, a south Louisiana group I started in the mid-nineteen seventies, is very aware of the biological stresses created by large releases of petroleum into a marine ecosystem. We are aware of the great difficulties involved in remediation of such releases. We know that the best solution to oil spills is their prevention, but that rapid termination of a spill is actually a far more beneficial action than can be the slow and usually only partially-effective measures employed to clean up animals, waters, sands, and rocks.

The crews of the F-111's (and the people who developed the technology that allowed the airmen to succeed in their mission) deserve recognition for the great environmental service they have accomplished. Our resources are limited, so we can send only one medal, but please tell everyone involved that our gratitude is not limited, we truly appreciate what they have done.

Finally, I would like to thank President Bush and all of you for maneuvering the world through some difficult yet exciting times. The promise of freedom, realized most completely here in the United States, has become a hope now taken seriously around the world. I sense a resurgence of the global spirit of confidence that I felt when my father returned from the USAAF at the end of World War II. (Incidentally, his namesake, my "little" brother, Captain Frank Michael Tritico, Jr., is a USAF C-141 commander in Desert Storm. Maybe, during one of his turnarounds in the desert, he could, on our behalf, present the medal to the F-111 crews. Frank has always been semi-sympathetic to our RESTORE environmental involvements, and we have always had a real respect for his Eagle Scout type of advice for us.)

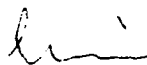

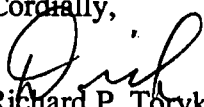

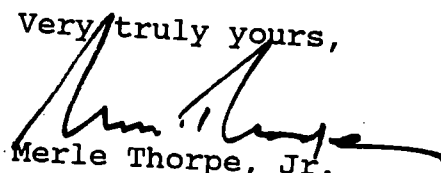

Dear John,

I am writing to request that you consider recommending to the President that Ethan Levin-Epstein, of Fairfield, Connecticut, be nominated as the next United States Attorney for that State. I know Mr. Levin-Epstein myself and I know of him from my friends in the F.B.I. who have worked closely with him for almost twenty years. It is my opinion that Mr. Levin-Epstein's unusual background and experience as a career prosecutor provide him with a singular ability to continue to serve his country and his community in this exceedingly important capacity.

As you can see from the enclosed impeccable resume and summary that Mr. Levin-Epstein has provided at my request, virtually all of his professional life has been devoted to the enforcement of the law. He has served no fewer than four "hitches" in federal and state prosecutors' offices and even one in the New York City Police Department. Of particular note in my endorsement of his candidacy for the position of United States Attorney are the years he served in that Office in the Eastern District of New York and the District in which he now seeks the position -- Connecticut.

Over the more than fifteen years in which he was a prosecutor he has learned the "ins and outs" of the United States Attorney's Office to a degree that is rare indeed. He has prosecuted every variety of violation, supervised the widest spectrum of investigations, tried literally dozens of cases, and compiled a record of success and a reputation for tough-minded fairness that is exemplary.

All this would be reason enough to consider him as a likely candidate for the job if a U.S. Attorney's responsibilities were only to investigate cases and try them. Mr. Levin-Epstein, however, brings another, all-important, dimension to the assignment. He is also intimately familiar with the administrative operations of the Office and has first-hand experience in running the very office in which he seeks the appointment.

When the most recent United States Attorney for the District of Connecticut, Stan Twardy, was appointed, he came to the Office with experience in neither criminal law nor trial work. Through a mutual friend he met and recruited Mr. Levin-Epstein to move to Connecticut to become his First Assistant United States Attorney. experience and help him to learn to run the Office in the way it should be run. It is no small credit to Mr. Levin-Epstein that during the stewardship of United States Attorney Twardy (with Ethan as his First Assistant and second-in-command) I am told that the Office became one of the most productive and well-respected in the nation.

I have no doubt that this tradition and well-deserved reputation will continue with Ethan as the United States Attorney.

I hope that after reviewing his impeccable credentials you will agree with my conclusions. I recommend without reservation Mr. Levin-Epstein for this position. I am certain that his appointment would serve well the interests of the people of the State as well as the oft-restated policy of this Administration to be firm but fair in its prosecution of those charged with crimes against the United States.

Thank you for accepting this recommendation and for forwarding it and the enclosed materials to the appropriate person on your staff for a favorable review.

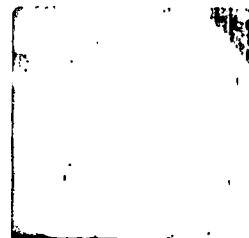

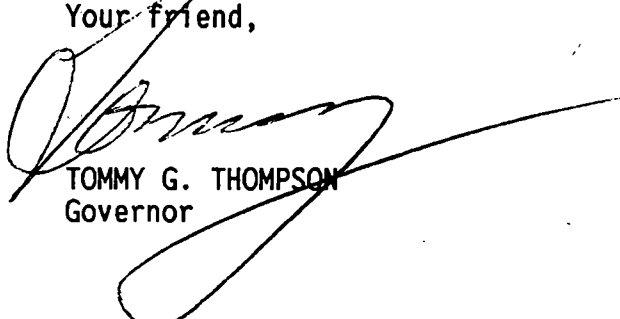

While he deals with the Persian Gulf crisis, I trust that you and other "insiders" are working on domestic programs, especially those involving housing, unemployment, education, and banking; we can't let a 1929-type crash destroy our monetary policy and status as a World leader! Contrary to thinking of recent years, Banking and Utilities have to be controlled, for the welfare of the masses. One domestic issue worthy of examination is flood-control, not dams just for power, but the controlled flow and distribution of water. The TVA Program has deviated!

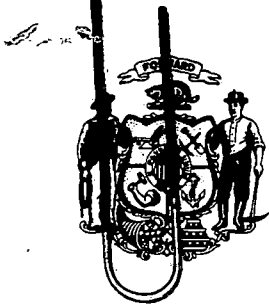

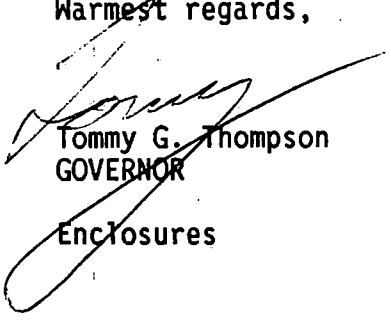
Enclosed are materials describing Wisconsin's innovative welfare reform initiatives. I have also sent a similar package to Secretary Louis Sullivan.

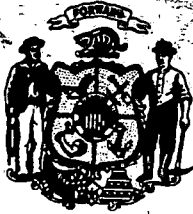

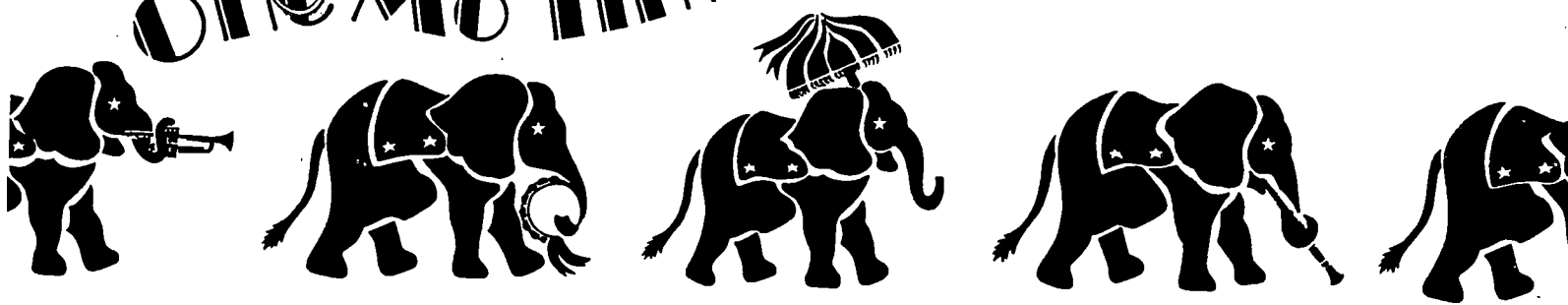

Dear John:

With all of the demands on your time on matters of critical importance, I hesitate to impose by writing this letter. I do so, however, because I know the subject of this letter is of interest to you and that you may be expressing your views on the matter, and may also be conveying the views of the President.

As you can see from the letterhead, I am chairman of the committee put together by the Louisiana Republican Party and the City of New Orleans to lobby for the selection of New Orleans for the 1992 Republican National Convention. Before I accepted this assignment, I said I wanted to take some time to think about it because I would only make the effort if I felt that coming to New Orleans in 1992 was in the best interest of the Republican Party. I believe you know me well enough to know that my motives are sincere.

After some careful reflection and investigation of alternate sites (San Diego and Houston), I became convinced that it was in the best interest of our Party to have the convention in New Orleans again.

As you know, the 1988 convention was a smashing success. Party officials, delegates, visitors, and even significant numbers of the news media proclaimed that the 1988 convention was probably the best staged convention, by either Party, in this century. The facilities of the Superdome cannot be matched. We have proved the technical feasibility and have the physical elements necessary to transform the Superdome into a gigantic convention hall. The city administration and the governor's office are both completely behind this effort. The business community is eager to carry its share of the financial cost. We have outstanding hotels within walking distance of the Superdome. You know about our restaurants, and our hospitality. Since the 1988 convention we've added the fabulous Aquarium of the Americas.

I won't take more of your time on the positive points of New Orleans, but I am sending you under separate cover a video tape about seven minutes in length which provides additional information of importance about New Orleans. Before you finalize your view, I hope you will take a look at the video tape.

I also hope that you will take the time to reflect on the following political considerations.

First. I've heard some say that we Republicans should not return to the same city. Let's remember that we went to Miami in both 1968 and 1972. And, our nominee for president won both ensuing elections! We nominated George Bush in New Orleans, and he went on to victory. The fantastic success of this convention created a sense of enthusiasm and momentum which played a role in our victory in November. New Orleans is a winner for all of us. Why argue with success?

Second. We're going to need the South again in 1992. Some say that a site in California is a political plus because California will have 54 electoral votes in the next election. Let me point out that the five states in the immediate vicinity of New Orleans (Texas, Arkansas, Mississippi, Alabama plus Louisiana) have a total of 60 electoral votes! The Old South together will have a total of 156 electoral votes - 58% of the number required to win! The South was highly honored by hosting the 1988 convention -- it meant a lot to the voters of this region, and it made a deeply favorable impression on us. In my opinion, the Democrats' only chance to beat us in 1992 is to nominate a southerner such as Senator Robb of Virginia or Senator Nunn of Georgia. We'll need to counter the natural attraction of either of those in the southeastern states. Having the

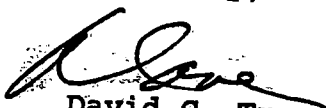
delegates thoroughly enjoyed New Orleans in 1988. And no wonder: they and their guests were easily accommodated in the Superdome, first-class hotels put them within walking distance of the Superdome, and our famous restaurants stayed open late at night to accommodate all who wanted to continue the party after our sessions. Let's be sure those who work in the trenches in the 1992 campaigns for president and Congress leave with a happy and upbeat spirit.

Democrats joined Republicans in providing 10,000 volunteers in 1988. Our city leadership and local Republicans provided the resources to insure a spectacular success. This enthusiasm continues, and I guarantee you it will result in another overwhelmingly successful convention if New Orleans is chosen for 1992.

John, unless the President has already made up his mind about what he would like done in this matter, I would appreciate tremendously having 10 minutes, or even five minutes, of his time, if that is all possible. I will come to Washington on short notice any time that the President might be able to see me. I make this request as a long-time Republican activist, former Republican congressman and governor, a Republican Eagle, a friend of yours and a sincere friend of the President.

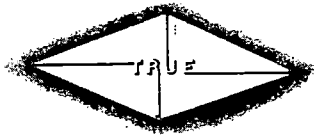

Dear John:

It is our understanding the Economic Policy Council will in the near future make a recommendation to the President for a National Energy Strategy.

It is also our understanding that this draft strategy which the EPC will submit to the President may include a "mandate" that by the year 2000 from five to ten percent of the nation's transportation fuel must be provided by alternative fuels.

It has always been our experience that anytime anyone--and in particular the federal or state governments--"mandates" how a program or project will be carried out, then that project or program invariably fails because the governments forget that if programs and projects are left alone, economics will decide the most effective, efficient and least expensive method of meeting specific objectives or goals.

Ethanol blended with gasoline would give a very small security benefit because ethanol is produced from domestic corn, and considerable petroleum inputs are required to produce ethanol from corn. Ethanol blended with gasoline does reduce carbon monoxide emissions, but it increases the evaporative hydrocarbon emissions. Most importantly, however, it must be remembered that ethanol costs two or three times more than gasoline.

The alternative fuel use of substituting methanol for gasoline gives about the same results from tailpipe emissions as would be produced by gasoline hydrocarbon emissions on a mass basis. Methanol is considerably more costly to produce than is gasoline until the price of crude oil exceeds approximately \$40 per barrel. There is no real energy security benefit by substituting methanol for gasoline since much of the methanol would need to be imported. It can, therefore, be concluded that methanol would not be a cost effective alternative to gasoline for reducing emissions.

Compressed natural gas has been suggested in some circles as an alternative fuel use for vehicles, but so few vehicles have used or been tested with compressed natural gas that emission benefits are not known. The cost of compressed natural gas for vehicles is estimated to be about equal to the cost per gallon for future conventional gasoline vehicles to 40 to 50 cents more per gallon equivalent than gasoline. It must be remembered, however, that there are approximately \$750 higher costs involved with installing equipment to enable the use of compressed natural gas in vehicles, and additionally it would cost over \$250,000 per service station to convert to the use of compressed natural gas. Because of these extra costs and the lack of infrastructure, compressed natural gas would most likely be limited to use in fleet vehicles. While CNG might lower petroleum imports, it would necessarily boost imports of natural gas and displace other natural gas end uses.

Ethanol and methanol have totally different chemical characteristics than gasoline. These chemical differences would require considerable modification and expansion of current gasoline and diesel distribution systems. Also, methanol has a much lower energy content than does gasoline, which would require much greater volumes of methanol to be distributed versus gasoline--methanol is also highly toxic which would pose safety problems.

We strongly urge that a "mandate" not be issued for the use of alternative fuels other than gasoline, but instead we urge you to let the market itself decide which is the most efficient, effective and least costly fuel.

The enclosed article sums up our concerns.

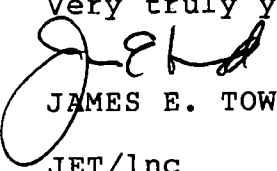

I hope you will caution President Bush not to start a war over there. We've got to focus on the long term, not the short. We don't belong in Kuwait or Iraq or Saudia Arabia.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

Our office has been making mailings to the media, to prominent individuals, and to influence-centers suggesting ways that the Iraq problem might be defused for a peaceful settlement.

But, if war does come we believe that the U.S. should have the objective of not simply getting Iraqi forces out of Kuwait, for that merely would restore the status quo, pose a continual Iraqi threat to Saudi Arabia, to Israel, and other gulf nations.

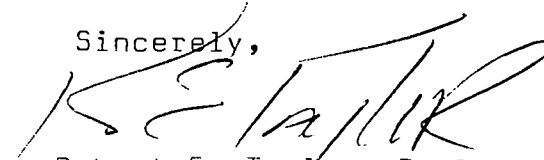
Instead, we believe the proper objective will be to vanquish the Iraqi armed forces, occupy Bagdad, and then carve up Iraq by giving pieces of it to Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, and possibly to Turkey.

The objective will be to remove any future threat from Iraq so we do not need to keep armed forces in the region for many years.

In order to help pay for the heavy costs of a war with Iraq, we should retain pumping rights either in Iraq or in Iraq's portion of the Ramali oil fields--until reparations are made. The oil pumped there could be designated for our reserves ("as a replacement").

From the standpoint of psychological warfare, this objective (carving up Iraq) should be enunciated at once. It will cause civic disturbances in Iraq and it will be tremendous morale booster for our troops. They hardly can get motivated by the goal of merely regaining Kuwait and re-establishing the status quo. If we are going to lose American lives in the Middle East we must make their sacrifice worthy of the objectives for which they have fought. The American people will not be satisfied merely to restore the monarchy in Kuwait, to have Iraq remain as a continuing threat to peace. It will be seen as "wimp" treatment.

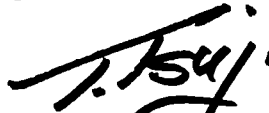

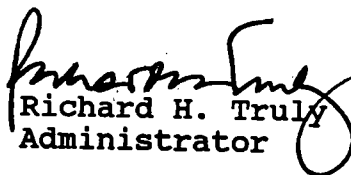
Dear Governor Sununu:

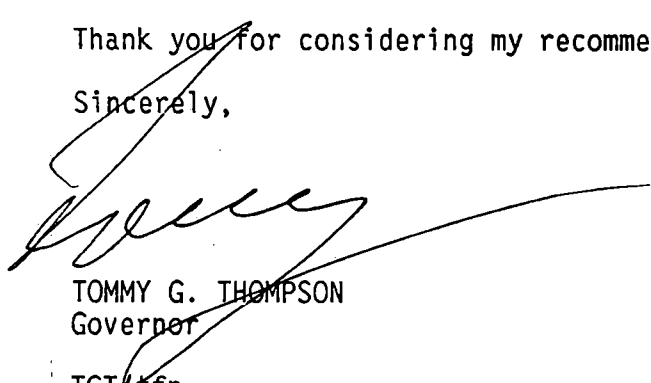

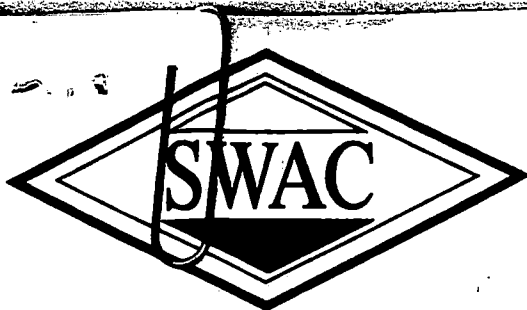

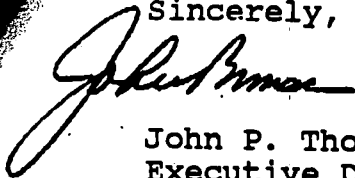
On December 5, 1990 we wrote to EPA Administrator Reilly to again express our concerns regarding the materials separation provision of the proposed Municipal Waste Combustor New Source Performance Standards and Emission Guidelines. We understand that the Agency is considering a modification to the materials separation provision to include a size limitation whereby only the largest combustors would be subject to the source separation requirements. The purpose of this letter is to advise you that such a provision does not, in any way, change our opposition to this provision.

The issue here is not size, but the inappropriateness of the provision. As we have stated many times before, the provision fails to recognize the arrangements between these facilities and local government; it fails to consider the wide diversity of uses within the service area of a combustor; it fails to recognize the need for markets for materials removed from any municipal solid waste stream; and tries to create a national recycling policy in an air emission regulation, an inappropriate place for such an attempt.

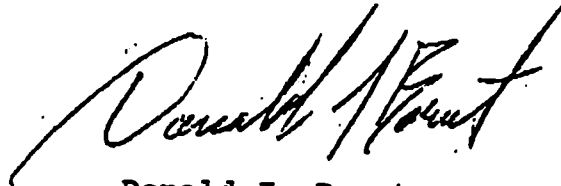
Further, this modification of the materials separation provision merely exacerbates the problems caused by the previous language. It will deter regionalization of municipal solid waste management and result in smaller facilities with lesser ability to afford the best in control technologies. It will encourage construction of smaller units to circumvent the provision.

once again, we encourage you to remove this provision from the final rule. Once again, we encourage the Agency to work in concert with our organizations and other to craft a national policy and direction for recycling in the context of a comprehensive municipal solid waste effort - the reauthorization of RCRA.

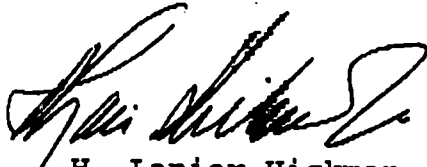

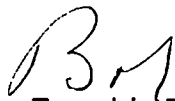

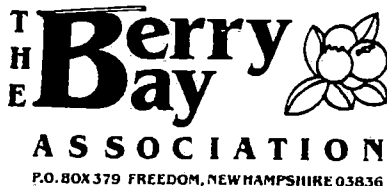
