Dear Mr. Sununu:

Winning the peace is much more difficult than starting a war in the Gulf. We ask that you use your good offices to urge the President and State Department:

- to provide and encourage substantial aid to the Kurds
- to support and guarantee a safe haven for the fleeing Kurds within Iraq territory, and
- to openly discuss the Kurdish issue with all concerned parties.

Violations of human rights and genocide have been perpetrated by the government of Iraq against the Kurds who are being massacred, starved and driven from their homes. The U.S. army has occupied one-tenth of Iraq and, therefore, we have the right to an input in the policies of that country and cannot dismiss the Iraqi genocide of the Kurds as an "internal matter." If we do not act now, we will have managed to produce an unsatisfactory outcome in the Gulf: a military victory but a moral failure in the aftermath.

The Kurdish people have become pawns in the game of war and power politics and are in the intolerable position of being massacred, exposed to the elements and starved to death. Since human rights knows no boundaries the United States cannot stand by passively and turn its back on the desperate Kurds since we are partly responsible for their predicament.

We must once again become the beacon that lights the path for those seeking to establish and abide by democratic principles. Thanking you for your support, we remain

On May 9, 1989 and then again on March 26, 1990 you wrote to me indicating that you had considered my comments regarding the composition of the U.S. delegation to the United Nations and would share those observations with the staff at Presidential Personnel.

At this time I once more wish to be considered for an appointment to one of the public member positions with the next U.S. delegation to the United Nations General Assembly for its session which will commence this September.

Since the United Nations Organization was founded in 1945, numerous U.S. delegations aggregating hundreds of members have served there. However, in all that time no one in any U.S. delegation at the U.N.O. has yet been a person of a Baltic-American heritage.

Following the military invasion by the Soviet Army in June of 1940, there was an illegal annexation of the Baltic Republics by the U.S.S.R. During the ensuing 50 years the U.S. has continued its policy in support of self determination by the people of Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia.

It would surely serve our U.S. Baltic policy at the world forum of the U.N.O., as well as our domestic political concerns, if after nearly five decades there could now be someone of a Baltic heritage included as a member on the next U.S. delegation to the United Nations Organization.

I would greatly appreciate your support in this matter. Mr. Untermeyer has been advised of my keen interest in such position.
