I understand the Judge William Zloch of the United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, has been interviewed by the United States Department of Justice regarding two (2) openings (Florida seats) on the United states Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

Judge Zloch was appointed to the United States District Court, Southern District of Florida in November of 1985 by President Ronald Reagan. I have known Bill Zloch and his wife, Nancy, ever since we met in 1967. We were both officers in the Navy, stationed at the Pensacola Naval Air Station. Out of that relationship grew a friendship that has continued over the years.

Bill would be an excellent appointment to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals. He is bright, enthusiastic, perceptive and of absolute integrity. I have always known Bill to be a solid person, committed to his family, with high moral standards.

Ever since we met, Bill's conservative philosophy has been reflected not only in his support of pro-life, but also in those social issues which are important to the administration. This philosophy is further seen in his concern with the crime and drug problems that pervade our society. He is not permissive or inclined toward the indulgence of criminals, but he does insure that every defendant receives a fair and impartial trial. His reputation as a District Judge is that of a good, fair judge.

A review of Judge Zloch's record will show that he is a judge who exercises judgment rather than will, who reads the law as written and applies it as written, and who does not engage in "legislating" or "making up the law." I feel that Judge Zloch would bring a breath of fresh, conservative philosophy to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.

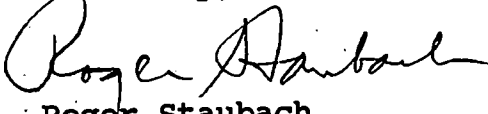

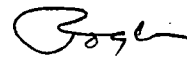

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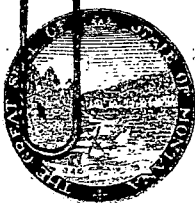

Dear John:

As you may know, the Environmental Protection Agency has recently requested a White House decision on how to distribute bonus allowances to power plants that elect to use scrubbers as a compliance strategy in phase I of the acid rain law. How the bonus allowances are distributed is a very important issue for Montana because of the very important role the low sulfur coal mining and railroad industries play in our states' economy. We in Montana worked hard during the legislative debate to limit the number of power plants which would be eligible to receive such bonus allowances, not only for regional economic reasons, but because fuel switching to low sulfur coal usually represents the least cost control strategy. Now, however, the high sulfur coal lobby is hoping to win through the regulatory process what they could not win during the legislative debate.

I know that Governors Tommy Thompson and Mike Sullivan, as Co-Chairmen of the Alliance for Acid Rain Control, have written to you regarding this matter and have asked you to intercede to put this issue to rest. I would like to echo the Governors' concerns as both a member of the Alliance and as Governor of the State of Montana.

The option paper forwarded to the White House by the EPA addresses the distribution of the 3.5 million tons of scrubber bonus allowances and reportedly outlines two options:

1. require utility applicants to "stand in line" for the distribution of bonus allowances with the distribution process terminated once all of the 3.5 million allowances have been allocated, and
2. treat all applications received on the same day as "tied" and distribute the 3.5 million allowances pool on a pro rata basis among those tied applicants. (The high sulfur coal/utility air resources group option)

Reliance on a pro rata option would result in a larger number of power plants electing to use scrubbers than if the stand in line principle were followed. This would negatively affect the low sulfur coal mining industry in Montana and would increase electricity costs for consumers in other parts of the nation as well. I strongly oppose such a pro rata option.

The language of Section 404(d)(4) of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 makes clear that bonus allowances were to be distributed on a sequential basis rather than on a pro rata basis: "if no allowances remain available in the reserve for further allocation before all proposals have been acted upon by the Administrator, any pending proposals shall be disapproved."

As you may recall, this provision was developed with great specificity during the Senate-White House negotiations prior to Senate floor consideration last spring. This issue was again debated during the House-Senate conference, and my office worked closely with Senator Baucus and Senator Simpson's staff to make certain that proposals similar to pro-rationing scrubber bonus allowances were rejected.

Senate-White House negotiations emerged unchanged in the final legislation. Allowing a change in this balanced agreement during the regulatory process would significantly undermine the hard work you and many others put into crafting this provision during the Congressional debate.

Governor, I appreciate any help you can give Montana in insuring that a strict interpretation of first-come, first-served approach to scrubber bonus allowances is required in the acid rain regulations proposed by EPA. This represents the best, and least cost, solution to our air quality problems. If you have any questions on this issue, please feel free to contact me or talk to Ned Helme at the Alliance for Acid Rain Control in Washington, D.C.

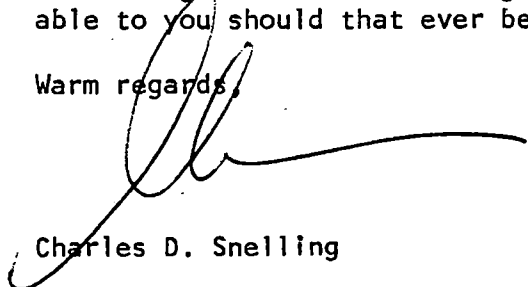

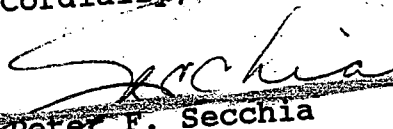

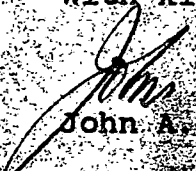
Dear Mr. Sununu:

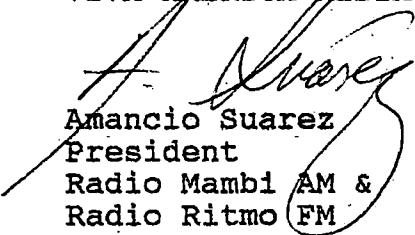

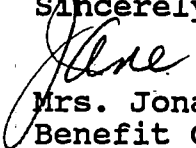

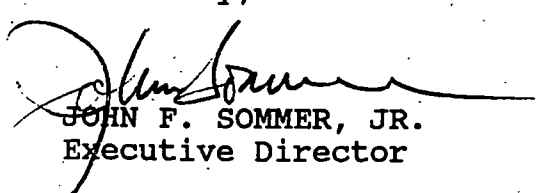
Dear Governor Sununu:

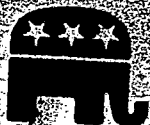

Dear John:

The Environmental Protection Agency has recently requested a White House decision on how to distribute bonus allowances to power plants that elect to use scrubbers in phase I of the acid rain law. As you know, we worked very hard with your help to limit these bonus allowances during the congressional process. Now, the high sulfur coal lobby is hoping to win through the regulatory process what they could not win during the congressional debate. We are writing to ask you to intercede to put this issue finally to rest.

The issue centers on interpretation of the statutory requirement that the 3.5 million tons of scrubber bonus allowances be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis. EPA's option paper forwarded to the White House reportedly outlines two options:

- 1) require utility applicants to "stand in line" for the distribution of bonus allowances with the distribution process terminated once all of the 3.5 million allowances have been allocated, and
- 2) treat all applications received on the same day as "tied" and distribute the 3.5 million allowances pool on a pro rata basis among those tied applicants. (the high sulfur coal/utility air resources group option)

Reliance on a pro rata option would result in a larger number of power plants electing to use scrubbers than if the stand in line principle were followed. It would raise costs to consumers and increase environmental costs as well.

The language of Section 404(d)(4) of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 makes clear that bonus allowances were to be distributed on a sequential basis rather than on a pro rata basis: "if no allowances remain available in the reserve for further allocation before all proposals have been acted upon by the Administrator, any pending proposals shall be disapproved."

As you may recall, this provision was developed with great specificity during the Senate-White House negotiations prior to Senate floor consideration last spring. This issue was again debated during the House-Senate conference, and proposals similar to prorationing scrubber bonus allowances were rejected. The detailed agreement developed in the Senate-White House negotiations emerged unchanged in the final legislation.

Governor, thank you again for all your help on acid rain during the congressional process. We will very much appreciate any help you can give us in insuring that a strict interpretation of first-come, first-served approach to scrubber bonus allowances is required in the acid rain regulations proposed by EPA. For your information, we have enclosed letters from Senator Simpson and Members of the House Energy & Commerce Committee which express the same concerns. If you have any questions on this issue, please feel free to contact either one of us or to talk to Ned Helme at the Alliance.

Recognizing the many demands placed on your time, I hesitate to call your attention to the matter of one federal judgeship. I do so, however, because it is of considerable importance for Tennessee.

At issue is the pending appointment of a replacement for retiring Judge Harry W. Wellford of the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals. Judge Wellford's is one of three seats traditionally held by Tennesseans (Michigan and Ohio currently have six apiece; Kentucky has the remaining two; a newly-created 16th seat is to be assigned to Michigan).

I have assumed, as have many in Tennessee, that a Tennessean would be selected to replace Judge Wellford. Accordingly, I have recommended to the Justice Department the nomination of U.S. District Judge Julia Gibbons of Memphis, a well-respected, well-credentialed young woman whose judicial philosophy is in keeping with the President's.

It has recently come to my attention, however, that the Justice Department intends to give the Wellford seat to Ohio, basing its decision, I'm told, on the number of appeals originating in each state and the average caseload per judge.

Using those measures, however, the case for shifting Tennessee's seat to Ohio is weak, at best. The Justice Department's own figures show a declining number of appeals originating in Ohio, contrasted with steady growth in appeals from Tennessee. Moreover, on the basis of appeals-per-judge, each of Ohio's seven judges would handle approximately 150 cases, while each of Tennessee's two remaining judges would have to decide 406 appeals.

In short, the number of appeals filed in Ohio has remained constant over the past five years, except for an unusual statistical spike in 1988; the number of appeals filed there last year represents an increase of 14.6 percent over 1986. Appeals originating in Tennessee, on the other hand, increased annually during that five year span, and the 1990 total represents a 30.5 percent increase over 1986.

I have no quarrel with awarding the new seat to Michigan. The judges there have by far the heaviest caseload and, like the Tennessee judges, have seen steady and considerable growth in appeals filed. Using the Justice Department's own measure, Ohio's argument for parity with Michigan is unconvincing; Michigan's caseload is about 35 percent heavier and its caseload per judge was 227 last year, compared with Ohio's 180. Tennessee's three judges last year handled an average of 271 cases apiece.

The only other argument for increased judicial representation for Michigan and Ohio lies in a comparison of population figures. Fair enough. I suggest, however, that the current apportionment of judges already takes population into account. Michigan has one judge for every 1.5 million people, Ohio and Tennessee each have one judge for every 1.6 million people, and Kentucky has one judge for every 1.8 million. Transferring Tennessee's seat to Ohio lowers Ohio's ratio to 1:1.5 million, but raises Tennessee's to 1:2.4 million -- way out of line with ratios for other states in the 6th Circuit.

To sum up, I would argue that the Justice Department's inclination to shift Tennessee's traditional third seat to Ohio is not only unwise, but contrary to the department's own criteria for distributing judicial appointments among the states in the Sixth Circuit. Indeed, the shift would burden Tennessee's remaining judges with one of the highest caseloads in the nation, while leaving Ohio's judges with among the lowest.

Hon. Mr. Sununu:

This letter is a personal appeal to you to see if you can help the mentally ill youth of our town, and of the State of Illinois, I had the opportunity of meeting you at the NAMI Convention in the Chicago Hilton, Chicago. We conversed in Spanish at your reception.

Statistics of the State of Illinois concerning the care of the mentally ill, ref. The Rating of the States by Torrey, Erdman, Wolfe and Lauri M. Flynn: Per capita income, 1987 \$16,442; per capita income rank 12; per capita mental health spending, 1987 \$24.48. Per capita spending rank FORTY FOUR. National average per capita spending \$42.11.

New Hampshire has a per capita spending of \$50.90. 1989, Illinois census, 12 million inhabitants, Ohio almost 11 million. Ohio per capita spending on mental health is \$45.33. At this point in time the human tragedies behind the statistics of the State of Illinois will be left unmentioned.

Yesterday, April 13, the Director of the Bureau of the Budget, Joan Walters, made a presentation of the budget of the new Republican Governor, James Edgar, and for the sufferers of mental illness the pattern that has emerged is frankly alarming, while mental health services are being drastically cut more jails are going to be built. Specially alarming is the wide eyed surprise of this administration at the "explosion" of the penal population.

An excellent way to make room in the jails would be to remove the sufferers of mental illness who are improperly jailed, and put them in hospitals to be treated.

The pattern that I see emerging is a return to the dark ages of lack of treatment for the mentally ill: Jail them, a la Amadeus. Governor Edgar wants to be known as the Education Governor. Before the mentally ill individuals can be educated they must be stabilized, and made functional. The Supported Employment Program in our community, with job coaches experienced in dealing with the mentally ill will be extinguished practically. Yes, we expect these persons to be productive. The treatment funding for the dually diagnosed, mentally ill substance abuser, does not exist. *in our community*

Our community youth and adolescents, and adults ^{are} served by a mental facility, Madden State Mental Hospital, which has "during FY 90 more determined efforts at contacting and utilizing community alternatives, especially psychiatric units on General Hospitals with Medicaid and Emergency Purchase of Service Agreements, reduced the influx by 15% allowing the facility to operate at capacity and to improve the quality of care". The families had began to work with this facility. Due to the cuts in mental health the Children and Adolescent ward of this hospital, where our suburb and most of the *city + suburb* western area youth receive services, will have to go to Horner in the northside of Chicago, if we tolerate it. (Four million are being taken away from Madden Budget).

We believe that sick children belong close to their families where they can be visited often, and in a safe place. From our area it will take four buses to reach Horner. One or two to reach Madden.

About Horner, Chicago Tribune, March 28, is the target of a lawsuit "charging that conditions are dangerous, because of crowding, daily violence and inadequate care". Lawsuit details attached. Further, Horner is across from Reed Hospital where a female delivered a child in a bathroom not too long ago. The child was found dead in the toilet. Front page news.

ALERT

The information here provided was already given to the Governor, the Director of DMHDD, elected officials, and the local press. I am seeking your assistance to prohibit a passing administration to destroy what little protection the mentally ill children and youth of our community already have. The same protection is being destroyed throughout the State. The children from Rockford, Ill., are going to be sent to Peoria, 150 miles away from the families. PLEASE HELP.

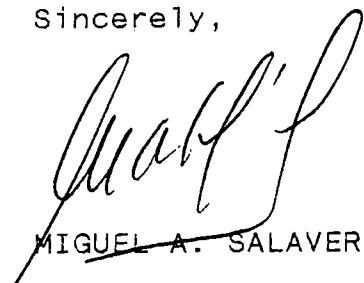

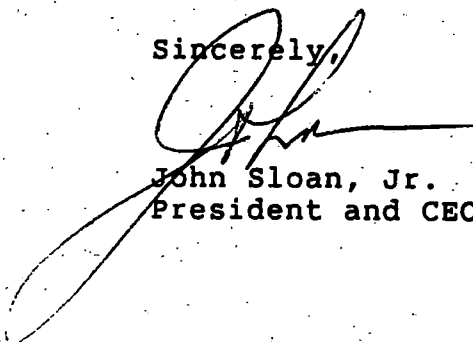
Following recent media reports, there has been some mischaracterization of the position of the business community with regard to civil rights legislation. While some elements of the business community are engaged in discussions with civil rights groups in an effort to reach some common understanding, the reported results of their negotiations do not reflect the views of the small business community.

The jury trials and punitive and compensatory damages contained in H.R. 1 would be devastating to America's small firms. According to a recent NFIB survey, 38% of the small business owners who responded take home less than \$40,000 annually -- less than half the average cost of attorney's fees alone in a civil rights case.

Similarly, H.R. 1 limits an employer's defenses in discrimination cases to the point where they are unworkable and will result in defensive quota hiring in order to protect against costly litigation.

We fully support the President's efforts to achieve fair employment laws in this regard and will work with you to prevent H.R. 1 from being enacted.

I am writing on behalf of the California Bankers Association to request a meeting for banking officials from my State.

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the California Bankers Association. It also marks a time in which the banking industry is facing its most significant challenges and, in my opinion, most far-reaching opportunities for needed reforms.

The President is providing clear and essential leadership in advocating meaningful reforms. As you can well imagine, California's 460 banks, whose combined deposits represent roughly twelve percent of all deposits nationwide, have a large stake in the outcome of this debate.

The reason for this meeting request, however, is to focus our efforts on the immediate and most pressing problem facing the banking industry -- the credit crunch -- which is compounding our economic downturn. This phenomenon is very real, as you know, and it holds very serious consequences for not only the banking industry but our housing and real estate markets. Moreover, it diminishes capital formation opportunities for high technology and small business development to name but two examples. As you know, it is these sectors that, typically, provide us with the greatest opportunities for economic growth and the creation of new jobs.

Clearly, the consequences of the current economic downturn reach into every corner of the Nation. While I am particularly sensitive to the problems in New England, I am extremely concerned that the California economy, while resilient, may be seriously injured should the current credit crunch continue.

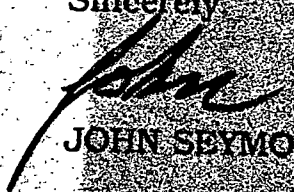
By virtue of its size, some economists have suggested that California is our Nation's economic engine. I agree with this assessment, and therefore am concerned that should California suffer significantly from a recession, it will drive the rest of the country into deeper financial problems and fiscal uncertainty.

For these reasons, I am requesting a meeting with you and Michael Boskin, myself, and members of the California Bankers Association to discuss this issue in greater detail, and to provide you with California's perspective. I believe such a discussion will be beneficial, and help lead to strategies that might alleviate the burden of the credit crunch.

I understand the obvious limitations of your schedule. The California Bankers Association will be in Washington the week of April 22, and I know they would appreciate and benefit greatly from such a meeting.

As always, thank you in advance for your willingness to consider this request.

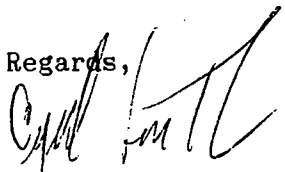

SUBJECT: TWA'S PROPOSED SALE TO AMERICAN AIRLINES
OF AIR ROUTES TO LONDON

As you know, TWA and American Airlines have asked this Department to approve a transaction in which six TWA routes to London's Heathrow Airport would be sold to American for \$445 million. (We recently approved a similar transaction between Pan Am and United; as a result, United today is starting service to Heathrow as Pan Am's successor.)

The transaction is strenuously opposed by civic and political interests centered in St. Louis and Kansas City, where TWA is a major employer. Senator Danforth and the Missouri congressional delegation have been the most visible leaders of the opposition. They fear that the sale of TWA's London routes will irreparably damage the carrier's prospects for long-term survival. As an alternative to the route sale, they have been working with TWA's unions to facilitate a buy-out offer from the financier Kirk Kerkorian -- a transaction, they believe, that would have a better chance of keeping TWA intact.

I have decided to approve the proposed sale of the six routes to American, but I will also require -- for reasons relating to competition and market structure -- that American divest itself of three of the routes within six months. (We have worked in close cooperation with the Department of Justice, and Justice is comfortable with the proposed divestiture requirement.) The decision will enable American to serve Heathrow from New York, Boston, and Los Angeles almost immediately. American could also provide service to London from St. Louis, Philadelphia, and Baltimore -- service currently provided by TWA -- until those routes are sold to other carriers.

Like Pan Am, TWA has been in serious financial trouble for a number of years. In both cases, we have understood for some time that the sale of at least some international route authority would

be essential to the carriers' corporate survival (although not necessarily sufficient). Because both airlines' most valuable route assets were their landing rights at Heathrow, and because the sale of those assets was prohibited by our aviation agreement with the U.K., I called for a renegotiation of that agreement more than a year ago. Our objective was to ensure that our strongest carriers would be able to serve our largest overseas aviation market in the most effective way possible. Our recent accord with the U.K. fully achieved that result.

Despite press accounts of a forthcoming proposal to TWA by Mr. Kerkorian, no such proposal has been presented to the Department. Moreover, our analysts are of the view that a buy-out along the lines we have seen discussed in the press would almost certainly require TWA to file for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Act. A negotiated sale of TWA would almost certainly take time, particularly in the course of a bankruptcy proceeding. Because TWA would have to compete with both United and British Airways in the U.S.-London market during that time, the delay would almost certainly result in even greater damage to TWA and its employees.

Our best course in circumstances like these is to rely to the greatest extent possible on marketplace transactions formulated in a deregulated environment. Approval of the TWA-American route sale will help to ensure the maintenance of robust competition in our most important international aviation market, with enormous dividends for the traveling public.

I expect to transmit the decision to the White House tomorrow for Presidential review under Section 801 of the Federal Aviation Act.
