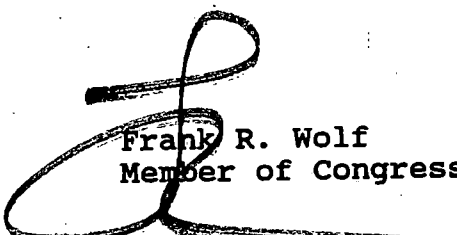

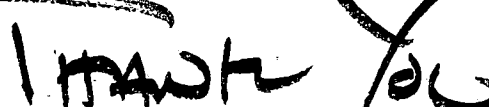
I hope you will find this information helpful as you continue to monitor and evaluate the progress of the Space Station Freedom Program.

Dear John,

As you know, the Administration has some problems with gun groups over the Brady Bill. The White House position regarding this situation is understandable as a tactical move, but the long-range implications of what they might do does not have a particularly rosy view - witness what they did to help elect Jill Long.

There is something you may want to consider to alleviate the problem. During the Korean War, the United States shipped various arms to South Korea. Some were sold for a minimal amount while others were given away on a grant basis. For example, M-1 rifles are classified under the law as curios and relics. This classification allows them to be imported. The Korean government would like to sell the M-1's and other items classified as curios and relics while gun collectors here would like to buy them.

The solution lies in 22 U.S.C. 2314 (f) which allows the President to waive that restriction.

Not only will this move help to balance the scales with the gun lobby, it has the added advantage of being a purely executive action -- Congress has nothing to do with such a waiver. You may wish to look into this.

For your convenience in obtaining an overview of the legal situation, I have attached a short explanation sheet with appropriate sections of the laws and regulations affixed.

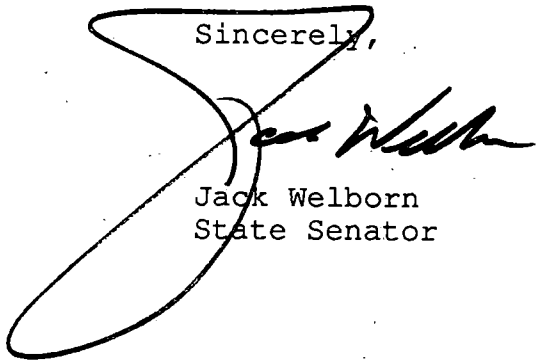

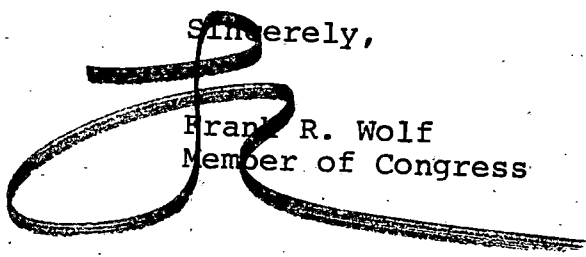

Dear Governor Sununu:

I am writing to urge the Administration's consideration and support for **increasing the dependent tax deduction for children**. Your instrumental role in securing the Young Child Tax Credit last fall was a critical breakthrough in properly redirecting the family debate toward more options and financial resources for families rather than more government rules and programs.

When this hard-earned measure is combined with the considerable expansion of the Earned Income Tax Credit, the President has already provided many families with a successful domestic policy, which unfortunately, is not given the credit it is due.

I hope to highlight these recent promising developments for families obtained in last year's budget agreement and expand this successful agenda by continuing to focus family policy on the families themselves and providing additional tax relief targeted at families with children.

On Monday April 15, the Select Committee on Children, Youth, and Families held a hearing on "Reclaiming the Tax Code for American Families." Both the majority and minority witnesses were unanimous in their support for tax relief for families with children. I have introduced legislation, H.R. 1277 -- **"THE TAX FAIRNESS FOR FAMILIES ACT OF 1991"** -- which will increase the dependent deduction for children under 18 to \$3,500 (from the 1990 level of \$2,050). We already have a wide range of bipartisan support for this measure from members such as Rep. Bill Dannemeyer, Rep. Bob Walker, Rep. Nancy Johnson, Rep. Jerry Lewis, Rep. Mike Parker, and Rep. Pat Schroeder (the new Chairman of the Select Committee on Children, Youth and Families.) Senator Coats has introduced a companion bill in the Senate, S. 701. Diverse groups such as The Heritage Foundation, The Family

Research Council, and The Progressive Policy Institute have all called for an increase in the dependent deduction for children.

With the trust of the American people and the facts on his side, President Bush can continue to assist the families of America by allowing them to keep more of their own hard-earned money to provide for their families. In fighting the war in the Gulf, General Norman Schwarzkopf noted the wisdom in allowing the military to "fight this war exactly as it should have been fought." The emphasis is that the President gave those who knew best, the autonomy and resources to do the best job and did not allow them to be hampered in their efforts by arm-chair experts and those removed from the everyday realities of war.

Similarly, in the battle to save the family, President Bush has recognized the need to provide broader latitude to those who are most directly knowledgeable and proficient in family matters -- the parents and family members themselves. As Secretary of Health and Human Services Dr. Louis Sullivan has noted, "Many have overlooked the most powerful supporter, advocate, and ally children have -- the family."

Parents today spend 40 percent less time with their children than they did a generation ago. Many of these parents are now experiencing what First Lady Barbara Bush spoke of in her Commencement Address to Wellesley last year as the "regret" at "time not spend with a husband, friend, a child or a parent." As the First Lady correctly observed, "Our sucess as a society depends...on what happens inside [our] house[s]." Unfortunately, in too many houses today, the lights are out and nobody's home.

As you know from your experience as governor of one of the most family friendly (i.e. low taxes) states, tax fairness for families is a strong and successful message for Republicans to put forward as a pro-family measure. While some Democrats would have us believe that higher taxes are the solution for better child welfare, the state of New Hampshire, for example, which ranked fifth in a recent survey on overall child well-being, contradicts this liberal shibboleth.

I look forward to working with you in getting out the message that President Bush has already provided families with much needed tax relief and I hope we can continue these positive developments with some of the following measures:

1. **TAX FAIRNESS FOR FAMILIES**

- A. **INCREASE THE DEPENDENT DEDUCTION.** The dependent deduction has dramatically eroded in value for families over the last several decades. Economist Eugene Steuerle, who played an instrumental part in the 1980s tax reform efforts, estimates that it

would be worth over \$7,800 if it had kept pace with inflation and per capita income. (See graph A attached). The **TAX FAIRNESS FOR FAMILIES ACT OF 1991** is a modest increase in the deduction for children under 18.

2. ALTERNATIVE WORK POLICIES --

Creative public and private sector policies on part-time work, job sharing, telecommuting and home-based work offer a much more attractive alternative to families with children, than does the costly, short-term benefit policy of family leave.

In many surveys working parents voice a desire for more time with their children and more flexible work policies. Mandatory family leave is a limited policy that does not address this need. Even with current economic pressures, a majority of parents of preschoolers still choose to have either a parent care for a young child or work part-time or "tag team" shifts in order to minimize parental time away from a young child. (See Graph B) Families clearly want more choices and longer term flexibility when raising children. Obviously we do not want to make these family oriented choices more difficult for families. Tax relief for families in conjunction with voluntary flexible workpolicies is the best way to provide a positive family agenda.

In my role as ranking member of the Select Committee on Children, Youth, and Families I plan to highlight such policies and develop legislative initiatives to advance these flexible work options.

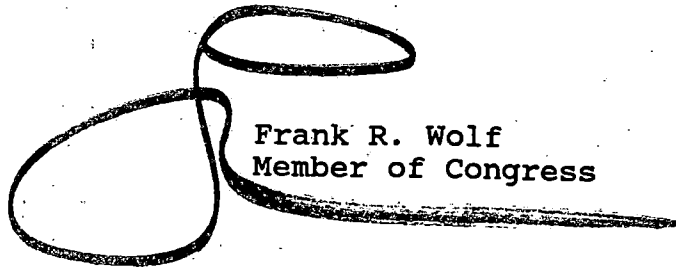
The President has so often spoken eloquently about the virtues of **strong communities**. "What government can do alone is limited, but the potential of the American people knows no limits" -- here, President Bush accurately captures the vision that most Americans hold. A recent Time magazine article supported the President's assertions in noting that there has been a 10 percent increase in charitable contributions and a 23 percent increase in volunteerism despite rough economic times. This is a domestic agenda that all Americans can be proud of and aptly illustrates the President's "thousand points of light."

A "new community order" in which families are economically

invigorated and called upon as a resource to serve their communities is a promising future for America's children and families. Reinvesting in families instead of more government programs is the way to build this new order. **THE TAX FAIRNESS FOR FAMILIES ACT OF 1991** is a first step on a road to economic freedom for families.

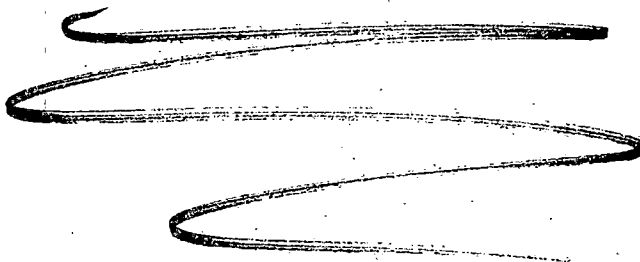

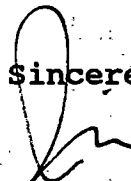
As you know, the President and Mrs. Bush are entertaining a group of supporters of the Kennedy Center on Monday, April 22.

The American Gem Trade Association (AGTA), a not-for-profit trade organization representing 500 direct importers and wholesale gemstone distributors in the U. S., needs your help.

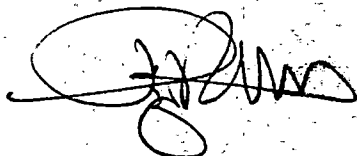
It is our understanding that the U. S. government is considering an embargo on imports of cultured pearls from Japan in connection with a Pelly Amendment certification.

Pearls play an important role in the American jewelry industry. To the \$105 million worth of pearls imported annually, we Americans add \$600 million worth of clasps, re-stringing, manufacturing into finished jewelry, insurance, transportation, and profit. In addition, Japan's cultured pearl industry is the sole market for \$15 million worth of fresh-water shells harvested from rivers and lakes in the American mid-west and southwest. These shells are made into the nuclei around which Japanese oysters form their pearl. The U. S. shell industry would collapse if sanctions were placed on Japanese cultured pearls.

We believe the proposed embargo will inflict far more damage to American importers, wholesalers, manufacturers, and retail jewelers than on the target of the certification.

Neither our Association nor our members approve of or endorse Japan's violations which led to the Pelly Amendment certifications, but we request your assistance in preventing the imposition of sanctions against a product which provides employment for approximately 125 American importers, 4,000 jewelry manufacturers, and 35,000 retail jewelers in the United States.

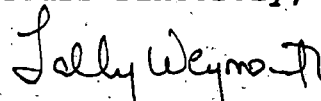

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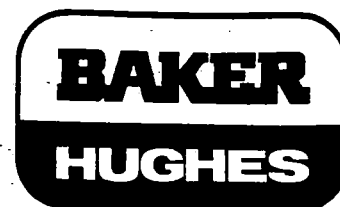

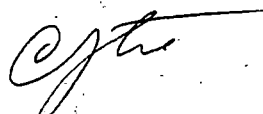

SUBJECT: Superconducting Super Collider (SSC)

John:

I have heard that the President will be meeting with Prime Minister Kaifu of Japan sometime in the near future. It is extremely important that the SSC be included on their agenda.

Japan has indicated to us that they will not seriously consider funding support (we are asking for \$ 2 billion), unless the issue is raised at that level. On two previous occasions, the SSC has been in the briefing book for the President, but was not raised. The Vice-President was also prepared, but was unable to discuss the issue at his last meeting with Kaifu.

We are under real pressure by the Congress to show progress in foreign participation in the SSC. Unless Japan agrees to contribute, there may not be adequate foreign support to meet the one-third target for non-federal funding. Congress could seriously damage, if not destroy the project this year with an inadequate appropriation and may do so if convinced there is little likelihood for international funding.

Ichiro Ozawa, Secretary General of the Liberal Democratic Party in Japan, is in town this week and may be meeting with the President and/or Secretary Baker. The mention of the SSC at that meeting would also be very beneficial as he is most influential.

I will be sending a similar note regarding this matter to President Bush on Friday.

I am writing this letter with a deep concern for Transnational Association of Christian Schools. I believe that it is very important the TRACS be recognized by the Secretary of Education, because there is a large percentage of Americans who are conservative Christians and are interested in the recognition of TRACS.

There is an overwhelming need for TRACS, because there are literally hundreds, and even perhaps close to a thousand schools that are not what they should be and they use the fact that they are religious non profit schools to reject accreditation by secular organizations, such as a regional accrediting agency.

If TRACS was in place and recognized, it would be a vehicle to help those schools improve and be what they should be, and actually become what they say they are. This would help a large portion of the constituency that has elected the last two Presidents of the United States.

TRACS is substantially in compliance with all criteria, except for one sub point of one criterion. This sub point relates to recognition by other agencies.

It is my opinion that a requirement that other agencies recognize TRACS before the U.S. Department of Education will recognize TRACS has the door open for a conspiracy of existing agencies. After all, if they never recognize TRACS, that's fine.

Even recognition for a period of two years would provide TRACS time to meet that one last criterion.

I hope that you will do what is possible to help TRACS in relation to this dilemma.

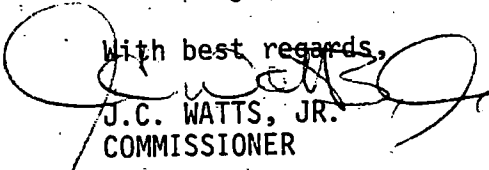

On March 12, the Administration will testify at the House National Parks and Public Lands Subcommittee hearing on the grazing fee issue. This letter is to request a strong statement from the White House in favor of retaining the current grazing fee formula.

As Senators representing states where livestock grazing on federal lands is a mainstay of the economy, we are decidedly alarmed about legislation that might damage its economic viability.

The grazing fee formula established by the Public Rangeland Improvement Act of 1978 (PRIA) adjusts the grazing fee up or down according to livestock prices, forage values and production costs. When economic conditions are favorable, the fee goes up. When profitability declines, the fee moves accordingly.

Continuing the current PRIA formula is crucial to maintaining the vitality of western livestock operators and the economies of rural western communities.

President Reagan signed Executive Order 12548 which set forth the PRIA formula. President Bush, during his 1988 campaign, stated that he and his administration would continue to support this critical measure.

Unfortunately, the PRIA formula is consistently under attack by non-western Democrats in Congress. In fact, the House Subcommittee on National Parks and Public Lands will hold a hearing on grazing fee increase bills sponsored by Congressmen Darden and Synar that will be, if enacted, devastating to western livestock communities.

The Departments of Agriculture and Interior have both been requested to testify at this hearing and their testimony will affect our ability to defend the PRIA formula in the Senate later this year.

Although both Departments were solidly in favor of our position on similar bills at the House hearing on April 11, 1989, the Administration's stated position was weakened after it was reviewed by OMB. Needless to say, this was a great disappointment to Western Republicans who have been the strongest supporters of the Administration's legislative agenda.

This year we have watched as the Forest Service expresses a heightened emphasis on recreation. While we encourage the careful development of all our resources, we are adamant in our position that a recreational focus does not weaken the Administration's support for the current grazing fee formula. Enthusiasm for recreation cannot be allowed to lessen the traditional multiple-use of public lands.

At a time when resistance to certain federal natural resource policies has the potential of reigniting a Sagebrush Rebellion, we urge the Administration on March 12 to testify strongly against the Synar and Darden bills and in support of the Marlenee-Campbell bill that legislatively codifies President Reagan's 1986 Executive Order.

The President's support of this fundamental element of our western economy is truly critical.

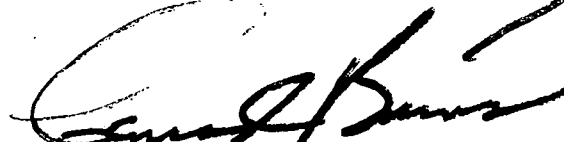

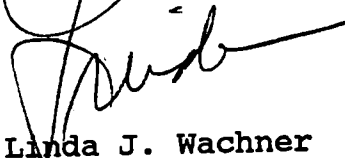

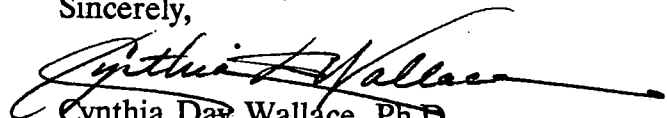

I want to follow up my February 14, 1991 letter to the President on federal nursing home provisions in OBRA '87 and, specifically, to provide you more information on the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA) mandated interpretive guidelines.

As you know, to obtain Medicare or Medicaid reimbursement, nursing homes must comply with federal statutory requirements and any clarifying regulations HCFA adopts through the Administrative Procedures Act (APA). In addition, HCFA requires the state survey agencies to use a specific "survey process" to evaluate the nursing homes' compliance with the law and regulation. Within this survey process, which has not been adopted through the APA, HCFA mandates with great specificity resident sample size and sampling methodology, forms to be completed by surveyors, and information gathering techniques to be used. Also, as part of the survey process, HCFA has written interpretive guidelines which HCFA claims are for clarifying and background material only and contain no requirements on facilities but must be used by state surveyors.

We disagree that these guidelines impose no requirements on facilities. I have attached three examples of literally dozens of new requirements found in the interpretive guidelines which impose both requirements and costs on facilities.

In sum, we object strenuously to HCFA imposing requirements on facilities without complying with the APA, the Paperwork Reduction Act, and other laws intended to ensure public and state input and cost-benefit analysis.

The new survey process, estimated to take three times the length of the current survey process, was mandated by HCFA without complying with the APA or the federal court decision in Smith v. Bowen, which ordered that standards and forms used in facility evaluation be promulgated as regulations. HCFA also has announced its intent to adopt a surveyor competency test based on the interpretive guidelines which all surveyors nationwide must pass -- again, without complying with the APA.

In addition to our concern that HCFA has not properly promulgated substantive new requirements as regulations in accordance with the federal APA, the State of California faces a major fiscal impact due to the interpretive guidelines. This occurs in three ways:

- ° The costs associated with facility compliance with the interpretive guidelines. While HCFA argues that the interpretive guidelines impose no new requirements on facilities, it is absurd to argue that guidelines used by surveyors will not affect facility behavior and, therefore, costs. In fact, the California Association of Health Facilities has filed a motion for summary judgment in a U.S. District Court, Eastern District of California, case (no. CIV-5-1226 EJG EM), Valdivia et al v. Kizer, Sullivan, and Wilensky, requesting the court to order immediate payment of \$442 million for costs for facilities to implement OBRA '87-- costs primarily due to interpretive guidelines.
- ° HCFA is withholding federal financial participation (over \$9 million) for surveyor staff because California is not using the interpretive guidelines.
- ° HCFA also plans to withhold federal financial participation for Medicaid payments to facilities which have not been surveyed (or re-surveyed) using the interpretive guidelines. When applied to the 1,200 facilities in California, this decision would result in a loss of \$1 billion in federal financial participation (50 percent of the \$2 billion California spends annually for nursing home services).

As a former Governor, you can appreciate California's dilemma. Instead of mandating administrative requirements not required by either law or regulation, the federal government should encourage states to use less costly processes to ensure compliance when they are available. HCFA should be an advocate for states in this regard.

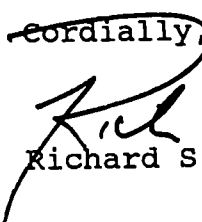

I am writing to follow-up on our conversations regarding the administration sponsoring a series of international trade expositions in major cities around the United States.

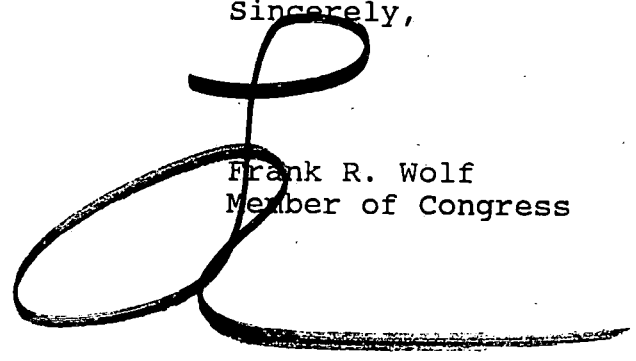

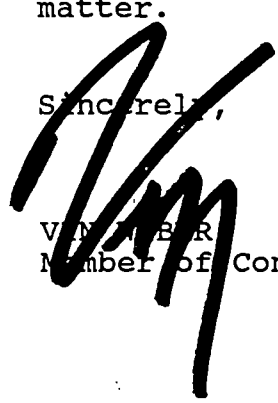

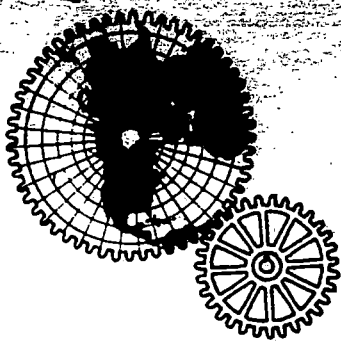

Dear Governor:

I'm delighted to hear your getting along so well with Ted Forstmann, one of the true financial wizards of our time. I count Michael Milken as another, but alas, Mike is not available for consultation at this time. The big difference between Ted and the other Big Names on Wall Street is that he is an Entrepreneur, not a corporate bureaucrat who climbed an internal ladder. He sees things from angles that others never thought about, which is what enabled him to amass a fortune of megamillions from a standing start. I think I mentioned to Ed Rogers that he almost surely would have been Jack's Treasury Secretary, but don't hold that against him.

The problem you have with Treasury's banking reform is that it was designed by a Harvard professor of finance, with help from a Comptroller of the Currency whose experience is just as narrow and specialized. The Secretary himself has only a lofty perspective and is unable to properly critique the handiwork of Messrs. Glauber and Clark. Dick Breeden, like Nick Brady a terrific guy, is just a lawyer. Bill Seidman has more raw savvy than the rest of the bunch and has a more hands-on understanding of how things work at the level of Main Street America. He lacks sophisticated expertise in economics, though, which keeps him from being top drawer. Wayne Angell, like Forstmann, has it all - a farmer, a country banker, a professor of economics, a politician and legislator, and now an internationally respected central banker. Which is how he has been able to dominate the Fed since he has been there, often to the consternation of those at Treasury who have neither his experience nor his vision. Just a thought for you.

Congratulations on dreaming up the Greenspan Commission and trumping Treasury with it. We can call the Wall Street rally the Sununu Bull Market! Let us keep it going to the moon!
