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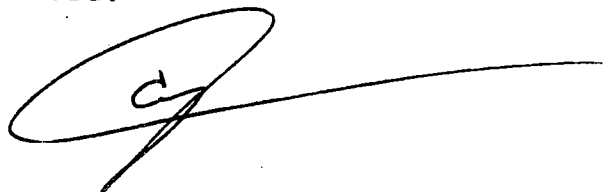

John, I'm getting ready to head for Florida where we'll spend the next three days firing up our State Chairmen. Before I leave I thought I should pass on some Hill feedback on the fast track issue, for whatever it may be worth.

Nick Ashmore, who works for Tom Foley, called this morning to discuss the matter because Foley is trying to be helpful. (I've known Ashmore for many years.) He said that he hoped I'd do everything I could to encourage the Administration to send back a helpful letter to Bentsen and Rostenkowski. In other words, he pleaded that we give them as much ammunition as possible to use in neutralizing labor union pressures.

Specifically Ashmore asked if the Administration couldn't indicate a willingness to put what he called "fail safe" mechanisms in the agreement. I told him that the trade policy jargon for this is "safeguards," and that we did build some of those in the U.S.-Canada Agreement. I said that Carla Hills probably will not wish to make definitive commitments on this or anything else before the negotiations begin, but perhaps she could indicate a willingness to negotiate such provisions if they seemed necessary and appropriate. I'll pass on that recommendation to Carla, who apparently has been cool to the idea thus far.

A couple of hours later I had a call from a representative of the MTN Coalition, the business group that is supporting the negotiations. They wanted to get the word to you that: (1) Carla's allegedly brusque manner may be costing some votes; (2) they had heard that the response to Bentsen and Rostenkowski may be confrontational, which also worries them. Finally, they're picking up reports that some Democrats are again suggesting separate votes on the Uruguay Round and the U.S.-Mexico Agreement.

All of this may be just rumormongering, but I pass it on for evaluation in your shop.

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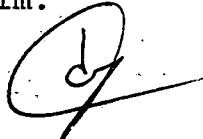

If the video can not be, we would be most appreciative to receive a letter from the White House which we could publish in our local newspapers and read over the air during the ceremony.

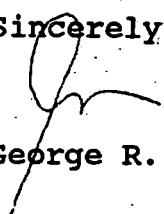

Dear Governor Sununu:

I am writing to request that you call EPA Administrator William Reilly to direct EPA to continue discussions with the wood preserving industry on a regulation affecting it. I hope that these discussions will achieve a more cost effective regulation that meets the President's FY 1992 Budget goals and provide adequate compliance time.

On December 6, 1990, EPA promulgated a final rule for the industry which the President's Budget has identified as the least cost effective regulation in over 20 years. The regulation's cost per premature death averted, according to the Budget, is \$5.7 trillion. EPA and the industry are currently discussing implementation issues raised by the final rule including unreasonable compliance deadlines. It will simply be impossible for most wood preserving facilities to meet a June 6, 1991 deadline.

In 1989 and 1990, I was among 150 Members of Congress who strongly urged EPA to regulate the wood preserving industry using an integrated, multi-statute approach. EPA has ignored these Congressional requests and has promulgated a cost-ineffective, RCRA-only regulation that is no more protective of human health and the environment than alternatives proposed by the industry and rejected by EPA.

Industry-wide capital expenditures for the EPA regulation could be as high as \$5 billion, easily exceeding more than twice the estimated net value of the industry. Most wood preserving companies have insufficient capital to meet the EPA regulation's costs. EPA's final rule will force a significant number of plant closings within the industry.

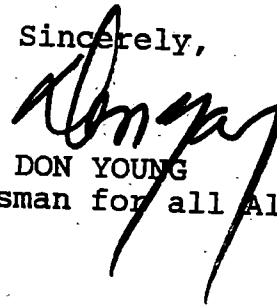

EPA has been told of the potential economic harm that could result from its actions and has acknowledged that some of the rule's negative effects were not intended. In this vein, EPA should work diligently to address industry's legitimate concerns.

Dear Mr. Sununu,

I am writing to express our concerns about the proposed "Fair Trade in Financial Services Act," which may be discussed in the upcoming conference between the Senate and the House of Representatives on the Defense Production Act.

Our specific concern is over the legislation's grandfathering provisions. As Sir Leon Brittan, Vice President of the EC Commission noted during his recent visit here, it has been suggested that the lack of complete grandfathering in the draft legislation was aimed at one country rather than another, and the European Community need have no fear. The same argument was used before 1989 by Europe towards the United States, which correctly rejected it at the time. Similarly, we should not accept it from you. To be effective, grandfathering must be unconditional.

I have enclosed a copy of a letter I sent to the Senate leadership in October, which expressed our broader objections.

I hope that both you and the conferees will seriously consider our views and will support modifications to the bill's language, where appropriate.

Dear Senator Mitchell:

I am writing in regard to the proposed "Fair Trade in Financial Services Act", which has been attached as an amendment to the Defense Production Act. I understand that the conference report (HR 486) may be considered by the Senate as early as today.

Although you may have heard that the "Fair Trade in Financial Services Act" is consistent with banking legislation adopted by the European Community and that the EC therefore has no problem with the proposed bill, I am writing on behalf of the EC Commission to emphasize that there are in fact significant differences between EC policy and the legislation soon to come before the Senate.

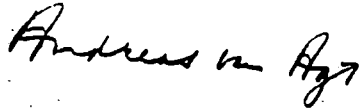
The Community's provision are part of the EC 1992 program, which is bringing about comprehensive liberalization in the financial services area and will provide unparalleled opportunities for banking firms, including those from the United States. It is unfortunate that the proposed bill would not provide for greater liberalization of financial services. We also regret that the bill places such a strong emphasis on reciprocity rather than national treatment, contrary to the approach taken by the EC.

Our more specific objections concern the grandfathering provisions, which could unfairly restrict the operations of European banks already established in the US. In Europe, established US banks will automatically enjoy the benefits of our Single Market Program without such restrictions. This legislation does not provide an equivalent right to EC institutions, and unless amended could therefore become a source of unnecessary conflict in the future.

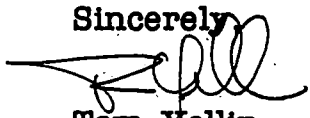
Dear Governor Sununu:

I am taking you up on your suggestion in your letter of February 22, 1991. We have another idea that we are enthusiastic about and believe will be much easier to accomplish. Our goal is the same, to produce a documentary that reveals the President's decision making process during the Gulf war.

But this time all we are asking is for the opportunity to interview the President and his principal advisers, and to have access to official White House photographs. The documentary would be put together using the descriptions of crucial meetings when key decisions were made. We would illustrate these descriptions with the photographs taken by the White House photographer. There would be no outside interviews, no editorializing, and no outside experts analyzing the results of those decisions. The story would be told by the President and his advisors, in a way that accurately reflects the historic decisions that were made, in the words of the men who made them.

This approach takes into consideration many of the concerns you raised at our meeting last month. It also will accomplish our goal of recording for history the decisions that guided the war effort. If you think this project has merit we would like your guidance about how best to proceed.

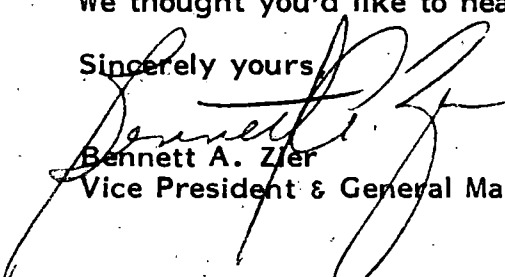

John, as you recall we discussed at our Wednesday Strategy Group meeting a couple of weeks ago the desirability of briefing subcabinet members on the President's budget, and Dick Darman was charged with getting that done. We talked a little bit about doing that with other key issues too, and the purpose of this memo is simply to encourage and foster that thought within the White House.

As we near 1992, it is important to have both the Cabinet and subcabinet at least reasonably tooled up on domestic policy issues. They'll not likely incorporate all of them in their speeches and other presentations, but they will do some, particularly if they feel comfortable with their level of knowledge.

We can certainly add to that level of knowledge if they receive succinct written briefing materials on all the key issues, and a verbal briefing on those that are particularly important to the Administration.

You may wish to task Roger Porter or someone on the White House staff to evaluate on a continual basis which issues merit verbal briefings, and then to schedule those at the OEOB. As you know, there are some recent candidates in banking reform, transportation, the forthcoming energy strategy, etc.

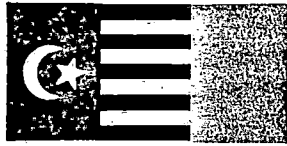

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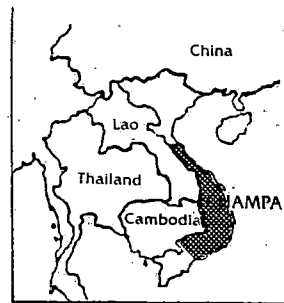
