Dear Mr. Sununu,

I hope you will spare me a few minutes to help resolve a matter both personal and national. It is about the yacht Sequoia, of which I was commanding officer from 1983 to 1988.

In June I wrote to the President, (reprinted copy enclosed), but to date I have had no reply, no doubt due to the great volume of mail he receives and the pressure of work. In any case, I would appreciate it if you would review the enclosed letter and give me some guidance.

As of July 9th, the yacht ownership passed to Norshipco. Charles Eure, President and CEO of Norshipco has stated to me that he hopes, "the vessel will (yet) take her place in Washington as originally planned." He added: "I guess we live in eternal hope of this occurring."

I feel that if this is to occur, through her being donated back to the Navy, presidential interest in her must be expressed. That would enable those of us who want this historic presidential yacht preserved and again used, to try to put together a consortium to donate the yacht to the Navy.

Perhaps you could determine if there is presidential interest in having her donated and if so, suggest to me an appropriate procedure of making this known to potential donors..

This note is about the ex-presidential yacht SEQUOIA.

From 1983 to 1988 I was her commander and was aboard when you cruised in her with the Vice Premier of China. Many other members of the cabinet and leaders of Congress also made good use of the SEQUOIA during my watch.

As perhaps you know, in 1988 the yacht was scheduled to be returned to the Navy as a gift for presidential use. The Navy was preparing to receive her. However, the transfer did not happen because her owner, The Presidential Yacht Trust, was deeply in debt.

The yacht is now laid up at Norshipco in Norfolk where she is being well taken care of by the yard. However, the CEO of Norshipco has recently informed me she will be put up for auction around July 9th to pay off her debts.

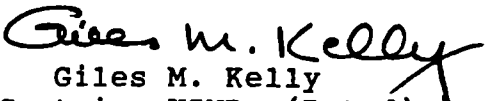
Since she is such a special yacht, I believe a consortium of "Friends of the Sequoia" could be formed to buy the yacht and to donate her to the government, if there was a statement of presidential interest in having the yacht available.

In such case, I want to try to organize a consortium to bid on the yacht for the purpose of returning her to the government.

As her history shows, the yacht is not just a luxury. She provides a modest, but elegant way to entertain official visitors. She also provides a handy, secure and intimate place for meetings.

I have absolutely no financial interest in the yacht, but as her former commander, I have a sentimental attachment to her and would like to see her back in presidential service.

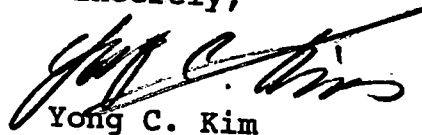
Dear Mr. Sununu:

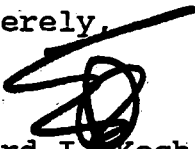

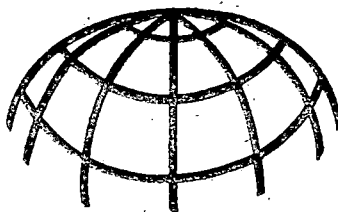

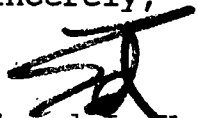
I think the press is treating you unfairly. Since the President is so popular, he is not subject to their attacks, and it frustrates them.

Dear John:

I believe, and suspect you do as well, that in addition to H.R.1, the issue that will overwhelmingly dominate presidential electoral politics will be the need for comprehensive national health insurance. Everyone agrees -- no matter what their party -- that we cannot continue to deny affordable medical coverage to 35 million Americans and we should examine how to improve the programs now covering more than 200 million Americans.

I am 67. Having served both the city and federal governments, I am now covered not only by Medicare but by several other private sector and governmental medical benefit programs, and I have seen how those benefits protect me. I have had a stroke, prostate problems and arterial fibrillation, all of which required medical attention, and I incurred large medical expenditures, all paid for by insurance companies.

Those lacking such coverage are truly fearful of the cataclysmic impact on their families if they become seriously ill. With so many countries -- Great Britain, Canada, Scandinavia, Germany, France, Israel and Japan -- providing national health coverage in different degrees, we should be able to learn from their experience and devise the best plan involving both the private and public sectors. We should not get caught up in ideology or phrases such as "socialized medicine."

President Bush should select 10 to 15 of the most competent people to deal with this issue. This panel would be given a deadline of six months to one year to examine all of the major health plans in the countries named above. Using this information, the panelists would fashion the best plan they can which would provide universal medical coverage and set limits on the medical care to be provided, e.g. fees; limiting the availability of diagnostic tools such as MRIs to regions; similarly, limiting specialty programs so as to reduce the costly duplication in performing transplants; braking physician visitation through co-payment requirements; permitting a denial of extended expensive treatment where appropriate as they do in England for kidney dialysis so as to provide maximum dollars for the entire population; and limiting expenditure growth to inflation. I could go on, but the purpose of this letter is to outline what I have in mind.

You may wonder why I, a Democrat, would urge the President to take an action that can only redound to his credit and assist him in his re-election campaign. The answer is obvious and simple. The issue of health care should not be viewed from a parochial standpoint. It is too important. We must face the fact that nothing will be done without the President's involvement and commitment. If he benefits by producing legislation that will deal with this most important issue in a satisfactory way, then so be it. Isn't that the best kind of politics? Besides, there are so many issues on which the Democrats can assail the President that eliminating one, even though it's one of the most important, will not be decisive.

Administration support of this bill would greatly compliment the work of the President's Competitiveness Council in trying to rein in excessive government regulation. The bill seeks to enhance OIRA's role in reducing the paperwork and regulatory burdens imposed upon the public.

Our bill enjoys broad support from the business community. I hope the Administration can join us in our effort to give business and the public some relief from the government's incessant need for more paper.

For your information, I have enclosed a copy of a recent op-ed on this issue.

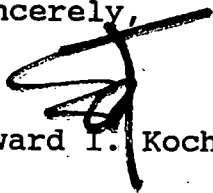

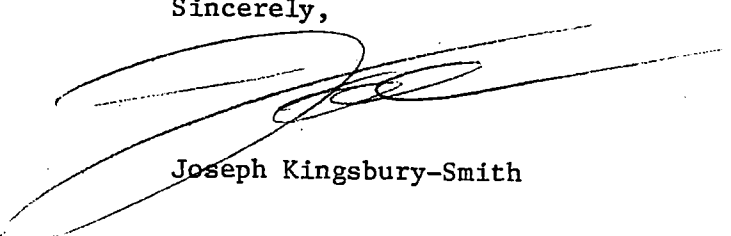

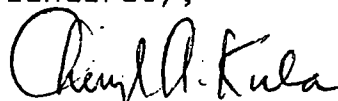

The consul and press attache of the German Consulate General in New York, Detlev Peters, will be leaving in August and return to the Bavarian state government as a counselor. Peters has served several terms in the United States for a total of 12 years and he spent a year at Georgetown University.

Peters and I have been friends for two decades and I can say that he is the most pro-American German diplomat I have met. His children are more American than German and his daughter plans to remain in the U.S. His outspokenness on certain elements of German foreign policy, especially Bonn's position during the Gulf war, has not, to put it mildly, endeared him to Genscher. The fact that he is a Christian Democrat and was one of Strauss' top aides hasn't helped him either.

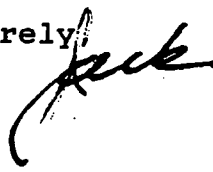
Peters is also an incredibly talented painter and has had many exhibition in the U.S. When Germany was re-united, he produced a painting of the Nikolai Church in Leipzig and named it "Birthplace of the Revolution -- Nikolai Church".

Peters told me that he would like to present the painting to the American people in appreciation for their support of unification. Would it be possible -- and this is my idea -- for the President to spare a minute to receive the painting? Or perhaps the Vice President could stand in. In any event, Peters would like to bring the painting to the White House. I enclose a photograph of the painting and a brief CV of Peters.

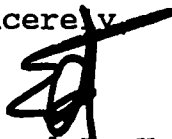

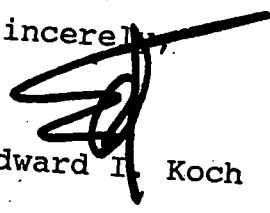

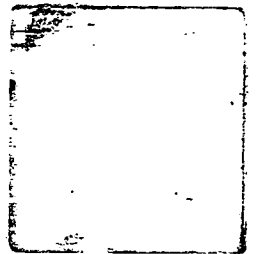

The Luftwaffe has approached the State Department and the Pentagon about locating an airforce training base stateside. Enclosed is a photocopy of a relevant New York article as well as a letter from Deutsche Aerospace AG to me. I favor this project providing a Luftwaffe stateside training base can be linked to promoting the exchange and establishment of German applied sciences, engineering, and training programs among American defense corporations, universities, and trade schools. I would greatly appreciate it if you, the President, the Vice President, and Secretary's Baker and Chen should consider the benefits Long Island's economy and educational environment would derive if the Navy would lease its Calerton base to Germany. A substantial

training and research base could fill the gap
left by Grumman's declining defense position.
Alcoa could place students and faculty at
nearby BNL, SUNY Stony Brook, Polytechnic
University, New York Institute of Technology,
and Dowling College. As part of this deal,
Dowling-Bey AG should be compelled to locate
a manufacturing plant nearby. This would
improve opportunities for long skilled machinists.
Naturally, Alcoa should be carefully
monitored by the Pentagon.

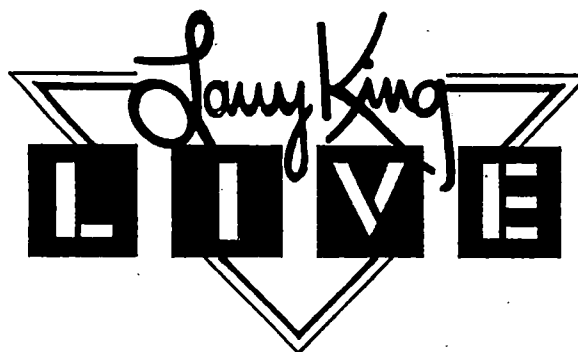
