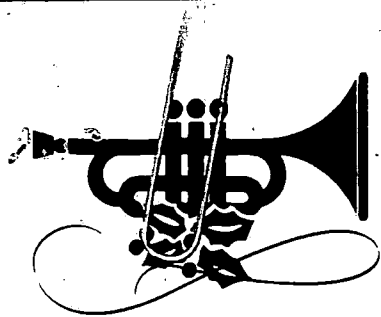

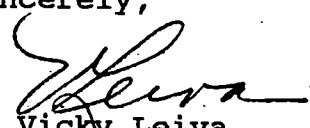

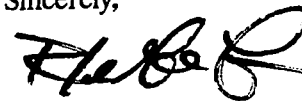

This letter follows up on our July 12 conversation and Bob Grady's letter of the same date in reply to my July 10 correspondence on the Administration's position on natural gas imports. While I appreciate the promptness of Bob's reply, the artful nature of the substance of the reply compels this rebuttal. I cannot allow the absence of a rebuttal to be misunderstood as agreement with the contents of the reply.

At the outset, I acknowledge several positive aspects to Bob's letter. Most notably, it is heartening to be reassured that the Administration opposes the Wirth-Domenici amendment to S. 1220, including the transfer of jurisdiction over natural gas imports from the Department of Energy to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

The most disturbing aspect of Bob's July 12 reply is that it avoids the central matters about which I wrote you in the first place. The reply invites my "careful focus" on the legislative language sent to Senator Domenici, yet most of my concerns were not about the legislative language itself. Instead, I wrote you on July 10 primarily because Bob's July 3 cover letter to Senator Domenici was being interpreted as putting the full weight of the Administration behind the IPAA position on the "rate tilt" issue despite the contrary views of the interagency working group. You should know that a member of Bob's own staff admitted that the interagency working group did not approve the cover letter to Senator Domenici and the status it gave to the legislative language which accompanied it. The fact that the July 12 reply is silent on these matters is deafening.

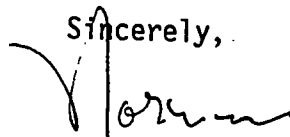
In addition, I confess to being disappointed by the extent of the written clarification of the status of the legislative language which accompanied Bob's July 3 letter to Senator Domenici. Bob's July 12 reply to me states "if indeed language on this subject is going to be included in the National Energy Strategy bill," which suggests that the Administration does not believe that Congress should legislate in this area. Senior officials at the White House and the Department of Energy have been more direct in the weeks since this flap began in verbally stating to me their view that no legislation should be enacted on the so-called "rate tilt" issue. It would have been better had Bob simply made that statement in his July 12 reply, a statement which trade press reports indicate was in a draft reply prepared by the interagency working group. Absent such a

Bob's July 12 reply put his comments to Senator Domenici in context by stating that, "[w]hether and to what extent competitive distortions result from different rate policies, and the appropriate remedy, are complex matters," to be addressed on a case-by-case basis at FERC. Since the Administration has not opined on whether there is a "rate tilt" in particular cases, it is inappropriate for IPAA to be citing the July 3 Grady letter in such cases, as it has done several times in pleadings filed at FERC in recent weeks. Given the confusion it is causing, I strongly suggest that Bob either withdraw his July 3 letter, write FERC Chairman Martin Allday, or contact IPAA, to put a stop to the use of the July 3 letter for propositions (i.e., whether there is a rate tilt in particular cases) for which Bob's July 12 reply indicates he did not intend. I would appreciate being advised of actions taken in this regard.

Thank you for your continuing attention to this important matter.

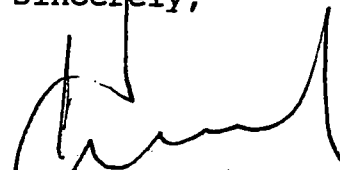

I am writing this letter, hoping that you will be able to help a guajiro who is tired of fighting; (but has not given up), the federal bureaucracy to obtain work, as a consultant.

I applied to the Small Business Administration for approval to participate in the 8(a) program. After almost three years of fighting: but not before I had to appeal to their own appeals court, the SBA approved me. (Their Appeals Court found the disapproval to be: Capricious, Arbitrary, and Contrary to Law). Even after their own court ruled in my favor, they dragged their feet for over 7 months. Finally, Congressman Schulze, R,PA, helped expedite things. My own representatives, Dyson and Mikulski, did not help at all.

The SBA has not been very effective in their assistance, I don't know if it is because of my winning appeal, my heritage, or my personality. One thing I can tell you, it is not because of my abilities, or experience. (Please see attached mini resume).

What can you do for me?, I really dont know: but it feels good to write to another guajiro in a position way out of my league, with una esperanza, even if remote.

I would be happy if there was an opportunity to demonstrate my ability to help a federal agency implement Total Quality Management. Now the federal agencies are hiring companies that became experts on the subject, five minutes after the government showed interest in it. The Federal Quality Institute refuses to allow my company to get in their register of available consultants, yet their present roster contains mostly, if not all, "sietemesino" experts, and no minority firms. The SBA itself is planning to advertise for TQM services, and although they coerce others to reserve certain contracts for 8(a) firms, they will not do so for my company (According to their Baltimore office).

John, even if you cannot help me, Joyce, and I would like to extend an invitation to visit us for an experience you will not forget. (Maryland softshell crabs, frijoles negros, Paella, and other cuban favorites). We feel that you might want to get away from the "swamp, and the alligators" for a relaxing R&R, and we are only two hours away next to St. Mary's City, Maryland.

If we dont get to meet you, remember that many of us are very proud of you, support you, and pray for you.

Dear John,

I recently asked Allen Bromley for a little practical political advice regarding the President, and he said that only you could provide useful counsel. (Allen's pretty good about keeping our PCAST team out of the political maelstrom, but my problem is outside of his territory.)

I am in communication with President Vaclav Havel, who was scheduled to speak at Lehigh last April, but postponed his U.S. trip due to tensions in Slovakia. He and I met last October, but current communications come to me via Rector Radim Palous of Charles University and Professor Zdenek Slouka of Lehigh University. Through these channels I was asked to encourage President Bush to accept the suggestion that will come (or has come), to him through official channels to meet with President Havel this fall in Bethlehem, PA, founded 250 years ago by the Moravians and the site today of Moravian College as well as Lehigh University. Apparently Havel's instincts are excited by the image of two "education presidents" on the Lehigh University campus celebrating the past and the future of higher education.

I'll resist the temptation to develop Havel's theme, but there is much to be said in its favor. I wrote the requested letter to President Bush on 25 June, and he has received letters of encouragement to visit Bethlehem from Drew Lewis and Walt Williams initiated by Moravian College. In this letter to you I should get directly to the point.

Havel's people have also asked me to arrange for invitations to their president from the President of Moravian College, Mayor of Bethlehem (a promising Republican named Ken Smith), and the Governor of Pennsylvania.

I have hesitated to involve Governor Casey, whom I know well from my service on his Economic Development Partnership Board. In my letter to our President I presumed to suggest that Dick Thornburgh's campaign might benefit from sharing the platform with Presidents Bush and Havel just before the election in this key region of the state, on the campus where his grandfather once taught mathematics. But I can't involve both Governor Casey and our President's party in President Havel's visit here; I must make a choice.

If I knew that the proposed joint meeting of the presidents in Bethlehem was a realistic possibility, I would not accept the suggestion from Havel's people that I involve Governor Casey. On the other hand, if I knew that the proposed joint meeting was impossible, I would move quickly to encourage Governor Casey (who might include Senator Wofford).

How can I find out which way to move? Apparently only John Sununu can sensibly estimate the probabilities that should guide me here.

I realize that the President's schedule is always a delicate matter, and in this case both domestic and international politics are involved. You may prefer to counsel me by telephone. I hope therefore that this letter will serve as background for a telephone conversation to follow.

You're traveling with the President now, I believe, and should expect to hear from me when you return. Alternatively, you may wish to call me at the office (215-758-3157) or at home (215-758-3299). I will be most appreciative.

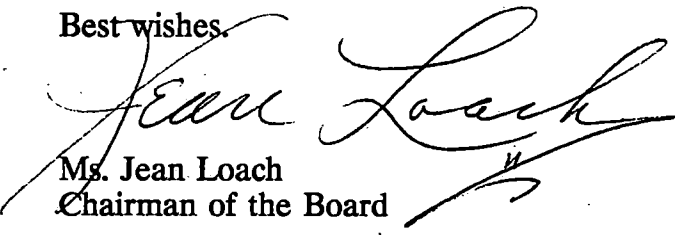

Dear Governor Sununu:

This letter is prompted by the correspondence from Robert Grady of the Office of Management and Budget to Senator Pete Domenici last week on natural gas imports from Canada. Mr. Grady's letter and its attachment, if left uncorrected, would result in higher natural gas rates for American consumers. My deep regret upon learning of this letter was only magnified by the fact that it is in direct conflict with what I am told were the decisions of the interagency working group charged with handling this issue and representations made to me as recently as two days before the letter was sent.

Bringing more natural gas to the Northeast, whether domestic or imported, is one of my top priorities in the Congress. To help accomplish that objective, the Chairman of the Rules Committee, Joe Moakley, and I started the Northeast Gas Congressional Caucus. The caucus monitored the process at FERC which resulted in the issuance of a certificate to the Iroquois Gas Transmission System last year and similarly favorable action by FERC on other Northeast natural gas projects.

As you may know, Senators Wirth and Domenici added an amendment to S. 1220 on natural gas imports during mark-up in the Senate Energy Committee earlier this year. The Administration opposes this amendment and with good reason. Aside from violating the FTA with Canada, the amendment runs counter to the National Energy Strategy, which calls for deregulation of natural gas imports and exports.

I was aware that the interagency working group was drafting language for Senator Domenici's consideration at his request to take the place of the Wirth-Domenici amendment. Presumably, this request was made in light of the strong objections to the amendment registered by the Administration, the Government of Canada, and other affected parties, and the recognition that the Wirth-Domenici amendment faced rough sledding on the Senate floor and in the House. I was given express assurances by Administration officials responsible for handling this issue that any language developed by the working group would not constitute an Administration proposal. I was similarly told that there would be no change in the Administration's oft-stated position that this type of amendment is not necessary and that pipeline rate design matters are best left to FERC on a case-by-case basis under existing law and the pending "mega-NOPR" proceeding.

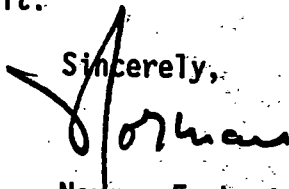

In light of these assurances, you can appreciate my sense of shock and disappointment upon learning that Mr. Grady's letter appears to advocate the draft legislative language, thus changing the Administration's involvement from something akin to technical drafting assistance into a full blown endorsement of the Wirth-Domenici position. I refer specifically to the second paragraph of Mr. Grady's letter in which he purports to put the Administration on the side of the Independent Petroleum Association of America in its dispute with U.S. consumers and local utilities over pipeline rate design matters. The energy trade press is already characterizing Mr. Grady's letter as a request to adopt the draft legislative language. Is that what the Administration intended?

I hope you will look into this matter, determine how it happened, and take such action as you deem appropriate. At a minimum, I request the Administration clarify its position on natural gas imports. Is it the Administration's position that Congress should enact the language Mr. Grady sent to Senator Domenici? In other words, is the draft legislative language an Administration proposal? If so, how do you reconcile this language with the text of the proposed National Energy Strategy Act which would deregulate imports? What impact will implementation of the language Mr. Grady sent to Senator Domenici have on residential consumer rates?

I look forward to hearing from you with what I trust will be a clarification that will put Mr. Grady's letter and its attachment in their proper perspective. While I appreciate the many demands on your time, mark-up of this issue is likely in the Subcommittee on Energy and Power on July 17, 1991. Thus, a response before that date would be particularly helpful to avoid any unnecessary confusion at the mark-up about the status of Mr. Grady's letter and the legislative language attached to it.

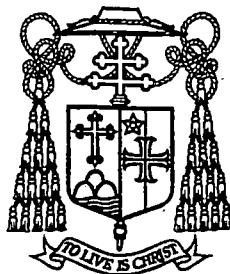

Since that time he has twice been contacted by Chase Untermeyer's office requesting his resume and test scores both of which were forwarded.

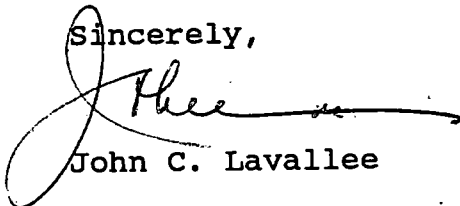

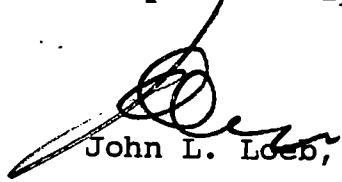

I am writing to request your assistance on an energy trade matter with the Japanese. For the past several years my firm has represented the Yukon Pacific Corporation and its parent, CSX Corporation. Yukon proposes to liquify natural gas from the North Slope of Alaska and ship it to the Pacific Rim, and has received its export license and its right-of-way.

This project will have enormous trade benefits. It will reduce the annual trade deficit with the Pacific Rim by \$3 billion per year, far more than any other single project or trade agreement could accomplish. And it will greatly strengthen global energy security by introducing a major, reliable and long-term source of energy into world markets.

The Soviets are making a strong play for this energy market. Gorbachev pressed hard for a deal on Soviet natural gas when he was in Tokyo in April. There is no good reason why the United States should forfeit this opportunity to the Soviets, particularly in view of our persistent trade deficit with the Japanese.

Korea has already signed letters of commitment to purchase Alaska gas and Taiwan is about ready to come on board. While the Japanese informally concede they need the gas supply, they have played the "reluctant bride" thus far.

State, Energy and Commerce have all pressed the Japanese on Alaska gas during bi-lateral energy talks. These talks have kept the issue on the front burner but failed to produce any hard commitments from the Japanese. This topic was also among the discussion points for the President's meeting with the Prime Minister of Japan in April, but unfortunately was not directly raised in the brief exchange which occurred.

What we need now is a nudge forward which only the President can provide. It was our hope that this matter could be raised during the bi-lateral discussions which the President will have with the Prime Minister during the G-7 summit in July. Officials at the National Security Council responsible for the G-7 agenda are fully briefed and have previously prepared background papers and talking points on this issue.

If circumstances permit, we would greatly appreciate an appropriate reference to Alaska natural gas at the summit in July.

Please let me know if any further information is required. Thank you for your consideration.

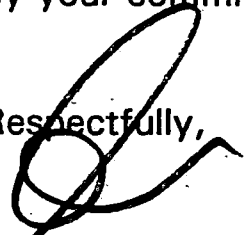
helping them re-organize and clean up their deficits. These units would analyze the delivery of city services and aid municipalities in the streamlining of their public programs.

By joining together with other apple growers throughout the eastern part of the U.S. who must harvest their crop with imported labor as we do, the costs represent about \$50 per worker per year. We use about 100 Jamaican pickers, hence our share represents about \$5,000. It is difficult enough farming these days without the harassment caused by the class action suits perpetrated by the Legal Services Corp.

If they would adhere to the original intent of Congress i.e. the day to day legal needs of the nation's poor or poorly educated we'd support them.

There is a bill introduced by Barney Frank HR2039 we ask the administration not to support, instead support the McCollum Stenholm Reform Act of 1991, HR1345.

It is rare that I have asked support, as Merrell and I feel your philosophies are the same as ours. Probably this letter is unnecessary but the issue is very important to us and our apple industry.

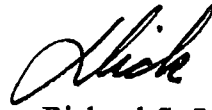
It was an honor and pleasure meeting you last week. You asked for reading and Nancy Maynard assured us that you meant it, so here are some items for your perusal:

- 3) A preprint of a paper by myself and a student from the PRC, De-Zheng Sun. This paper has been submitted to the **Journal of Climate** and uses paleoclimate data to argue that the water vapor feedback is likely to be strongly negative.
- 4) A brief note explaining my scientific approach to the problem of climate change. This note explains why I feel an overly programatic approach to this problem may prove ineffective.
- 5) A brief note offering some observations on the history of the politicization of the climate change problem.
- 6) A possibly wacko suggestion on how the GOP can corner the domestic agenda for a generation.
- 7) A white paper I have prepared on a global observation system based on remotely piloted high altitude aircraft. Such a system provides what may be a preferable alternative to EOS.
- 8) A mild parody of the NRC **Policy Implications of Greenhouse Warming**. It was prepared for a dear good friend, George Carrier, who knows nothing about climate, who is a good applied mathematician, and who Frank uses because he is universally liked and goes along with almost anything.

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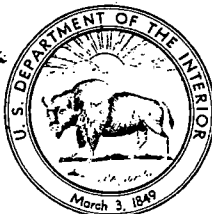

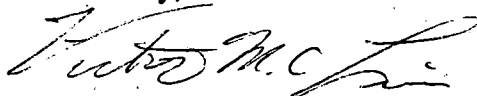

I am taking this opportunity to bring to your attention a matter of great concern to the Catholic Bishops of the United States. As you know, the Supreme Court's decision last April in Employment Division v. Smith has left religious organizations somewhat more vulnerable to arbitrary or insensitive government action. This has been especially true at the state and local levels. As a way of remedying that imbalance created by the Supreme Court's determination, numerous religious groups have banded together and proposed a Religious Freedom Restoration Act. Although the Conference shares the concern about the need for some relief to the more egregious results in Employment Division v. Smith, it has raised several concerns about the scope of the existing proposed remedy with Congressman Solarz (its principal House sponsor) as well as representatives of various religious organizations represented by its supporting coalition. The Conference has never been a member of that coalition.

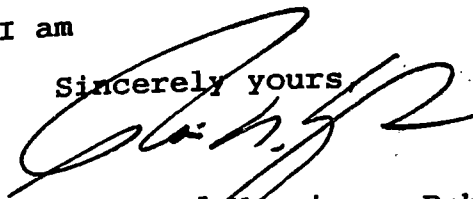
In an effort to bring the President and you up-to-date on the nature of these concerns, I am enclosing a copy of a commentary on the legislative remedies prepared by members of our legal staff. It addresses the need for meaningful relief after Smith but indicates that present efforts could be used to advance abortion on demand or undermine church-state partnerships. After you and your staff have had an opportunity to review this document, I request the opportunity to have a meeting with the appropriate representatives of the Domestic Policy staff, so that we might share with you in some detail our concerns as well as discuss with you the prospects for legislative relief in this Congress.

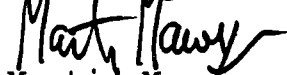

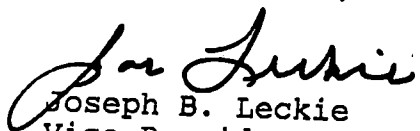

In 1987 I was fortunate to have been selected to participate in the President's Executive Exchange Program. As an alumnus of the Program and as a career Federal Employee with some thirty years service with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), I was deeply disappointed by the decision to terminate the Executive Exchange Program.

Having spent the initial 27 years of my career in the Federal Service, I sought to participate in this program in order to gain first hand experience in the private sector. I can state without reservation that the year I served as a Presidential Exchange Executive was one of the most meaningful and professionally rewarding career development opportunities I have experienced in my thirty years of government service. As a senior federal executive I must work closely with my counterparts in industry. However the opportunity to see and understand the world from the perspective of the private sector has proven beneficial to me and to NASA as I continue in my career with the Federal Government.

Since leaving the President's Executive Exchange Program and returning to my Agency, I have had the opportunity to discuss the benefits of the Program with both alumni from my class as well as other classes. I can say without exception that the participants I have talked to consider this program to be an extremely valuable part of their career development. The training and educational opportunities incorporated in to the Program have proven valuable to all of us as we continue our careers in both the private as well as the public sectors. To have the opportunity to meet and interact with world leaders in government, industry and the military was a career growth experience for all of us.

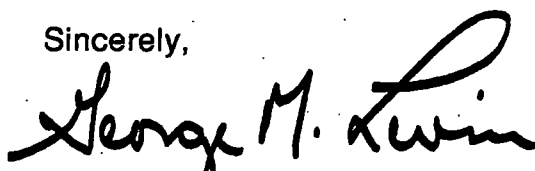
Speaking for myself, I believe I was able to give as much as I got. The opportunity to work closely with other members of my class during the educational and training segments of the Program meant the opportunity to learn from each other. This is to expand my comments at the TALC meeting concerning the Administration's decision on the Phase I extension "order of receipt" issue in the Acid Deposition control program. On May 7, the decision to use a telephone queuing method to establish the "order of receipt" was announced. My comments are not to address the issue, but are directed at the imperative for immediate implementation. There is no impediment to EPA proposing a rule now with final action prior to July. I urge that EPA be directed to proceed immediately.

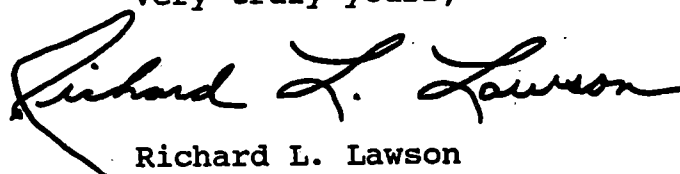
The issue of accelerated rulemaking for Phase I extension was discussed at the second meeting of the Acid Rain Advisory Committee on January 28. The Permits and Technology Subcommittee recommended an early rulemaking because "the time required to plan, permit and install scrubber technology is so great that any additional planning time will assist utilities in using these technologies and furthering statutory objections." The issue was addressed at the third ARAC meeting on February 21 and 22 with a recommendation from ARAC for expedited rulemaking. Still, no decision was made by the Administration until May 7; months after the need for accelerated rulemaking was identified. Valuable time has been lost, but action now can lessen the impact of this delay.

An accelerated rulemaking does not have to address all of the Phase I Extension issues. They can be addressed in subsequent rulemakings prior to the filing of the proposals.

What is necessary is the expedited determination of the "order of receipt" so that companies can justify to the public utility commission and shareholders the expenditure of funds for planning and permitting to comply with Phase I requirements.

The May 7 decision provides a foundation for moving ahead now. Utility knowledge of whether it will receive Phase I extension allowances will allow it to plan a least cost compliance. Least cost options may well be precluded as time passes. The Vice President has publicly committed to least cost implementation of the Clean Air Act. Immediate implementation of this Phase I rulemaking will contribute to that objective.

Dear Governor Sununu:

Please find enclosed a copy of a letter I have sent to Dr. Roper, Director of the Centers for Disease Control, concerning a \$25,000 grant for the 13th National Lesbian and Gay Health Conference. The letter cites numerous workshop and conference topics which should not be supported in any way by the federal government. It is an outrage that any taxpayer's money is being used to underwrite any part of this conference.

I cannot emphasize too strongly the symbolic significance of such episodes. Southern Baptists voted in overwhelming numbers for a President and an administration that portrayed itself as pro-family and pro-traditional values. They are angered, frustrated, and confused when they hear about such activities as those taking place in this conference being partially underwritten with federal grants.

Governor, what do I tell perplexed and confused Southern Baptists when they ask me about the CDC incident and the National Endowment for the Arts as they relate to the Bush Administration's commitment to traditional family values? Such episodes can and do seriously undermine a great deal of goodwill in a very short time. Please instruct Dr. Roper to cancel the \$25,000 grant to this egregious conference, and please advise the President to consider instructing his administrative officials to refrain from such ill-advised and counter-productive actions in the future. Surely, some specific policy guidelines could be issued which would prevent such episodes in the future. On October 30, 1990, when we and several other evangelical leaders met with you and the President about our concerns related to the NEA and invitations to representatives of homosexual and lesbian groups to White House events we proposed a draft Executive Order regarding federal policies relating to their impact on traditional families. If that proposed Executive Order had been promulgated as we requested, this grant would not have been given since it violates both the spirit and the letter of that proposed Executive Order.

Thank you for your attention to these concerns. Please feel free to contact me should you have any questions.

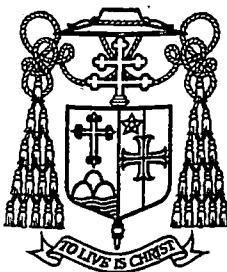

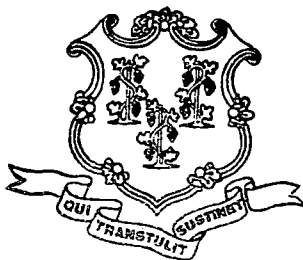
