Dear Mr. Sununu:

On behalf of the nearly 800,000 members of the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®, I would like to thank you for the leadership you have shown during the Administration's recent deliberations over revisions to the Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands and we urge your continued support of these revisions.

The NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® is pleased with the consensus definition of protected wetlands recently reached by the Administration, which more narrowly and clearly defines a true wetland. The new criteria represents a balanced approach by the Administration in recognizing the need to protect the environment, as well as the property rights of private citizens.

We commend you and the Administration for your courage in moving forward on this critical issue, however several areas remain that need to be addressed, such as classification of wetlands by function and value, the use of mitigation banking, and, most importantly, just compensation to property owners when their land is taken as the result of a wetlands permit denial. Therefore, our association will continue to press for passage of legislation now pending in Congress, entitled the "Comprehensive Wetlands Conservation and Management Act of 1991."

The bill, H.R. 1330, introduced by Reps. James A. Hayes, Tom Ridge, Billy Tauzin, Don Young and Beryl Anthony, has broad bi-partisan support in the House with 170 co-sponsors to date. In addition, the Senate companion bill, S. 1463, introduced in July by Senator John Breaux, has already garnered 24 co-sponsors.

The Administration's agreement is a bold step and again we thank you for your role in achieving it. However, the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® continues to feel that H.R. 1330 and S. 1463 provide the most balanced and equitable legislative solution to the wetlands problem.

MEMORANDUM FOR GOVERNOR JOHN H. SUNUNU

Subject: Superfund Progress and Problems

The Superfund program was launched in 1980 as an effort to clean up uncontrolled contamination of the environment caused by past mismanagement of hazardous wastes. The conventional wisdom at the time held that there were a few hundred sites of national priority that could be cleaned up quickly. Congress set up a \$1.6 billion Hazardous Substance Response Trust Fund and directed EPA to establish a National Priorities List of the most serious sites requiring cleanup. Parties responsible for contamination problems, including owners, operators, and generators, are held accountable for cleanup through a strict standard of joint and several liability established in the statute.

The original law was authorized for five years. However, the problem of uncontrolled hazardous waste sites has proved much larger than anyone originally imagined. The statute was reauthorized in 1986 at \$8.6B and again in 1990 at \$5.0B. Over 31,000 sites have been evaluated and there are 1200 sites on the National Priorities List for cleanup. EPA expects to continue listing approximately 100 additional sites per year.

EPA has been faced with the challenge of reducing environmental risks from a growing list of increasingly complex sites in a situation characterized by incomplete knowledge, immature technology, and relentless pressure on limited resources. Rampant public criticism during the mid-80s added pressure and increased the sense of urgency. When I was confirmed as EPA Administrator, I committed to a Superfund Management Review to find ways to increase program effectiveness and improve public confidence. The major themes that emerged from the study were:

- enforcement as a first priority to compel private party response
- make sites safe by controlling acute threats
- make sites clean - worst problems at worst sites first
- bring new technology to bear on cleanup problems

Implementation of the recommendations in the Superfund Management Review has been very successful. Responsible parties are now agreeing to contribute over \$1 billion per year in cleanup work, (three times more than in the year before we took office); immediate threats are under control at all Superfund sites; work is underway at 90% of the sites; and many promising new technologies are under development.

Public perception of Superfund progress continues to be undermined, however, by the fact that only 63 sites have been cleaned up and by problems perceived in the way EPA manages the contracts used in the various phases of cleanup. The public perception regarding the rate of cleanup and contracts management, along with concerns about the breadth of the Superfund liability scheme, will continue to plague the program.

Attached is a summary of Superfund's status and a brief description of key issues.

Dear Governor Sununu:

As dean of the New Jersey Republican congressional delegation, I am writing in anticipation of the upcoming Presidential campaign to offer my strong support for the President's bid for re-election.

As you may know, the 7th District, which I represent, is an overwhelmingly Democratic district. The largest municipality, Elizabeth, is a city of 110,000 people, where Democrats outnumber Republicans by roughly 15-1; the entire city council is Democratic, as is the Mayor and every state legislator. It is, however, an area that is typical of New Jersey as a whole: voters are independent and willing to cross party lines for candidates they support. 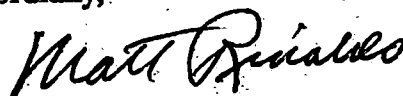

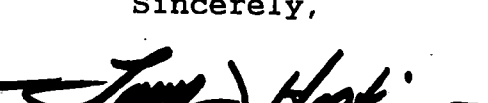

The decision to locate in Lexington would be a major boost for the State and the entire Lexington region.

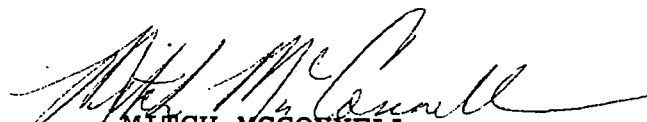
We trust that Kentucky will be given every consideration in the selection process. However, we want to stress our strong belief that Lexington is the best choice to serve the Federal government's needs.

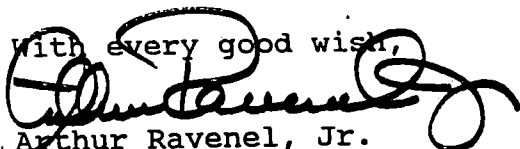
Dear Governor,

It was good to speak with you this morning. I appreciate very much your early return of my call.

As we discussed, Dr. Fox over at NMFS has put their amendments to Turtle Excluder Device regulations out for comment. When implemented, the new regs will extend the time this year that TEDS will be required in shrimpers nets. On the Southeast coast last year, when the TEDS came out of the nets at the end of August, a great many turtles drowned in shrimpers nets and washed up on the South Carolina beaches. This caused a great uproar from my constituents.

Please know that the regulations in question affect only the Southeast coast and are not applicable in the Gulf. I have confirmed this with Dr. Fox. I have also discussed the situation with Congressman Tauzin and he has no objections. Please be so kind as to expedite these regulations out of OMB so that they can be in place by the end of this month. What we don't need is a reoccurrence of the turtle drownings that occurred last year. This would result in public indignation, critical press and substantial adverse editorial comment.

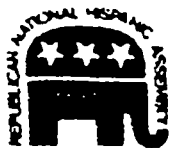

Dear Governor Sununu:

Although I remain committed to the Administration's overall environmental goals, I wanted to express to you some of the frustration that I, and other Republican Members of Congress, have experienced with regard to the current wetlands situation.

During the 1988 presidential campaign, George Bush committed himself to a policy of "no net loss" of wetlands. However, in 1989, at about the time the President was taking office, the Army Corps of Engineers, Environmental Protection Agency, the Fish and Wildlife Service and the Soil and Conservation Service issued, without public notice or comment, the infamous Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands. I honestly believe if the President had known by making his campaign promise that he was unleashing this bureaucratic monster, he would have never committed himself to "no net loss."

As the Domestic Policy Council prepares to meet to decide the fate of the new wetlands manual, I wanted to urge you to do all you can to assure that the market-based option receives full consideration. In addition, I want serious weight to be given to those experts who are saying water should be present for 21 days in order to trigger a wetlands designation.

I have heard from numerous businesses who are trying desperately to create job opportunities in my economically depressed district. I had one particular incident when a business with a \$7 million development plan had to stop dead in its tracks for months while the bureaucracy made its determination that a sinkhole was a sinkhole--and not a wetland. Ultimately, an accommodation was reached, but unnecessary delays and loss of revenue resulted from the imprecise regulatory environment in which wetlands issues are determined.

While these changes to the manual will provide a measure of relief, I want to reiterate that, as an original co-sponsor of the Hayes/Ridge bill (H.R. 1330), I feel a legislative fix is still needed. H.R. 1330 will provide for classification of wetlands by function and value, allow for public notice and comment on

designations, and provide for compensation to private
property owners whose lands have been rendered useless by federal
denials.

Again, I urge you to be an aggressive advocate for returning
some sanity to federal wetlands regulation. While as Republicans we
must remain committed to a clean environment, we must also recognize
the necessity of allowing our private sector to grow and prosper.

Dear John:

Whenever there happens to be an intelligent and intellectual individual serving competently as White House Chief of Staff, as is the case now, there are always those of the liberal media and the disloyal opposition who would join farces and nip at the heels of their betters in yuppie puppie fashion.

Maybe Pat was right; he said the U.S. Congress was Israeli-Occupied territory.

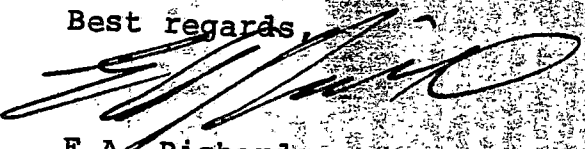
It's a shame!

It was my sole intention to improve the cooperation between the executive and legislative branches outside of the blaring television lights of our hearing room.

I won't take issue with the Administration's willingness to add "substantial resources" but I wish you had tried your hand at what our Federal policies are relating to drug abuse law enforcement, education, treatment and prevention, what programs in these areas are effective, what initiatives have been evaluated by Federal agencies and recommended to the States, and whether your clipping services have any statements concerning international initiatives against drugs attributed to our Secretary of State or our Ambassador to the United Nations. I hope that you might have your staff forward them to our Select Committee's attention.

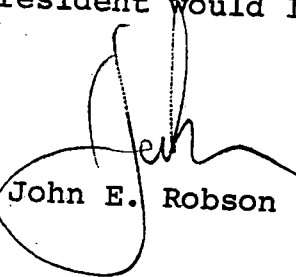

Analysis:

Federal Reserve Board

- o It is too early to point to concrete results or cite empirical evidence of a change in the willingness or ability of banks to increase their lending activities. However, in recent weeks, a number of banking organizations have taken steps to raise new capital - a necessary precondition to a pickup in lending activity.
- o Through communicating and clarifying supervisory policy guidelines to each field examiner, there is more consistency among field examiners' practices leading to a more balanced approach to conducting on-site examinations.
- o The clarification regarding the recognition of income on a cash basis may be of particular importance because it will allow lenders to recognize income in a manner that is consistent with GAAP.
- o The clarification on the evaluation of real estate collateral will contribute to a more positive lending climate.

- * Dayton Congressman Tony Hall voted against President Bush and the troops in the Gulf and ridiculed American involvement as "an unjust war."
- * Dayton Congressman Tony Hall voted for minority quotas against businesses in the 1990 Quota Bill.
- * Dayton Congressman Tony Hall voted in 1990 to increase taxes on working Americans in the biggest tax bill in our nation's history.

As you know, running for office costs money. I am writing you to ask if you would be willing to serve on my Finance Committee to raise the money to oust Mr. Hall. Our goal is to have 300 members who will raise \$1000 each. Under federal election laws, each individual you ask may contribute up to \$1000 in a primary season, and up to \$1000 in the general election.

If you believe, as I do, that our Congressman's most important mission is to articulate the hopes, dreams, and aspirations of the citizens he represents, and to build a stronger community and America with the greatest opportunities and freedoms for our families and our neighbors, won't you join me today? Can't Dayton do better? Can't we bring businesses and jobs back to Montgomery County? Isn't it time for fresh, vigorous leadership to get Dayton moving again?

In closing, President Ronald Reagan often spoke movingly about the unrivaled power that citizens enjoy in our democratic system of government to move mountains. He reminded us that the ideal foremost in our Constitution, that thousands of men and women, from Iwo Jima to Kuwait, have given their lives to preserve, is, "We, the People." And he inspired millions of his countrymen that together, in America, we have the power to begin all over again, to attain the ennobling vision the Pilgrims painted three centuries ago of "America, the shining city on a hill." I believe I share that vision with most of you. Can we make that vision come true for Dayton?

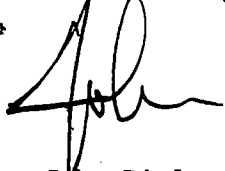
I feel as though Peggy Noonan has invaded my body.

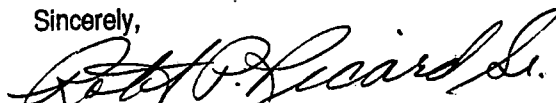

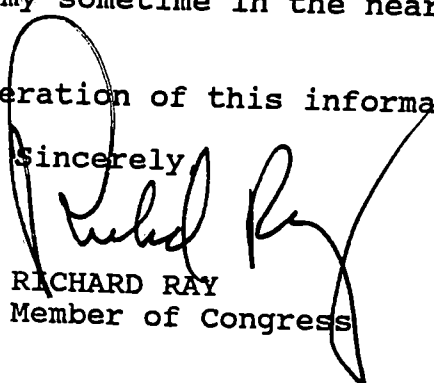
Please find attached information I received from the United States Merchant Marine Academy.
