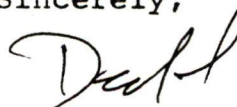

The attached article from the WALL STREET JOURNAL about "Republicans for Choice" is only one of quite a few press clippings in the last three months about the efforts of a handful of abortionists to "make war" at the Republican National Convention in Houston in 1992. Indeed, Ann Stone is getting more flamboyant and divisive all the time. After the meeting referred to in the JOURNAL, she said "we're going to stop being civil and silent. . . . there is going to be a floor fight."

You will note in the JOURNAL piece, Ann Stone says she will be fielding "favorite daughters" so Republicans can vote "for a pro-choice George Bush."

At this point, we are not worried about President Bush retreating from his pro-life stand -- he has been stalwart on this issue, and we appreciate his loyalty. We are sure he also realizes that the absolute worst position any candidate can take is to retreat from a previous strong pro-life position (a la Jim Courter).

We in the Republican National Coalition for Life are determined that the pro-life plank in our Platform remain intact. I'm happy to report that our efforts are meeting with growing enthusiasm, and enclosed is our most recent list of Endorsers. We're pretty proud of it.

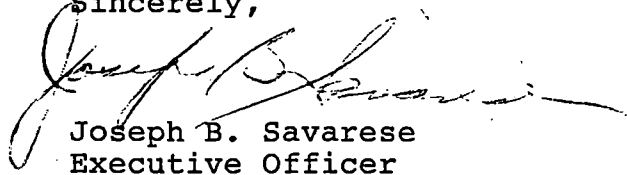

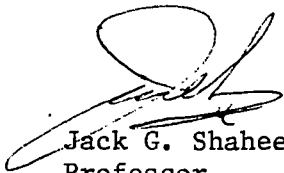
I sincerely hope all is well with you and yours.

Dear Mr. Sununu:

On Thursday, May 16, 1991, you made a decision to help a couple trying to adopt a baby from Romania. As far as your major decision responsibilities are concerned, this one doesn't rank high on your list. But as far as my wife and I are concerned, your help was instrumental in saving the life of one small child we were privileged to adopt.

My wife and I were granted adoption privileges by the Romanian government on May 2, 1991. When we went to the American Embassy to complete the procedure with the US government, we were denied a visa by the INS organization. The implementation of the INS rules had changed during the few short weeks after a "60 Minutes" presentation on baby buying in Romania. Unfortunately my wife was already in Romania in the midst of the process and we were totally unaware of this procedural change. Our little baby had been in a hospital for seven months and never had human contact except for feeding time by the nurses four times a day. The parents of the child had given her up and she was completely abandoned. As we tried to complete our adoption process we ran into an unreasonable, illogical, and very uncompassionate organization in the INS. We contacted our Congressman, Elton Gallegly, who tried to work with the INS to no avail. Only when he contacted you did a realistic hearing take place. It is my understanding that you listened to my family's situation, discussed the problem with President Bush, and then told the INS to grant us humanitarian parole. For this decision we are forever in your debt.

Little Alyssa was only 10 lbs. when we took her out of the hospital. She was very undernourished and had no mobility in her two legs. With proper feeding and a lot of love she is now well on her way to recovery. Alyssa is now healthy and is rapidly catching up to a normal development cycle. Our doctor indicated that if she had been left just a few more months in the condition from which she came, Alyssa would have been permanently marred if she survived. For rescuing our daughter, only one of perhaps thousands, we want to thank you from the bottom of our hearts. I hope that you can look upon this one event in your life and understand just how much you personally made a difference.

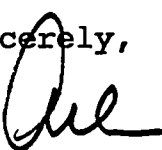

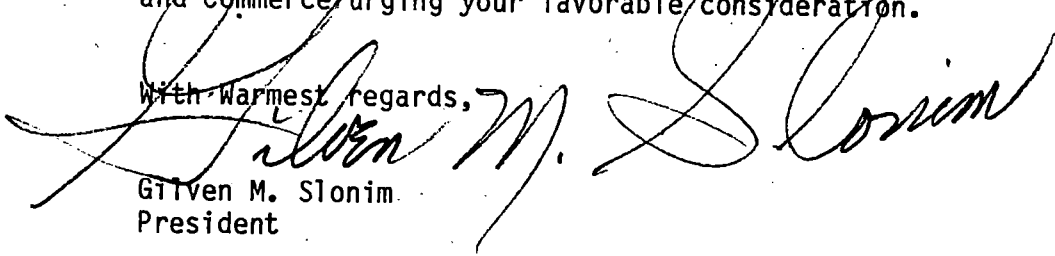

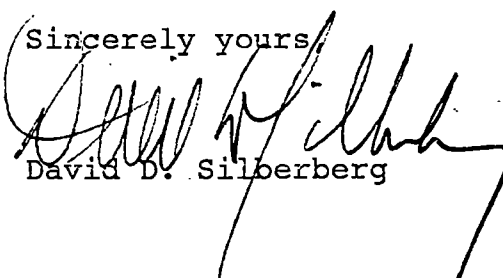

I am writing to let you know that the Trustees of the College Board have authorized me to develop a major new array of academic course syllabi and related achievement tests for all students, in response to the nation's emerging needs.

We plan to call this array of integrated curriculum designs, assessment methods, and professional development opportunities "Pacesetters," signifying our hope that they will indeed set a faster pace for educational reform than has been the case up to now.

President Bush in his "America 2000" plan has urged that the nation establish high expectations for the academic performance of all students, and also develop appropriate ways to determine if those expectations are being met.

The Trustees believe that it is essential to ensure that classroom teachers and subject matter experts play a leading role in the pursuit of those objectives. Moreover, they believe that it is essential to begin by defining specifically what skills and knowledge we aspire to have all students master, and only then proceed to consider how to assess progress toward those standards. In such consideration, they also believe that the assessment practices which are adopted must be diverse, and include performance-based features, so as to give students a variety of ways to demonstrate achievement.

The Board is already in partnership with the Mathematical Association of America and the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, working to conceive a model twelfth-grade experience in mathematics for all of the nation's students. Accordingly, the Trustees have encouraged the staff to seek similar partnerships with appropriate groups in the fields of English, history, science, foreign language, and the arts.

As in the mathematics effort, the process we propose involves creating a nationally representative task force of teachers to identify essential learning outcomes in the curriculum and a variety of frameworks or paths to achieve them, along with a process for assessing student achievement that would combine and integrate daily work with end-of-year examination.

may discern a similarity in this process to the Advanced Placement program of the College Board, about which the Bush administration has spoken approvingly. However, important differences distinguish the new effort--especially in that it addresses learning at the high school level for all students, while AP addresses college-level study for the most able students. In common with AP, however, we expect the new effort to incorporate a structure for professional development in support of its aims, and to make appropriate use of student performance in assessment.

In thus pursuing its chartered purpose to foster representative opinion with regard to educational standards, it is my hope that the Board may contribute significantly to answering the many questions now before the nation about how to get from where we are to where we want to be in educational reform.

As this activity proceeds, we expect to keep educators, policymakers, and all interested parties informed. In the meantime, I most sincerely invite any comments, suggestions or reactions to this initiative which you might like to offer--and, in fact, your participation. Please let me know whether you are interested in playing a part in this initiative. I look forward to hearing from you.

Dear John:

You'll recall I asked to see the President before he decides the wetlands issues.

It makes absolutely no sense to make Alaska, which has only used 1/2 of one percent of all our wetlands and has more wetlands set aside for protection than all the other 49 states, subject to the same requirements under wetlands policy. Furthermore, when we became a state, Alaska received 103 million acres for development; our Natives settled their claims against the U.S. for 40 plus million acres, at least 20 million of which were for development.

Applying federal no net loss wetlands concepts to these areas none of which has been available for development yet is tantamount to condemnation of our potential private enterprise land base.

I don't ask to see the President on the drop of a hat -- and I've never called him on any substantive issues.

This may be the exception.

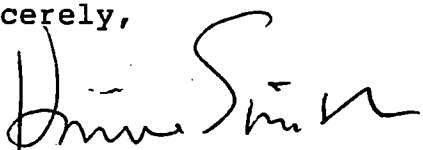

As part of its ongoing efforts to preserve America's free market system, the Legal Studies Division of the Washington Legal Foundation (WLF) has published a working paper written by Judge Robert Bork entitled, "Federalism And Federal Regulation: The Case Of Product Labeling." Judge Bork argues in this publication that the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has misinterpreted the federalism principles outlined in our Constitution in its refusal to preempt state labeling laws such as Proposition 65 in California.

In this publication, WLF and Judge Bork have identified an issue that has widespread implications not only for the food industry, but also for our economy as a whole. Over the last several years, more and more inconsistent state laws have led to substantial compliance costs to industries thereby hampering interstate commerce and discouraging economic growth. Through its unique combination of litigation and legal policy education, WLF hopes to effect a change in this trend, and to create a legal environment that is more suitable to business.

Judge Bork has had a distinguished career as a Professor at Yale Law School, Solicitor General and Acting Attorney General of the United States, Circuit Judge on the U.S. Court of Appeals, Supreme Court nominee and currently as the John M. Olin Scholar in Legal Studies at the American Enterprise Institute.

John, I trust that you find Judge Bork's paper to be as well-written and significant as we do, and I encourage you to contact me with your thoughts on this and other issues of mutual concern.

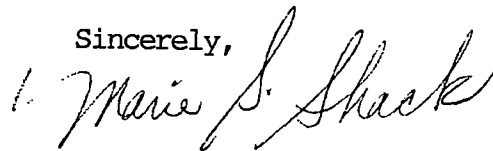

Dear John:

It is interesting to note that two of the best Chief of Staffs came from New Hampshire, both former Governors. We also find that both John Sununu and Sherman Adams were so thorough and knowledgeable that it was very easy for them to make enemies. I was sorry to see what had happened to you, John, on account of a ride in an airplane. There are two ways of looking at what happened to you ---

I was in the U.S. Navy for four years and 21 months was spent with the Air Corp. Many of my good friends were test pilots. We were known as NAS and when a squadron came in to our station with planes that were shot up or damaged, NAS had to take these planes and repair them. After they were repaired, the test pilots had to check them out before they were turned back to the squadrons. The test pilots naturally had to put in quite a few hours and quite a few miles testing these planes before returning them to the squadron, and during this time, they could give any of the other military men a ride to Boston, Philadelphia, anyplace that they spent some time, because the planes had to go a certain distance. If you found that someone from the service talked about getting a ride back and forth from Boston to Atlanta, then people that were not knowledgeable were trying to say that they were using the planes for their own purpose. The Presidential plane that you flew on has a complete crew that is standing by for the wishes of the President or his staff very easily for 10-15 days without doing anything. It would seem to me then that the only expense that this plane had if someone wants to be pinch-penny about it would be that you had to pay for the gasoline. I am glad this is all behind you.

I find sitting here at a distance of 525 miles from Washington that it was easy for me to think that after the Iran Contra was finished, I could never understand why they didn't cut off the funds from Attorney Walsh and left him sitting around there and he was so disappointed in losing the Iran Contra that when he was left alone, I'm sure that he kept digging, digging, digging, looking for trouble. I'm still not sure why they didn't shut off his funds and send him home.

It would seem to me that the bases that are going to be closed around the country, that if a skeleton crew was left to keep them open just in case of an emergency, I cannot understand why these bases that all have barracks could not be used to shelter the homeless. They could bus or use cars to be sure they picked up the homeless and remove them from the streets. It is a very, very poor advertisement for our country to see homeless. I also do not think that the government would have to feed them, but that citizens could donate food.

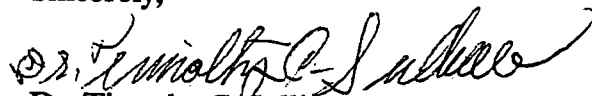

In that way, you will find some of the people on the WPA working as assistants to carpenters, electricians, plumbers, and this could help them find a new way of making a living. The trouble today with trying to find a position as a recent college graduate is getting more difficult all the time. You have a lot of young fellows graduating from college and becoming second lieutenants and you couldn't find a better place for them to start work after college than the CCC camps.

It is very easy to find a good many college graduates finding it almost impossible to find a decent position today --- the above may help.

I would agree with outlawing strikes, if everyone, employees and employers, would agree to arbitration --- both sides would win.

I would like to once again say that I've always thought, and I still do, that the two best Chief of Staffs were Sherman Adams and John Sununu --- Governors of New Hampshire!

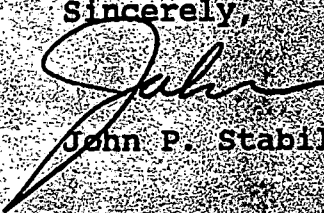
Dear John:

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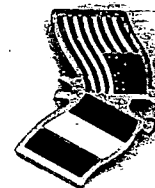
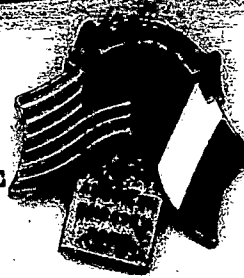

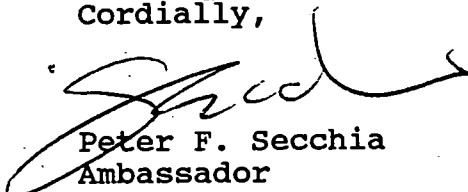
This year Barbara Bush has been invited and Susan Porter Rose called me months ago asking me about the "quality and integrity" of this organization. I vouched a strong "yes."

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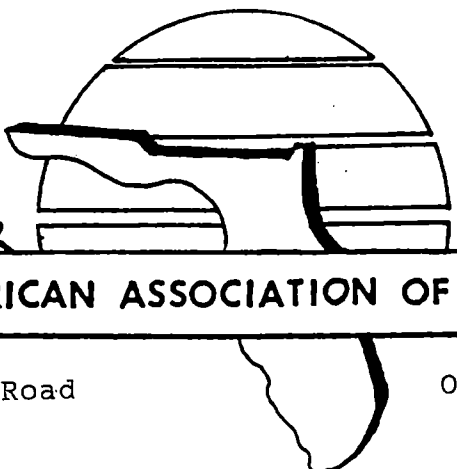

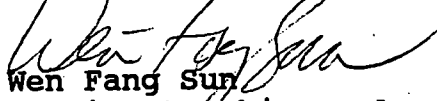

Dear Mr. Sununu,

It has just been relayed to me that you have read an article in which I criticize our Senator, Patrick Leahy, for his dairy bill, and that you used this as evidence that the dairy industry is not united behind Sen. Leahy. I want you to know that my comments were not that I oppose his efforts in general, but that I feel he has not set a high enough price for dairy farmers to earn a living.

Just two days ago I met in Sen. Leahy's Montpelier office with his staff person, Ron Allbee (former Vermont Commissioner of Agriculture), along with several farmers. We spent two hours on a conference call with Sen. Leahy's Washington staff, with farmers addressing their concerns on details of the legislation. All of their concerns were addressed by the staff except for one, and that is the price they feel is adequate which should be stated in the bill.

Sen. Leahy has told us repeatedly that the administration opposes any legislation in general, and a higher price specifically. He sees the president and the Secretary of Agriculture as a major stumbling block in putting through a supply management system that will provide dairy farmers with a stable price that covers their cost of production plus cost of living. The anger I was feeling, which was quoted in the news article that you saw, was toward this price problem, and I was telling Sen. Leahy to act decisively and with a price our farmers will be happy with.

As you are from our neighboring state of New Hampshire, you are well aware of the beauty that Vermont boasts in large part due to our dairy farms. We are indeed "a special state," and our economy is based largely on the dairy income (which brings in \$1 million per day to Vermont). More than any other state in the union, Vermont relies on the dairy segment of our agriculture, or 80% of all farm dollars which are generated by the dairy farms.

Some see a future trend of losing these farms, and say that is a normal market evolution. However, we can strongly argue that there is a market for Vermont milk, as we supply 47% of the Boston market, and, as I'm sure you're aware, produce wonderful dairy products such

as Cabot Cheese and Ben & Jerry's ice cream which are marketed across the country. We do not have a surplus of milk in the northeast, and there is a strong demand for the fresh, wholesome milk that is being produced on our Vermont farms.

What is causing us to lose our farms is the government manipulation that causes the downward trend of the farm price for milk, along with processor monopolies in the midwest that are able to set a price for the entire country. You have no doubt seen the surveys made across the United States that show an average of 80% of all dairy farmers now support supply management, with a two-tier system favored by a heavy majority.

So farmers are experiencing prices that are causing bankruptcies, while their own USDA is issuing reports that say there is nothing that can be done. The president's spokespeople have testified that we should not raise the farm prices, as it will cause consumer prices to rise, and thus result in a decreased demand for dairy products. I would like to submit these facts to you:

<u>Price per ounce</u>	<u>Per capita consumption</u>
Milk .02¢	20.9 Gallons
Soda .04¢	45.9 Gallons
Beer .065¢	23.6 Gallons

As you can see, consumers are accustomed to paying more, and do so willingly, for products that have much less nutritive value than milk. We are losing our markets for fluid milk to the beer and soda industries for obvious reasons: those industries have better profit margins and are able to promote their products much heavier than milk. The federal government could and should be stepping in to help promote milk as the healthiest beverage for American consumers, and helping to bring these alarming statistics back to a situation that would promote longterm health for our citizens.

The constituents in rural America are not as ignorant or uninformed as you might think. We see what the federal government's policies are doing to our rural economy, and we're not happy! While you once had a strong majority of Republican voters in Vermont, we have elected Rep. Bernard Sanders, an independent, because we are quite frustrated with "politics as usual" in Washington. We see that the voices that are heard by Congress and administration are those that have money and can afford to pay you folks to speak to them for an evening in return for the vote they will be looking for in the future, which in this case is to keep farm prices unbearably low so that large processors can continue to reap the benefits.

Meanwhile, you have a hardworking core of the American economy, the dairy farmers, who are wondering how to pay for their electricity so they can continue to milk the cows. I invite you to come here and let me take you to some farms, meet with

our farm families and hear about their financial problems. At the current price of milk, they tell us they are losing an average of \$1,000 per week! And we are not that much different than any other region of the country; I have been told that Wisconsin's cost of production is only 20¢ less per hundredweight than ours, with the difference being that they are closer to the grain sources. We can make that up somewhat as we have excellent forage capacity here in Vermont.

Yes, we are frustrated with our elected officials here in Vermont, but as I am trying to convey, we are not any different than other regions of the country. If Pres. Bush plans to run again for president, and hopes to win the support of rural voters, I would strongly suggest that he put his ear to the ground and listen to what we are trying to say. Also, I suggest he look toward Japan, the Europeans and the Canadians to see how they value their food growing economy and protect it from competition. It is a matter of national security that we have an agricultural infrastructure that can be found in any town, any county, and state of America. We do not want to depend on trucks or rail to bring us our dairy products in the northeast, where we already import 85% of the food we consume.

There are no easy solutions to the complex problems faced by the dairy industry right now, but I do feel that the legislation Sen. Patrick Leahy is introducing in the Senate is a well thought out move in the right direction. A new system of supply management is needed in dairy, which can work as well as other commodities which already have such systems in place. For myself, as an elected official, I have an obligation to help our troubled farmers, and am doing all that I can. But dairy solutions must come from the federal level, and we need your support. Our farmers need to hear from you loud and clear that you recognize the severe stress they are experiencing, and that you will offer support for Sen. Leahy's two-tier supply management plan.

If you honestly consider all the facts, I do not see how anything less could possibly be justified.

Please let me know if you agree with me, and will be able to act on my request.

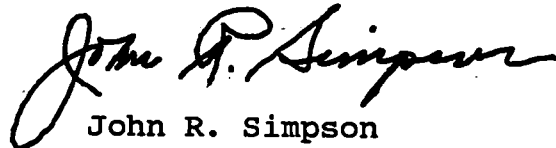

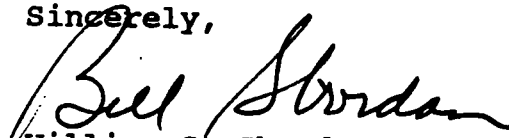

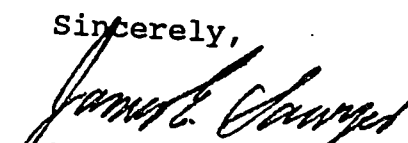

We would like to bring to your attention three matters of concern. We pray that you will use your influence on these issues.

First, we are concerned about statements made by the President and those on his staff regarding his willingness to "compromise" on the Title X regulations. We respectfully request that the President hold firm on this issue. Despite Planned Parenthood's massive media and newspaper advertisement propaganda campaign, we are convinced that the President's veto will be sustained. Moreover, a veto is the right thing to do and our only defense against the multi-million dollar Planned Parenthood effort.

Second, please do all you can to block the impending nomination of Judge William Yohn to the United States District Court (Pennsylvania). 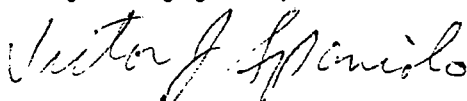

We understand that the members of the President's Cabinet will be meeting soon to discuss possible options for implementation of the President's policy on "no net loss of wetlands". On behalf of The National Wetlands Coalition, I want to express our appreciation for your attention to this important matter. The Coalition strongly believes that the Administration now has before it the opportunity to establish a coherent national wetlands conservation policy that fairly balances the goals of improved wetlands conservation, reasonable economic development and respect for private landowner rights. We therefore encourage you to take full advantage of this opportunity and recommend the adoption of a comprehensive approach to wetlands conservation that can win the active support and participation of those who must live and work in wetlands areas.

Attached to this letter is a copy of our testimony that was submitted to the Subcommittee on Environmental Protection of the Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works. This testimony outlines the views of the Coalition on a national wetlands policy and also describes the essential principles of H.R. 1330, the Comprehensive Wetlands Conservation and Management Act of 1991. In our view, this legislation embodies the principles that must be embraced by the Federal government if wetlands regulation is to work effectively.

We believe that several principles are essential for a viable Federal wetlands conservation and enhancement program. The definition of wetlands for purposes of Federal regulation must be narrowed to focus on the nation's truly valuable wetlands. The March 1989 manual for delineating wetlands has broadened the sweep of the Federal regulatory program to include as wetlands lands that meet the bare minimum scientific criteria for wetlands delineation. However, the delineation of wetlands under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act has direct Federal policy consequences: once land is delineated as "wetlands", that land comes within the scope of a Federal regulatory program that was originally designed to regulate public waters of the United States. Delineating wetlands for purposes of Section 404 clearly implies a policy decision that the Federal government has an interest in regulating the use of these lands. Thus, the delineation of wetlands must be limited to those lands that have sufficient environmental value to merit the exercise of Federal regulatory power. We believe that this area is a much smaller universe of lands than might fit in a "lowest common denominator" scientific definition of wetlands. The policy judgment in this area is particularly important given that there is no unified science on this issue and that the delineation manual is subject to disagreement, even among experts.

Wetlands must be classified for regulatory purposes according to functions and values. Even with a narrowed definition, the Federal regulatory program must be sufficiently flexible to permit regulators to concentrate attention on resources that need the highest level of protection and project proposals that require the most effort. Wetlands classification, accompanied by loosened regulatory requirements for lower value lands, ensures this, and also serves as an important incentive to landowners, on their own initiative, to concentrate their development activities to the fullest extent possible on lower value lands.

There must be a public interest test for determining whether to issue permits. Because over 75% of wetlands are privately owned, and so much of our population lives and works in wetlands, there must be a device in regulation for making public policy choices among social, economic and conservation values. Thus, the permit process must include a balancing test which permits the agency to select among these values. Classification permits the agency to weigh conservation values more heavily in the case of higher value wetlands.

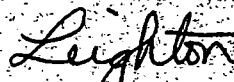

No net loss can only be accomplished if the regulatory system encourages a trading of wetlands functions and values. Federal policy must take a realistic approach to accomplishing the goal of "no net loss". This does not mean abandoning the principle. Rather it means that we must structure a regulatory system that encourages trading of wetlands functions and values. Mitigation banking represents the most attractive option available to date for reconciling the enormous conflicts that beset the current program. It is also the only device that can actually add to the current wetlands base by channelling private sector resources into restoration of the areas that have been lost or degraded by prior activities.

Private property rights must be protected. We believe that for the vast majority of wetlands areas, such a regulatory program will work effectively to reconcile land use problems and provide a heightened level of protection for wetlands values and functions requiring Federal protection. We also recognize that some wetlands are so scarce, fragile or rich in environmental resource value that the highest level of protection is required. If the policy choice is to preclude development on privately owned wetlands, we must own up to the consequences of that decision: private property has been taken, and the land owner should be compensated. We believe that the regulatory program outlined above is sufficient to accommodate competing interests in the vast majority of cases. But where the Federal interest in protection is presumed to override the private interest, then the public as a whole, not just the private property owner, must bear the cost of that protection.

Thank you for your willingness to address this important issue.

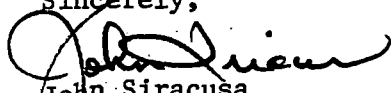

Dear John:

I am writing to ask your assistance in resolving a personnel matter that has been pending for over fifteen months.

In March 1990, I wrote to the Bush Administration recommending Vaughan Edward Taylor for nomination to the Court of Military Appeals. As I stated in the initial correspondence, Vaughan is not a constituent of mine, nor do I have any political connections with him. He is simply supremely qualified to serve on the Court.

Subsequently, I sent four followup letters to, and spoke on numerous occasions with, Chase Untermeyer in support of Vaughan's candidacy. Moreover, I discussed the issue with members and staff of the Senate Armed Services Committee, whose feedback was consistently positive. Further, my staff contacted Judge Cox, a member of the Court who is thoroughly familiar with Vaughan's qualifications, and strongly supports his candidacy. In short, I researched and fully answered every conceivable concern regarding Vaughan Taylor's professional and political suitability for nomination.

Yet, irrespective of my efforts, it seems that no action has been taken on this matter. Presently there are three open seats on the Court. By law, no more than two of these three vacancies can be filled from one political party. However, since Vaughan has registered as an independent, his nomination would comply with the requisite statutory ratio. Additionally, the Court would gain an exceptionally qualified jurist.

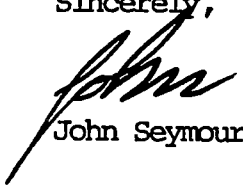
