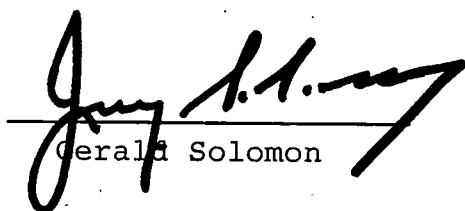

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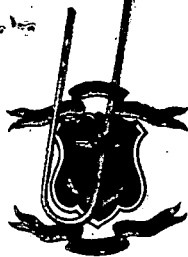

I am writing to you as both a friend and as General Treasurer of the State of Rhode Island, and I am appealing to you for your active support for a bill introduced Tuesday by Rep. Henry B. Gonzalez that will help Rhode Island resolve its credit union crisis.

Hundreds of thousands of Rhode Islanders have faced severe personal economic hardship because their bank accounts have been frozen in closed financial institutions since January 1. The stories of personal hardship are numerous and sometimes tragic. Besides the personal stories, there are the potential business failures as a result of decreased spending that already had diminished because of the country's recession.

The recession that struck the rest of the nation, hit hardest in Rhode Island because of the credit union crisis, and has thrust the state into a deep recession. The only bailout is to do whatever we can to speed up the process of returning money to depositors. Congress has it within its power to provide substantial help.

The bill before the House would direct the Federal Emergency Management Agency to make \$150 million in emergency 6 percent loans available to Rhode Island, and would provide another \$350 million in longer-term federal guarantees so Rhode Island could borrow additional money, if needed, to pay off depositors.

John, I am appealing to you to use whatever influence you have to help to make sure that this legislation is approved. If you need additional information, or help in any way, please do not hesitate to give me a call and I will provide whatever assistance I can.

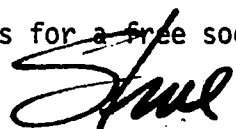
The United States Embassy has denied the visa request for these Noble children and has referred the case to the Immigration and Naturalization Service in Bucharest. From the Noble's perspective it seems that INS is taking no action on this case involving these two children.

I am requesting in the strongest possible terms that you intervene to have our government promptly process the necessary documents to allow Mrs. Noble to bring these adopted children to their home in Idaho.

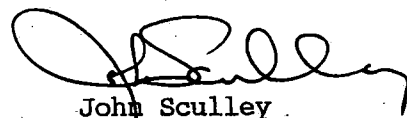
Because of your interest in U.S. competitiveness, we are writing to point out an anomaly in the antidumping procedures that could have a significant negative impact on the international competitiveness of U.S. high technology. Apple, Compaq, and IBM compete vigorously with each other every day in the marketplace. However, we share a common concern that a petition for antidumping relief could produce an unintended result.

Flat panel displays -- very thin computer screens -- are currently used in laptop and notebook computers. U.S. production of these displays is limited to what are known as emissive technologies -- electroluminescence and gas plasma. For technological reasons, including color and power management, all of our laptop and notebook products employ a non-emissive technology known as liquid crystal. The electroluminescence and gas plasma displays made by the United States industry that has petitioned for antidumping relief are unacceptable technological substitutes for liquid crystal displays.

We support the application of the antidumping law when a viable domestic industry is threatened by unfairly traded imports. But, when there is no domestic industry, we question a procedure that would nonetheless impose antidumping duties. We are deeply concerned at the prospect of such duties on the import of liquid crystal displays from Japan since these displays are not manufactured in the United States. The international competitive implications of such duties would cast doubt on the viability of U.S.-based manufacturing of products incorporating liquid crystal displays, the fastest growing segment of the computer industry.

We would appreciate it if our representatives could meet with your staff to explain, in greater detail, the international competitive implications for the U.S. computer industry of restricting the import of liquid crystal displays. They will contact your office in the next week.

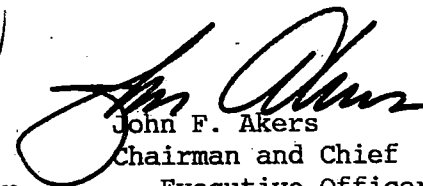

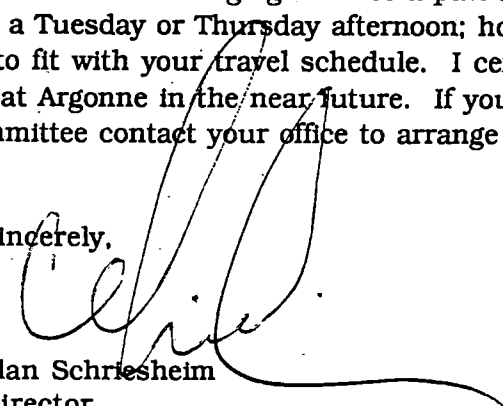
Dear Governor Sununu:

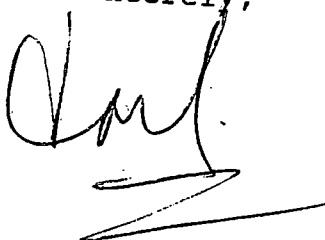

I am taking this opportunity to write to you in light of what I perceive to be very dangerous economic conditions which now prevail. When we had dinner with you and Governor McKernan, I was very impressed with your grasp of economics. In that regard, may I please take this opportunity to share with you my serious reservations regarding not only the economic times that this country now finds itself in, but specifically the actions of Alan Greenspan.

I was absolutely appalled when travelling to New York to read USA Today and saw what Mr. Greenspan was quoted as saying that "we have a stable economy, clearly not one that is deteriorating". It seems that everyone has a short memory as to the chaotic conditions Mr. Greenspan created when he was last head of the Fed. Today's events are certainly starting to parallel the history of 1930.

On May 10, most of the last bond auction had been purchased by dealers. When they found they could not sell the bonds, they began to cut the price of their holdings and in effect raise the yields, but they did so at sharp losses. It is apparent that the Treasury is not flushed with cash from tax payments. Even more frightening, the M-1 money supply reached a peak of \$851.9 billion on April 1, and the following month it was reduced to \$840.3 billion. Back on February 1, M-1 was \$832 billion. In 2 months, M-1 grew by \$20 billion. Wall Street expected M-1 to increase another \$10 billion higher by May 1. However, instead of being up \$10 billion, M-1 was down \$10 billion. It was a \$20 billion gap between what Wall Street and the economist subconsciously believed was in the M-1 till. The Fed has actually stopped the growth of money which is further confirmed by the broader M-2 numbers.

M-2 reached \$3,379.1 billion on March 18. Six weeks later, M-2 stood at \$3,377.9 billion. Six weeks after March 18, the M-2 money supply was lower by \$1.2 billion. In the interim, M-2 got higher. On April 15, M-2 reached \$3,388.7 billion, but this only makes the fall that more dramatic from that level. In

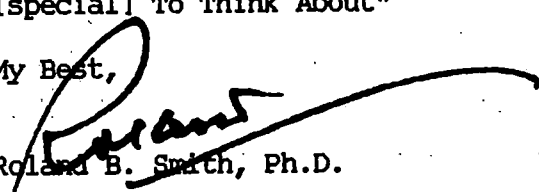
I really think this has a sound economic base, good potential for bringing in the cash, especially from former non-payers, and provides for fairness to low income earners determined according to each individuals economic status.

I am writing to share with you my concerns regarding the Office of Personnel Management's proposed guidelines affecting the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC), the annual charitable giving campaign for federal employees. After May 15, OPM will submit these proposals to the President for approval by executive order. As chair of the board of The Metropolitan Atlanta United Way, I ask that you urge OPM to withdraw the proposals and support efforts to establish a Presidential commission to study ways in which federal employees' contributions to the CFC can be used for their maximum benefit.

There are two proposals, which, if enacted, would damage United Way's ability to impact local needs. First, agencies would receive the same percentage of undesignated funds as they receive from designated dollars. Second, the donor could designate a gift to all local or national participating agencies. As a result, the undesignated funds which, historically, have assisted local communities in meeting pressing needs, would be diluted. Therefore, United Way is firmly opposed to OPM's measures, as they would reduce the availability of undesignated funds to local communities.

OPM estimates that, based on these changes, 1991 undesignated dollars would be reduced to 1% of the total campaign, down from about 12% nationally in 1990. Based on that figure and on United Way of Metropolitan Atlanta's share of undesignated dollars in the last campaign, United Way would receive less than \$6,000 in undesignated funds for local agencies. That is a decrease of \$189,210 from last year's amount.

The disturbing reality of such a sizable reduction is that there would be fewer resources to distribute among the seventy-eight agencies supported by the United Way of Metropolitan Atlanta. These agencies offer more than 250 community-based programs to people in a ten-county area which is home to more than 46,000 federal employees, many of whom benefit from these programs.

There is no evidence to suggest that OPM's proposals are based on anything more than an arbitrary mathematical equation which is designated to achieve proportional distribution as opposed to meeting the needs of people in local communities. Among the organizations in our community that would be affected are the American Red Cross and the USO.

The cumulative impact of austerity cuts made to the federal social services budget, combined with reductions levied upon Georgia's Department of Human Resources during 1991, will limit the amount of public funds available. These funds are vital to the state's growing population of persons qualifying for Medicaid, AFDC benefits, unemployment insurance and other forms of public assistance. It has been United Way's experience that when there are fewer public resources available, those in need of assistance turn to the nonprofit community to help fill the void in services left by these budget cuts. This condition underscores the need to maximize the potential of human care organizations to provide effective, quality services to their constituents. OPM's newly proposed guidelines, however, would only frustrate our efforts to accomplish this critical objective.

The proposals also conflict with President Bush's stated commitment to empowering volunteer-oriented nonprofits, such as those supported by United Way. During his State of the Union Message Mr. Bush reaffirmed this commitment by calling upon the "community of conscience" to contribute to a collection effort to address human service needs in our nation's communities.

OPM has a responsibility to ensure that the money contributed by federal employees, particularly the undesignated donors, is distributed in a manner that is both thoughtful and responsible.

I urge your immediate action on this critical issue.

Thank you for taking time out of your demanding schedule to consider this matter.

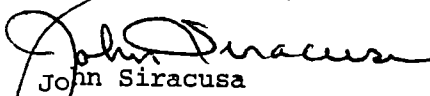
