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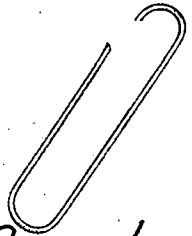

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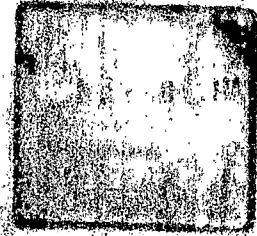

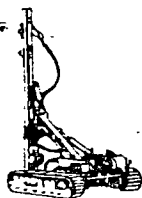

Dear Governor Sununu:

The House version of the Coast Guard Authorization Bill for fiscal year 1992, (H.R. 1776) contains a provision authorizing the Coast Guard to acquire one new command and control aircraft. This provision is not contained in the Senate bill, (S. 1297), as introduced. It is my understanding that the Senate Commerce Committee will markup the Senate bill during July. I would like to solicit your support for this new command and control aircraft.

The command and control aircraft is used not only by the Commandant of the Coast Guard but also by the top officers in the Coast Guard in the conduct of their official business. The Commandant is a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and as such must be immediately available to the President in times of national emergency. During the recent war in the Persian Gulf, the Coast Guard proved to be an integral part of the nations military effort. The Gulf Stream 2 was needed during that time not only to provide immediate and secure transportation for the Commandant and his staff, but was also needed to transport Coast Guard personnel to the Persian Gulf for the purpose of providing oil spill advice and assistance to the Saudi Arabian government.

The Coast Guard currently has two command and control aircraft. One is a Gulfstream 1 which is a propellor driven jet is approximately 28 years old and the other is a Gulfstream 2 which is 23 years old. Both aircraft require the expenditures of significant funds for upkeep and maintenance. Both planes have recently had extensive repairs. The Coast Guard estimates that the G1 will require \$5 million in maintenance over the next five years to keep it flying safely. The GII will need \$2 million in immediate repairs and because

of corrosion problems may need as much as \$20 million over the next five years. Spending this kind of money on repairs of old worn out planes makes no, fiscal sense.

The propellor plane is unreliable and recently lost an engine in midair. The plane which was carrying the Commandant at the time was required to make an emergency landing. The Coast Guard has not requested this airplane nor are they authorized by the administration to support the request. Therefore, recognizing the need and the possible danger to those who fly these planes, Congress has have a responsibility to address this issue at this time.

I have been assured that if my proposal passes, the Coast Guard will be seeking to purchase the least costly aircraft available that will fit their needs.

For these reasons, I strongly urge you to support the specific authorization for the Coast Guard to acquire one new command and control aircraft.

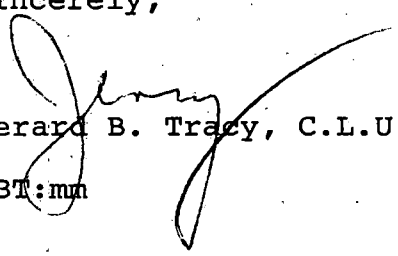

It is offensive to all American workers that American companies, having won contracts to do this rebuilding, would turn their backs on their fellow Americans and hire other foreign nationals instead. I feel that you were offended or at least surprised to learn what might happen in Kuwait and I certainly hope you will use all of your resources to make sure American workers are not short-changed.

Governor, you made it very clear that you would get back to me with your findings.

I thought you might be interested in the attached letters we recently sent to Congress outlining our opposition to passage of S. 5 / H.R. 2, the Parental and Medical Leave Act, and S. Res 78 / H. Res 101 which, if passed, would have denied the president's request for an extension of fast track negotiating authority.

This represents just one component of our overall lobbying strategy on these issues which included Hill visits and grassroots communication to our brewery and wholesaler network.

I want you to know how much Coors' appreciates the administration's commitment and resolve in opposing any legislation which proposes federally mandated benefits as a means of dealing with family/workplace problems. In addition, we believe the President's course in setting a strategy to eliminate trade barriers and thus allow us to more effectively compete in world markets is vital.

Finally, we are beginning the process of executing substantial legislative efforts in support of the administration's push to renew China's most favored nation status (MFN).

Failure to renew MFN could have a devastating financial impact on Coors' Bio- Technology Company and its ability to compete in the marketplace. Coors' Biotech currently imports vitamins from China for animal feed fortification and, in addition, is working on closing an agreement to export ribo-flavin (vitamin B-2) for animal feed use in China. 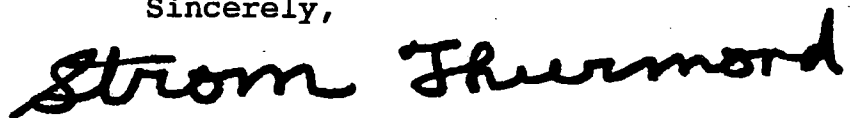
