Dear Mr. Sununu:

If no one has apprised you of a problem back home in New Hampshire, I want to. S.K. Tool Company polluted a town well in Milford, N.H. The company sold out and left. Two companies in the immediate vicinity, Hitchiner Manufacturing Co. and Hendrix Wire and Cable Co. may be ordered by the E.P.A. to clean it up. If that happens Hitchiner Manufacturing Co. will be forced to cease operations in New Hampshire and will probably move all its production to its plant in Mexico. I doubt Hendrix can go it alone. The devastating results are obvious. Can you help?

Please find position papers enclosed that were presented by Hitchiner Manufacturing Company. I am an employee of that company.

Hitchiner generally supports the EPA's proposed remedy for the site although we have some technical and phasing concerns which will be addressed in a written technical brief before August 12th from our environmental engineering consultants.

Hitchiner insists that the issue of fairness in deciding who is going to pay for the clean-up is just as important, if not more so, than how it is going to be done. The Well and aquifer problem was caused by O.K. Tool Company. O.K. Tool should bear the major share of the cost. Since the EPA has assigned the issue of O.K. Tool to be dispersed to its parent company, fairness dictates that Superfund monies be used to pay for O.K. Tool's share of the costs that will be incurred.

It was obvious in 1985 that the primary contamination at the site was the handling of PCE at the O.K. Tool Company. Nevertheless, the four local companies agreed to conduct the study to determine the extent of the problem and what should be done to deal with it. Hitchiner joined in the effort to study this site, working closely with EPA as required by the Superfund Law, because we believed it was the fair and reasonable thing to do as responsible members of the community.

That study has now been completed, and has confirmed what we knew all along; O.K. Tool caused the contamination which will require

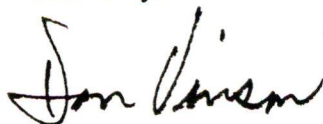

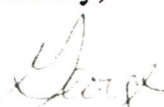
Dear John:

Savage Inequalities, an extraordinary book written by an extraordinary man, will be published in September. On behalf of Alberto Vitale, Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Random House, and Michelle Sidrane, Executive Vice President and Publisher of Crown Publishers, I invite you to a dinner in Washington on Thursday evening, September 19, to meet the author, Jonathan Kozol. We believe that what he has to say about public education in the United States will burn its way into the conscience of every individual who cares about this nation's children and their future.

In 1964 Mr. Kozol, Harvard-educated and a Rhodes Scholar, took a job teaching fourth grade in a poor neighborhood in Boston. Out of his experiences came Death at an Early Age, an uncompromising look at the destruction of the hearts and minds of young black children in the Boston public schools. Now regarded as a classic, the book won a National Book Award and has sold more than 2 million copies in the U.S. and overseas. Mr. Kozol has continued to illuminate areas of social and educational injustice, focusing attention on the problem of adult illiteracy in his book Illiterate America and painting an unforgettable picture of the lives of homeless families in Rachel and Her Children.

Twenty-five years after the publication of Death at an Early Age, he set out to take another look at our system of public education, examining schools in a number of urban and suburban areas in cities such as Boston, East St. Louis, New York, Chicago, and Washington, as well as in Texas and in the South. Savage Inequalities, which will be published in September, is the result of that study.

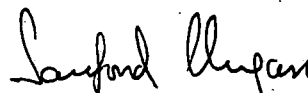

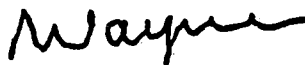

Dear Governor Sununu:

It has come to my attention that you received a letter from Tennessee Congressman Don Sundquist stating his opposition to an Ohioan filling the upcoming vacancy on the U. S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit. Because I believe the filling of this vacancy is very important to Ohio, and because of the inaccurate statements in the Congressman's letter, I feel compelled to write to you at this time.

I refer to a letter sent to you by Ohio Republican Party Chairman Robert T. Bennett, who notes the history of judges on the court and that judicial distribution was based on state size. Historically, Ohio and Michigan were equal in number until 1984, when the circuit was expanded by four judges, resulting in five judges for Michigan, four for Ohio and three each for Kentucky and Tennessee. The nomination of Judge Alice Batchelder to the new seat in Ohio federal district court, and replacing Judge Krupansky with an Ohioan, would restore the historical balance to the court.

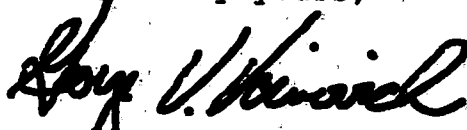
As indicated in a letter sent by my chief of staff, Paul Mifsud, to Ron Kaufman, I fully support the selection of N. Victor Goodman to fill the vacancy on the Sixth Circuit which will be created when Judge Robert B. Krupansky takes senior status on July 1, 1991. I am joined by seven members of Ohio's Republican congressional delegation, as well as Chairman Bennett.

I also refer to Chairman Bennett's letter explaining caseload distribution, and the fact that Congressman Sundquist erroneously assumes that each judge's caseload consists of appeals filed only from that judge's home state. In fact, a judge's caseload is not so limited, but rather drawn at random and an appeal from Ohio is not automatically assigned to a judge from Ohio. For that reason, Congressman Sundquist's figures as to the caseload of judges from Ohio and Tennessee are incorrect, as well as meaningless.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that you recommend to President Bush that Judge Krupansky's Ohio seat not be taken from Ohio. I would also again voice my strong recommendation that N. Victor Goodman be appointed to fill the Krupansky seat.
