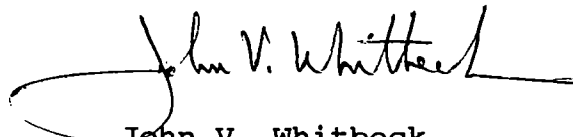
In the hope that an international peace conference may truly be near and that, accordingly, minds must soon focus on substance rather than procedure if such a conference is to have any hope of producing peace, I am taking the liberty of sending you the most recent of the ten published versions of the "Two States, One Holy Land" framework for peace.

Since January 1988, this framework has also been published by the Los Angeles Times, Al-Qabas (Kuwait), the International Herald Tribune, the Jerusalem Post (West Jerusalem), Al-Yamamah (Saudi Arabia), Al-Fajr (East Jerusalem) and the Christian Science Monitor (Boston) and twice by Middle East International (London).

I believe that any framework for peace which, notwithstanding that its author is a mere private citizen, has been published by prominent newspapers on both sides of Jerusalem must have some intrinsic merit, must be very finely balanced and should have a genuine chance of forming the basis of a settlement acceptable to both sides.

I hope that you will take the time to consider it seriously - and will forgive me for sending you a form letter. I wish to reach, as quickly as possible, all those who could count in the search for peace with some measure of justice in the Holy Land.

On behalf of the National Society of Professional Engineers (NSPE), I am writing to share our comments on the Administration's recently announced comprehensive plan for improving protection of the nation's wetlands. In addition, I am submitting our Position Statement on Wetlands Protection, which was adopted by NSPE's Board of Directors on July 26, 1991.

The National Society of Professional Engineers represents 75,000 engineers of all technical disciplines, employed in all areas of practice, including industry, education, government, private practice, and construction.

We are pleased that many of our recommendations pertaining to wetlands protection are consistent with components of the Administration's strategy. For example, the Administration's plan proposes to expand research on wetlands; revise the *Federal Manual for Identifying and Delineating Jurisdictional Wetlands* (Manual); improve training on the use of the Manual; define selected wetland categories based on function and value; and establish mitigation banking guidelines. NSPE is supportive of these individual components of the Administration's strategy.

While supportive of these programs, NSPE urges the Administration to implement them in the context of a restructured wetlands regulatory framework. Such a framework should concentrate regulatory responsibilities for a national wetlands program at the state and local level. Under the NSPE plan as outlined in the enclosed position statement, local governments should have primary responsibility for administering a nationally-defined wetlands permitting program through the development of wetlands conservation plans or the incorporation of such plans into existing land-use planning activities. States should be responsible for developing wetlands management plans consistent with federal goals and implementing a

wetlands identification, inventory, classification, and indexing system. The federal government should have the responsibility for developing minimum standards for such a system, certifying state wetlands plans, and funding research education and outreach. NSPE believes that protection of the nation's wetland resources can best be achieved, while meeting the future infrastructure and development needs of this country, within this framework.

NSPE supports the Administration's stated goal of no net loss of these valuable ecological resources. We are confident that the framework we have proposed provides a fair mechanism for achieving this goal. NSPE encourages you to consider our proposal as you further define the Administration's long-term wetlands protection policy. Dear Governor Sununu:

For years in Alabama we have had many severe obstacles to medical care which has resulted in our having one of the highest infant mortality rates and one of the lowest levels of funding for child health care in the country. Our eligibility level for medicaid has been the lowest (16% of federal poverty level) in the country, consequently we have had vast numbers of the working poor who have no health insurance and no way to pay for medical costs.

We still have a long way to go, but the past 3-4 years have seen tremendous strides in improving our health indicators, especially the infant mortality rate and in perinatal care. This has been done by increasing medicaid eligibility and reimbursement, especially in the perinatal area and by having to comply with the mandates of SOBRA and OBRA 89. The preventive programs that are being implemented have been shown, time and time again, to be extremely cost-effective.

The only way the State of Alabama has been able to improve its desperate situation is through a provider-specific tax program which, combined with federal matching funds, has raised 795 million dollars, or 49% of its medicaid budget. This method was approved by Congress in OBRA 90 as a state's right, but now Richard Dorman, Director of the OMB, is attempting to eliminate this very successful fund-raising effort. Without this funding the entire state medicaid system would be in jeopardy since we have to meet federal mandates in order to qualify for federal funding.

This would be devastating to the health care of our children and pregnant women. It should be an unacceptable alternative for any of us.

I would implore you to use your influence to not allow OMB to take away our right to tax and to expend tax revenue as we determine best for our citizens.

Dear John:

Following up on last Friday's meeting with you and Boyden Gray regarding Wyoming's interest in the 10th Circuit Court of Appeals judgeship, we want to reiterate once again the importance of this appointment to us and our state.

As we said, Wyoming and New Mexico are the only two 10th Circuit states that have only one judge on that bench. When Congress passed the Federal Judgeship bill last year, it was with the good faith belief that Wyoming and New Mexico would get the two new judgeships created. Oklahoma and all the other states in the circuit already have two judges each; on that court, and Wyoming deserves one of these new seats.

The Department of Justice says that Oklahoma's caseload somehow justifies one or both of these seats. We would remind you that Oklahoma has some 200 death row inmates, which is a large part of its circuit caseload, and frankly the two sitting Oklahoma judges on the 10th Circuit don't seem to have done much to deal with them. There have only been three death penalty executions from the 10th Circuit in 20 years--and all three were Utah cases.

At the district level, Oklahoma also has a large number of bankruptcies, which constitute a significant amount its federal caseload, but the fact is that they are not commonly appealed. Also, much of Oklahoma's caseload is from Indian-related issues. Wyoming has one of the largest Indian reservations in the nation, and a Wyoming judge would be equally sensitive to those problems and issues.

If caseload is the determining factor, Oklahoma's problem is not that it lacks 10th Circuit judges, but that it needs more district judges. Let's give them more of the latter if we need to address Oklahoma's caseload problem. If, on the other hand, the Administration is saying that only judges from Oklahoma are equipped to handle Oklahoma appeals, that is hogwash. A Wyoming

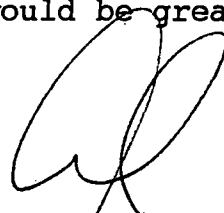

Government imposed regulations have placed paperwork burdens on us that are onerous.

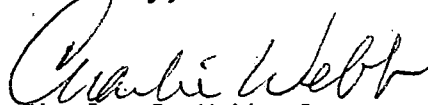
Consequently, I write to urge the Administration's support for S. 1139, the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1991, recently introduced by Senator Nunn and a bipartisan group of senators.

This measure would reauthorize the Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs (OIRA) for an additional five years, address the Dole v. United Steelworkers decision that significantly weakened OIRA's ability to constrain unnecessary imposition of paperwork burdens, and would require the establishment of a government-wide goal to reduce the aggregate paperwork burden by fully five percent, among other important reforms.

Needless to say, passage of S. 1139 is of great importance to our company and the entire business community, especially small business. The importance of paperwork reduction, however, transcends business interests and reaches on a day-to-day basis ordinary citizens. Indeed, the perceived legitimacy of and respect for, government materially hinges on minimizing the paperwork burden that now prevails. A strong, unequivocal statement of Administration support is crucial to the Bill's fate, and the remedy it seeks.

I urge the President to take a leadership role on this issue. Thanks for your consideration.

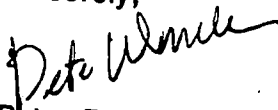

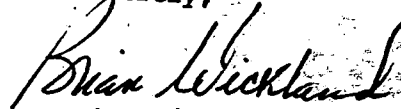

Susan and I would like to thank you for all of the hard work and wisdom that you have given both to the State of New Hampshire as Governor and to the United States as Chief of Staff for President Bush.

Your guidance and wisdom was a major factor in resolving the chiropractic dilemma that existed in the State of New Hampshire. At present, chiropractic in New Hampshire is running extremely well with no intraprofessional controversies. All problems and difficulties are being resolved behind closed doors before being brought to the public and to the legislature.

Whenever one problem is resolved, it always seems that there is another to take its place. The Administration's proposal to eliminate the Health Education Assistance Loan (HEAL) Program, and to expressly exclude chiropractic college students from programs that would replace HEAL is a matter that touches hundreds of thousands of Americans. Ultimately, it will, if enacted, impact millions of American consumers who will be denied the free choice of health care providers through the market domination of the medical profession that the squeezing out of alternative providers will insure.

Attached is testimony presented to the US Congress on May 30, 1991, on the HEAL issue. Included in these remarks are statements by the International Chiropractors Association, on whose Board of Directors I currently serve, the Association of Chiropractic Colleges, representing 14 schools and nearly 10,000 students and the American Black Chiropractors Association.

The critical points I want you to understand are as follows:

- . Historically, chiropractic education has received little or no federal assistance. This is in sharp contrast to the hundreds of billions poured into medical education in this country from the public purse.

- . In the health care marketplace, chiropractic has, likewise, been sustained by private sector demand. In the current year, the average medical doctor will receive well over half his/her income from government programs. For the doctor of chiropractic, this figure is somewhere around eight percent. If there is one primary health care profession that can point to private sector demand and to genuine marketplace validity, it is chiropractic.

- . Chiropractic students have excellent default levels in other student loan programs. Only in the HEAL Program are there noteworthy problems, and these can be clearly traced back to structural flaws in the program itself. The establishment of an adequate grace period prior to the beginning of the payback schedule will solve such default problems as exist in excess of our current fine record in other programs.

- . HEAL provides for generous deferments for medical school graduates, allowing years of internship, residency and post-graduate study deferral.

- . What is urgently needed is the amendment of the payback schedule to reflect the realities of the post-graduation process of obtaining a chiropractic license and establishing a practice. The process of licensure can easily take a full year, or perhaps even longer, depending on the time of graduation. It is not possible in many instances to have a license and be earning a professional income before the payback obligation begins.

- . The HEAL Program is no giveaway. Those who borrow pay at the highest rate of any federal

assistance program. Most borrowers do pay their loans in full and on time. To eliminate this program would seriously and unfairly hurt able, motivated, courageous young people who have no other means of funding a chiropractic education.

These and other points made in the testimony provide a convincing argument in favor of a change in the Administration's attitude toward chiropractic students and for a reexamination of the HEAL Proposal. I hope you will look at this question closely and objectively. If you have questions or wish additional information, I can provide, on behalf of my professional organization, prompt and detailed responses on any issue related to this matter.

This proposal and specifically the way it is worded concerning chiropractic will be devastating to the growth of chiropractic not only now, but in the future.

Governor, any assistance or advice you can give concerning this critical issue would be so appreciated.

Dear Governor:

A federal judge in Philadelphia has restrained Julianne Ross Davis, General Counsel for the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA), from further repetition of defamatory comments about the American Family Association or me.

I, along with AFA, sued Ms. Davis in federal court for defamation and sought a restraining order. The judge's order addressed statements first made by Davis in a speech at the University of Pennsylvania Law School on October 24, 1990. She told an audience of law students and professors that

"The American Family Association (headed by the Reverend Wildmon) is simply a direct mail political action committee. And it has a 24-point political agenda it would like to see obtained by the year 2000. And it's not a pretty agenda. I saw a report a few days ago. It includes the elimination of democracy, elimination of public schools, (and) advocates that astrologers, adulterers, blasphemers, homosexuals, and incorrigible children be executed, preferably by stoning. That's one of our enemies. This is true."

Equally as appalling as the remarks made by Ms. Davis are the sworn statements of NEA Chairman John Frohnmayer after he knew that Ms. Davis had uttered these false statements about me and AFA in her speech.

Chairman Frohnmayer, fully knowing that what Ms. Davis had said was false, declared under penalty of perjury on March 28 that Davis presented "the views and position of the N.E.A....In fact, the statements that Ms. Davis made during the public presentation that the plaintiffs complain of were not only part of her official duties, but are also exactly the type of speech that she is employed to perform."

It is astounding that Chairman Frohnmayer would say, under oath, that the statements by the NEA General Counsel were "part of her official duties" and "exactly the type of speech that she is employed to perform." Mr. Frohnmayer made these statements under penalty of perjury while sworn to tell the truth! And this comes from a man who holds a degree in Christian ethics.

Frohnmayr stated that Ms. Davis' statements "occurred within my authorized time, and their purpose clearly was to further the interests of the N.E.A...."

He also said that Ms. Davis was "acting as the official designee of the N.E.A. when she presented the controversial statements to the audience at Pennsylvania State University on October 24, 1990."

Frohnmayr concluded: "After carefully reviewing the text of her speech [her speech included the false statements], it is my view as Chairman of the N.E.A. and a member of the Federal Council on the Arts and Humanities, that Ms. Davis was acting within the scope of her employment and was speaking to further an important public interest and on behalf of the National Endowment for the Arts..."

For the head of a national government agency to act in such a manner indicates a lack of integrity and leadership. His contempt for taxpayers concerned about NEA abuse of their funds is regrettable.

Under the court-approved settlement which is a part of the court's order, Davis is restrained from any further utterance or publication of the false statements. She must also pay me and AFA \$100,000 in damages if it is ever repeated. In the agreement Davis admits the statements were false and is compelled to send a letter of retraction to the Deans of the University of Pennsylvania Law School and Wharton School of Business, whose students also attended the speech. The agreement also requires the NEA General Counsel to send a letter of apology to me and AFA. We have agreed to drop the remainder of the lawsuit against Davis for damages.

I am gratified over this restraint on the NEA's top lawyer and pleased with the retraction and the apology. It's unfortunate that we have had to humiliate the NEA's number two official in order to stop her from uttering these lies. However, no smear by any NEA official will stop our public criticism of the NEA's continuing abuse of the taxpayer's money.

The comments in question are underlined. Responding to an NEA press statement that he had issued no restraining order, U.S. District Judge Robert S. Gawthrop III told the Washington Times: "The order speaks for itself. It was stipulated and agreed to by all parties. The order is rather clear. I guess she [Ms. Davis] can call a cow a pig if she wants to."

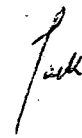
Dear John:

I want to thank you for your help as we attempt to resolve the issues surrounding OBRA '87 and, specifically, how the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA) had proposed the use of guidelines to interpret those provisions.

As you know, HCFA and the State of California's Department of Health Services had reached an impasse on issues that were not related to OBRA '87 nursing home law or regulations. Subsequent to my original letter to you and our phone conversation a few weeks ago, federal and state staff have worked together and are continuing to work together to reach agreement as to how the law and regulations are to be implemented.

I would also like you to know that Darrel J. Grinstead, HCFA General Counsel, and HCFA staff in the San Francisco regional office, were tough but fair negotiators, and have been of assistance in attempting to resolve this matter.

Again, thank you for your efforts and your support of our earlier request. I look forward to continuing to work with the federal government to improve the quality of our nursing homes.

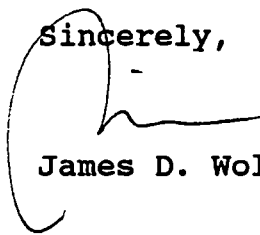

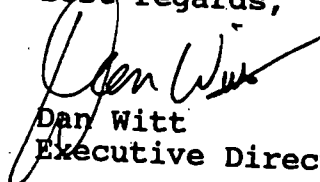

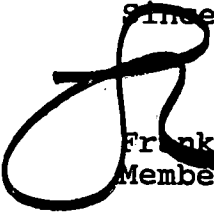
