Dear Mr. John Sunnunu:

We are for the first time seriously considering voting for, supporting, and campaigning for, NON INCUMBENT Republicans or Democrats in the 1992 election.

The economy in the State of New Hampshire has not seen "such hard business times" since the 1929 depression. N.H.'s largest five banks have "Failed" miserably. These banks were sold to other banks which don't appear to have the necessary FLEXIBILITY, ABILITY, WILL or CAPITAL to infuse our already long standing "choked" economy. What are we to do?

3. FDIC financing of foreclosure properties. (Why not refinance before foreclosure if the existing businessman has good collateral but needs money to temporarily make his payments? EX. A 1-2 year moratorium on payments, which would be allowed to accumulate depending on the present value of the collateral.)
4. Flexibility in handling some problem loans that could be made good in the next 1-3 years. Entrepreneurs don't always fit into pigeon hole regulations.
5. Allow banks to take the workable loans back from the FDIC without requiring them to set aside loan loss reserves and allowing them to give said loans back to the FDIC within 2-3 years without penalty if they prove to be unmanageable.

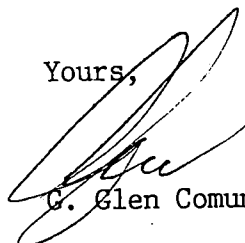

Where I serve as an outside the White House Advisor, as I did to several senior officials in the Reagan Administration, as you probably know. Course with this past sentence, this will sound less intriguing!

I believe part of the problem of the President's domestic programs are not getting over to the people is not only the Congress, but if you were to notice how the CSPAN covers the entire press conference when the President announces a particular domestic program, you get very little coverage in either the print media, or by the major television networks. We know that the major television networks, nor the print media can't give the time or space to cover the President's news conference, like the CSPAN can. But yet, I have noticed for the last several months that the same is true, and is not just an isolated incident I think that this should be looked into.

 program. Henry became a national figure during the Iran-Contra affair, not
 only because of his wisdom, but also of his sense of humor. We should not
 forget the Republican stalwarts in both the Congress and the Senate, who have
 in their own districts an already based campaign which would also be helpful
 in winning the grass roots support.

The Israeli-Americans should be reminded how the United States was extremely
 helpful to Israel in eliminating Iraq has a threat to their internal security
 to the State of Israel, while furnishing Israel with advanced hardware, plus
 the Patriot missiles, as we should not forget the vast economic aid given to
 the State of Israel.

For Arab-Americans, the U.S. established peace and stability in the Persian
 Gulf, with the peace process going forward between the Israelis and Arab
 nations, a final and just peace has a great chance of becoming reality better
 than before.

Many Americans forget about the economic impact of the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait.

Me: "We also give thanks that, when the war in the Gulf was over, General Schwarzkopf could report: "Central Command, all present -- or accounted for." We kept faith with those veterans who made the final sacrifice. We received an accounting and brought them home. Their loss is still a devastating one, but we pray that knowing their fate will allow our wounds to heal. **And at the same time, we remember the veterans of other wars; veterans for whom there has been no accounting as yet -- veterans missing in action. We will keep faith with them as well and will not rest until we have received that accounting.**"

Now, that may not be Churchillian prose, but it merited a reply at least, didn't it? If you think so, I'm still looking for a job and have been cleared by Presidential Personnel for anything you have available. I hope to hear from you.

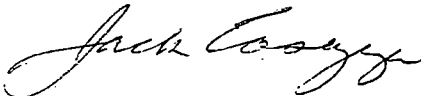

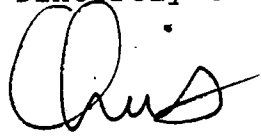
The purpose of this letter is to express my extreme displeasure with the current Democratic proposal to extend unemployment compensation.

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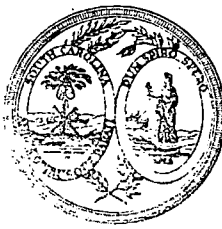

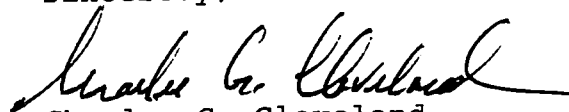
Dear Mr. Sununu:

I want to register my opposition to the interim final HCFA regulations published on September 12, 1991. The administration's statements that donations and provider specific taxes have not been used to improve services and extend medicaid coverage are not true of Alabama. Alabama is a poor state and cannot fund the medicaid mandates of the last five years without the use of donations, intergovernmental transfers, and provider specific taxes. The federally mandated programs for low income children and pregnant women will be severely damaged by the implementation of this regulation. The nursing home reforms mandated by OBRA are very expensive. The mandatory coverage of low income elderly who are qualified medicaid beneficiaries is another tremendous expense to the state.

If the administration does not support these programs, the disagreements should be addressed through the legislative process. It is unfair to the states to enact these programs into law, then use executive action to undercut a state's ability to tax and expend state revenue.

We urge that the regulations be revised to allow states to continue these valuable services to Alabama's low income citizens.

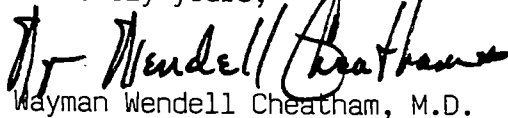
It would be a great honor to have a representative from the White House present at our affair and to have that individual take part in the honoring of Mrs. Doe.

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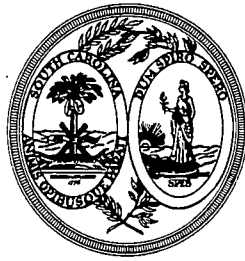

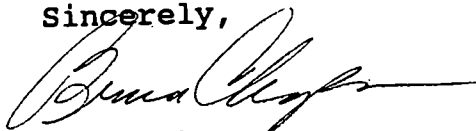

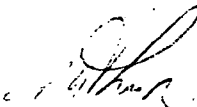

Dear Mr. Sununu:

On October 31, 1991, the United Nations General Assembly passed a landmark resolution. It was sponsored by Poland and co-sponsored by Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania, Albania, Byelorussia, the Ukraine, the Philippines, El Salvador, Costa Rica, Guatemala, France, the United Kingdom, the USSR and the United States. It was approved by consensus; not one voice of dissent was heard.

The resolution basically established the Institute of East-West Dynamics as an affiliated UN operation and authorized the Institute to accept voluntary contributions from UN Member States. The Institute has been operating as a United States 501(c)(3) corporation since 1989 and, by charter, defines its role as "the promotion of governmental and private activities designed to accelerate the development of market economies in nations making the transition from central planning." Specifically, as the language of the resolution suggests, the Institute will offer assistance "through transfer of professional and technical expertise."

The main reason the undersigned feel the resolution was "landmark" is that, as you are well aware, there are strong elements in the United Nations system which have held strong socialistic convictions and, even at this time in history, still hold out for a socialistic revision of the free market trend. These forces are led by the UN Director General, Antoine Blanca, a doctrinaire

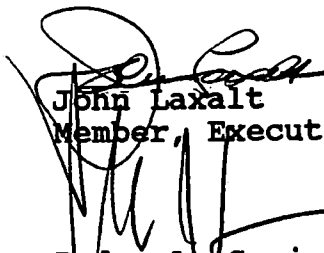
French socialist who frequently declares publicly his dislike of American influence in Eastern Europe. Mr. Blanca is joined in his mission by the traditionally anti-U.S. Centre on Transnational Corporations and some elements within the United Nations Development Programme, which, as you know, is funded in large part by United States voluntary contributions.

We feel that the Institute, which is the sole example of market-oriented UN activities, should receive a moderate UNDP grant to conduct its programs. Your assistance in this matter will be greatly appreciated.

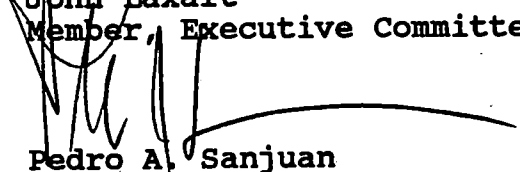

Dear Governor Sununu:

The recent Medicaid regulations that eliminate or restrict a wide variety of state financing approaches will create severe problems for many state budgets and, more importantly, will reduce health services to poor families, their children and the elderly. Under attack are voluntary contributions and provider-based taxes which have been used by states, counties and providers to meet increasing service demands and rising health care costs. The use of some types of intergovernmental transfers, an integral part of Medicaid since its enactment, are also in question. The regulations must be withdrawn and a legislative remedy found.

In the 1990 OBRA legislation, Congress extended the moratorium on regulations affecting voluntary contributions. Congress intended to continue allowing provide-based taxes. Limitations on intergovernmental transfers were not even discussed.

The need for services will not end if the regulations stand. What would end is another piece of intergovernmental cooperation in addressing a national problem: providing health care to the poor.

Legislation and withdrawal of the regulations is needed

Given the President's interest in visiting schools, I would like to invite him to participate in a presidential teleconference on the STEP/Star educational television network. It would be an opportunity to utilize some of the most state-of-the-art technology used in education today and personally reach over 500 schools in 10 states -- all at once without leaving Washington, D.C.

This innovative use of technology, supported by a federal grant, has proven to be extremely successful in assisting many of America's students. The program is the Satellite Telecommunications Educational Programming network (STEP/Star). STEP/Star reaches about 6,000 students through full-time courses and 8,000 through special programming known as enrichment. An estimated 33,500 teachers also have access to for-credit, graduate-level courses offered on the network.

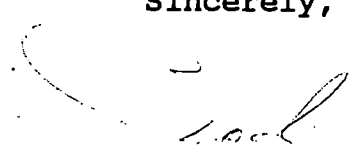
STEP/Star, which is operated by Educational Service District (ESD) 101 in Spokane, Washington, offers live, interactive K-12 programming that allows teachers and students to communicate through two-way audio and one-way video. Teleconferences from our nation's capital with members of Congress have been a regular feature.

It's a great system with which I am personally familiar. Two years ago I participated in a live teleconference from D.C. with high school students around the Northwest. Since then, ESD 101 has received a federal Star Schools grant which has allowed it to expand its network by 400 sites. By the end of this year, an estimated 532 schools will be on-line. STEP/Star programming is now seen in Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Idaho, Kansas, Mississippi, Montana, North Dakota, Oregon, and Washington.

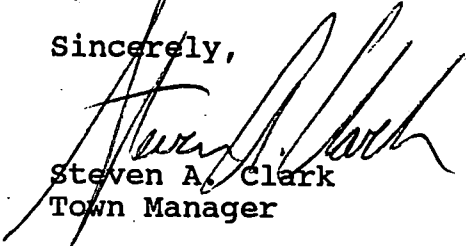

Since our meeting I have been following our weekly figures and see no improvement whatsoever to date in either gains or in delinquency. None of our regions in the United States show any significant improvement in charge off or delinquency through the end of September.

Similarly, there is no trend whatsoever for an improvement in credit growth throughout the country. I enclose two charts which exclude all purchases to date for both 1990 and 1991 and you can see that the trend line has been negative since June. Overall, we are still in a positive mode because we are making significant purchases from the RTC, S & L's and banks and, thus, are gaining market share. However, the internal growth which more truly reflects the state of the consumer remains dismal.

I will continue to monitor this extremely closely (for obvious reasons of self interest), and should there be any trend line change you will be the first to know.

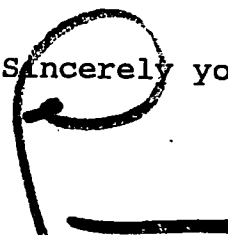

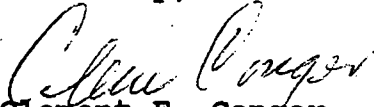

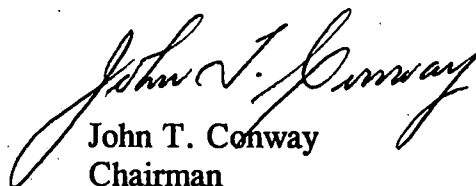
The current Members of the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board, after nomination by the President, with the advise and consent of the Senate, took office effective October 19, 1989.

By law, all Members of the Board in the future will serve for 5-year terms. However, the current Members comprising the initial Board have terms that vary from 2 years to 5 years. Mr. John W. Crawford, Jr. is the Board Member having the 2-year term, and his original appointment will expire October 19, 1991. I understand that the President intends to renominate Mr. Crawford to a full 5-year term; thus, he would succeed himself.

Chapter 21 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42 USC 2011 et seq) which established the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board provides that "A Member may serve after the expiration of that Member's term until a successor has taken office."

In order to avoid a break in service, and in accordance with the authority contained in Chapter 21 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 as amended, I, as Chairman of the Board, have signed the necessary personnel action (copy enclosed) continuing Mr. Crawford's service on the Board beyond October 19, 1991.

Dear Governor Sununu:

The recent Medicaid regulations that eliminate or restrict a wide variety of state financing approaches will create severe problems for many state budgets and, more importantly, could reduce health services to poor families, their children and the elderly. Under attack are voluntary contributions and provider-based taxes which have been used by states, counties and providers to meet increasing service demands and rising health care costs. The use of some types of intergovernmental transfers, an integral part of Medicaid since its enactment, are also in question.

I urge you to oppose the regulations and seek a legislative remedy.

In the 1990 OBRA legislation, Congress extended the moratorium on regulations affecting voluntary contributions. Congress intended to continue allowing provider-based taxes. Limitations on intergovernmental transfers was not even discussed.

Counties participate in Medicaid by making payments to their public hospitals, long term care facilities, and health departments. In some states, counties pay a portion of state Medicaid match. These methods have enabled us to serve more Medicaid-eligible individuals.

The need for services will not end if the regulations stand. What would end is another piece of intergovernmental cooperation in addressing a national problem: providing health care to the poor.

Legislation and withdrawal of the regulations is needed.

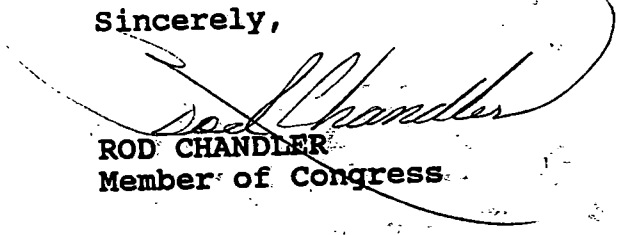

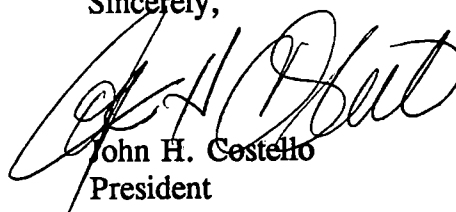

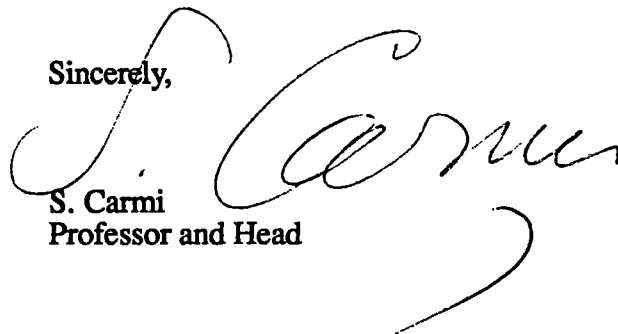

The Federal Library and Information Center Committee (FLICC) is a federal interagency committee established by the Library of Congress in 1965 to provide a mechanism for federal libraries to work cooperatively on pressing library problems and to strengthen the ability of federal libraries and information centers to contribute to the fulfillment of the missions of their agencies. Under the terms of FLICC's recently approved Bylaws, the Executive Office of the President is one of the thirty-three designated permanent members to FLICC.

This letter, therefore, is a request that you designate an Executive Office of the President representative to serve on the Committee. Your designated representative should be in a management position, authorized to speak for the library and information service interests of your office. Only federal employees are eligible to serve on FLICC. FLICC Committee members are expected to attend the quarterly FLICC membership meetings-- usually held at the Library of Congress-- with alternates sent only in emergencies. In addition, they are asked to advise and assist on occasion with one or more appropriate FLICC Working Groups devoted to specific topics of general concern to all federal libraries and information centers.

The permanent members of FLICC are the Librarian of Congress, the directors of the National Agricultural Library and the National Library of Medicine, designated representatives from each of the cabinet level executive departments and representatives of fifteen additional federal agencies that have major library programs, plus the chair of the FEDLINK Advisory Council. FEDLINK is FLICC's network component through which some 1600 federal agencies have cost-effective access to an array of contracted information support services including online reference databases from the major vendors, online cataloging, interlibrary loan, acquisitions, and serials control from bibliographic utilities, and ordering services of book jobbers and serials subscription agencies.

The enclosed factsheets and FLICC annual report give you further information about the objectives, functions, and the membership of FLICC. I look forward to receiving the name of your office's designated representative as soon as possible. The next Federal Library and Information Center Committee quarterly membership meeting, is scheduled for Thursday, September 26, 1991 in Dining Room A (6th floor), James Madison Building, Library of Congress. An agenda will be mailed in advance to your designated representative.

It is especially important at this time when important information issues face federal libraries and information centers that a full complement of designated FLICC members be active to address them.

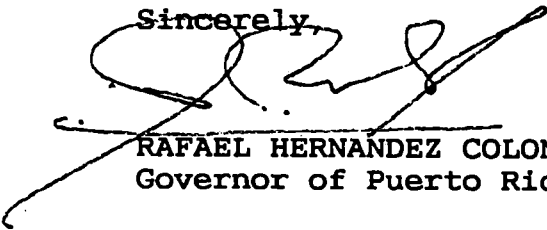
Dear Governor Sununu:

A front-page article in our local newspaper, "El Nuevo Día", yesterday, reported that the President is considering issuing an Executive Order that would in some way affect the relationship of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and the agencies of the United States Government. The matter is so important to Puerto Rico and the 3.3 million American citizens living here, that I would like to obtain a clarification.

The article states that, under the proposed Executive Order, Puerto Rico would be treated like a state by all Federal agencies. If this merely means that there would be no discrimination in federal social programs against Puerto Rico, that would of course not be cause for concern. If, however, the concept is one that would somehow affect the basic relationship between Puerto Rico and the United States, I think it only fair that the Government of Puerto Rico have the opportunity to be advised of the proposed policy change and be afforded the opportunity to present its point of view before the President issues the order.

I would appreciate your earliest response.
