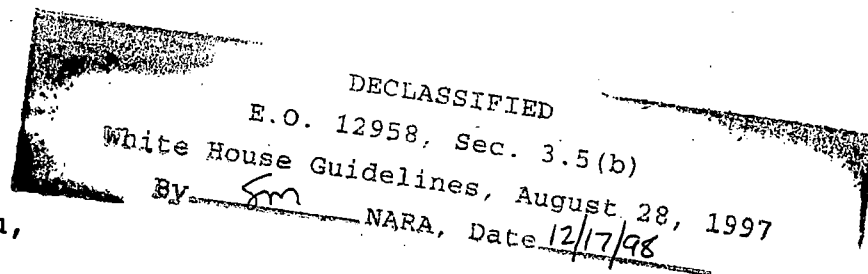

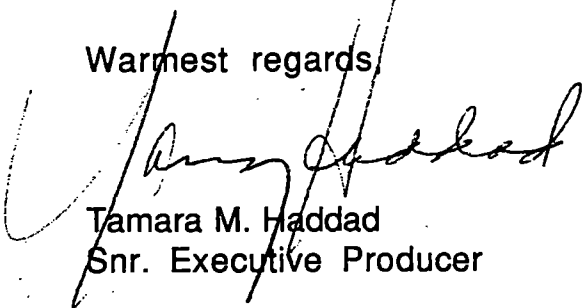

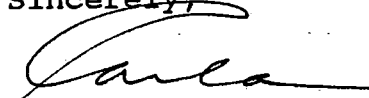
Dear John:

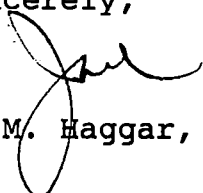

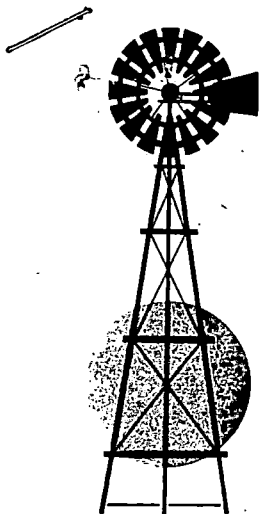

Christ's Peace!

I was very grateful to hear back from you in the matter of the group of fourteen people who were to have been executed down in Grenada, and to know that you had taken cognizance of it at the White House. Just how that worked out I don't know, but I was glad to see that the sentences were commuted.

I've been concerned with another quite different case in which a man's life is gravely endangered, and would ask your help with this. An Irishman, Patrick Stagg, is appealing against a deportation order and asking political asylum in the United States. The case will be decided in a U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Court in Boston, I expect on November 26th, by Judge Leonard Shapiro. If, as I hope, the judgment is favorable to Stagg, it is likely enough to be appealed by the government unless a decision is made that the favorable judgment should be allowed to stand. It is at that stage that I would look for your help.

The man, Patrick Stagg, comes from a family with a long history of very prominent Irish Republican activity, going back to the 1916 Easter Rebellion, and his uncle, Frank Stagg, is quite famous in Ireland, having died on hunger strike in an English jail in 1976. Patrick joined the Sinn Fein party as a teenager in 1972, was jailed in the Irish Republic in 1976 as an IRA man, though he denies that he was actually IRA (process in those trials is less than we would require in our law). At any rate, he came to the U.S. in 1985, an illegal immigrant, explicitly in order to separate himself once and for all from anything to do with Irish Republican politics or activity. He has married and brought up an adopted child since then, worked very hard, and to my knowledge been a decent and excellent man all that time, altogether separated from that earlier Irish Republican life.

His trouble began in 1989, when he was found out by an FBI man, who tried to get him to act as a spy-informant on Irish Republican types and their supporters in the Boston area. When the FBI agent first went to his house, he did not find Patrick Stagg at home, and left a card identifying himself as an FBI agent with a neighbor. Shortly afterward this agent was in all the media for having cracked the case of the several people who were trying to supply the IRA with advanced electronic and rocket technology, and all the Irish Republican types in the local

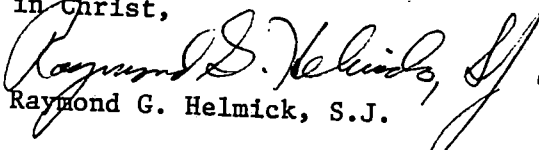
community drew the obvious conclusion that Stagg was an informer. Stagg's was turned upside down. The agent was threatening to have him deported unless he would act as his informant, he was under constant threat from IRA men and members of the still crazier INLA -- Irish National Liberation Army), and even when he ran away to Chicago under an assumed name, his wife was subjected to constant harassment from both sides. Consequently, on a lawyer's advice, Stagg turned himself in to the INS, so as to get the FBI man off his back. That of course exposed him to an immediate deportation order, which he has appealed, asking for political asylum on the basis that he would be very swiftly executed either by the IRA or the INLA if he were once returned to Ireland.

I've submitted an affidavit to the court on the danger Stagg would face if deported, and various people have written on his behalf. I'm enclosing here, for your information, a selection of the affidavits that describe the case, and a couple of pieces of evidence: the card left by the IRA agent with the neighbor, and a death-threat Mass card that Stagg received from Ireland.

I think it likely enough that the judge will decide favorably on this case, but the appeal of that decision by government might be simply automatic unless you in the Administration were alerted. I think Patrick Stagg ought to get asylum here, particularly in view of the role played in creating his endangerment by an agent of our government.

In the unlikely event that you have not seen Warren Brookes' "Confusing CO2 Cause and Effect" and Fred Singer's "Policy by Press Release" in today's WASHINGTON TIMES, p.F1, I would commend it to you. Brookes mentions the startling congruence between the length of solar cycles and global temperature variations found by Danish researchers whose paper is published in SCIENCE (Nov. 1, 1991, p. 698).

Given the public stance on global warming taken by the Administration and often attributed (I hope correctly) to your influence, I was particularly struck by the final sentence of the Danish paper -

"Estimation of the natural variability of the Earth's climate and its causes are needed before any firm conclusion regarding anthropogenic changes be made."

I would like to pass on to you a suggestion made by Fred Singer in a recent conversation...that the White House sponsor a conference to assess the current state of global warming science for the purpose of preparing the position to be taken by the U.S. in the forthcoming 1992 Brazil meetings. This would offer a public forum in which both proponents and skeptics among atmospheric scientists could debate the role of manmade gases in affecting climate.

Too often alarming scenarios are propounded, promoted by people like Senator Gore, and swallowed whole by the press with no opportunity for opposing views to be heard. Such a conference might provide enough confrontation and "cross examination" to make news and at the same time, allow credible opponents an unusual public chance to point out flaws in the conventional wisdom, thereby reducing the heat which the President must take in the course of wise policy-making.

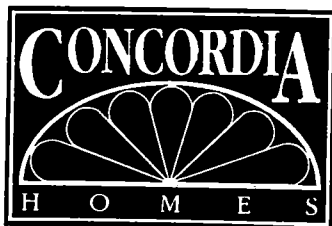

Dear Governor Sununu:

I have supported the President for years and continue to do so. I am writing to bring to your attention what I believe are mistakes that are occurring related to the credit crunch. It does no good for the President to stay home from a trip abroad only to be seen playing golf, while 600,000+ construction workers are without jobs. Times are very difficult for many of the people in our industry. The banking problem is serious, it is real, and it is not going to go away by election time. Spooking people about losing their credit five weeks before Christmas is just an example of how the banking industry might fight back.

At this point, I am extremely concerned about our ability to maintain Republican control of The White House. To me, this is a moral as well as a financial imperative, but the state of the economy may actually be worse in November, 1992, than it is today unless we can do something to ease construction loans to qualified borrowers on good projects.

I believe both Congress and the Administration have failed to understand the seriousness of this issue and want to hear that the President thinks we should wait until the State of the Union Address to make a proposal for fiscal solutions. I shudder because I recall in the early 1980's it was very difficult for the Reagan Administration to restart the economy.

This economy is going to be even harder to jump start because housing has previously led the economy out of slumps. As to housing leading the economy out of a slump this time, there may not be much of a building industry out there. In addition, I am pretty sure that the banks are not going to be lending because they have other agendas, including low-cost of funds and high interest income, to help them recoup and recapitalize. I also suspect, even though I can't prove it, that they are shrinking liquidity to recapitalize.

It is this last issue that concerns me the most. Liquidity has shrunk dramatically from the recession. It has shrunk dramatically from the OCC and the OTS and their bureaucratic bullying, the dramatic drop in M-1 and M-2, and the evaporation of our traditional banking system in favor of an elusive - and maybe never coming - future world market.

The next and most dramatic thing I believe will be the discovery, perhaps to late for the election of '92, that the banks in fact are not planning on lending until they shrink their assets down to a sufficient size so that their capital makes unlikely targets to merge in defunct or near defunct Savings & Loans and Banks. What a crisis this is!

Please warn the President this is not going to be resolved as quickly as he is being told.

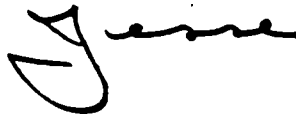

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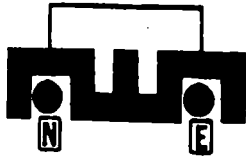

I do not know if you will remember me (when you were Governor of NH), but I am the Temple NH Fire Chief. Even though you are very busy, I would greatly appreciate if you could take a few moments to read my letter.

In August, the most wonderful thing in my life happened. I traveled to the Philippines and met Erlinda. She was my pen pal for quite some time and, through correspondence and telephone calls, we got to know each other very well. So when I finally met her, I fell in love with her and we were married in the Philippines on August 31st.

Erlinda comes from a rural area of the central Philippines called Busay. It is similar to Temple in New Hampshire. She comes from a large, but poor family that manages a living through flower farming. Even though they are poor, they managed to provide for an education for Erlinda. She has a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing which she obtained in Cebu, Philippines and has worked as a nurse several places including Cebu Doctor's Hospital. Erlinda is quiet, shy, and conservative. Just like her family, she is a practicing Roman Catholic who takes religion seriously. She is a person who loves children and small town life.

This is where we have much in common. I work as Engineering Manager for General Diagnostics Incorporated in Nashua, New Hampshire. Although I am employed in a high technology position in the computer support industry, I am very active in the small town in which I live. For the last ten years, I have been a member of the Temple Volunteer Fire Department. Since I joined, I have risked my life time and time again for my town and country. 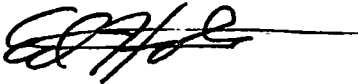

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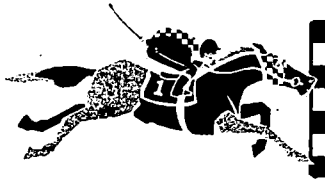

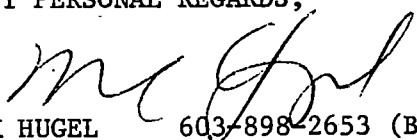

The Senate will shortly be taking up consideration of S.1220, the "National Energy Security Act of 1991," introduced by Sens. Bennett Johnston (D-LA) and Malcolm Wallop (R-WY). Though imperfect, this comprehensive bill can provide the necessary framework for creation of a workable national energy strategy and deserves vigorous debate rather than a threatened filibuster.

Increasing dependence on foreign oil and the rebirth of OPEC as a political force threatens this nation's long-term energy security. To deal with this threat, the United States needs a national energy policy.

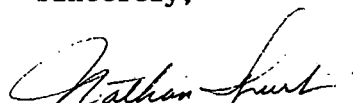
The American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME), in testimony and statements presented previously to Congress, urged that the federal government adopt a national energy strategy to guide our country's near- and long-term energy policies. We see the President's proposed National Energy Strategy, together with the Johnston-Wallop bill, as the first chance in more than a decade for Congress to produce a comprehensive, long-term energy policy for the nation.

We recognize that many areas of S.1220 remain contentious, and ASME does not endorse all elements of the bill. However, the bill's provisions can serve as the means to develop a legislative direction for an energy policy that ultimately balances enhanced energy production strategies (including increased use of renewable energy sources as well as development of indigenous resources) with a national program to reduce energy consumption. In addition, any meaningful policy must balance long-term energy security with preservation of the environment.

We urge you to support expeditious consideration of S.1220, and to work with the House of Representatives so that a comprehensive energy policy can be sent to the President for his approval.

The ASME as a knowledgeable technical resource stands ready to help policy makers assess the potential impacts of the provisions of the proposed legislation.

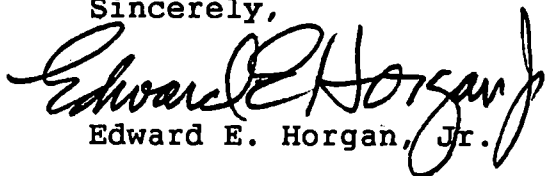
Dear Governor Sununu:

When Tony Frank wrote to you on September 10, he included a copy of his letter to Secretary of State Baker offering the assistance of the U.S. Postal Service to the newly independent Baltic nations.

In Tony's absence from Washington, I am writing to let you know that we are following up on our offer. Within a few days the U.S. Postal Service will announce a limited term "Humanitarian Airlift" program which will provide airlift service to parcels mailed by persons in the United States to individuals and families in Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania, as well as in the Soviet Union. This special service will be available during the period November 1, 1991, through March 31, 1992. It will provide a means of mailing that is faster than regular surface mail, at a cost lower than airmail service.

This program has been closely coordinated with officials of the Department of State and I am enclosing a copy of a letter I am sending to Secretary Baker.

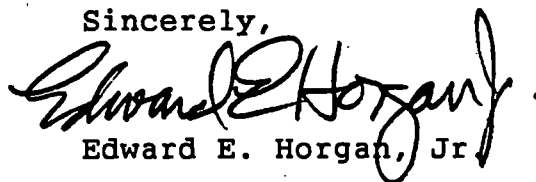
One of the proposals mentioned in the letter involved the possibility of special arrangements for people in the United States to mail relief parcels to individuals in the Baltic countries during the coming winter season.

In Tony's absence from Washington, I am writing to let you know that within a few days we will announce that the U.S. Postal Service will provide airlift service for parcel post mailed by persons in the United States to individuals or families in Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania. We are extending the service to include the Soviet Union. This special service is limited to the period November 1, 1991, through March 31, 1992. It will provide a means of mailing that is faster than surface mail, at a cost lower than airmail service.

We are offering this service to help persons in the United States send humanitarian aid to individuals and families in those countries through a means that is faster than regular surface mail, at a cost lower than airmail service.

Throughout the development of this program, there has been close communication and coordination with the Office of Eastern European and Yugoslav Affairs and the Office of Soviet Affairs of the Department of State. The guidance and assistance extended by the staff has been invaluable to us and we are deeply appreciative for their support.

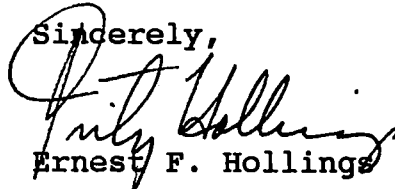

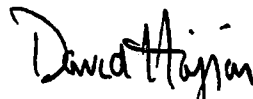
I write to you at this time to inquire about any potential opportunities for me to serve the President as a consultant on federal scientific advisory committees.

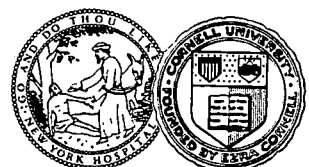

Our Corporation has launched a private project to build an Arts and Convention Center, Hotel and Retail Complex in Krakow, Poland. We feel that such a mega-project, which has been estimated to be \$2.6 billion (U.S.), will have a significant impact on a staggering Polish economy and will help to transform Krakow into a prime tourist and convention city, in former Eastern Europe.

Thanks to long-term U.S. government policy and political changes which have occurred in Eastern Europe and the Soviet Union, the right climate for such a development has been created. We further believe that this development is in line with the United States' governmental policy towards Poland.

We have obtained broad support from the cultural and academic community in Krakow and political support from the City Hall officials in Krakow, the Governor of the Krakow District, and the Chancellery of President Walesa. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development expressed interest in possibly becoming a partner in the project. We have several international hotel chains committed to joining us in the venture. The Coopers & Lybrand Consulting Group has been cooperating with us in preparing necessary economic studies and analysis related to the viability of the project. We are hoping that one of the major American construction firms will become our partner in the venture.

I am writing to you because I feel that it is necessary that a political decision should be made at the highest level in Washington to possibly give support for the project.

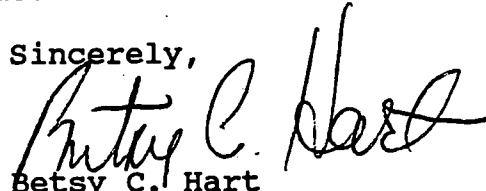

The recent Medicaid regulations that eliminate or restrict a wide variety of state financing approaches will create severe problems for many state budgets and, more importantly, will reduce health services to poor families, their children and the elderly. Under attack are voluntary contributions and provider-based taxes which have been used by states, counties and providers to meet increasing service demands and rising health care costs. The use of some types of intergovernmental transfers, an integral part of Medicaid since its enactment, is also in question.

The regulations must be withdrawn and a legislative remedy found.

In the 1990 OBRA legislation, Congress extended the moratorium on regulations affecting voluntary contributions. Congress intended to continue allowing provider-based taxes. Limitations on intergovernmental transfers were not even discussed.

Counties participate in Medicaid by making payments to their public hospitals, long-term care facilities and health departments. In some states, counties pay a portion of state Medicaid match. These methods have enabled us to serve more Medicaid eligible individuals.

San Bernardino County has participated under the voluntary contribution program of the State of California (SB 1255). This program has enabled the county to serve many more Medicaid eligible individuals, particularly children and expectant mothers.

San Bernardino County will benefit greatly from the intergovernmental transfer bill, SB 855, which has been passed and signed by the Governor.

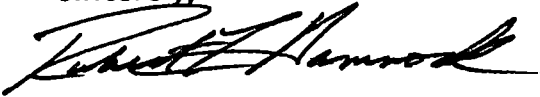
Without such legislation, San Bernardino will be unable to effectively deliver care to the Medicaid eligible individuals who reside in our county and depend upon the San Bernardino County Medical Center for their care.

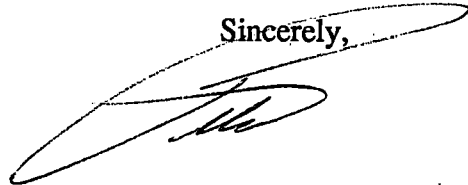

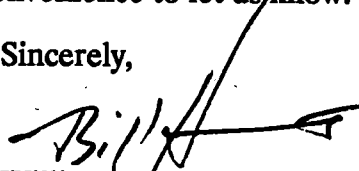

I am enclosing some of the materials I spoke to you about relating to fuel economy that I honestly believe should be considered.

I don't have to point out the difficulty in trying to do business in today's economic climate; the luxury tax, New Hampshire's banking collapse, and since 1988, we have lost over one hundred jobs in new car dealerships in Exeter--things are not good! We need to change the debate on CAFE.

The enclosed proposal embodies a market approach which will both maintain the safety level in the U.S. passenger car fleet while improving overall fuel economy and maintaining consumer choice. Developed by engineers for the leading European manufacturers, the approach is currently receiving careful analysis by the Office of Technology Assessment and the National Academy of Sciences.

Enclosed you will find the following:

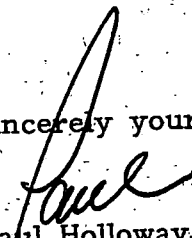
1. A one-page summary of the overall program;
2. A one-page explanation of the policy basis for choosing the new factors to measure fuel efficiency;
3. A one-page summary of the proposed safety credit proposal;
4. A graphical illustration of all 515 EPA certified models sold in 1990 as judged by the current CAFE standard of 27.5, compared to the standard that would be generated under this alternative approach. As a car dealer it is interesting to note that the new approach follows closely the way cars are manufactured and consumers make their buying decisions, whereas the 27.5 standard has no relationship to these factors. In addition, the new proposal would allow an increase in the stringency of the standard by either an mpg or percentage level on a car by car approach thereby not forcing the sale of only small cars;

5. Finally, a detailed description of the overall program and factors utilized.

John, this technology based approach to fuel economy may be the middle-ground I understand a number of people are looking for. Calculations have been made to show how it affects manufacturers, both foreign and domestic. In addition, draft language has been developed that could be used in the current energy legislation. If you think this idea shows promise, as I do, and would like to have this additional information, please let me know and I can arrange to have it sent to someone on your staff. In the meantime, let me know if there is anything further I can do.

I have taken the liberty to send it to your home as well--this really needs your attention!

I want to make you aware that my brother John will be a candidate for the United States Senate from Idaho to succeed Steve Symms who is retiring. 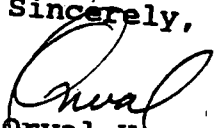

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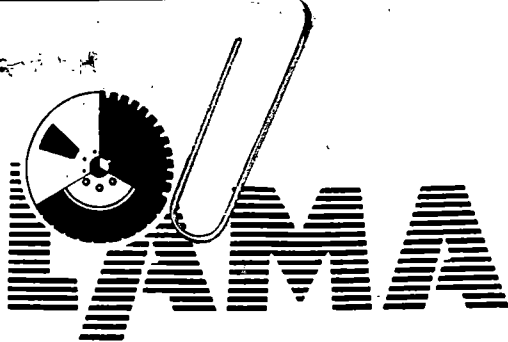

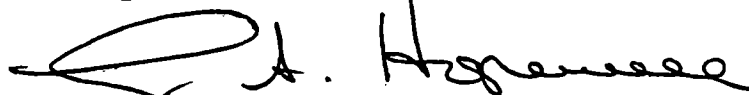

I am writing in response to the letter dated August 22, 1991, from James B. MacRae, Jr., which he wrote on your behalf regarding proposed regulations by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) related to the disposition of interest revenue earned from state hunting and fishing licenses.

The referenced letter states that on April 25, 1991, the FWS had submitted a draft final regulation entitled "Program Requirements, Federal Aid in Sport Fish and Federal Aid in Wildlife Restoration Acts" to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for review under Executive Order No. 12291. The letter goes on to say that on July 1, 1991, the FWS requested that the draft regulation be withdrawn from review at OMB; it is therefore no longer being reviewed by the OMB. As a result, existing procedures regarding the disposition of interest revenue remain in effect -- which means that investment income from the sale of fishing and hunting licenses will continue to go toward fish and game restoration programs.

It is our understanding that the current FWS regulation remaining in place as a result of the above described actions as related to investment income from the fishing and hunting licenses going toward fish and game restoration programs is not mandatory until May 1992. This would allow plenty of time for the administration to rethink their position and take affirmative action to amend the definition of license revenues in 50 CFR 80.4 to exclude interest, dividends, or other income earned on license revenues.

It is our strong conviction that the State of Alabama as well as all other states have an inherent right to determine the disposition of state revenues. The decision-making for matters relating to the application of interest earned by the State of Alabama on investment of its funds should be made by appropriate authority in Alabama not in Washington, D.C. Furthermore, the Wildlife and Sport Fish Restoration Acts prohibit diversions of license fees, and does not refer to interest earnings on license

fees. How can the implementing regulations thus be broader in scope than the law itself? Is it possible the FWS may be over zealous in their interpretation of the law?

A "generally accepted principle" that was espoused as a rationale for adoption of the current rule is that "interest should accrue to the principal from which it was generated." This principle is neither enunciated nor implied in governmental generally accepted accounting principles. Statement No. 11 of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) entitled "Measurement Focus and Basis of Accounting--Governmental Fund Operating Statements", says that the accounting treatment of interest earnings will be based on the state or local government's legal or contractual provisions. The "generally accepted principle" is not consistent with the GASB standard.

The general principle used by the State of Alabama and other states is that interest earnings of the government are deposited in the state's general fund unless otherwise dedicated by law. The Federal government's policy is identical. Consequently, the Federal government's policy coincides exactly with state policies. It is entirely unreasonable for a Federal agency to impose a mandate on state governments which the Federal government itself does not adhere to. If this interest policy mandated by the FWS is allowed to stand which Federal agency is next in line to adopt similar regulations?

There are no administrative expenses assessed the Game and Fish Program in Alabama for such items as general accounting, purchasing, legal services, salaries of elected officials, operating expenses of elected offices and other overhead costs of state government. These costs are paid by the state's general fund. If the FWS requirement remains intact, then it will necessitate charges against the Game and Fish Program for the above described governmental services to compensate for the loss of interest income to the state general fund. We estimate that the charges would approximate the amount of interest earned by the Game and Fish Program, therefore resulting in a great amount of bureaucratic bookkeeping with no appreciable benefit to anyone.

Amending the regulation would be consistent with the Federalism Executive Order 12612 and with the policy positions of the National Governor's Association. Section 3(b) of the Federalism Executive Order states as follows:

"Federal action limiting the policymaking discretion of the States should be taken only where constitutional authority for the action is clear and certain and the national activity is necessitated by the presence of national scope."

The nation's Governors have also taken the position that Federal action should be limited to problems that are national in scope. It is clear that if the Federal government and the states have the same policy on crediting interest earnings, there is no problem, national or otherwise.

Therefore, on behalf of the State of Alabama I again respectfully request you intervene with all due haste to have the FWS amend the definition of license revenues in 50 CFR 80.4 to exclude interest, dividends, or other income earned on license revenues. I will be glad to discuss this matter with you and provide any additional information that you may need in your efforts.

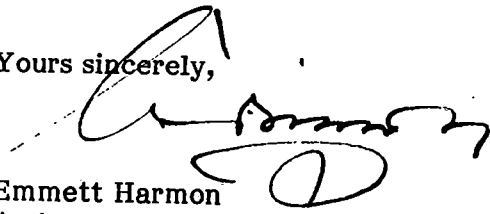

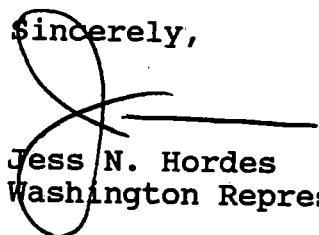

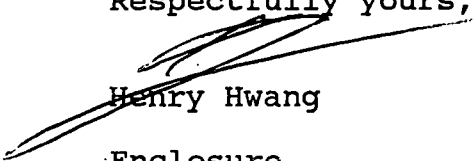

You had asked, when I sent a copy of my last letter to Prime Minister Shamir, that I let you know of any response. To the best of my knowledge there has been nothing direct as yet, unless it is because of that letter that two separate copies of Aryeh Shalev's book on The Intifada: Causes and Effects (from the Jaffee Center) have been sent me. They weren't identified as to source. I can understand that Mr. Shamir may have found it too difficult to formulate a response to the letter I sent him.

I assume the same goes for the accompanying letter that I just received today from Mr. Arafat, and that you ought to have it as soon as possible. It's a response to my letter of July 16th, which you have.

Naturally enough, he doesn't say whether or not he will take up my recommendation that they hold an election, with all the elaborated detail I went into in that letter. He would have to make a public announcement of something like that, rather than say it in a letter to me. I phoned the P.L.O. Observer Mission when I got the letter, and spoke with Dr. Mansour, who had forwarded it to me. Normally I would talk to Dr. Nasser al-Kidwa, Arafat's nephew and the head of the Observer Mission now. He's out of the country, so I got less information than I would have from him. Not long after I sent the letter I did talk with Dr. al-Kidwa, and he told me then that people in the P.L.O. found the idea attractive, but hesitated to act on it because they didn't want to create complications in the way of the American-proposed conference. As of then, they were most anxious to see the conference come about and to have Palestinian participation. But al-Kidwa thought this idea of an election might actually be something the Palestinians would propose at the conference itself, or possibly at a PNC meeting before. The issue of who would represent the Palestinians hadn't come to such a head at that time (about a week after I sent the letter on July 16). I need to talk with al-Kidwa again now, and will do so when he gets back to the country. Who "people in the P.L.O." means, in the phrase he used then, is rather a puzzle now that there is so much dissent being expressed, but I doubt that al-Kidwa himself would express an opinion that didn't have some resonance in Arafat's own thinking.

In mid-August, members of the Washington State Senate Republican Caucus met with Secretary of Education Lamar Alexander for a very lively and informative discussion regarding education reform.

We informed the Secretary and Debra Anderson, who was also present, of our resolve to effect meaningful change to the education status quo in Washington State.

To the extent possible, we would like to coordinate our efforts with the Administration in achieving shared goals. We therefore welcome the communication that we have had to this point with White House staff, including Mary McClure, Lanny Griffith, Debra Anderson and Rae Nelson. It is important that we prevent miscues such as the one reported in the attached article. The union-influenced bill the President is reported as supporting contained none of the restructuring sought by the President, and its passage would have hampered efforts to effect change in the future.

Please accept my thanks for the efforts of your staff in arranging the meeting with Secretary Alexander.

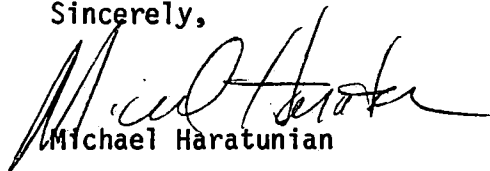

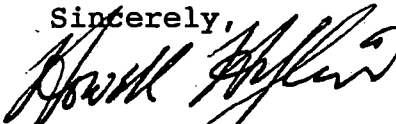

I address this letter to Your Excellency as we continue to live the tragic outcome of the painful events that afflicted the Gulf region during the past year, resulting in much loss of life and property, untold damage to the political and socioeconomic progress of the Middle East, as well as serious degradation to the global environment.

Among these tragic consequences was the misunderstanding to which Jordan's position on the Gulf Crisis and War was subjected, which, in turn, had an unfortunate effect on our relations with our long-time friends. Therefore, in order to clear the air once and for all and to remove this misunderstanding, we have prepared a White Paper clearly outlining Jordan's position from the outset of the Gulf Crisis and the development of this position as events unfolded.

I am sending Your Excellency a copy of the White Paper, hoping that it may help in removing any blemish on the strong ties of mutual respect and constructive cooperation that have long existed between our two countries, and allowing us to resume the work of developing our relations in the services of our common principles and interests.

I also take this opportunity to reassure Your Excellency of my sincere friendship and to send to you my warm personal regards.

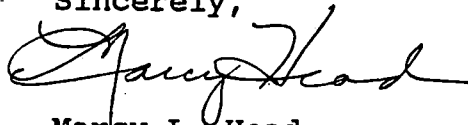
