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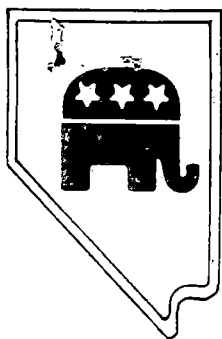

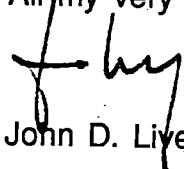

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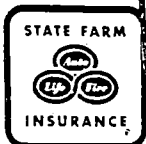

Let me point out four areas that I believe make George Terwilliger, III the man for this job:

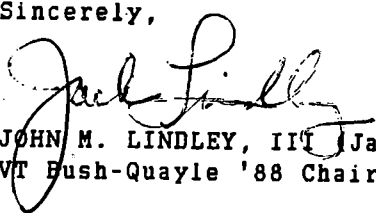

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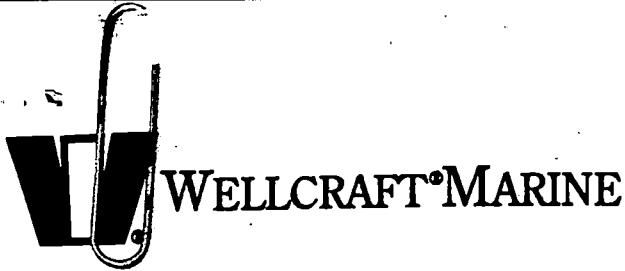

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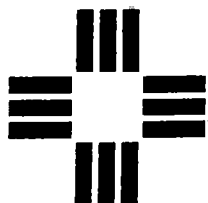

Dear Governor Sununu:

I write to you concerning a matter of urgency and significant concern to the Catholic Church in Oregon and the United States. The State of Oregon has submitted an application for waivers to the Federal Government to begin a proposed Oregon Medicaid rationing experiment. In testimony before a Congressional subcommittee and in a letter to Secretary Sullivan, both the Oregon Catholic Conference and the United States Catholic Conference have gone on record opposing the granting of these waivers by the Federal Government.

While the Church supports health care as a basic human right and universal access to health care, we cannot support the means Oregon has chosen to attain that end. The proposed Oregon experiment represents a significant shift in the delivery of medical care in the United States. The Medicaid standard of "all medically necessary care and services" currently used to provide services to recipients is proposed to be changed to a subjective "quality of life" standard which represents a dangerous precedent in health care delivery.

There are serious flaws to the Oregon proposal, particularly as they relate to the dignity and sanctity of human life in the issues of abortion and other life concerns. Cardinal Law and I have discussed this matter, and I know that Cardinal Law contacted you previously to discuss this issue. Cardinal Law has urged me to contact you to discuss the impact of Oregon's proposal on abortion and other life issues, such as euthanasia. I will be in Washington, D.C. for the bishops' annual meeting between November 9 - 14. I would welcome the opportunity to visit with you to discuss the Administration's response to the State of Oregon's application for waivers to implement this Medicaid rationing experiment.

It was good to see you Saturday night at Eli's birthday party. I particularly enjoyed our conversation about the credit crunch.

As we discussed, I have enclosed a copy of the Small Business Recovery Act which I recently introduced, along with Senators Chafee Dodd, Chafee, Rudman, Smith, and Pell, the Small Business Recovery Act, which I believe serves two primary purposes. First, it would aid in the re-capitalization of economically sound smaller banks -- using private capital with a Federal guarantee -- and therefore provide much-needed and long-awaited relief to one of the primary causes of the credit crunch -- the lack of bank capital.

Second, this program focuses directly on lending to small firms. Small businesses are the most vulnerable in a tight credit market and are most affected by the credit crunch. Under this legislation, capital raised by security sales would be placed into a "loan pool" for the purposes of making small business loans. The multiplier effect of this capital investment would provide approximately 12 times the guaranteed portion of the investment -- 60 million dollars per small bank -- much of which will lead to small business lending.

Finally, this program is largely self insured. Banks participating in the program are required to pay an origination fee of .5 percent and an annual premium of 1 percent. Over the 7 year life of the program these fees would grow into a \$31 million reserve to protect against losses.

I hear on a daily basis from businesspeople that the credit crunch is strangling our economy and impeding economic recovery. I hope you can support this bill and that we can work together in the near future to address this very serious problem.

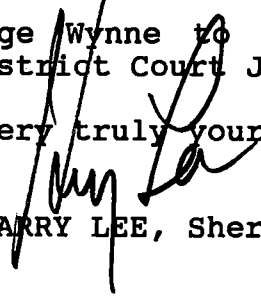

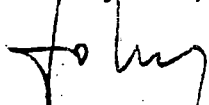
Dear John:

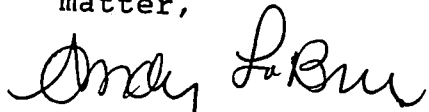

I will appreciate another opportunity to secure direction for consideration, of my developed writing technique, to simplify the forms and instructions for individual income tax reporting.

In response to my inquiries to the IRS Forms Development Branch and the Tax forms Coordinating Committee; they advised they do not have the authority to utilize outside consultants.

No doubt a certain amount of scepticism has developed regarding simplified reporting, as the resulting failure of the previous attempts to simplify the forms and reporting instructions. I am confident the writing technique, I have developed, will resolve this problem. The immediate difficulty is to develop an interest and to secure authority to initiate the program.

The application of this technique to the present IRS procedure is almost unbelievably simple. The efficiency of The Internal Revenue Service substantially improved and the monetary savings are incalculable. As an example the need for Forms 1040A and 1040EZ will be eliminated.

To illustrate the need for simplification, of the present Forms and instructions, I am enclosing;

- A- Articles indicating interest and the need for improved reporting procedure.
- B- My analysis of the problem.
- C- An illustration of the simplification.

Your assistance is sincerely appreciated. If we can develop simplified income tax reporting; all those concerned with income tax reporting, will regard this achievement as a major accomplishment of the President's Administration.

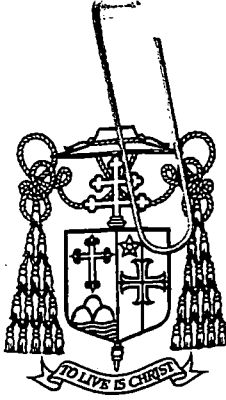

With the presidential campaign around the corner I thought it would be appropriate to mention a strategy for the president's effort in New York State. As you may recall I garnered 827,000 votes on a budget of \$200,000 in the 1990 gubernatorial race. That vote was obtained for the Conservative Party, even though I'm a registered Republican, a loyal Republican and a Republican who was eager to carry the banner of his own party.

While a victory in New York is obviously not needed for President Bush to achieve an electoral majority, such a victory in the state over Cuomo (the likely Democratic candidate) would have a profound effect on the state Republican Party and significant ramifications for national politics.

With the coalition I can assemble and the regular Republicans in alliance, an overwhelming victory in New York is possible, one that would dramatically shift political alliances in both state houses and offer New York the political boost it desperately needs.

I would suggest that we chat about this matter if it is at all an interesting prospect. And I would further suggest that you hire my campaign coordinator, Steve Gilbride, a young man with superb political instincts (resume attached), to work on this New York effort, even though I should hastily note I am not interested in a paid position.

As a follow-up to our 1990 Outlook, we have again undertaken an internal evaluation of the U.S. natural gas supply outlook. As before, this analysis captures the expertise of reservoir engineers, geologists, economists, and financial analysts throughout our company.

Once again, we are coming to the market with a more optimistic view than that which pervades the industry. A major reason for this optimism, and the main motivation behind updating our Outlook, is the development and rapid diffusion of new technology. While the conclusions we draw from the results are clearly stated in the text, it is worth emphasizing some critical points:

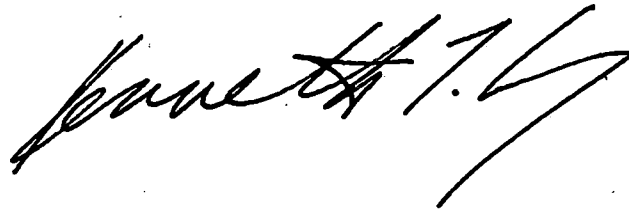
- The resource base is large - much larger than we had anticipated in 1989, and sufficient to support adequate supplies at reasonable prices well into the next century. We now estimate the remaining economically recoverable resource base at approximately 1,200 Tcf, (including 160 Tcf of proved reserves), well over a 60 year supply and equivalent to 200 billion barrels of oil.
- We expect the so called "gas bubble" to gradually erode toward the middle of this decade. This erosion will bring natural gas prices into closer parity with oil prices which, in turn, will encourage increased gas reserve findings and ultimately, increased production.
- The compelling economic and environmental advantages of natural gas power generation should make this sector the fastest growing market for natural gas this decade and beyond. Further restrictions on carbon dioxide or other emissions would further stimulate this growth.

- By the end of this decade, a sizeable fleet of vehicles will be fueled by natural gas, reducing imports of foreign oil and contributing to a cleaner environment. Much faster conversion to clean, domestic natural gas for vehicles could be achieved with more aggressive public policies.

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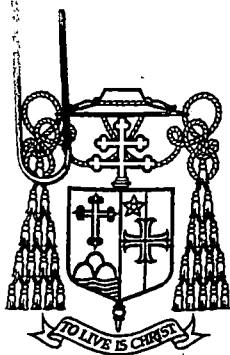
