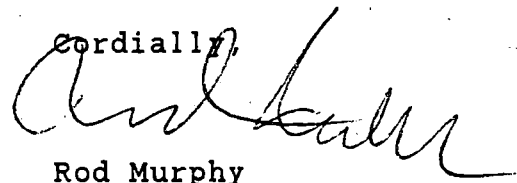

I extend my sincere thanks for your meeting with me and others in the real estate industry on December 2, 1991, to hear our views on ways to stimulate our nation's economy through incentives provided to the housing and real estate industries.

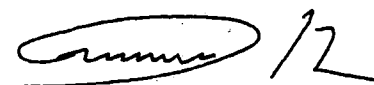
As I said in the meeting, modification of the passive loss rules as they apply to real estate professionals are needed now, to ensure tax parity, increase equity investment in real estate by private investors and to stem decline in real estate values. These changes supported by the real estate and housing industries would not reinstate tax shelters, but rather would permit professional real estate organizations to deduct legitimate expenses currently granted to other taxpayers in other lines of business. These measures would create stability in local property tax bases, preserving neighborhood and community services.

While a capital gains tax rate reduction would provide a long-term stimulus to the real estate and housing industries and to the overall economy, immediate incentives must be implemented to lead the nation out of the recession. Passive loss tax changes would furnish this necessary short-term catalyst.

Also, as I mentioned, the recent changes in the FHA program have severely impacted the ability of FHA to assist first time homebuyers and others seeking to buy a home. Reversing these changes would not only help low-and-moderate income homebuyers but it would also stimulate housing construction and other sectors of the real estate industry.

It is through a cooperative spirit such as was demonstrated during our meeting that we can overcome the problems plaguing the economy. The real estate industry is committed to supporting constructive, positive action and to restoring fairness in national policies and confidence in real estate and financial markets. Thank you again for taking the time to meet with me and listen to our concerns and recommendations.

I am writing to support the President's consideration of Pamela Talkin, now at the FLRA, for the seat on the Federal Labor Relations Board which remains open in the wake of Mary Cracraft's withdrawal from consideration.

I have followed Pamela's work for some time, and count myself a fan. We are both familiar with the excellent work she did supporting Clarence Thomas during his hitch at EEOC. That is the primary reason for my support.

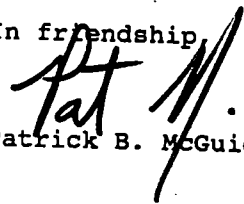
I also express my admiration for one whose commitment to fair play and decency has been amply demonstrated by her substantive record at FLRA and by her willingness to speak up during the recent unpleasanties. A person willing to stand for fair play in that context can certainly be counted upon to bring to bear the same sense of fair play and decency in considering difficult cases and controversies surrounding the rights of workers.

Opposition to Cracraft was merited, in my view. Support for Talkin is also merited. I believe she will rule for the law as it stands, including in such difficult and contentious areas as the Beck case. I believe some friends reached a contrary conclusion about Talkin some time back. I respectfully dissent from those conclusions and believe a closer examination of her record will lead them to agree she will do exactly what should be expected of a member of the NLRB -- rule for the right of workers to be informed of their rights and able to practice them.

Please give Pam Talkin every consideration. I concur with the high opinion expressed of her two years ago by Clarence Thomas: "Not only can't you go wrong, she will be one of the your best. I stake my name and reputation on her."

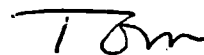

A number of pro-growth tax proposals have been put forward recently, and after reviewing them I wanted to share with you NFIB's opinions on them and other things we consider to be vital to small business growth and prosperity.

NFIB represents over 500,000 small, independent business owners across the country. They have repeatedly informed us that they believe the federal government has grown out of control and that the country would be much better off with less government and more room for private initiative.

NFIB members, however, are not enthusiastic about many of the pro-growth tax incentives that have been offered, and they are skeptical of how helpful many of these incentives will be. Enterprise zones, research tax credits, IRAs, tax credits for home buyers, and an increase in the Social Security earnings limit are all good ideas and supportable in a vacuum, but they will have a very limited impact on economic growth and job creation.

The best approach to spur economic growth is to cut the cost of capital. The cost of capital can be best reduced by increasing the amount of business equipment small business owners can expense each year, and reducing the capital gains rate. Increasing expensing will permit these same business owners to purchase more equipment sooner, enhancing the size and efficiency of their businesses. Properly cutting the capital gains rate will increase the number of investment dollars flowing to small business owners.

The best way to generate new jobs is to cut the cost of labor. The federal government currently charges an employer a 7.65 percent FICA tax on the first dollar earned by every

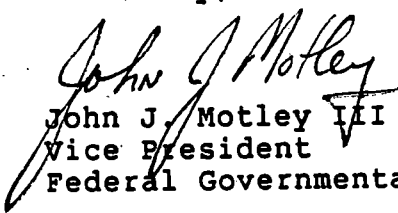
person employed. This tax is far higher than it needs to be to pay Social Security, and it is a direct tax on jobs. Cutting FICA taxes will immediately reduce the cost of labor and enable employers to hire additional workers.

In addition, a FICA tax cut is the quickest, easiest way to provide a meaningful tax reduction to low and middle income working Americans. Under the budget agreement, a FICA cut doesn't need to be offset. Therefore, it may be the most politically viable tax cut.

Although NFIB understands the constituency to which many of the proposed "pro-growth" tax cuts appeal, we encourage you and the President to support proposals that will directly address the economic difficulties our nation is facing. Lowering the cost of capital and labor is the most direct road toward economic recovery because it will allow small business owners to build their businesses and hire more employees.

Thank you for your consideration of NFIB's concerns about the best legislative approach toward improving our nation's economy.

Thank you very much for sending me the Presidential tie clasp, which replaces the one stolen from me (along with all the rest of our luggage!) in Italy.

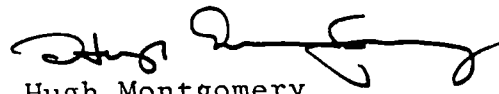

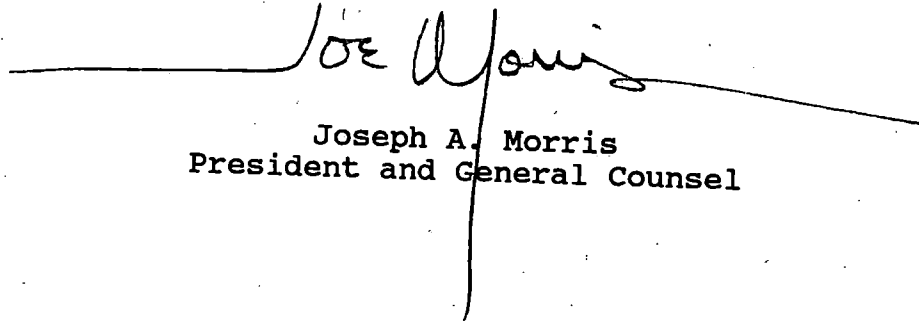

Last week at a La Salle Military Academy Board of Trustees meeting, I learned that Brother Charles Baxter, F.S.C. passed away October 17, 1991. Charles, along with Brother Michael O'Connell, were close personal friends to many alumni from the fifties. 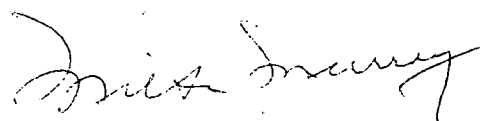

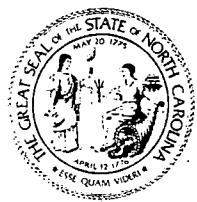

Dear Governor Sununu:

I wanted to advise you of North Carolina's continuing support for onboard gasoline vapor recovery systems as part of the package of tools needed to comply with the Clean Air Act Amendments. It is my understanding that performance testing, as well as safety and economic assessments, have shown the benefits of an onboard canister vapor recovery system.

Section 202(a)(6) of the Clean Air Act requires the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to promulgate standards to require installation of "onboard" refueling vapor control systems on light-duty vehicles beginning in the fourth years after the standard is developed. The Act also requires EPA to consult with the Secretary of Transportation regarding the safety of onboard refueling emission control systems. Establishing a standard soon is necessary to allow engineering design and safety concerns to be addressed well in advance of the 1996 model year so an orderly phase-in can occur.

For your information, I have attached a copy of my June 12, 1991, letter to EPA Administrator Bill Reilly urging him to expeditiously comply with this statutory deadline. I appreciate your assistance in this matter.

I am writing to you about what I believe is a wasteful expenditure in our federal budget. This problem relates to the ASSIST program announced by the Department of Health and Human Services in the enclosed press release.

Professor Gerald M. Goldhaber, of the State University of New York at Buffalo, testified before the Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism and Hazardous Materials of the House Committee on Energy and Commerce. His testimony about H.R. 4543, the Cigarette Testing and Liability Act of 1988, was very persuasive.

"In my judgement, a higher degree of awareness of the risks associated with smoking and health is simply not possible, and Congress would be mistaken to assume that still more warnings imposed by states and municipalities would somehow lead to even greater public awareness of the possible danger than now exists.

In sum, the level of public awareness on smoking and health issues is virtually unprecedented in our national experience. Indeed, I can think of no other example in the public opinion literature that shows a higher level of public awareness than on the issue of smoking's health risks."

On top of the testimony by the professor, HHS also did some research of its own on the topic. They conducted a poll and found that 95% of those polled believe that there may be a health consequences from smoking. Also, a recent Surgeon General's report disclosed that 90% of smokers who quit do so on their own without any outside help. The federal government is spending \$135 million to relay a message that has already been heard by the public. It is more perplexing that we spending this vast amount of money on a redundant message during a time

tight budget crisis.

\$135 million is a lot of money to spend if our goal is educating those remaining 5% of the American people about the risks involved with smoking. I believe that this money could be put to better use, perhaps in the war against drugs, cancer research or AIDS research. It is clear to me that efforts in the past in this regard have succeeded and it is now time to redirect those funds to other areas where they could be equally effective.

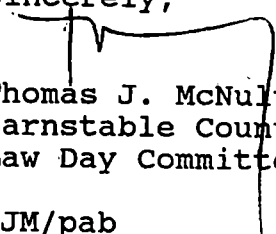

In fact I have been placed on the National Finance Committee for the President -- but, John, Robert Clarke was not the man to be Comptroller of the Currency. That regulatory agency is in shambles -- quite frankly, I am glad he was not confirmed.

I did mention, most sincerely, to Senator Byrd and Senator Rockefeller (who are close, personal friends of mine) that this man was not suited to be Comptroller of the Currency. Here again, I am certainly not against what the President mandates, but I am a 35-year veteran of the banking industry, and I think Robert Clarke was the worse Comptroller of the Currency we ever had! If you ever need me to backup what I am saying, I would be pleased to do so.

In the meantime, I will be at the meeting next week regarding Bush-Quayle '92. I am rearing to go with fundraising in the State of West Virginia.

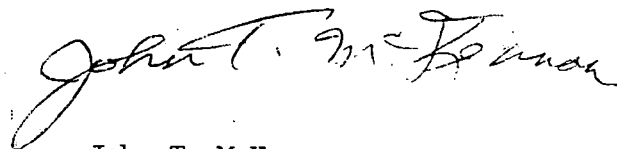

You were right and I hope you get to slow the train, now that it's left the station. Talk about what U.S. government

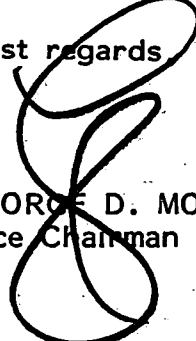

Dear Mr. Sununu:

I am extremely disappointed in the White House Staff. I have written on several occasions and received incurious response. On pushing the issue with follow-up letters, I receive no response from your Mexican Desk, a Mr. Raymond Dayland.

I have been attempting to receive some help from our White House staff through President Bush to help bring a murderer to justice. For two and one half years I have gotten the runaround from our American authorities as well as our White House Staff and the American Consulate staff in Tijuana, B.C., Mexico, a Mr. Paul Conley Kline.

My friend and a hard working Republican campaign worker was murdered in Tijuana by another American citizen. The killer admitted the killing. It was in front of 25 witnesses. The killer's uncle, Federico Valdez was the Mayor of Tijuana at the time of the killing. The killer's name is Federico Sanchez Valdez. The killer's aunt works in our American Consulate in Tijuana.

The following people vowed to help us bring the killer to justice and have all been silenced: Agent Tony Falcon of the F.B.I.; Officer Ron Collins of the San Diego Police Department; and Julie Brossy of the Tribune Newspaper in San Diego. We are afraid to set foot in Tijuana anymore.

Hector Gastellum, the murdered victim, was a loving family man of three children and a wife. He went to visit his father-in-law in the upper class neighborhood of Tijuana when a group of "El Juniors" were playing loud music and yelling and drinking. Hector went to ask them to quiet down and was shot in the back of the head and knifed in the front torso. (We believe that he walked into a drug sale operation and was killed for it.)

It took us a year to get a Warrant issued through General Kraus Coronel the Attorney General of Baja California. The Second District Judge issued the Warrant.

I was told, on numerous occasions, by Paul Kline in the American Consulate that it would be no trouble (just a little time) to fill out the Request for Extradition paper process to get the Mexican Authorities to Request such an Extradition. It has been over a year and all my sources of help including Paul Kline will not answer phone calls nor letters nor do anything to bring about justice in this case.

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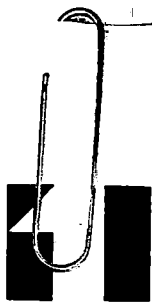

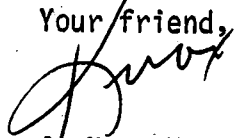

The FDIC has acted here in N.H. and magically nothing here in the business world has changed! People in business still cannot get working capital or commercial real estate loans even though the new takeover banks (1st N.H. and New Dartmouth) and the other existing banks have been advertising madly that they have money to lend. "Try and get it" is the most frequently heard comment referring to the availability to these so called readily available funds.

Having gone through the malaise, over the last year or so, of indecisive bankers not making decisions, for fear of losing their jobs: we are now into the period of indecisive bankers now employed by the FDIC not knowing whether they have a job for longer than "91 days" or less.

I guess we will have to continue to contend with languishing, as we have for the last year or more with unavailability of commercial loans for at least into the first quarter of next year; by which time hopefully the FDIC and the "new Banks" will have decided which loans they will keep or not keep; maybe there will be some experienced real estate types and general contractors still around that have not gone bankrupt, to assist in sorting this mess out.

From the day to day talk in the industry it is only the "double income no kids" first time house buyers that come anywhere near qualifying for mortgages, under current banking requirements; you can forget anyone who has been in the business for the last five years as they have been tainted by the last year or two's regressive conditions.

I continue to get daily foreclosure notices as I am on Mr. St. Jean's mailing list, which I enclose for your enlightenment and I enclose last week's Thursday night auction pages which has not diminished in length at all since I last wrote you.

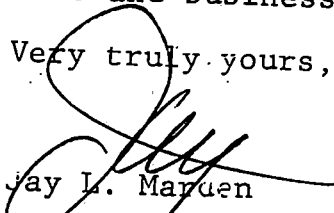

I appreciate the interest which you showed when we spoke recently about the impact of the Uruguay Round on jobs and production in the U.S. textile and apparel industry. Our estimates of job losses and production cutbacks have been questioned by Ambassador Hills and others in the Administration, but I want to share with you very briefly our rationale for reaching such conclusions:

- O We used estimates of possible import growth under the Uruguay Round MFA phase-out that match almost identically the possible import growth projections made by the Department of Commerce.
- O We used a U.S. market growth rate of one percent per year over the next decade. One can disagree with our projection, but we believe we are on firm ground for several reasons. First, textile and apparel consumption in the U.S. has historically followed the population growth and U.S. population growth is slowing to less than one percent over the next decade (Enclosures 1 and 2). Second, a one percent growth rate is supported by econometric work done by Hoechst Celanese and Dupont.
- O We also projected a significant and steady increase for our exports of five percent per year in real terms for 10 years -- something we have not seen in our history.

estimates of import growth, market growth and export growth to the conclusion the some 1.4 million U.S. jobs and over 1/4 of our production could be lost by the end of the MFA phase-out. This is a worst-case scenario (i.e., U.S. market access given to foreign textile and apparel exporters is completely filled by them).

It is possible our projections are wrong, but even if U.S. market growth is two percent per year (a number viewed by our industry as completely unrealistic) and export growth is 10 percent each year we will still lose nearly one million jobs and almost 2/3 of our production.

Finally, the most conservative scenario presumes that India, China, Pakistan and Indonesia do not totally dominate the U.S. textile and apparel market because the U.S. industry has been given time to become even more competitive---then there is a distinct likelihood that our industry will lose 500,000 American jobs and a significant portion of our production capacity.

Under any of the above scenarios, the real beneficiaries of this tremendous damage to a vital manufacturing industry and its workers will unfortunately be China, India, Pakistan and Indonesia. These large, low-wage, non-market oriented textile exporters are also countries who keep their markets closed to our exports.

We obviously will be a big loser. Mexico will also be a big loser as will many other developing countries, including those in the Caribbean and Central and South America, because they will not be able to compete with the Far Eastern suppliers -- even with preferential access to our market.

The administrations of President Bush and President Reagan promised our industry that in return for phasing out the MFA, they would make a major effort to open up the World's markets to our textile and apparel exports. I have included in this package the Commerce Department's most recent publication outlining the barriers that currently exist for our textile and apparel exports (Enclosure 3).

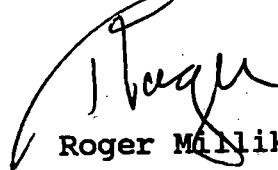
this point in the GATT Round nothing has been done to get agreement on any market opening initiatives other than tariff reduction. Our industry strongly believes that no country should be able to take advantage of the proposed liberalization of access to our markets here in the United States unless they have in fact opened their markets as well.

The United States allows the importation of over \$33 billion worth of textiles and apparel. One would think that U.S. negotiators would have negotiated by now substantial market opening abroad. Unfortunately any notion of reciprocity has been lacking in the GATT, the MFA and the objectives of our negotiators.

Finally, I would like to share with you some tables entitled "Top Ten Industries---In Terms of Market Share of Total World Exports" (Enclosure 4). There is no better way to judge the international competitiveness of an industry than to ascertain what share of the world export market they dominate. When you compare our top ten industries with Japan's, we come out second best. This is due in part because business and government in our country have an adversarial relationship while in Japan industry gets its government's full support. There is an important lesson for us to learn here and we had better learn it quickly.

I would welcome the opportunity to meet with you and your staff to discuss our projections in detail.

Dear John:

Recently, the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services launched the American Stop Smoking Intervention Study for cancer prevention (ASSIST). Secretary Sullivan called it "the largest-ever national tobacco control program." While I have never objected to efforts to reduce smoking, particularly among our nation's youth, I must question the justification for this particular program.

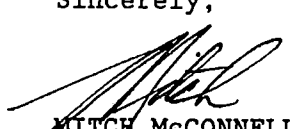
Based on this Department's own statistics, virtually every American knows of the supposed health risks associated with smoking. Why then does the Secretary propose spending \$135 million to fund state and local activists to lobby against smoking. I just do not understand why we should funnel precious federal dollars to state agencies which will be allowed to hand millions of dollars to state and local anti-tobacco coalitions over the next seven years.

ASSIST appears to be nothing more than an expensive duplication of current programs. Nothing proves this point more than a statement by a spokesman of the National Cancer Institute admitting that "from more than 60 large intervention studies, we have learned which strategies and approaches are most effective in controlling tobacco use." Do we really need another study on a subject where the entire public is considered universally aware?

It is hard to reconcile the duplicative and expensive purpose of this program. Another case in point, is the October 4 press release announcing the ASSIST program. Money for Phase I will identify high-risk smoking population groups in each state. A detailed breakdown of the high risk smoking population groups follows on the very next page of the release.

One last important point based on the American Cancer Society's annual report. Only one-fourth of their annual income is spent on research. Therefore, I believe the \$135 million in this program could be used in a much more prudent manner such as true medical research or deficit reduction. Any attention which you could provide to this matter would be most appreciated and I look forward to hearing from you.

RE: Appointment to the Federal District Court

Sirs:

I am writing to you as a result of reading an article in the October 14, 1991 edition of the Massachusetts Lawyers Weekly. This article dealt with the several vacancies for the U.S. District Court. Specifically, I am writing to you because as a resident of Massachusetts I have very little access to any Republican members of Congress and in the past Senator Rudman has assisted me in a federal matter which required a Republican to carry the banner for myself or my client. On two occasions he facilitated my dealings with Congress and the General Services Administration concerning the acquisition of land from the federal government in Boston Harbor. I sought Senator Rudman's assistance at that time because I am a "product" of New Hampshire since my father was from Berlin, New Hampshire and my mother, Dorothy Colby, was from Littleton, New Hampshire. I have maintained strong family ties to the family

home in Littleton through my uncle Reg Colby, the former owner of Littleton Whitefield and Lisbon Courier. It is because of these ties that I feel comfortable approaching you both on the above-referenced matter.

The article, a copy of which I have attached for your review, makes clear that you both are currently supporting a particular candidate for appointment to the Federal District Court. I am sure those candidates are highly qualified and deserves your support. Notwithstanding that fact, the article kindled my interest in such an appointment because I have the qualifications which are needed for the position and for the process. Unlike many of the candidates that are appointed to judgeships within the state system of Massachusetts, my qualifications have been developed completely outside of the political arena. While I would consider myself a political conservative, I have not taken part in political "activity" on behalf of either party. It is clear that the recent events surrounding Judge Thomas have illustrated the "political" aspects of the appointment process. This aspect has generally detracted from the standing of the judiciary and frankly those in the nominating position because the general public, whether through naivete or otherwise believes that the judiciary is free from political influence. Although Governor Weld is a Republican, few doubt that a Weld "nominee" would vary from the typical Massachusetts liberal political perspective. It is a viewpoint which continues to diminish public confidence. Clearly, I lack that "political" aspect. However, assuming that I were the best candidate for the position I lack the necessary conservative representation to expect consideration. If you would provide that initial consideration and advice which would put me on a even playingfield, then that is all that any expatriate New Hampshire product could ask for.

In addition to being free from the political ties, I have an extraordinary upbringing which crosses so many cultural and social levels that my perspective is reflective of the diversity of my upbringing. Although a product of New Hampshire parents, their death when I was 17 also made me a product of the boarding houses and low rent districts of Brockton and Boston. I was forced to survive unsupervised as a teenager, supported myself, worked my way through high school and Northeastern University, while still attaining significant academic and athletic achievement.

After graduation from college I went on to coach rowing at Princeton University and operated my own business. I ran the

United States Olympic Trials in 1976 and coached several national championship teams. This type of background further nurtured my ability to deal with people of hugely diverse backgrounds both cultural and financial. After a nine-year coaching career I returned to Boston University Law School and have been practicing for ten years in construction, real estate, banking, creditor's rights and debtor's rights. Most recently I have been focusing my attention on the current banking situation and have dealt extensively with the FDIC, Recoll Management (the successor of the Bank of New England), and I am involved on a day-to-day basis with representing banks and borrowers who are struggling to survive in the devastated New England economy.

Prior to becoming a lawyer, my non-legal work experience has been as diverse as my upbringing. These jobs ranged from driving taxi cabs and doing construction work to flying planes, from teaching school to coaching Olympic athletes, from representing the rights of the mentally retarded to representing some of the largest institutions in the State and the country. I currently hold the prestigious position as Of Counsel to the oldest law firm in the City of Boston and in the State of Massachusetts and I am the youngest attorney to ever hold this position.

I must make clear the fact that my position at this firm is long term and very stable. In addition, my current salary would indicate that such an appointment would result in a lesser income for my family. In spite of that I would seek such an appointment because I believe I could make a very positive contribution.

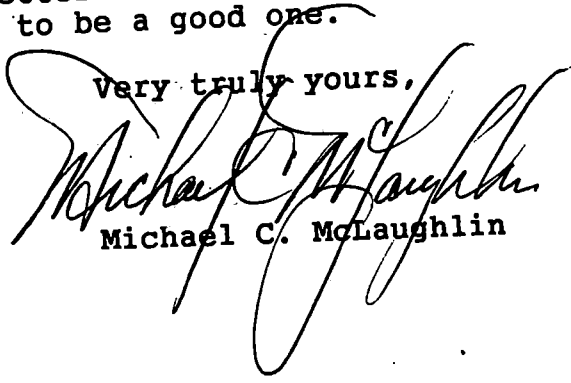
Again, the purpose of this letter is not to provide you with a resume of my achievements which I would be more than happy to provide at some future date. Rather, it is to let you know that I believe my qualifications and background would be well suited to the problems and decisions facing a Federal District Court at this point in time. In addition, my "relative youth at 43" may bring some much needed new blood to what I view as a relatively liberal Federal District Court bench.

I would be most appreciative if I might be able to talk with you concerning this matter at your earliest convenience in New Hampshire or Washington. At this point, I have not discussed this matter with anyone and I would seek your general advice as to the viability of my candidacy. At the risk of sounding antidotal, I was once sent a letter from a Canadian

high school student who claimed that if I recruited him to Princeton that he would be the best oarsman I would ever know. The other league coaches scoffed at such a confident statement and dismissed his application. I did not dismiss him because it seemed to me that he warranted a closer look. He eventually did attend Princeton and went on to be an Olympic gold medalist. While the Olympics are not in my future, I would modestly suggest that this letter warrants a closer look. The future may show your decision to be a good one.
