Liberal political and media figures are increasingly calling for re-regulation of airlines. Early this year, Heritage Policy Analyst Bill Laffer presented the case for continuing deregulation. *How To Improve Air Travel In America* remains relevant to the current debate, and I thought you would appreciate a second copy.

Delays, congestion, and safety hazards result from a failure to build facilities to keep up with the rapid growth in air travel, rather than of deregulation. "The ways to alleviate the congestion and delay are not by reimposing regulation of routes and fares but by deregulating the rest of America's air transportation network," argues Laffer. "Re-regulation would neither increase system capacity nor make more efficient use of existing capacity; what would do both is giving airports the freedom to charge demand-based prices for their services."

With pricing freedom, busy airports would give airlines an incentive to change locations and times, while gaining revenue to expand facilities. Beyond pricing reform, Laffer urges privatization of airports, by selling airports outright, long-term leasing and hiring private contractors to manage airports.

I think you will find Laffer's paper helpful, and I urge you to contact us if you have thoughts or suggestions regarding our work in this area.

Dear John:

As we have discussed, I am enclosing a memo that critiques H.R. 2039, Congressman Barney Frank's Legal Services Reauthorization Act of 1991. In addition, I am enclosing a copy of a memo prepared by Jim Wootton that reviews the background of the legal services debate and recommends that the White House convene negotiations to work out the differences between those who support legal services reform and those who support H.R. 2039.

I strongly recommend this course of action. H.R. 2039 contains a sizeable number of very objectionable provisions, many of which might force a veto by President Bush if in a final product sent to him. Unfortunately, it will be very difficult to rally support to win floor votes to strike these provisions, and Congressman Frank has rebuffed my efforts to get him to remove them. In my judgment nothing short of White House intervention will get a bill that is acceptable. The White House is in a unique position to play a very positive role in this process, and it seems only logical to play the role sooner rather than later.

If changes are not made to H.R. 2039, several of its provisions would seriously undermine the Legal Service Corporation's ability to conduct oversight and correct abuses. The bill in its current form also would weaken current law restrictions on the use of federal legal services funds to represent illegal aliens and to disseminate information regarding political training and union organizing.

In addition, four primary reforms are essential to making the Legal Services Corporation and the federal legal services program effective, efficient, and apolitical:

-- a prohibition on lobbying by federally-funded legal services attorneys;

-- a prohibition on involvement by legal services attorneys in redistricting activities, including census-taking, at the local, state, and federal levels;

-- a prohibition on federally-funded legal services programs using non-federal funds for activities for which Congress has prohibited the use of federal funds; and

-- a phased-in implementation of a competitive bidding system for the designation of grantees based on the delivery of high-quality, economical, and effective legal services.

Reforms to require the identification of plaintiffs and to prohibit acceptance of legal fees from private parties to lawsuits are needed to ensure fairness and prevent abuses. The enclosed memo goes into more detail on these issues.

I am optimistic that compromises could be worked out on most of these issues, and that is why I believe White House sponsored negotiations should be convened in the very near future. Any issues that cannot be worked out would be put to a vote on the House and Senate floors.

I appreciate your interest in and support for the reform effort. Please let me know if you need additional information or have any questions.

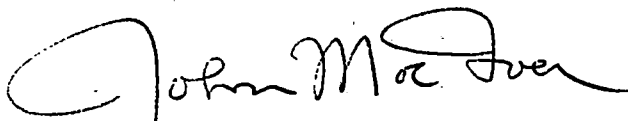

I am writing to bring to your attention that the Interim final rule just published by the Health Care Financing Administration and the Office of Management and Budget may jeopardize the Medicaid program in Mississippi, as well as other states, by prohibiting the use of voluntary contributions and provider taxes as the state share of the cost.

If the proposed regulation is implemented, the use of donated funds will be eliminated and the use of provider taxes will be severely restricted. Mississippi will be unable to continue its Medicaid program without substantial cuts in both services and eligibility. In the 1991 session, the Mississippi Legislature authorized a program budget for the current fiscal year of some 1.1 billion dollars. This budget included no expansions or new services other than those required by federal legislation. Because Mississippi has a 4-to-1 federal match rate, this budget requires 227 million state dollars. The Legislature appropriated 160 million dollars, projecting that the additional funds would be derived primarily from provider taxes and donated funds. If these funding mechanisms are curtailed in January, 1992, the Medicaid program could be underfunded by as much as 200 million dollars. This could force elimination of the optional portions of the Medicaid program, specifically reimbursement for drugs, long-term care, and durable medical equipment, as well as the elimination of certain categories of eligibility.

The consequences to Mississippi would be devastating. During the past year, the number of recipients of medical assistance has climbed to more than half a million. Approximately 65% of the state's births are financed by Medicaid, through programs which ensure timely prenatal care and special services for high-risk mothers and infants. Early and Periodic Screening and Diagnosis bring preventive and ameliorative services to young children in order to avert lifelong health problems and medical expenses. In addition, nursing home care is now available to virtually all of the State's elderly who live at or below the federal poverty line.

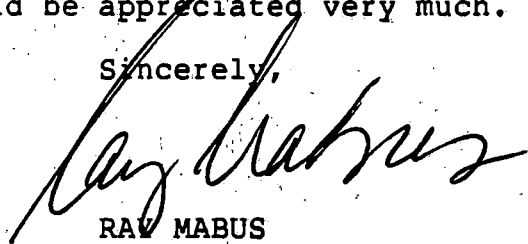

The impact of the proposed regulations would be proportionately greater in Mississippi than in other states because of Mississippi's high poverty rate which is reflected in increased Medicaid enrollment. More than 20% of the State's population are Medicaid recipients. Other states need only sustain 3 or 5% of their population, and, therefore, could fund their programs more easily. Mississippi does enjoy the highest match rate in the country (4-to-1); however, this does not offset the economic burden of providing medical assistance to such a large portion of the population. Without provider taxes and donated funds, our current program could not be funded.

Any action you might take in support of the states' authority to finance their cost of the Medicaid program through provider taxes and donated funds would be appreciated very much.

Helena Stanaslavska is the name of the young lawyer who has been keeping us informed. Her husband is in the Finance Ministry in Riga. She has an 8 year old son. Her conversations became very guarded the last four months, and now I know why.

The reason I am writing this letter is to ask you to have the President attend the AMERICAN-BALTIC PARTNERSHIP CONFERENCE to be held in Dallas on Jan. 30 the Feb. 2, 1991 in Dallas. Also, it would be nice if Dallasite Bob Strauss could attend. His sister-in-law is the present Mayor of Dallas, and she has been very effective in helping us help the Baltics. I'm sure that you'll get requests from other people to persuade the President to be here. But there is no one in Washington more informed than you are about our efforts. It is what ordinary citizens can legally do to help our government.

The presidents of the three Baltic countries will be here with key officials. The final economic plan will be announced at that time. We have already started, although in a small way.

I am enclosing an information sheet from Dick Shriver for your information.

As we discussed briefly last week, a significant number of my colleagues in the Senate have indicated that they would be more inclined to support S. 1220, the National Energy Security Act of 1991, if it contained mandated, attainable CAFE numbers.

Title III of S. 1220 presently contains language that states that CAFE standards for model years 1996 through 2001 and 2001 and thereafter shall be set at a level which the Secretary of Transportation "determines is the maximum feasible average fuel economy level for such manufacturer." Senator Johnston, along with Senators Conrad and Akaka, have indicated that they intend to offer an amendment to this provision which would require CAFE levels of 30.2 mpg in 1996; 34.0 mpg in 2001; and 37 mpg in 2006. And of course, we can anticipate that Senator Bryan will offer an amendment mandating his extreme requirements of 34.0 mpg in 1996 and 40 mpg in 2001.

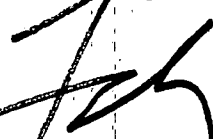
Governor, as you chart Administration strategy on S. 1220 I recommend addressing the merits of preparing a Republican alternative to the Johnston amendment which also mandates specific CAFE numbers. Based on conversations with my colleagues, it seems likely that a provision substantially along the lines of the Johnston amendment will win Senate approval. Offering a Republican amendment may provide opportunities to improve the Johnston amendment during consideration by the full Senate and could result in a better Senate position to take to an eventual Conference with the House.

As we've discussed on several occasions, my top priority is Senate passage of comprehensive national energy strategy legislation which includes ANWR leasing authority. We are very close to having the votes necessary to pass legislation in the Senate which achieves this goal. It has become clear, however, that CAFE legislation in some

form which includes mandated standards will be part of a successful effort.

Governor, as you know, I am strongly committed to opening ANWR during this legislative session. The continued support and leadership of the President will be crucial in making this a reality. I look forward to continuing to work with you on this matter of such great importance to Alaska and the Nation.

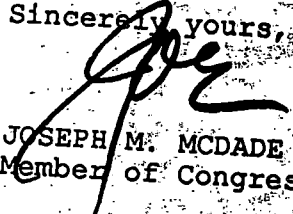

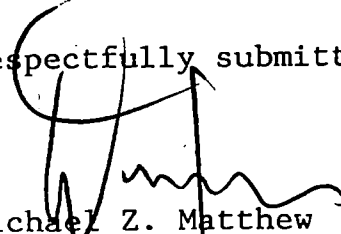
Dear Senator Sununu:

The aid to Israel question is in the news again. I, probably like millions of others, have bit my tongue on this issue for years. But I want to tell you how I've looked at this issue for many years.

In the news, and on the major TV networks, one constantly hears about "Israel being our greatest ally," and "Israel being a great Democracy". Frankly, I think this is a classic case of something being repeated so many times, for so long, few people even bother to question it's truth.

The "Israel being a great Democracy" question. Frankly, as I see it, Israel is a slave state. The West Bank Palestinians have no voting rights, no social security, little right to buy property and little or no rights to free speech or demonstration. They have no right to own firearms. If they do demonstrate they are, as a part of official Israel Government on-going policy, shot down in the streets. This is a hell of a way to define Democracy.

Suppose the Governor of Mississippi said that from this day forward, no Blacks in Mississippi would have the right to vote. They could not expand their property ownership. They could not own firearms. And, if they demonstrated in the streets, it was now official Mississippi police policy to shoot to kill and then burn down their homes. After the homes were burned down, the land would be given to whites. Then suppose Mississippi requested ten billion dollars from Washington, D.C. to carry out this policy. What do you think Washington would say?

The United States should say to Israel that two things can happen. Either (1) Israel incorporate the West Bank into Israel and give the people full rights of citizenship. Or (2) Israel give the West Bank its freedom.

Abraham Lincoln said it a long time ago. A nation cannot long endure half free and half slave.

As to the "Israel being our greatest ally" question. I've been a student of military history and strategy for 30 years and, frankly, I have no idea of what the people who say the above are talking about. Strategically, Israel is to the United States what Cuba is to the USSR. I'm sure that for years there were those in Moscow who said Cuba was a "strategic gem". The question is this. The Russians finally got smart and saw Cuba for what it really was. A dictatorship. A rat hole for money. An example to everyone else of what they really didn't want to be. An aggravation to all of Cuba's neighbors and a fountainhead of ill will towards the USSR for supporting dictatorship in Cuba.

If the Russians can get smart and see past the lies, how long is it going to take the United States to see that Israel is a slave state? A state that shoots down little kids in the street for wanting basic human freedoms. Frankly, taking my tax money and using it to murder little children is, in my opinion, a political crime and a crime against humanity.

I've heard some of my military friends say that Israeli Intelligence supplies a lot of information. If that's so, then why is so much of the CIA's USSR information so wrong? We do know that Israel steals USA military information and gives it to the Russians. And yes, they give USSR information to us. Or, to put it more accurately, they are playing both sides against the middle with a lot of dis-information to Israel's advantage put into the loop.

The old idea that we needed Israel because the Red Army was going to invade the Middle East and take over the oil fields, that total scam was a fabrication. And certainly today it is an impossibility. The "military need" for Israel was, in my opinion, always a fabricated need. The United States was played for a sucker, and is still being played for a sucker. Let's get smart about what's happening. Let's stop kissing Israel's ego and start working for a permanent peace in the area.

Getting tough with Israel would be in the best interest of the Jewish people everywhere. The government of Israel is incapable of doing anything constructive. It's going to have to be forced to solve the Palestinian question. And it has to be forced to do it now.

President Nixon was right when he said that each month the Arabs get smarter, wealthier and more sophisticated. "Desert Storm" gave them a first hand lesson in modern warfare. On the other hand, Israel exists on American money and American arms, and each year America vis-a-vis the world becomes weaker. Israel must make peace with the Arabs now before the Arabs realize the power shifts. This is the best chance we've had in 30 years. If Washington, D.C. is weak now, we are almost assured of a Middle East nuclear war sometime in the future.

I think millions of Americans who have been silent for a long time feel exactly the way I do. Thank you for your time.

Iraq's invasion of Kuwait called into question the wisdom of providing developing countries with vast arsenals of sophisticated weapons. While Iraq spent more of its gross national product (GNP) on arms than any other country in recent years, the growth of the arms trade is more widespread than most realize.

Military expenditures in the developing world rose about five hundred percent between 1960 and 1988, increasing at twice the rate of per capita income. In 1988, the developing countries spent approximately \$170 billion on military expenditures, which amounts to 4.3 percent of their GNPs.

Where are these weapons obtained? From 1971 through 1988, the five permanent members of the United Nations Security Council provided almost eighty percent of these arms. Surely they could do more to limit their exports. Increasingly, the weapons-exporting countries are also transferring the technology and the industrial capacity to manufacture sophisticated weapons to the developing countries. This practice will make controlling the arms trade more difficult in the future.

With the Cold War winding down, some practical steps are possible to increase security and reduce the developing countries' large military outlays. The great military powers could continue their reductions in conventional and nuclear arms. The arms-producing nations could tighten controls on the spread of weapons of mass destruction and the means to deliver them, and substantially limit conventional arms exports. The U.N. Security Council could state that it will act to counter external aggression. Finally, future financial aid to developing countries could be tied to their limiting military expenditures, e.g., to two percent of their GNP.

The time has come to reevaluate our policies on transferring conventional arms. To provide you with solid information and analysis on this timely issue, Council for a Livable World Education Fund has published the attached Briefing Book on Conventional Arms Transfers. I hope that you will find the book useful as you study global arms trade and the possibilities for limiting it.

I am pleased to recommend this briefing book to you.

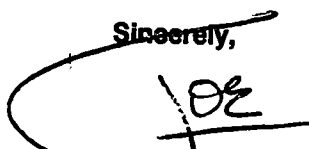

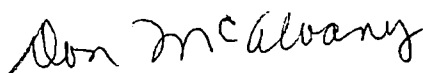

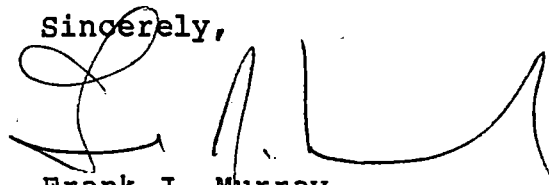

As you know, I had hoped to get this for our premiere Sunday edition but summer vacation plans intervened. Now would be a good time. Anytime, anyplace.

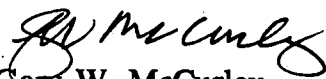

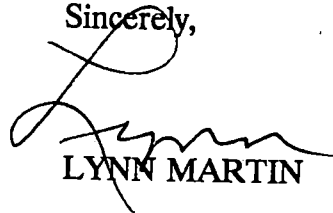

Last week I held a meeting to attempt to plan our company's long-term harvest plans for the next five years (1992-1996). Due to the current existence of six "owl circles" on our tree farm (I say current because these circles appear, disappear, and appear somewhere else at irregular frequencies), our family-owned company not only will have to dramatically reduce our cut, but may not be able to cut any timber two to three years from now. Approximately half of our merchantable (old enough to be logged) timber is frozen in "owl circles" where there exists less than the 40% minimum suitable habitat required by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Department. Under current Fish & Wildlife regulations, this means we will have to wait at least fifty (yes, 50!) years before the non-suitable habitat becomes old enough to be so-called suitable habitat!

So, due to harvest restrictions developed and enforced by Fish & Wildlife, the value of the Murray Pacific tree farm is less than half of what it was worth only two years ago. Although the timber is still there, it is not harvestable during my lifetime, according to current Fish & Wildlife regulations. This is a flagrant taking of private property. Our lending bank has obvious (and appropriate) concerns about this timber as collateral for our loans. And to top it all off, Fish & Wildlife is now stating to the media that private land will be exempted from their critical habitat designation under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, creating a public and congressional perception that all of my owl problems will go away.

Nothing could be further from the truth! Even if we are exempted from Section 7 of the ESA, Section 9 of the same act kills us. Section 9 of the ESA prohibits the taking of owls and requires strict compliance with Fish & Wildlife and Washington state harvest restrictions. In other words, the owl circles do not go away, my inability to harvest timber within these circles does not go away, and therefore, nothing changes. This is a cruel, purely political, hoax created by Fish & Wildlife to make people believe private land has been spared from current harvesting restrictions. The fact is: Spotted owl regulations are now eliminating at least 60% of our total timber asset value, costing tens of millions of dollars!

Fish & Wildlife's other new slight of hand trick is to blame sawmill closures on private lands. Fish & Wildlife knows it has a public relations disaster on its hands, so now it is attributing mill closures to log exports from private lands in order to avoid criticism of its devastating restrictions. Fish & Wildlife desperately hopes the public won't comprehend the magnitude of its land set asides and timber harvest restrictions. With a seventy percent reduction in public timber harvest levels and the regulatory confiscation of millions of acres of private lands, Fish & Wildlife and its preservationist cohorts know the public will be outraged at the oncoming economic impact.

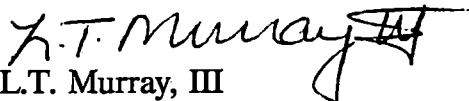
I don't know if this is an agency out of control, pushing its own agenda, or it is being subtly led by the "green influence" within its ranks or within Congress. Suffice it to say that Fish & Wildlife is issuing statements for public consumption that are without question meant to distort the facts to the public in order to lock up the great majority of the remaining National Forest land that previously had supplied the majority of Pacific Northwest sawmills. If Fish & Wildlife, or its congressional allies, succeed in restricting markets for the remaining timber we can harvest, the value of Murray Pacific's lands will be diminished even further. When will this "taking" stop? Who is going to compensate the private tree growers for the loss of the use of their lands? When?

The Washington "delegation" still has not remotely taken a leadership role commensurate with the impact this issue will have on our state. Can you even comprehend the effect of withdrawing 8.2 million more acres from the productive land base and the confiscation of millions more acres of private lands, like Murray Pacific land, due to owl-related harvest restrictions?

This issue is screaming for rational thinking and political courage! I beg of you, please rethink it and take a strong and aggressive stand against the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Department and the "nothing-to-lose" congresspersons from outside the Northwest.

Justice Hugo Black, for 34 years the great liberal champion on the Court, bitterly criticized the first of these cases precisely for reinventing natural law doctrine to strike down a state law. Justice Black was dead by the time of the abortion case, but it would certainly have earned his

thor criticized Roe V. Wade, but Judge Thomas offered no discussion of the abortion issue at all. The truth is that we do not know where Judge Thomas might come down on the abortion question. We do know of this principled opposition to racial preferences, which is another source of frantic opposition from groups like the NAACP.

I know Judge Thomas personally. I do not know what his position is on abortion, and although I have my own, I frankly do not care. This is a man of great character, intelligence and moral purpose who will make an outstanding justice. It would be tragic if his nomination is rejected at the urging of the well-organized liberal special interest coalition headed by the friends of abortion and racial quotas.
