Dear Governor Sununu:

As you know, the administration will be making a decision on whether to extend the machine tool VRA's before Thanksgiving. There are more machine tool companies in Ohio than any other state, and when you add the supplier companies which serve this industry, many jobs will be at stake.

Under the machine tool VRA's the industry has made considerable progress in improving its worldwide competitiveness against the focused targeting of Japanese and Taiwanese machine tool industries. The job is not complete. The industry needs an additional five year VRA to complete the task of rebuilding.

If the VRA's are not extended, layoffs and even plant closings affecting many upper midwestern states are bound to begin late next summer and fall. The Bush administration can take a leadership position by extending the VRA's which will not break the budget and will demonstrate that the Republicans are for creating jobs.

Machine tools are vital to our national security, and as such, this VRA is completely within GATT. The societal concerns are actually positive -- more American employment, more exports, modernizing other American industries -- without increasing prices to end users.

Dear John:

It was so good to see you yesterday. Bobby Brown, Steve Greenberg and I thoroughly enjoyed our visit and the ceremony for the Minnesota Twins. All of Baseball feels honored by the President's recognition.

As you requested, I am writing to provide you a short explanation of the Copyright Royalty Tribunal situation. The terms of Mario Aguero and J.C. Argetsinger, the Chairman and a member of the Tribunal, respectively, expired at the end of September. Ironically, the hearing in the 1989 royalty distribution case, for which parties had prepared for almost two years, commenced in mid-September 1991. Messrs. Aguero and Argetsinger both continue to serve on the CRT in the absence of reappointments or replacements. The current hearing is proving to be the longest and most complicated in at least six years, with dozens of live witnesses and mountains of documents and other evidence. We believe that the hearing will extend through the end of this year and into the first part of 1992. By law, the decision must be rendered by mid-April.

In the interest of efficiency and maintaining the integrity of the decision making process, it would not seem to make sense to replace two-thirds of the Tribunal members near or at the end of this long hearing. Doing so would necessitate repeating months of testimony or would require two new judges out of three, with, most likely, no background in this arcane area, to make decisions based only on tens of thousands of pages of transcripts of live testimony and other voluminous written evidence.

We believe that Chairman Aguero and Mr. Argetsinger, with their many years of experience on the Tribunal and intimate knowledge of this particular case, should be permitted to remain in their positions at least until the conclusion of the hearing and the rendering of a decision in April. Moreover, we do not know of any disagreement among other parties on this point.

We would greatly appreciate any assistance you can provide in this regard. Again, it was great seeing you yesterday.

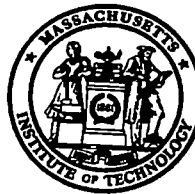

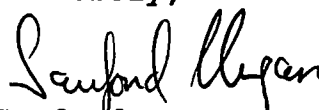

Overview

The recent coup and continuing developments in the Soviet Union point up the vital necessity for the U.S. and western nations to strengthen democratic forces in the Soviet Union and Eastern Bloc.

It is clear that the western and U.S. response will, and should, be a mixture of emergency humanitarian aid combined with training. It is now essential to train millions of Russians in the arts of the market economy. Various congressional proposals are now being crafted to address this situation. The President should maintain the initiative shown in the recent dramatic arms reduction announcement by demonstrating the leadership that only the chief executive can provide.

The time is ripe for President Bush to announce the formation of a "Free Enterprise Corps." The attached article by David Linowes outlines this concept.

The Free Enterprise Corps

The Free Enterprise Corps would function like the Peace Corps or the Executive Service Corps and would provide assistance and expertise in business and economics to people, groups, republics and nations seeking economic guidance. The movements towards democracy, particularly in Eastern Europe, have shown there is a vital need for the basic understanding of the workings of a market economy.

The Free Enterprise Corps would serve as a clearing house to provide information and assistance to government and business leaders in nations or republics striving to transform government enterprises to private ownership and control. Entrepreneurs, senior executives of major corporations and other qualified citizens would offer their expertise by serving on the Corps for specified time periods.

changes between groups and individuals would be organized and encouraged.

The Free Enterprise Corps would have the job of working with the emerging class of entrepreneurs that have developed to a surprising degree during perestroika. Managers of major enterprises as well as small entrepreneurs must receive training in the skills of industry, commerce, farming and distribution.

This on-the-job guidance would be based on free and creative thinking through privatization efforts, etc. and would be directed away from government and public sector decision-making.

Currently, the U.S. has several successful examples of this type of initiative. The Peace Corps helps poor nations increase their living standard. The Executive Service Corps helps businesses improve their administrative skills. The Free Enterprise Corps would help newly-emerged democracies build a foundation for economic stability through the free market. It could also use organizations such as Seniors in Retirement (SIR) and similar groups.

The Politics

The creation of the Free Enterprise Corps by President Bush would be a dramatic new initiative similar to President Kennedy's creation of the Alliance for Progress and the Peace Corps. It would receive worldwide attention and would harness the power of the U.S. private sector in what would be the most massive "point of light" ever.

The Free Enterprise Corps could be combined with the President's nomination of Elaine Chao as Director of the Peace Corps and would do much to revitalize that agency. It would demonstrate Presidential initiative and undercut many critics of the administration's policies towards formerly communist states.

I believe this would be an excellent opportunity for the Bush Administration to develop a program to continue its good work to promote freedom and democracy worldwide.

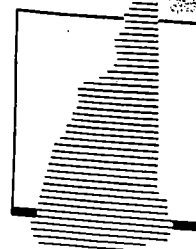

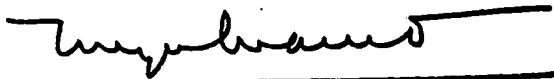

Dear Governor Sununu:

On behalf of the Board of Trustees of the U.S.-Mexico Foundation (formerly the Mexican and American Foundation), we would like to request your personal assistance to help guarantee a successful binational affair next month.

National representatives of CANACINTRA (Mexico's Chamber of major industries) have asked us to assist them with obtaining a prominent official from the Bush Administration to keynote CANACINTRA'S 1991 National Convention luncheon at 2 p.m., Friday, September 27 at the Fiesta American Hotel in Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico, where approximately 1,000 individuals from both sides of the border are expected to attend. Through the Foundation, we have extended invitations to Vice President Dan Quayle and Commerce Secretary Mosbacher (see attached letters), who could not serve as Keynote Speakers.

Governor Sununu, the Foundation is held in high esteem by Mexico's business, civic, and political sectors. Our perceivable support of the Administration's projects was one of the reasons that CANACINTRA asked for our assistance. For example, the Foundation was extremely active in assisting President Bush in lobbying all 435 members of the U.S. House of Representatives and the 100 U.S. Senators to support the fast track negotiation of the North American Free Trade Agreement; and, we sent letters to members of the Judiciary Committee supporting President Bush's nominee for the Supreme Court, Judge Clarence Thomas.

We have already been rejected by the White House in our quest to honor President Bush as our Man of the Year at our 20th Anniversary An Evening With the Stars event on Saturday, September 28 in San Diego, where Mexico President Carlos Salinas de Gortari was confirmed to receive the "Caballero del Año" award; however, his presence was dependent on President Bush also attending the black-tie affair. We must maintain our binational credibility with our Mexican friends, as the Foundation is in a position to provide further assistance to Mexico President Salinas de Gortari to convert some of the dissidents in his country who are opposing the North American Free Trade Agreement.
