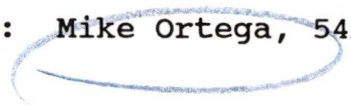

Dear Governor Sununu:

In December of last year, I lost one of the brightest and most treasured friends I have ever had. His untimely death was caused, ironically, by a device he was constantly involved with; an aircraft. I'm speaking, of course, about Joe Nall's tragic death in a Cessna 401 in Venezuela. Even though we differed drastically in our National Politics (he staunch Democrat, me staunch Republican), we never differed for a moment in our joint quests to analyze and improve this Country's air safety programs. And knowing Joe like I did, I know he would expect us to carry on the vigorous work he literally gave his life for.

In this context, Joe leaves vacant his seat as an NTSB member. This is a critical situation, given the general confusion and disruption (to say nothing of under-staffing) that the Board has suffered over the past twelve to eighteen months. Therefore, many of us in the Industry feel it is imperative for Joe's seat on the Board to be filled without lengthy delay.

As I understand it, Kenneth Peppard, Joe's Special Assistant has expressed an interest in filling Joe's vacant seat for the duration of Joe's term. I cannot think of a better candidate to do just this; for a number of good, valid reasons. Some of them are:

- o Ken knows Joe's business - where he was on certain projects, how he worked with other Board members, who he could work with in an effective fashion.
- o Ken's background in aviation is extensive. His diversity of experience in NTSB matters would be a large plus, and his FAA background would be of great benefit in working with that agency. It would also be refreshing and obviously constructive.

Governor Sununu, now more than ever, our NTSB Board needs to be fully staffed with knowledgeable, capable people who will not be a rubber stamp to outside interests. It is personally felt Ken Peppard is such a person and I would endorse his appointment to serve out Joe's unexpired term. I hope the Administration concurs.
