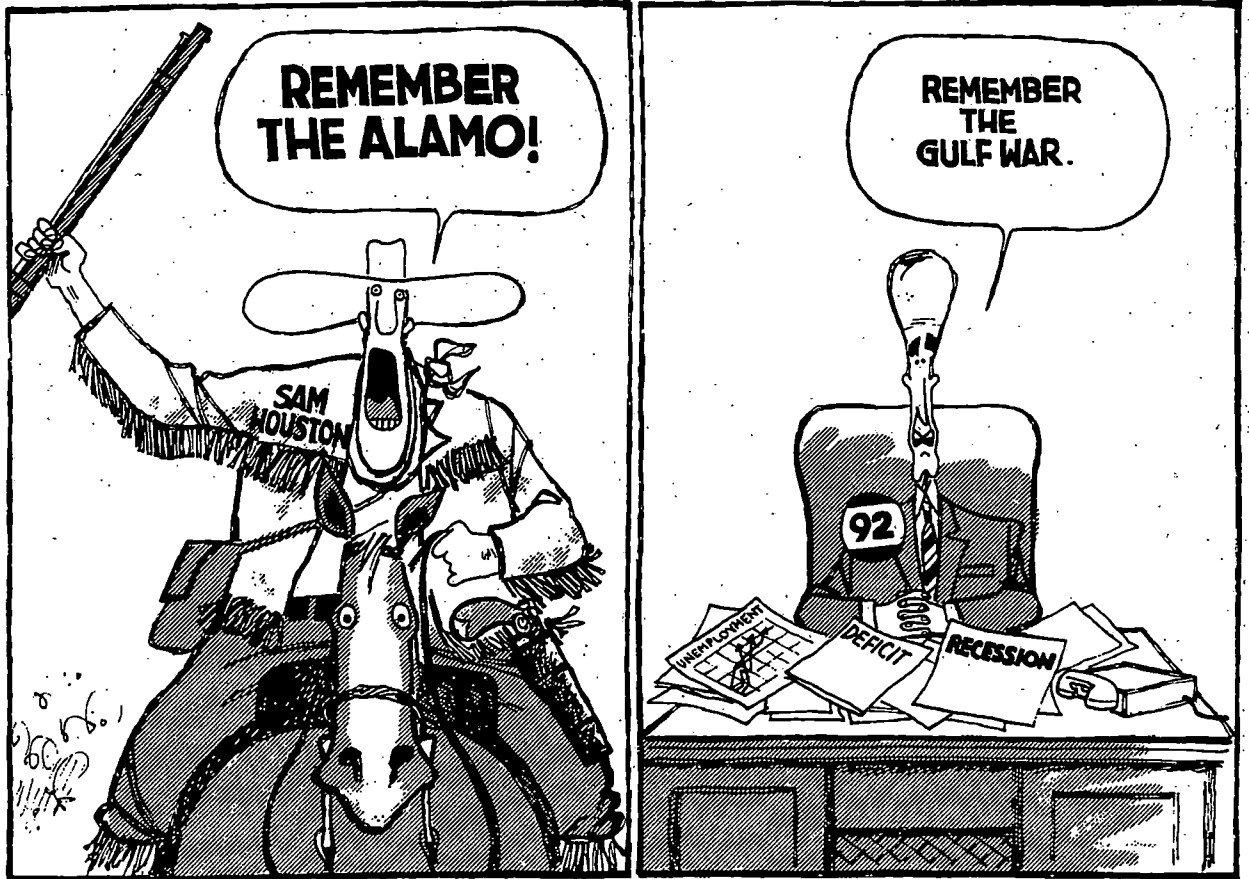

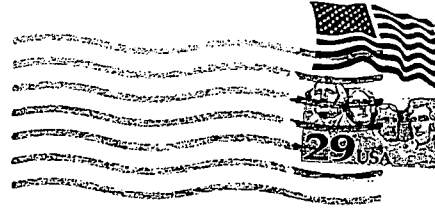

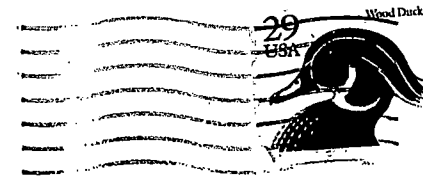

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The Paradox of Sexual Harassment

Finally, the confirmation hearings are over and Clarence Thomas sits as a new Associate Justice of the Supreme Court. The country expected the confirmation battle to be a fierce one when it began in the middle of the summer, and as the nomination process moved forward, no one was left with any doubt that the battle was on. The ferocity was controlled and polite, with all Senators either agreeing or disagreeing with the views of Judge Thomas, mostly if not always respectfully. But no decent American thought it would come to what we witnessed in the last two weeks. All Americans should hold their heads low in shame. What unfolded in the inevitability of democratic process was absolutely disgusting.

Our society is sick, and it does not know what to do about sexual harassment. Men cannot always behave themselves professionally in the workplace, as women would expect. Women cannot always use the system to protect their rights when threatened with sexual harassment, as men would expect.

The spectrum is complex and confusing. There are some very sick men who know they are sexual harassers and enjoy it. There are some men who perceive their friendly manners as normal male-female interaction and strive to promote the equal rights of women in the workplace. There are some men who are extremely careful about how they act and rigidly enforce the equal rights of women in the workplace.

As for women, it is unbelievable that there are any sane women who enjoy any form of received sexual harassment, although certainly there are also some sick women who engage in sexual harassment against men. But women certainly vary on what they perceive as sexual harassment. Some perceive friendly manners as simply friendly and to be expected, who feel limited, but nonetheless who do not feel threatened or harassed. Other women perceive these friendly manners as demeaning, trivializing, and threatening, and definitely feel harassed. These characterizations of men and women are only points in a spectrum: the range in perception is immense.

In order to clarify some of this confusion, the law is constantly amended as society is able to more carefully determine what it wishes the norms of behavior to be governing sexual harassment. But whereas the law against sexual harassment can sometimes be instrumental in legally resolving harassment allegations, it does nothing to prevent harassment from occurring when well-meaning citizens do not understand their own behavior or the behavior of others. In some instances, a woman may perceive that she is being harassed when legally she is not being harassed. In some instances, a man may perceive that he is not harassing when legally he is harassing. In both cases, where the legally aggrieved party prevails, injustice is also being done to the person whose well-meant position is not substantiated by law.

This is a paradox we live with, but it is unfathomable that it can never be resolved. In situations of subjective analysis, there certainly can never be absolute justice. But society must instead strive to achieve the best possible justice. It must attempt to instruct itself on how both men and women can behave in the workplace so that misunderstanding is minimized and resolution is found. It must also provide itself with adequate legal recourse when resolution remains elusive.

This is the dilemma faced by the country in understanding and dealing with the sexual harassment charges brought against Judge Thomas by Professor Anita Hill. A very credible woman stepped forward into the middle of a highly politicized process with strong allegations of sexual harassment, and transformed the paradoxical dilemma over sexual harassment into a national crisis. It is hard to believe that Professor Hill suffers from delusions or that she is the instigator of a political plot (although her efforts were of clear benefit to the opposers of Judge Thomas). But it is also very

hard to believe that Judge Thomas could be guilty of the conduct she alleges. He categorically denies the charges and feels that he is the victim of a high lynch mob — a quite powerful charge. A panel of witnesses testified to the integrity of Judge Thomas's character, especially in his professional relationships with women. A few but not enough witnesses also testified about the same for Professor Hill. Every credible, everyone was sincere, but each side took forward totally diametric positions.

Why this spectacle in front of the American people? The graphic details of the disgusting behavior Professor Hill alleged surged through the airwaves on television screens, stunning a Saturday morning audience of children. Judge Thomas's accusation of the rape of the American soul and his life effort to hit the same air and hit the American people with a powerful force of shame. The struggling of the fifteen Senators of the Judiciary Committee to keep their partisanship was sickly comical, the commentary of the media an annoying intrusion into the conflict at hand. Humans are avaricious creatures of horror and the perverted, and the "lost weekend" provided Americans with ample fill.

What a soap opera the affair became, replete with a cast of characters few directors would have been able to more masterfully assemble. On the left were the Fool from Ohio, the Silent from Massachusetts, Confused from Vermont, and the Jello from Alabama. On the right were the Ancient from South Carolina, Puritan from Utah, the Cowboy from Wyoming, the Manipulator from Pennsylvania. In the middle were the Yes-Man from Delaware, and in the ring were Ms. I'm-Not-Lying. Americans were glued to their seats in record numbers, and many people junkies ate up the gavel-to-gavel coverage like film fans at an all-night marathon.

But the democratic process is an imperfect choice. The charge had been leveled, through ever-underhanded means, and it had to be resolved. The opera wore on into its umpteenth act, the Yell of Liberty and reminded of Thomas and the feeding frenzy of feminist wardens that the presumption of innocence was the Judge. How curious it was to note that the inalienable and righteous concept of American prudence had to be so clearly recalled, as that sole chance for Judge Thomas to prevail had been forgotten in the theater dressing room.

Indeed, it was this concept that saved Judge Thomas in the end, convincing several of the Southern crats to cast their vote with the man they were prepared to affirm after the real hearings were over. Senator Johnston of Louisiana noted, the allegations of Judge Thomas and the 10-year silence of Professor Hill were utterly inconsistent with the person's demonstrated "course of conduct." There was just too much doubt. But a vote of 5-4 was awfully close.

In the context of the Senate Spectacle, the release of the MIT report "Stopping Sexual Harassment: A Guide to Options and Resources at MIT" is particularly timely. Men must be more sensitive to the difficulties faced by women in the workplace in women's struggle to overcome lack of power and the threat of trivialization. Men must be more sensitive and understanding of the difficulties men face in overcoming historical prejudices and acting professionally with women, as at MIT, people must be sensible in their approach to the issue, and follow the basic guidelines of the report: 1) don't sexually harass; 2) if you are sexually harassed, do something about it. The MIT community, as a nation, must come to terms with the paradox that perpetuates the unsexing of the workplace if the solution of sexual harassment is to be solved.

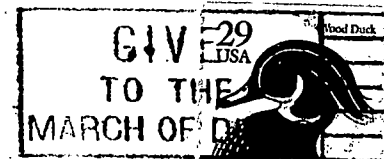

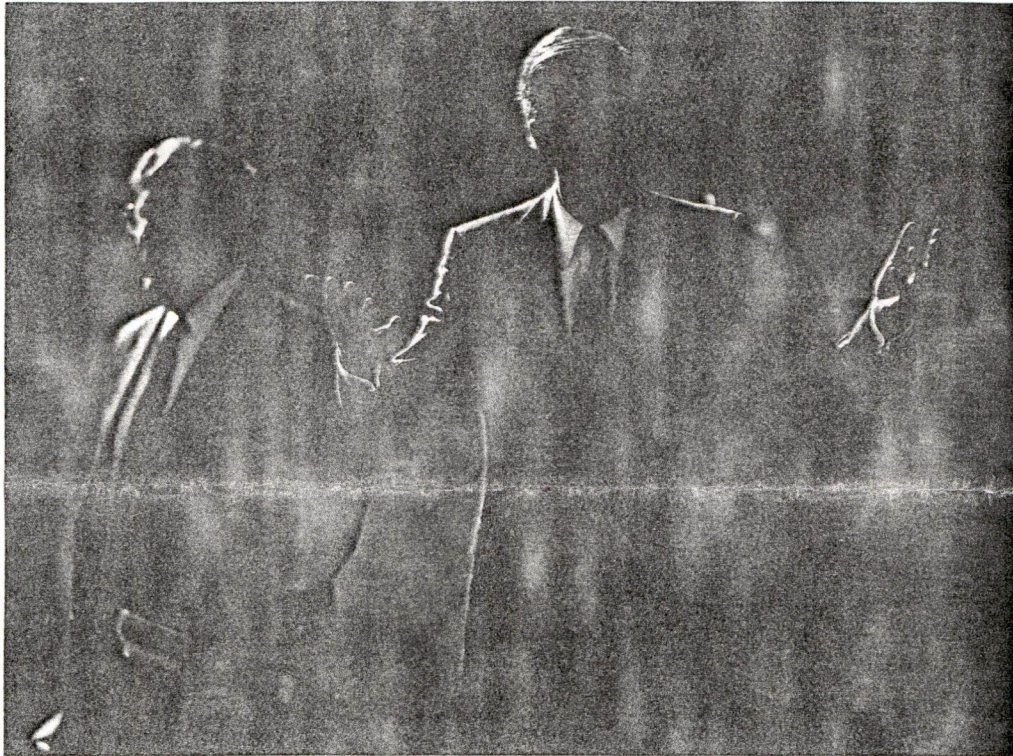

From Triple K to Capital R

The recession changes Bush's campaign strategy

Last summer George Bush's men were laughing at the Democrats, debating not whether the president would win re-election, but how many states he would carry. The plan was simple. Bush's cocky operatives called it the KKK strategy—crime, quotas and Kuwait. Bush would simply bash away at the Democrats as softies and lefties, while slick TV ads portrayed the commander in chief as Liberator, jut-jawed and resolute.

Last week a different Bush was on display. Unnerved by the flat response of GOP fat cats at a dinner in Houston, Bush reverted to his strident side. Departing from his prepared text, he ad-libbed a rambling defense of his presidency. "I have a responsibility to lead," he said, "and I'm not going to let Democratic liberal carping keep me from leading." Meanwhile, Bush the pragmatist was busily compromising with the same Democrats in Congress. The week before, he had dropped his threats to veto civil-rights legislation, despite his earlier denunciations of a "quota bill." Last week he ordered his top aides to negotiate a compromise on extending unemployment benefits, even though he had vetoed similar measures twice before.

Bush's transformation is not hard to ex-

plain. The triple K strategy has run head-on into reality with a capital R—recession. The president first sensed trouble around Labor Day, when he read a "misery index" in *The Wall Street Journal* that showed that a majority of Americans believed that the country was on the wrong track and that the economy was their biggest worry. At the time, Bush's aides counseled patience. The country would grow out of the recession, argued Treasury Secretary Nicholas Brady, budget chief Richard Darman and chairman of the Council of Economic Advisers Michael Boskin. But the latest numbers tell a different story: many indicators are down, and last week unemployment rose to 6.8 percent. Overall, growth during Bush's administration has been a weak 1.4 percent. No president since World War II has been re-elected with such an unimpressive economic performance.

In the White House, near panic has set in. Bush's advisers uneasily watched former attorney general Richard Thornburgh lose a 44-point lead in the Pennsylvania Senate race to an obscure Democrat, Harris Wofford, after being painted as a pro-status-quo stiff from Washington. At a dinner of 15 top GOP strategists last Wednesday night, many worried that the

same labels could be applied to George Bush. Several of the operatives complained that Bush, who is scheduled to travel abroad two out of the next five weeks, was spending too much time overseas.

Bush got the message. He told a gathering of congressional leaders the next day that he would craft a legislative package aimed at improving the economy and highlighting his domestic agenda. But his aides are divided over what that package should look like. The more politically minded, like Secretary of Commerce Robert Mosbacher, want Bush to take an aggressive stance, vowing to cut capital-gains taxes. But Bush's more cautious friends, like Brady, warn that tax cuts will have little immediate effect on the economy, and that Bush runs the risk of being branded as the rich man's friend if he pushes on capital gains. Visibly frustrated by the debate, Bush told his aides that he felt like he was standing in the middle of a hurricane. All he could hear was the noise swirling around him.

Eroding trust: A president is supposed to be able to count on his chief of staff to referee such disputes. But on domestic issues, Bush must turn to a man he no longer feels completely comfortable with or entirely trusts. Chief of staff John Sununu has been burned by his highhanded use of government planes and limousines, and last week the rumor mill began tying him to the BCCI scandal. Sununu's former aide, Ed Rogers, took a \$600,000 fee to represent one of BCCI's principals, Sheik Kamal Adham, prompting a conflict-of-interest investigation by White House counsel Boyden Gray. *NEWSWEEK* has learned that Gray's investigation will clear Sununu and Rogers of a conflict of interest regarding BCCI. But senior administration officials and congressional sources say questions remain concerning Sununu's connections to BCCI.

On the merits, Bush agrees with his old friend Brady that the best approach to the economy is probably to do not much of anything. Bush is a keen politician, though, so he will try to make what his aides call "perceptual changes"—sleights of hand to make it seem the administration is doing more than it actually is. But the country is growing impatient. If the president fails to change the economy, the voters may be tempted to change presidents—assuming the Democrats themselves can come up with a tempting alternative.

Letters Flood In From Troubled Readers

For 60 years, this has been a watchdog column that has supported the voiceless over the dominant, the helpless against their exploiters, the small enterprise above the octopus.

Its role was established by the late Drew Pearson, who became the champion of the downtrodden during the Great Depression. Millions lived vicariously through him as he rooted out the scandals of his day and plagued the scoundrels beyond the reach of the common people.

Not since those grim early years has this column stirred such an anguished response. Mail floods into our office on waves of discontent—troubled letters from concerned readers. They feel threatened by shrinking incomes, rampant lawlessness, exploding costs, inept leadership and an uncertain, onrushing future.

They have lost confidence in politicians who debate yesterday's issues and ignore today's realities, mismanage the government and let the economy drift, put special interests ahead of the public welfare, and raise their own salaries while the folks back home endure pay cuts and layoffs.

Those who write to us are worried, above all else, about the economic outlook. They are caught in a downturn they fear could leave them with mortgages they can't pay. Parents no longer expect their children to live better than they did. Students no longer believe a college degree will get them a job.

We've received thousands of letters from victims of crime who no longer trust the police to protect them, who feel the courts are more concerned about protecting criminals than victims. So they are triple-bolting their doors, installing security

systems and buying guns to protect themselves from marauding criminals.

In some neighborhoods, murder has become a commonplace response to trivial irritations. Legitimate enterprises are packing up to leave, and drug-pushing, theft and prostitution are the only thriving industries. The violence in these urban neighborhoods is beginning to spill into the suburbs.

Some of the most anguished complaints come from readers who can no longer afford health care. For many families, the combined cost of medical insurance and non-covered expenses has almost reached the breaking point. Deficit-ridden hospitals are beginning to refuse treatment to those who can't pay. The crisis is compounded by money-draining diseases such as AIDS, crack addiction and ailments of the aged. It's hard to avoid thinking the health-care system is breaking down.

There are constant complaints, too, about the government's clamor for more revenue and its refusal to stop wasteful spending; the daily hours lost in gridlock traffic; the poor performance of our schools; and dozens of other frustrations.

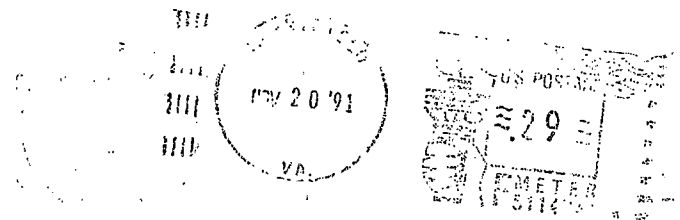
We've tried to be an advocate for the helpless against the mighty, the duped against the dupers. In a sense, our function is that of the steam vent that may help prevent the boiler from blowing up.

We're interested in hearing about what bothers you in the current economic and political climate. The volume of our mail makes it impossible to answer all the letters. Our basic rate includes the federal tax required by Internal Revenue Code Section 4271 on the air transportation portion of this Service.

The outrage brought upon Yugoslavia by the Western World is unprecedented in human history. Never have so many self-righteous turned the principle of "divide and conquer" against so few! Never has the power of economics, international law, religion, diplomacy and the media been used more deviously to break up and reduce a state completely innocent of any aggression or offense toward anyone.

Western television and press present exclusively the secessionist Croatian and Slovenian propaganda, attempting to create in the public's eye artificial realities: that Serbian expansionism is responsible for hostilities in Yugoslavia, and that a sovereign state has no right to oppose fragmentation of its own territory by regional political opportunism.

However, so far, history remains unchanged. Croatia, Slovenia, Dalmatia and Bosnia created a union on November 24, 1918 in Zagreb, and invited Serbia to join *them*. Croatian nationalism persistently opposed creative functions of the government, and culminated in the assassination of King Alexander I on October 9, 1934, through a plot organized by Pavelic. Croats welcomed Nazi occupation of Yugoslavia, using the opportunity to create an Independent State of Croatia, which annexed from Serbia all of Lika; Slavonia, Dalmatia, Srem, Bosnia and half of Vojvodina. The Ustasha government of Croatia, headed by Pavelic, embarked on a program of forced conversion, deportation and extermination of its Serbian and Jewish minorities, which resulted in over seven hundred thousand brutal deaths at the Jasenovac Concentration Camp alone. The vivid memory of this genocide remains forever an example of how Free Croatia treats its minorities. Communism was imposed on Yugoslavia by Marshal Tito, a Croat, and Edvard Kardelj, an ideologist from Slovenia, with *full support of the Allies*; while the Serbian democratic royalist faction was exterminated to the last. After the war, Tito allowed Croatia to keep most of the annexed Serbian territory, while the remains of Serbia were further divided into four autonomous parts. It is incredible that, having sacrificed in the Allied cause a quarter of its population in World War I, and a fifth in World War II, Serbia's reward would be the loss of two thirds of its territory and the subdivision of its people into five republics and two autonomous provinces.

In modern Yugoslavia, Croats enjoyed twice, and Slovenes three times the standard of living in Serbia. Each republic had the right to elect its own government, pursue its own social and economic policies, and make laws which *supersede* federal laws. There is no evidence they were subjected to oppression of any kind. In fact, it was the Slovenes and Croats who encouraged Albanian violence against the Serbian minority in Kosovo.

Slovenia and Croatia used the upheaval following the fall of communism in East Europe to *unilaterally* declare "independence". They received documented financial support from Germany, Austria and the Vatican, military equipment from Germany, Austria, Hungary and England, and proceeded to recruit thousands of Albanian mercenaries from Kosovo into their police and national guard. They took a *threatening* and *uncompromising* posture toward the Yugoslav Federal Government, The Yugoslav Army, and, in particular, toward the large Serbian minority, which they immediately deprived, with full European support, of the very same right to self-determination they themselves sought. The new Independent Croatia bears the same flag, with the checkerboard emblem, used by the earlier, genocidal, Ustasha government, and bows to the same German, Austrian, Italian, Vatican, and Hungarian allies! The very first acts of Dr. Tudzman's

"democratic" regime were to eliminate Serbs from positions in government, education and police, to forbid the use of the Serbian alphabet, to prohibit Serbian cultural and professional organizations, and to deprive Serbs of the right to public assembly. They laid siege to Yugoslav Army installations, and called on their own nationals to desert. All this came to pass before any significant hostilities were initiated in Yugoslavia.

It is not determinable any longer who fired the first bullet in the Yugoslav Civil War, and whether that bullet was fired in hatred or fear. The first bullet is hardly important considering the swarms of perfectly willing bullets which followed from *both* sides. As Croatia first elected to assert its independence from Yugoslavia by force of arms, so the Serbian regions in Croatia, already deprived of the most fundamental human rights, elected to assert their own independence from Croatia.

The European Community took upon itself to *mediate* the crisis in the early stages, but its interventions result in progressive *increase* in tensions and hostility. It is difficult to believe this is coincidental. The most influential members of the European Community, Germany, Austria and Italy, are Yugoslavia's mortal enemies, who have devastated the country and decimated its Eastern Orthodox population in two world wars. These countries have a continued personal interest in reducing Serbia to gain access to the Mediterranean, the Danube, the Black Sea and the Middle East. Through vigorous interventions of the Vatican, interested in renewing the Intermarium Curtain between the Baltic and the Adriatic, the revived German alliance was joined by Lithuania, Poland, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, and even Malta, in lending support to Croatian and Slovenian effort to disintegrate Yugoslavia.

Germany, Austria, and Italy are urging unilateral recognition of Croatia, outside the sphere of the United Nations. They are openly providing financial and material assistance, and exporting arms to Croatia in violation of their own embargo. They are engaging to deprive the Yugoslav federal government of international legitimacy because the federal president, Mr. Mesic, a fierce Croatian separatist, refuses to attend federal presidency meetings. They are waging a media war against Serbia with such conspicuous prejudice that it becomes difficult to believe in the freedom of the Western press. European Community's ultimatum to Yugoslavia to adopt a loose economic union contained no provisions for those republics which desired to remain within the federal state. This can be understood only as a poorly disguised attempt to further subdivide the remnants of the union.

The European Community is not mediating, but *provoking* and *escalating* the Yugoslav crisis toward the ends of personal economic, territorial and religious interests. In the process, it is violating its own arms embargo, and U.N. General Assembly resolutions of 1965 and 1979, which specify that no state shall use economic or military pressures against another state to subordinate exercise of its sovereign rights. The most sacred of all sovereign rights, surely, must be the right to maintain the integrity of a state against internal separatist movements.

By the imposition of economic sanctions on Yugoslavia, the European Community is acting not as a mediator, but a foreign dictator. By refusing to specify exactly the republics against which the sanctions apply, it endeavours to appear impartial, yet have the option to punish only Serbia and Montenegro for the insolence of wanting to remain in a federal state. On the same day the sanctions were imposed, Italy announced it would facilitate trade with Croatia and Slovenia, and no longer require Yugoslav federal export documents.

Probably by intent, rather than incompetence, the European Community has left open *no peaceful course* toward a reunion of Yugoslav republics.

In the end, escalation of hostilities in the Balkans will serve nobody's interests. The Soviet trust will be lost, the free flow of goods will be interrupted, divisive nationalist sentiments will reawaken, the dream of a united Europe will perish for two generations. The only *permanent* solution to the Yugoslav crisis will have to be a *just* solution, which satisfies not only the Croatian, but also the Serbian right to determine its own future. The self-interested European Community is clearly not the forum for a peaceful resolution. Economic sanctions and threats of foreign military intervention are clearly not the means.

For the third time in a century, the world is marching into disaster for lack of deference and want of open ears.



Reading is one of my greatest joys, and I learned to love to read at home, as my children and grandchildren have. I could wish nothing better for you and your family.

WHY READ TOGETHER?

Because it makes all the difference in the world to your children and to you. Visiting a library once, I met a young father in workclothes and boots, holding his daughter in his lap and reading to her. We talked about raising children, and he said, “I wish I could give my daughter more — a nicer home, prettier clothes.” And I told him, “You're already giving her the most valuable gift of all. You're reading to her!”

Here are a few of the experts' reasons for reading with your children:

- Children who are read to learn to read more easily than those who are not.
- Reading to children is good for their curiosity, their imagination, and their vocabulary. It helps them pay attention longer, think better, and communicate more successfully.
- Children's ability to understand what they read depends a lot on background knowledge — what they already know. The more children are read to now, the more they will learn for use in reading later.
- Reading to your child leads to great conversations that give you a chance to share thoughts and feelings. It helps your child grow emotionally, and it brings you closer together.

- When you read to your children you let them know that reading is a valued activity in your home.

Above all, children love to be read to. A dear friend told me that her most vivid and loving memory of her father is of snuggling up to him every evening as he read her the comics pages. Traditions strengthen families, and reading aloud is a wonderful tradition to pass on.

1. *Establish a routine for reading aloud.*

Jennifer and her father have their own nightly ritual. After dinner and before she gets ready for bed, Jennifer puts two pillows on the sofa — the big, old one for dad and the new, small one for herself. Jennifer gets the book, Dad turns on the reading light, and they settle down for the best half-hour of their day.

When you make reading aloud a regular, dependable part of your child's routine, you show that it's as much a part of daily life as brushing teeth or having an afternoon snack. Reading becomes a habit — one of the best your child can have.

2. *Make reading together a special time.*

George and I ask our visiting grandchildren to wake us up in the morning so that we can read with them in bed. They just climb up — the dogs too — and we all have a great time together. We keep children's books on the shelf in our bedroom, and we always let them choose what's read. While we are with them, we try not to permit outside interruptions.

Children love the coziness of reading a book together — and so will you. You can hold your child in your arms or on your lap. Let your child know that this is a time to count on your undivided attention.

3. *Try these simple ways to enrich your reading aloud:*

- Move your finger under the words as you read.
- Let your child help turn the pages.
- Take turns reading words or sentences or pages.
- Pause and ask open-ended questions like: "How would you feel if you were that person?"
- "What do you think might happen next?"

- Look at the illustrations and talk about them.
- Change your voice as you read different characters' words. Let your child make up voices.
- Keep stories alive by acting them out.

4. *Ask others who take care of your children to read aloud.*

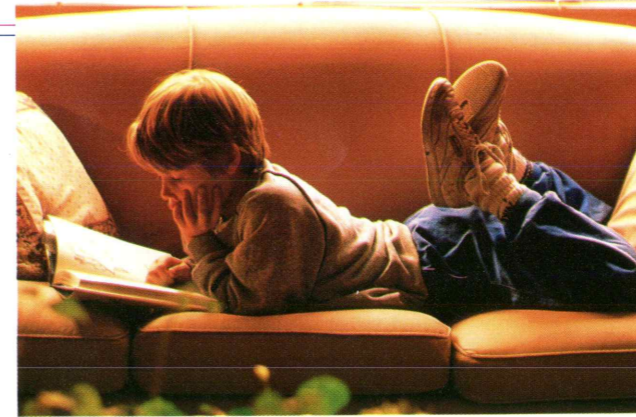
A young mother recently told me about going back to work and leaving her 14-month old son with a sitter. She instructed the sitter to look at a book with the child at least once a day. Not long after that, the sitter arrived one morning to find the baby toddling to greet her with a book in his outstretched hands. It was a triumphant moment for everyone.

Whether family or friends or employees, good caregivers read to children. If you're looking for a day care center for your child, ask if the program includes daily reading to the children. When your child starts school, visit the classroom and look for well-stocked bookshelves and lots of other things to read. And you can ask if the teacher reads to the children.

5. *Visit the library regularly.*

A friend recently overheard a conversation between two young boys. One was showing the other his new wallet. "What's in it?" the first boy asked, and the proud owner opened it up to show a dollar bill, a picture of his family, a card from his Little League team... and a library card!

Public libraries are an endlessly rich source of all kinds of reading material, and regular visits are something you and your child can plan together and look forward to. You can help your children feel at home in the library, get to know the librarian, and check out books themselves. Knowing how to use the library is a skill — and a pleasure — that will serve your children well.



6. *Let your children see you reading.*

Kids model their behavior after their parents'. If your children see you reading and enjoying it, they're more likely to follow suit. So spend some leisure time reading. Set an example by turning off the television and picking up a book. Over dinner or while running errands, talk to your children about things you've read.

7. *Read all kinds of things together.*

Not all reading takes place between the covers of a book. Use whatever is at hand — recipes, mail order catalogues, directions for assembling games or planting seeds. Newspapers offer a broad range of choices for daily reading aloud — from the weather report to photo captions to sports stories to the television schedule.

When you're choosing books, look for the best in children's literature. Your librarian can be a great help. Offer your children a variety of topics — famous people, other countries and cultures, science, adventure, mythical creatures, whatever might capture their imagination.

For very young children, look for picture books with stories and artwork that are simple, clear, and colorful.

Use children's interests and hobbies as

starting points. One mother I know had a very reluctant reader in her little boy. But he was fascinated by cars, so she subscribed to a magazine about automobiles, and soon she couldn't get him to stop reading!

Read old favorites as well as new stories. Children love familiar stories, and it helps develop memory skills. So many of the books I read to my own grandchildren are dog-eared and worn from being read over and over again. Mother Goose and other traditional rhymes and songs are especially good for reading aloud, and young children are eager to join in on favorite verses.

8. *Fill your home with opportunities for reading.*

Keep books, magazines and newspapers all over your home, and take them with you when you travel. In addition to a bookshelf in your child's room, have print materials everywhere — on the kitchen table, by the bed, near the toys, even on top of the television. Give books every holiday season, and encourage relatives and friends to give books or magazine subscriptions as birthday gifts. Make your home a little library.

9. *Keep reading aloud even after your children learn to read.*

Parents — and educators too — sometimes feel that children over the age of seven or eight years old don't want to be read to. This really is not true. A teacher once told me about reading "Treasure Island" to her sixth grade class, starting with five minutes a day. The students took turns watching the clock to tell her when to stop. It wasn't long before a great groan would arise when the five minutes was up, and the students — even the "coolest" of them — would beg her to continue. Years later the teacher met a student who still fondly remembered those times in her class and was then reading the same book to her own children. In my opinion, you're never too old to be read to.

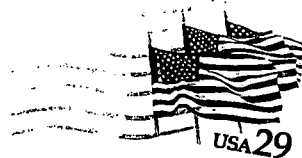

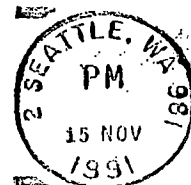

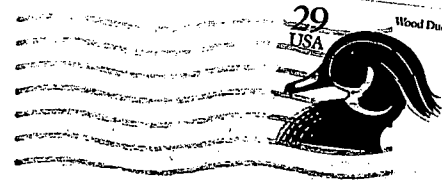

Thank you for your letter of May 24, 1990, concerning the grossly unfair accusations that have been made against Procter & Gamble as a result of your continued purchase of coffee beans from El Salvador for your Folger brand.


As I indicated to you previously, the Administration strongly opposes any boycott of Salvadoran coffee. This misguided attempt to cripple the Salvadoran economy will hurt peasant farmers, small producers, and other employees in the coffee industry, causing innocent people further hardship. The boycott will do nothing to advance the peace process, democracy, or human rights, which are fundamental aims of this Administration.

The Catholic bishops of El Salvador spoke out against the coffee boycott in an open letter to the U.S. bishops on May 23. The bishops declared that the boycott is unjust and that it is aimed at continuing abroad the economic war against the Salvadoran economy which the FMLN guerrillas have waged for the last 10 years.

The television advertisement implying that your company is responsible for bloodshed in El Salvador is offensive. In any event, I question the right of any government official to second-guess advertising decisions made by Procter & Gamble or anyone else.

Supporting democracy is in the best interest of the Salvadoran people and is a foreign policy objective of the United States. We recognize that Salvadoran beans are only a tiny proportion of Procter & Gamble's usage and that this controversy is unsettling. We appreciate that you have stayed the course and urge you and other coffee producers to continue to purchase from El Salvador.

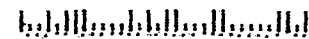



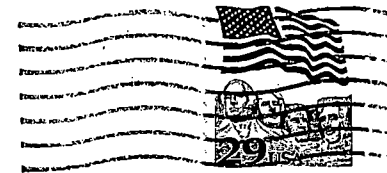
