SUBJECT: GUN OWNERS OF AMERICA

I have been picking up rumors today that the Gun Owners of America are circulating a letter for signature among conservative leaders that will soon be sent to the President. The letter is a basic "indictment" of his Presidency, citing issues such as:

- (1) The President's soft attitude in dealing with the Soviet Union.
- (2) His lack of intensity on the abortion issue.
- (3) Gun control / his reversal of position.
- (4) Speculation on when his "no new tax" pledge will be reversed.

My understanding is that Paul Weyrich and the American Conservative Union are among the proponents of this letter. Based on what I have found out thus far, there is no evidence that this is a "mass mail" effort, but rather is a conservative leadership letter to the President.
