SUBJECT: PRESIDENTIAL NEWS CONFERENCE
FOR FOREIGN CORRESPONDENTS

We recommend that the President hold a news conference with foreign correspondents just prior to his departure for Europe and Latin America, Thursday, November 15. The White House pool would also attend. We have received numerous requests for print and TV interviews in connection with the President's forthcoming trips to Europe, the Middle East, and Latin America. Our Embassies, the State Department, and USIA have strongly urged that the President do individual interviews. It is obviously not possible to accommodate all the individual requests. A news conference would help immensely in setting the groundwork for the President's trips and send signals of continued interest in Latin America. We suggest that the news conference be held in Room 450 at 11:00 a.m.
