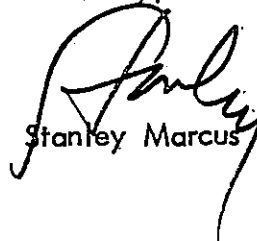
DEAR GEORGE:

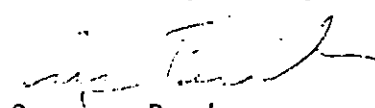

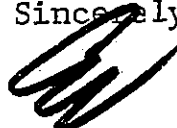
